- None

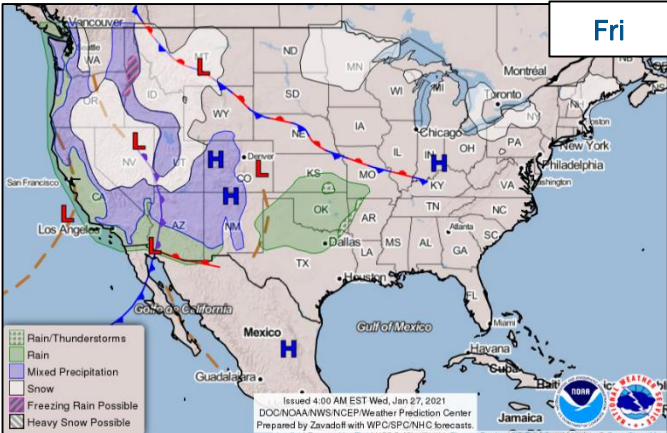
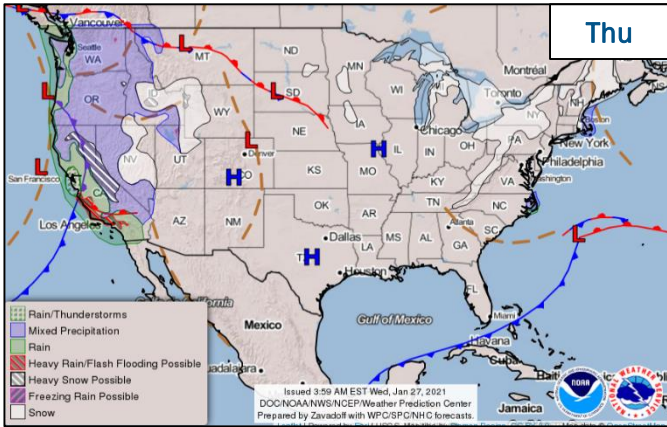
