COVID-19 Update



Situation: FEMA and HHS continue to work requirements supporting state, tribal, and territorial requests.

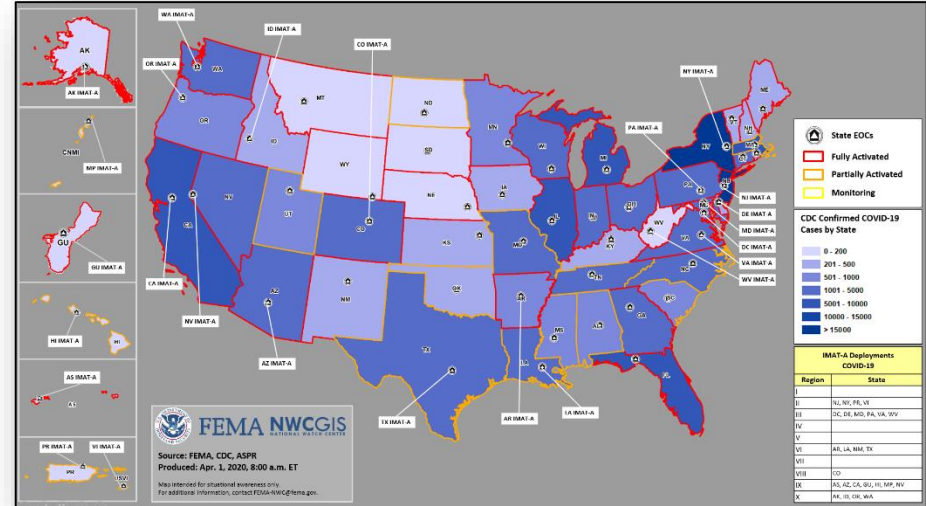
- All 50 states, the District of Columbia, 5 territories, and 16 tribal nations are working directly with FEMA under the nationwide emergency declaration (*HHS/FEMA COVID-19 SLB, as of 5:00 p.m. ET Mar 29*)
- FEMA is surging support to states seeing a steady increase of cases by using its Logistics Supply Chain Management System and working with HHS to deliver and track supplies and ventilators and expediting critical supplies from overseas to various U.S. locations
- FEMA is continuing to work with industry partners on distributing PPE; prioritizing sending ventilators and Federal Medical stations to areas in greatest need
- 30 (+6) states** and 12 tribes have issued shelter-in-place orders (*HHS/FEMA COVID-19 SLB, as of 5:00 p.m. ET Mar 31*)

State / Local Response:

- All State / Territories EOCs activated
- 4 additional Major Disaster Declaration requests were submitted (VA, IN, WI, and AR)**
- National Guard Bureau: Title 32 Status Approved 14 ; Title 32 Status Requested 20 (*HHS/FEMA COVID-19 SLB, as of 5:00 p.m. ET Mar 31*)

