### Situation

Invest 98P (as of midnight ET)

- 375 miles WNW of Pago Pago, American Samoa
- Moving SSE, maximum sustained winds 31-38 mph
- Potential for development of a significant tropical cyclone within the next 24 hours: High

Food, Water, Shelter

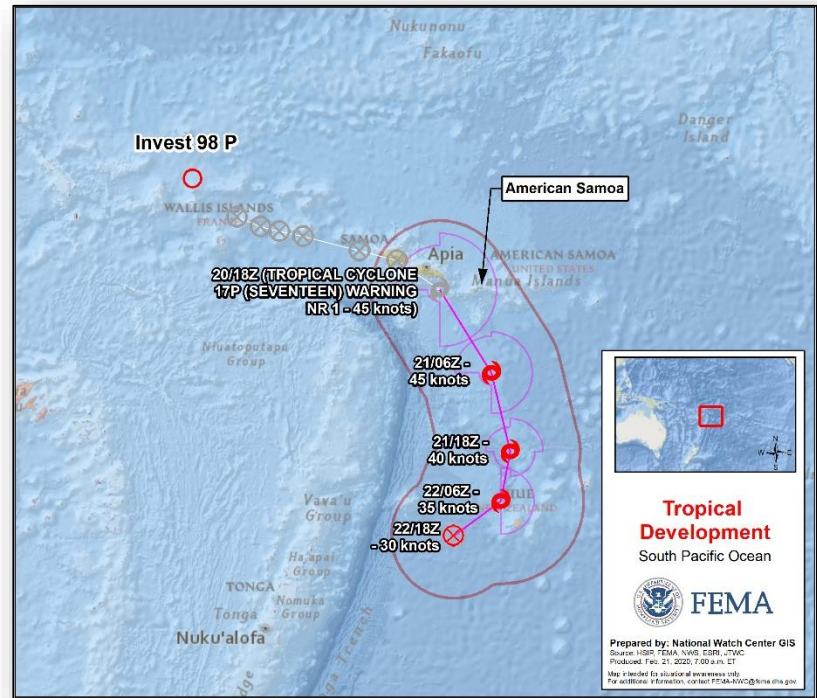
- 10 (+7) shelters open with 319 (+239) occupants (ARC Midnight Shelter Count, Feb 21)