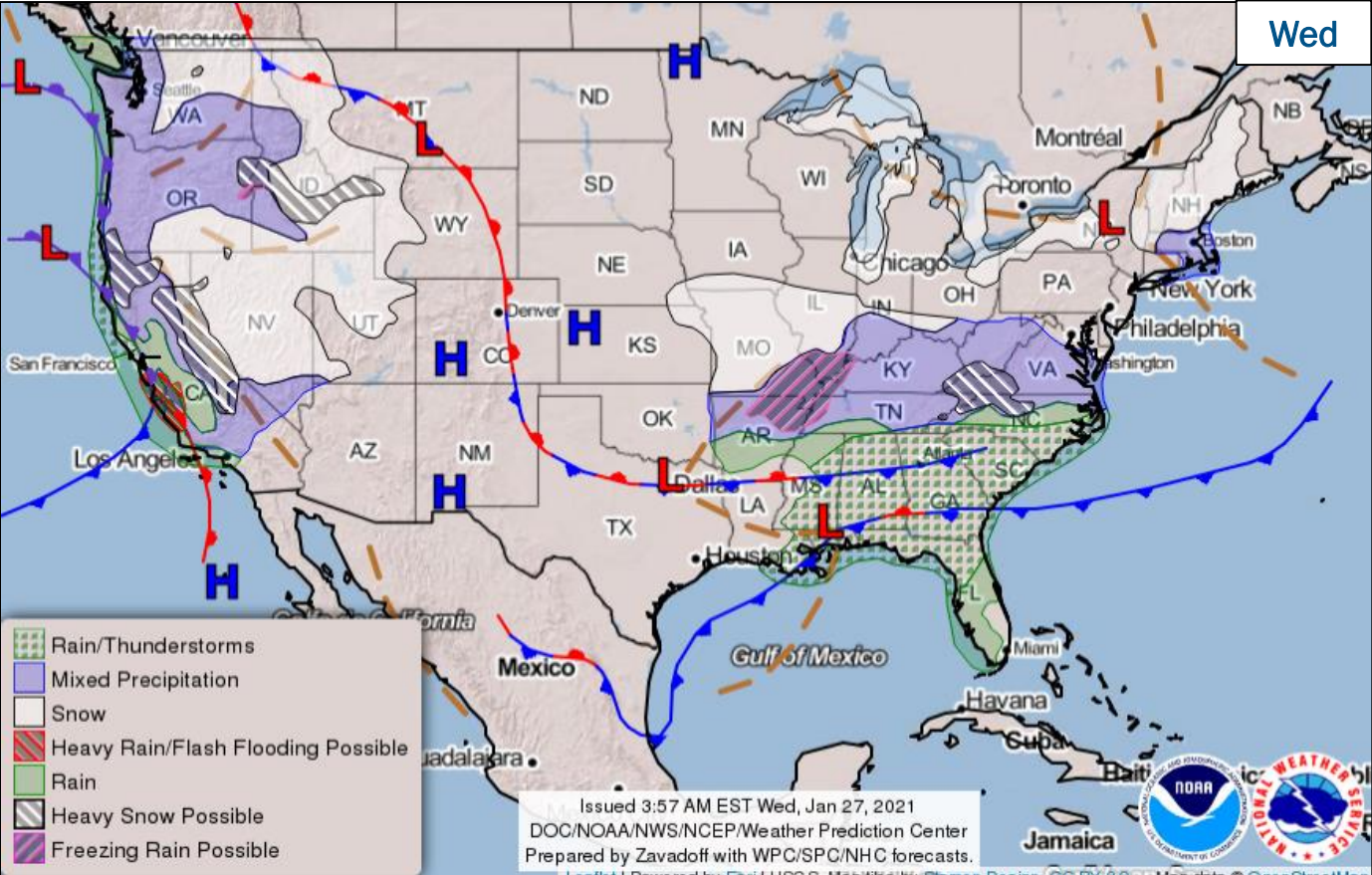

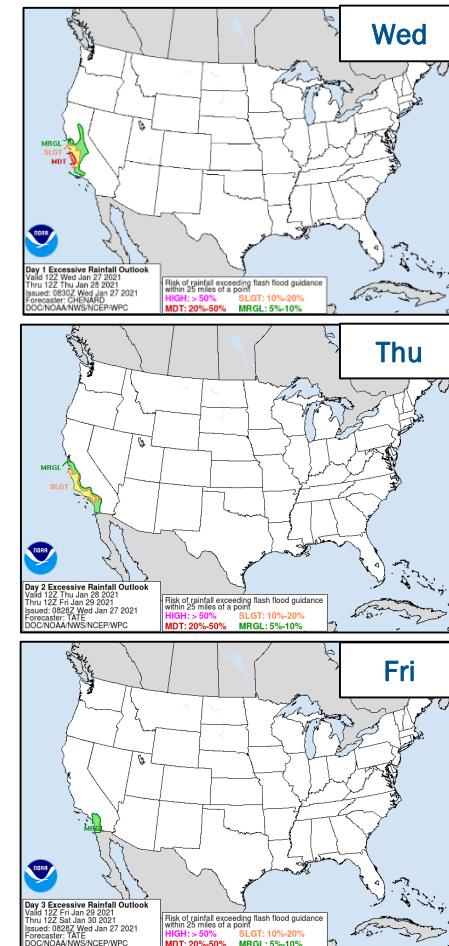
