
Lifeline Impacts

Food, Water, & Sheltering

- Warming Centers remain open throughout the impacted regions *Health & Medical*
- 3 confirmed fatalities and numerous temperature related injuries (FEMA Reg V) Energy
- Minimal Power Outages reported throughout the effected regions *Communications*
- USPS mail delivery remains suspended for much of the Upper Midwest *Transportation*
- 6k flights canceled and 4k delays in the past 24 hours (FlightAware)
- Rail service modified or cancelled this week for some Midwest Amtrak routes

State/Local Response

- NYS, IL, and WI EOCs at Partial Activation
- KY and MI EOCs at Monitoring
- Governor declared a State of Emergency for VA, IL, WI, and MI



- No FEMA assistance requested


Winter Weather Outlook






National Weather Forecast






Precipitation Forecast