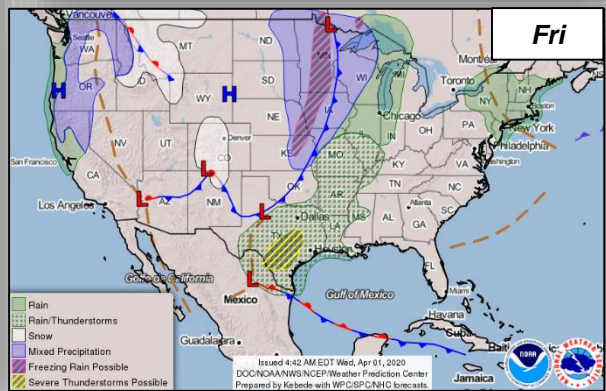
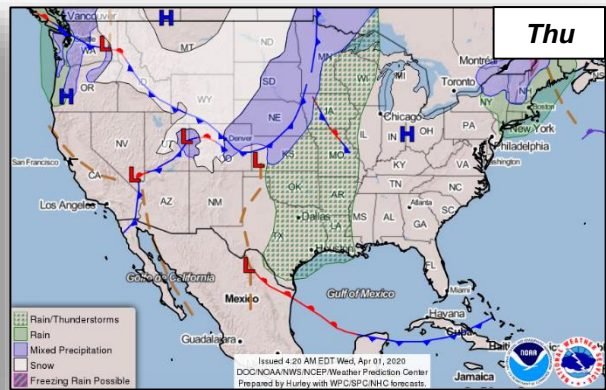
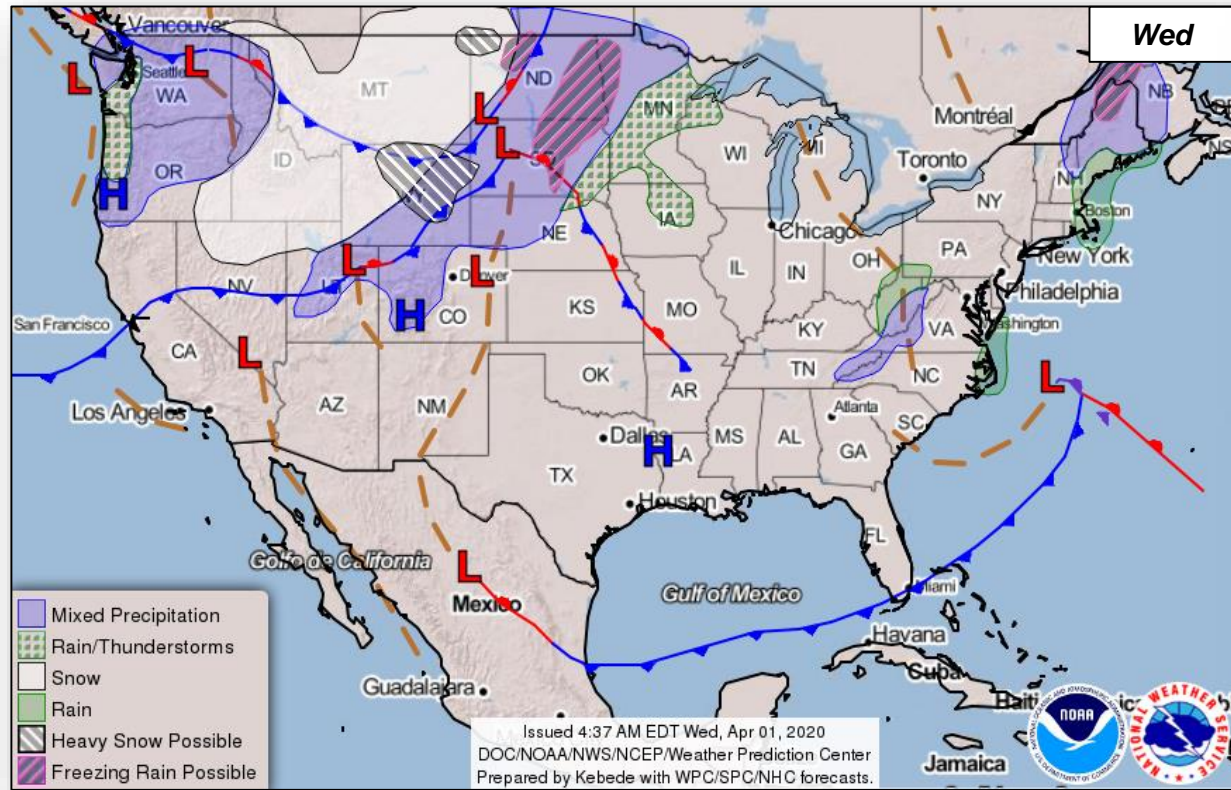
- NRCC: Level I in unified effort with HHS SOC; All RRCCs activated
- 26 (+2) IMAT-As** and 36 LNOs deployed
- USNS Comfort arrived in NYC Mar 30; USNS Mercy hospital ship is in Port of Long Beach, CA (*HHS/FEMA COVID-19 SLB, as of 5:00 p.m. ET Mar 31*)
- Dept. State posted Global Level 4 Health Advisory: Do Not Travel
- 29 (+2) Major Disaster Declarations approved and 11 (+2) Declarations in process**
- Eight task forces, jointly led by HHS and FEMA, continue work on assigned focus areas
- DoD will deploy two Navy Expeditionary Medical facilities; one each to TX and LA with approximately 200 medical personnel at each location (*US Northern Command Update, as of 2:59 p.m. ET Mar 30*)