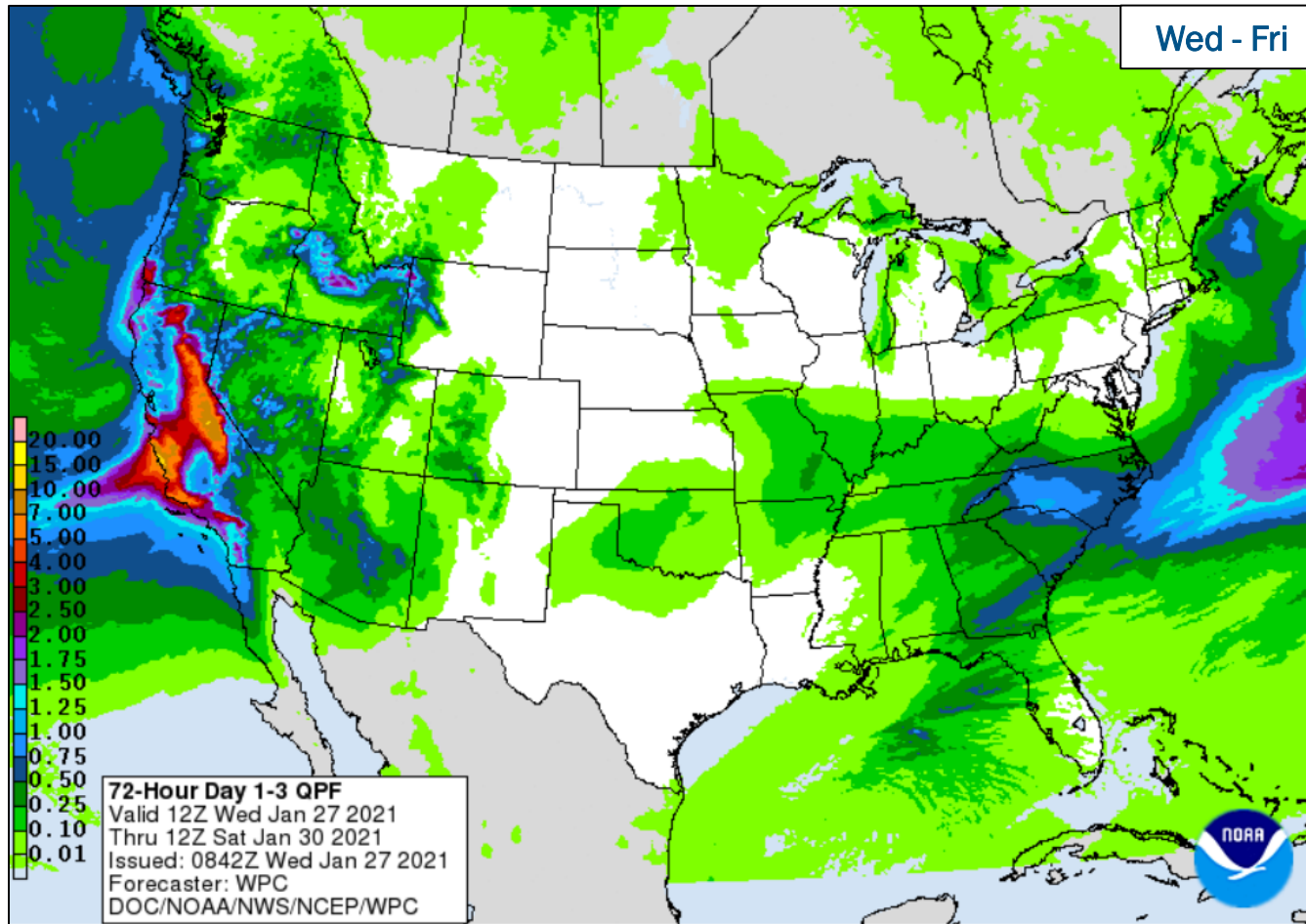
National Weather Forecast