### Territory / Local Preparations and Response

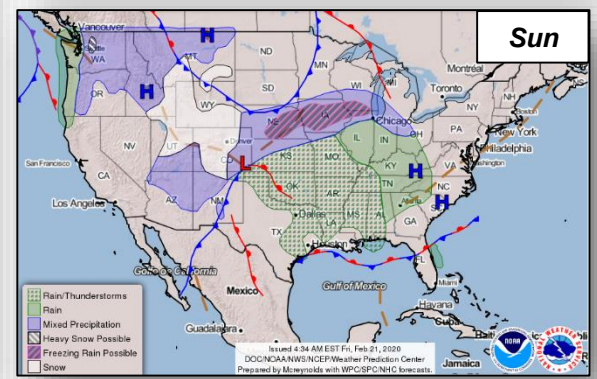
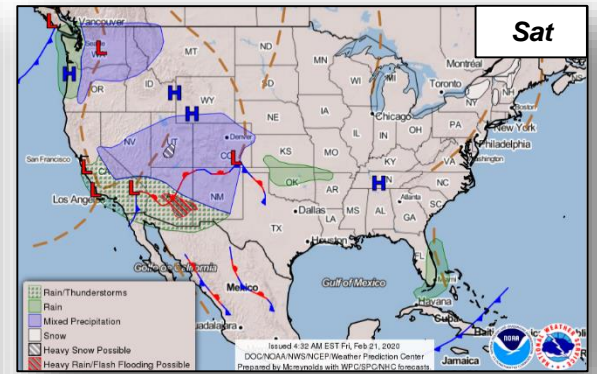
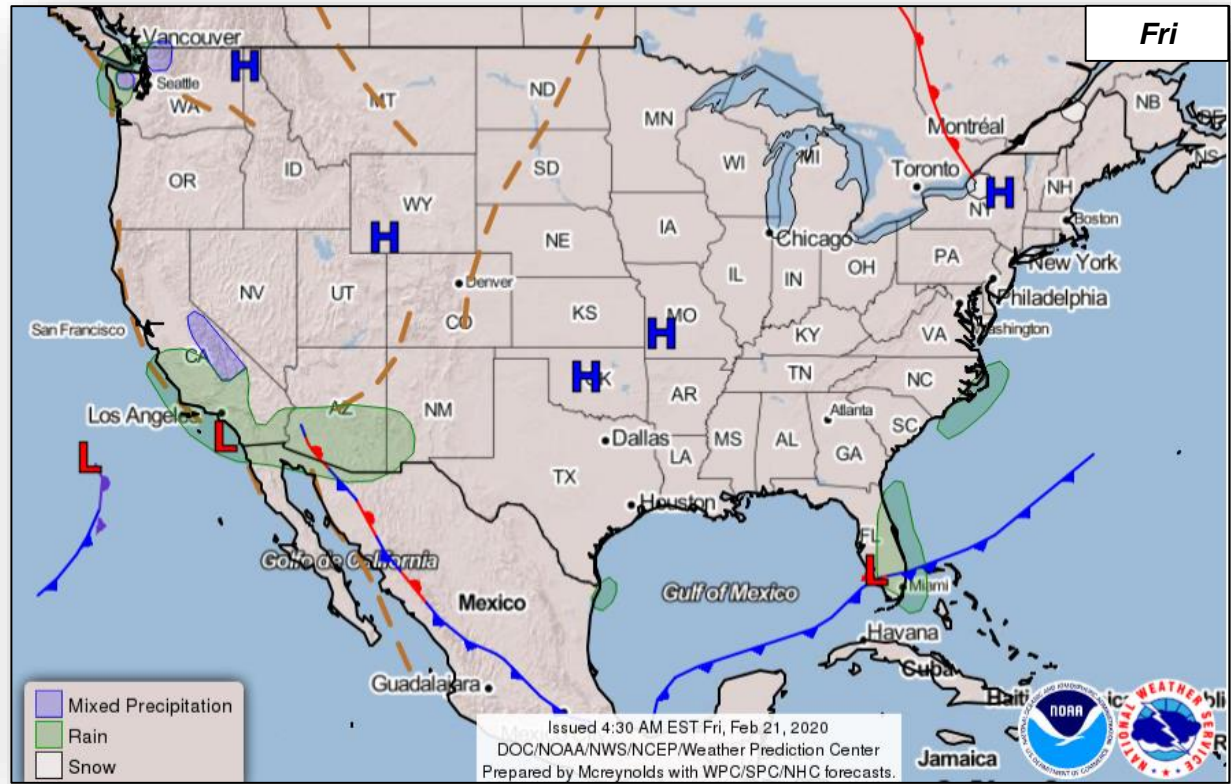
- American Samoa EOC at Full Activation (already activated for measles outbreak); no requests for FEMA assistance