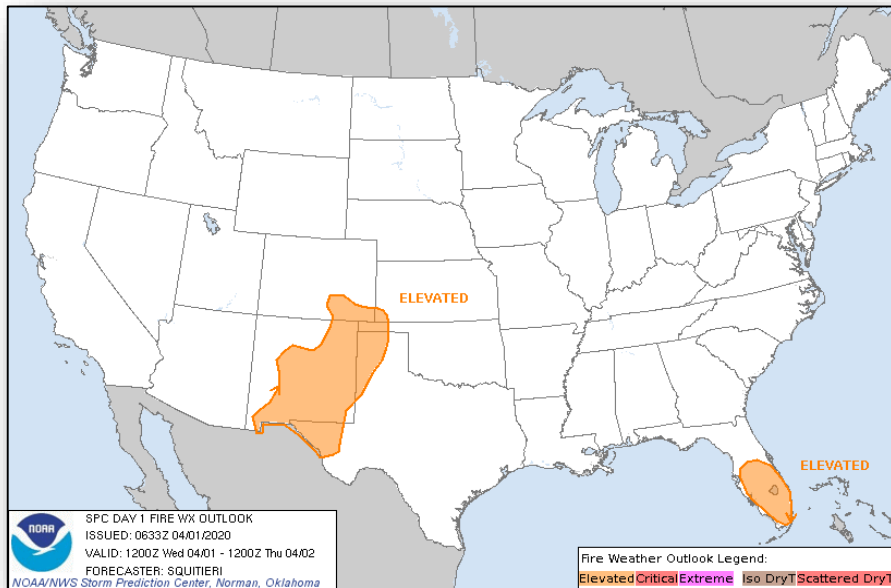

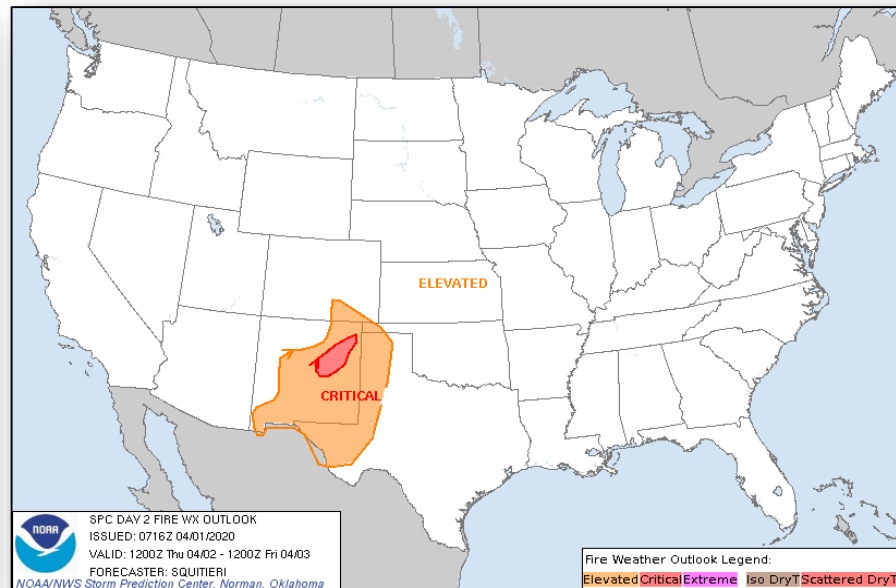