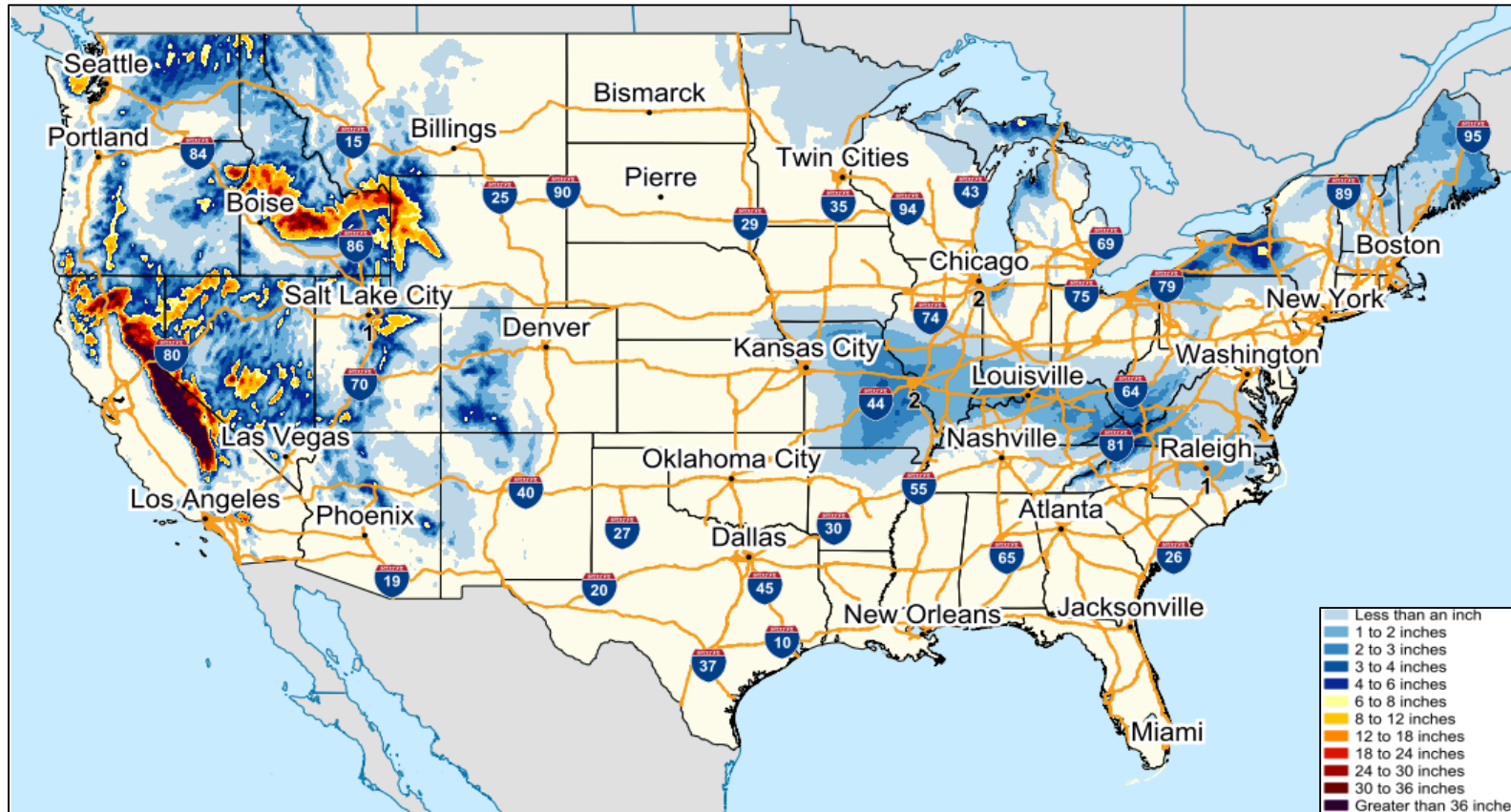

Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall



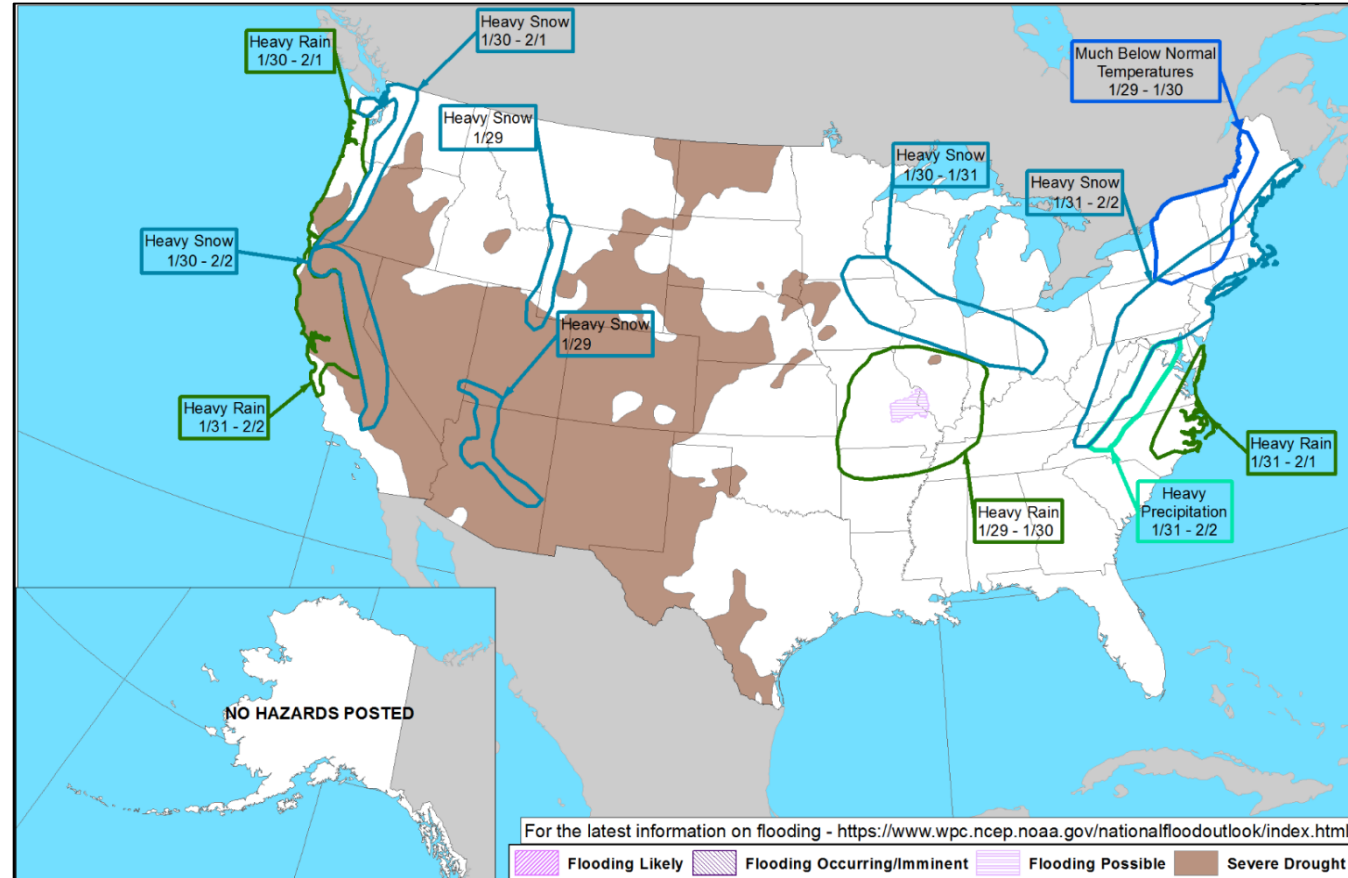

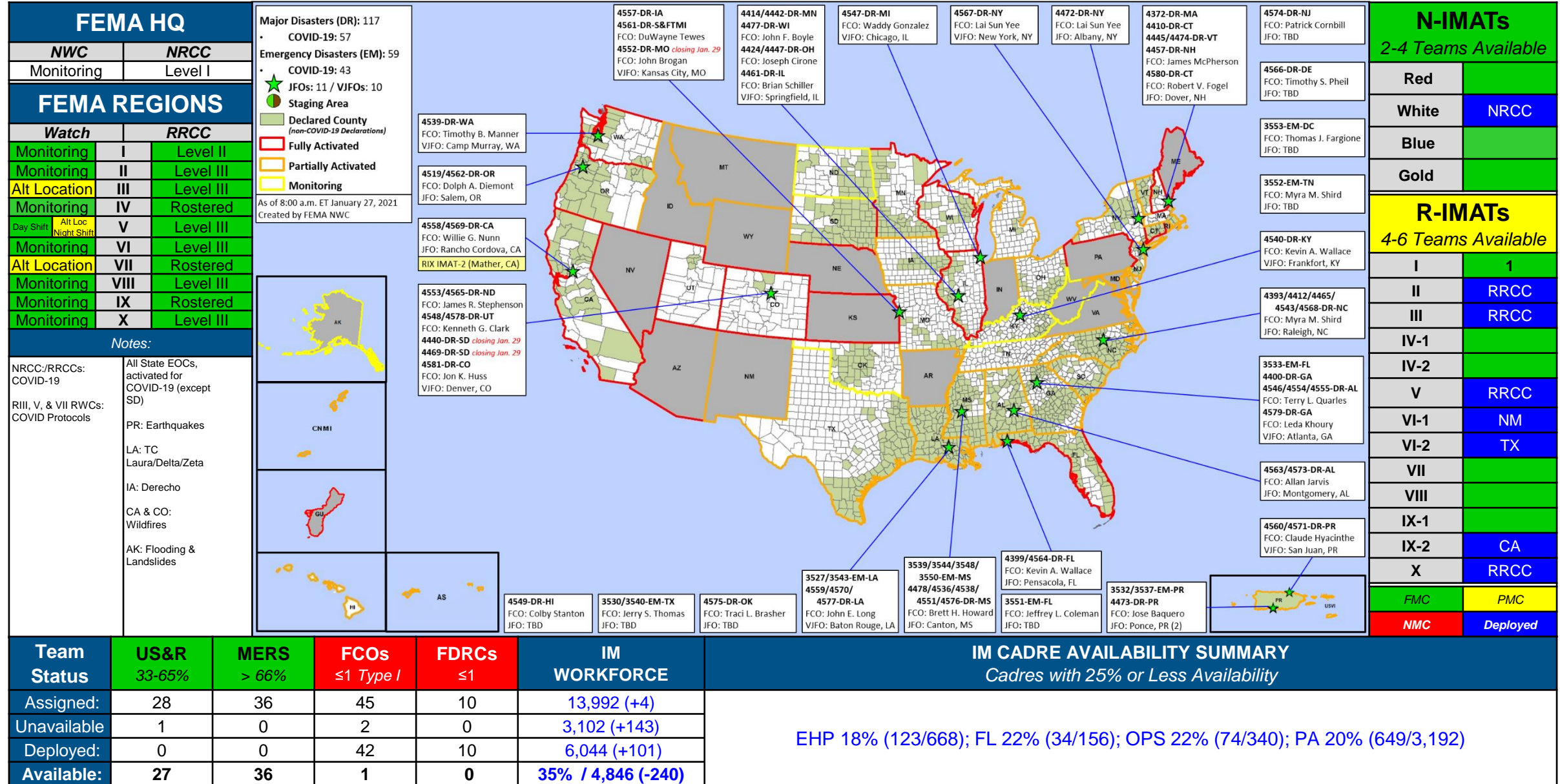
