COVID-19 Update



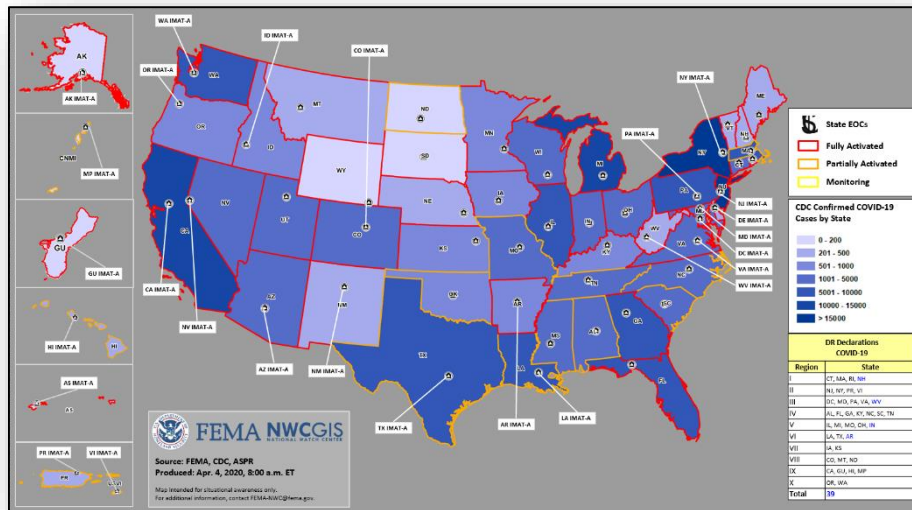
- Situation:** FEMA and HHS continue to work requirements to allocate and deliver key resources
- Working with industry partners on producing, allocating and distributing PPE and ventilators, including expediting critical supplies from overseas to various US locations
 - Coordinating with USACE on the build-out of alternate care sites (ACS), with significant expansion capacity
 - Regional Administrators are coordinating with governors, tribal leaders, state emergency managers, and state public health officials to execute a whole of government response to fight the COVID-19 pandemic

State / Local Response:

- All State / Territory EOCs activated
- All 50 states, DC, 5 territories and 21 (+3) tribal nations working on nationwide Emergency Declarations
- 40 states (+9), D.C., 4 territories (+4) and 12 tribes issued shelter-in-place orders (*COVID-19 SLB, 12:00 pm April 3*)
- National Guard Bureau (*COVID-19 SLB, as of 5:00 p.m. ET Apr 4*)
 - Title 32 Status approved: 25
 - Title 32 Status requested: 21

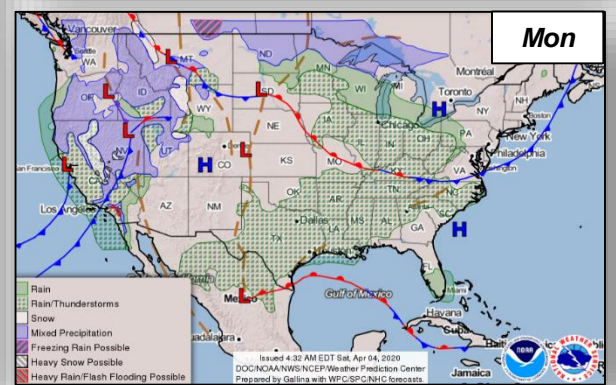
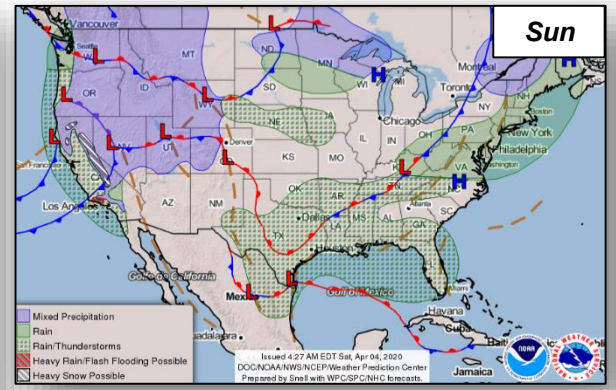
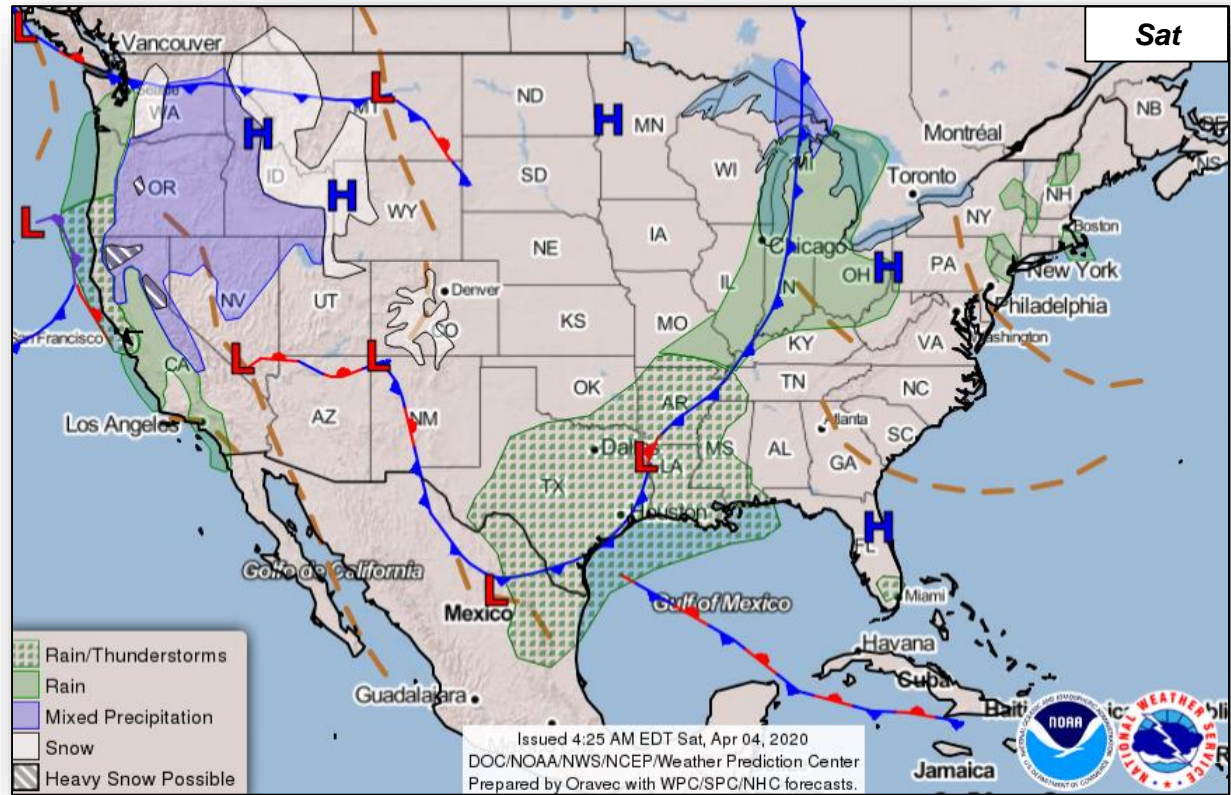
- NRCC: Level I in unified effort with HHS SOC; all RRCs activated
- IMAT-A teams deployed to 26 states; 37 LNOs deployed to state, territories, and tribes
- USNS Mercy 0/247 beds filled; 1/80 ICU beds filled (*HHS/FEMA COVID-19 SLB, as of 5:00 p.m. ET Apr 3*)
- USNS Comfort 12/275 beds filled; 0/80 ICU beds filled (*HHS/FEMA COVID-19 SLB, as of 5:00 p.m. ET Apr 3*)
- U.S. Coast Guard facilitated the arrival of 2 cruise ships in Florida; processing 1,200 passengers expected to take 2-3 days (*COVID-19 SLB, 12:00 pm April 3*)
- 39 (+4) Major Disaster Declarations approved and 11 Major Disaster Declarations in process
- Eight task forces, jointly led by HHS and FEMA, continue work on assigned focus areas
- DoD deployed two Navy Expeditionary Medical facilities; one each to TX and LA (*USNORTHCOM, as of 2:59 p.m. ET Mar 30*)