- NWC and Region IX RWC at Steady State; continues to monitor



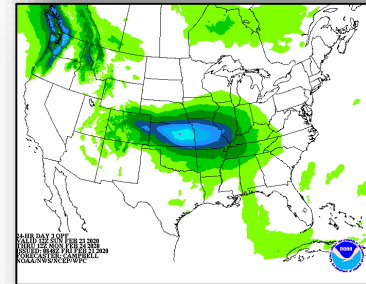
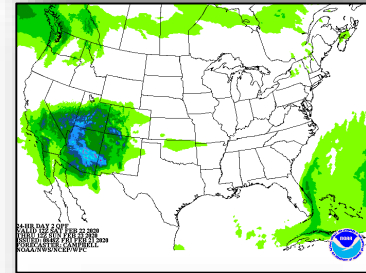
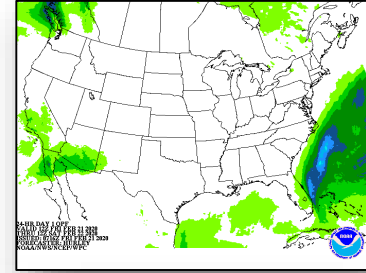
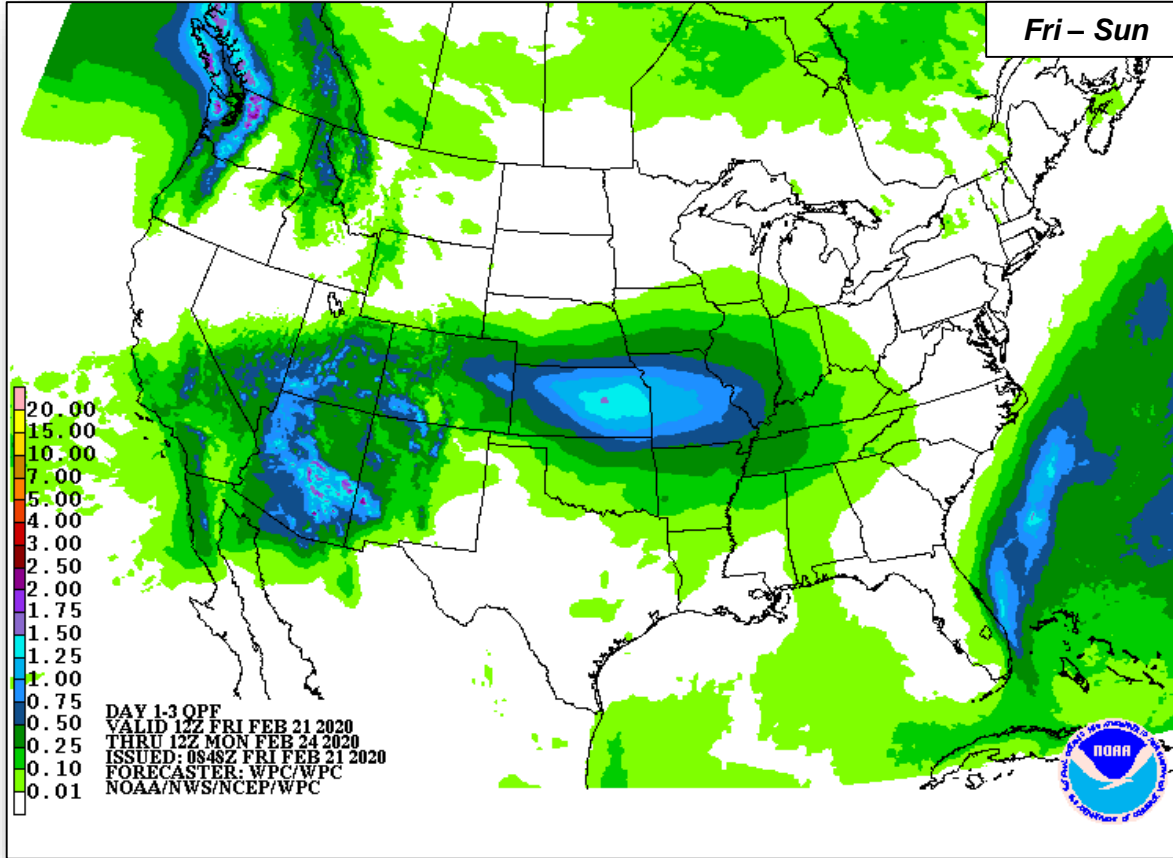
# National Weather Forecast