National Weather Forecast

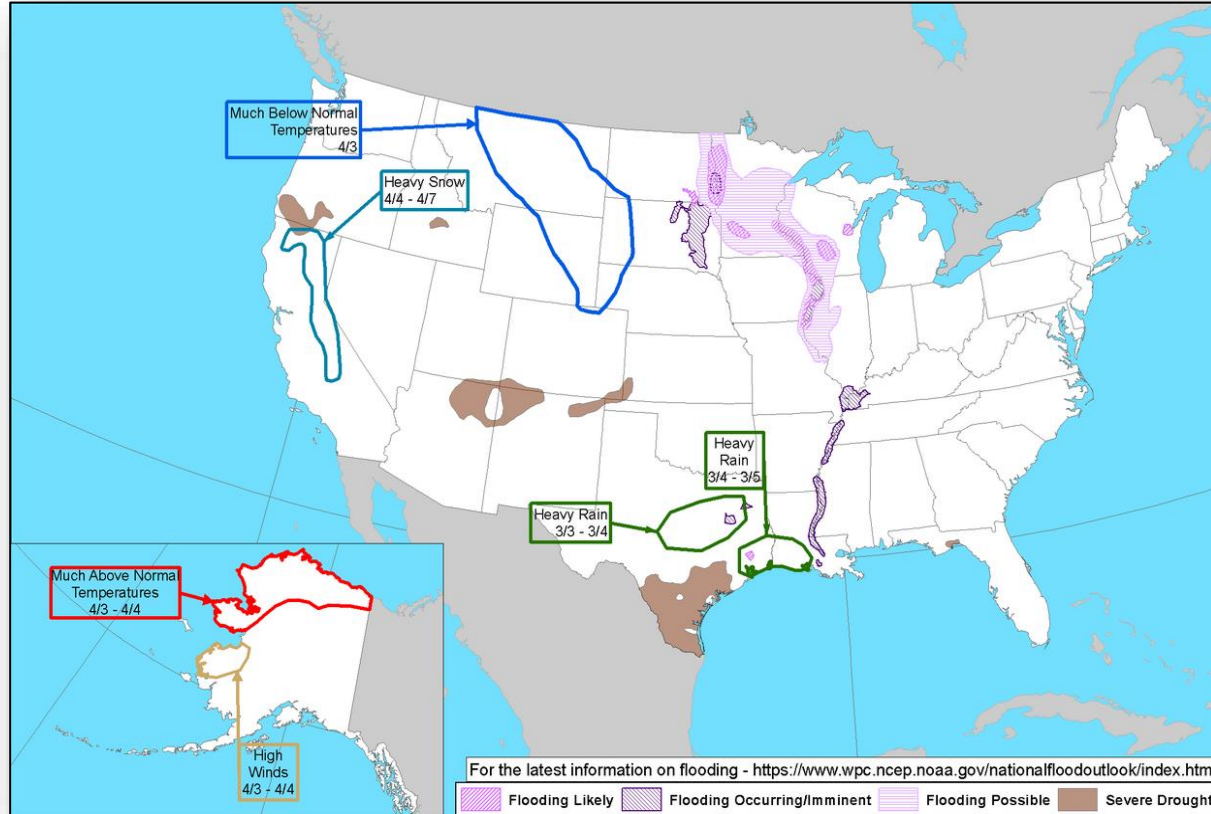

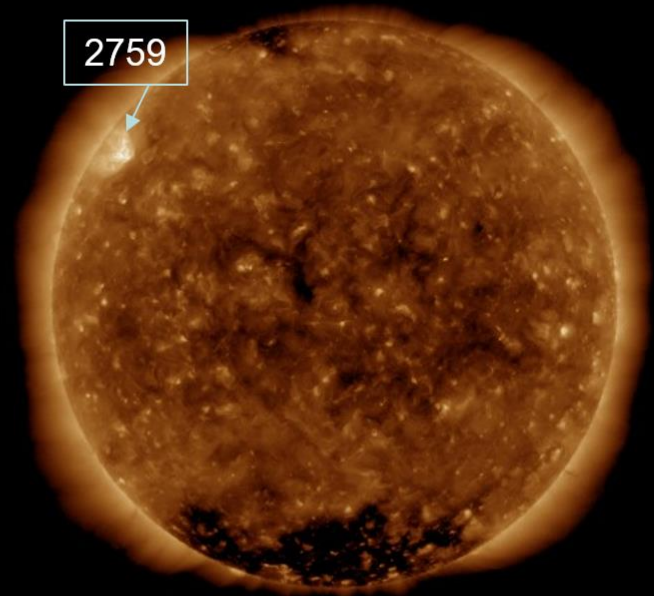