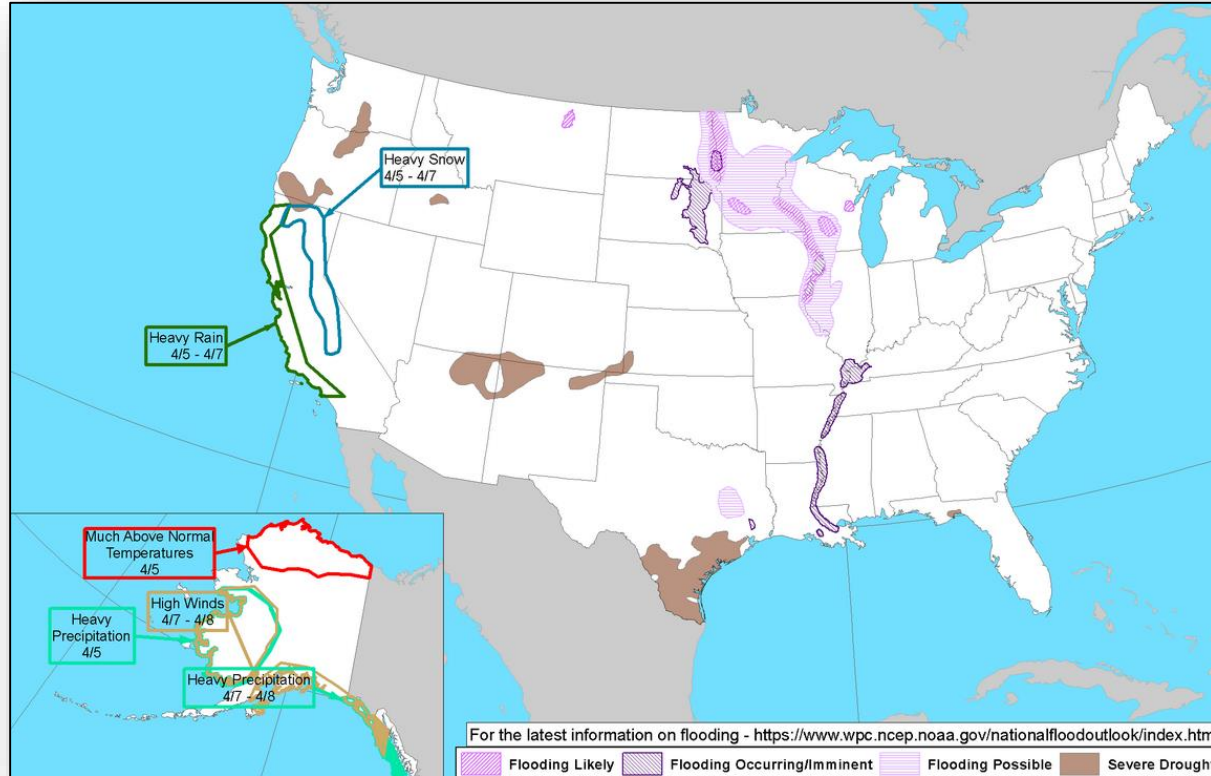
National Weather Forecast