# Precipitation



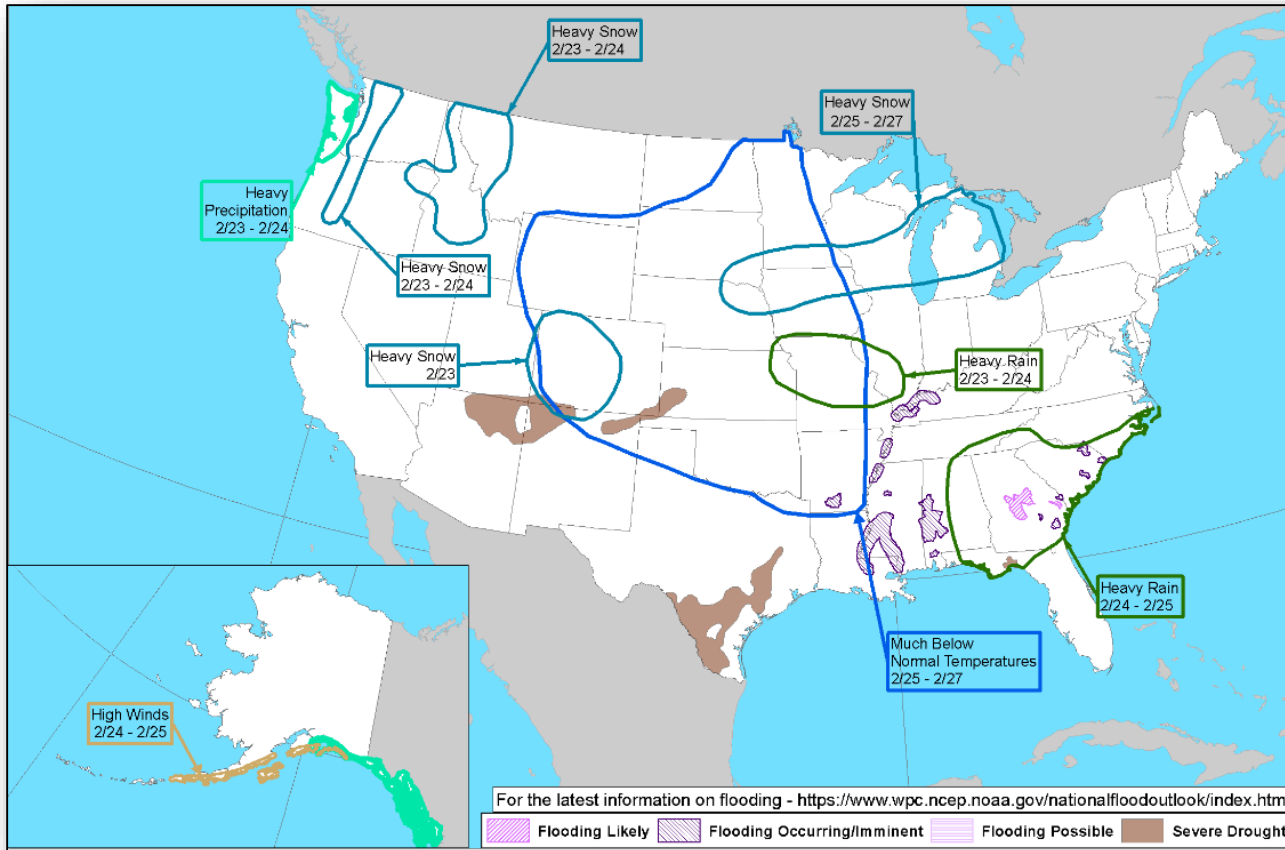

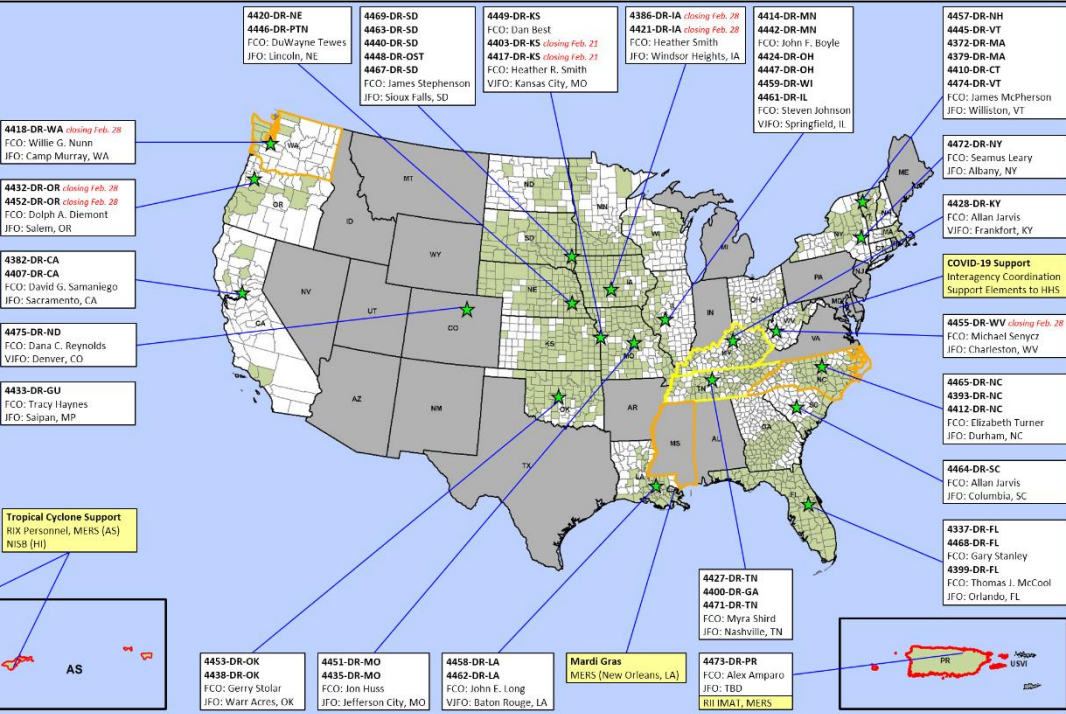
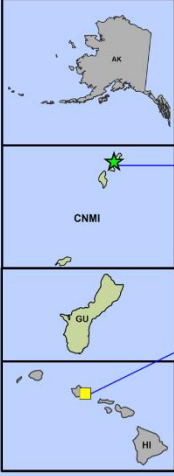
