# National Current Operations & Monitoring



## Significant Incidents or Threats:

- CA Wildfires - Kincade Fire, Getty Fire
- Extreme fire weather – CA
- Heavy rain / flash flooding possible – Tennessee Valley to Mid-Atlantic

## Tropical Activity:

- Atlantic: Disturbance 1: Medium (50%)
- Eastern Pacific: Disturbance 1: Low (20%)
- Central Pacific: No new tropical cyclones expected during the next five days
- Western Pacific: No activity affecting U.S. interests

**Declaration Activity:** None

# Wildfires – CA



## Situation:

- Wildfires occurring in northern CA (Kincade Fire, Sonoma County) and southern CA (Getty Fire, Los Angeles County)
- Extremely critical, life-threatening fire weather continues across CA through Thursday
- Damaging wind gusts between 50 and 70 mph likely for Los Angeles and Ventura counties

## Lifeline Impacts: *(Region IX SLB as of 10:00 p.m. EDT Oct 29)*

### Safety and Security:

- Mandatory evacuations:
  - Kincade Fire: 159k people and 3 tribes in Sonoma County
  - Getty Fire: 16k people

### Food, Water, Shelter: *(ESF-6 as of 6:00 a.m. EDT Oct 30)*

- Kincade Fire: 17 (+1) shelters open with 2,827 (-389) occupants
- Getty Fire: 0 (-4) shelters open with 0 (-19) occupants

### Health and Medical: *(Region IX SLB as of 10:00 p.m. EDT Oct 29)*

- 15 facilities evacuated / 45 impacted facilities

### Energy: *(Eagle-1 as of 6:30 a.m. EDT Oct 30)*

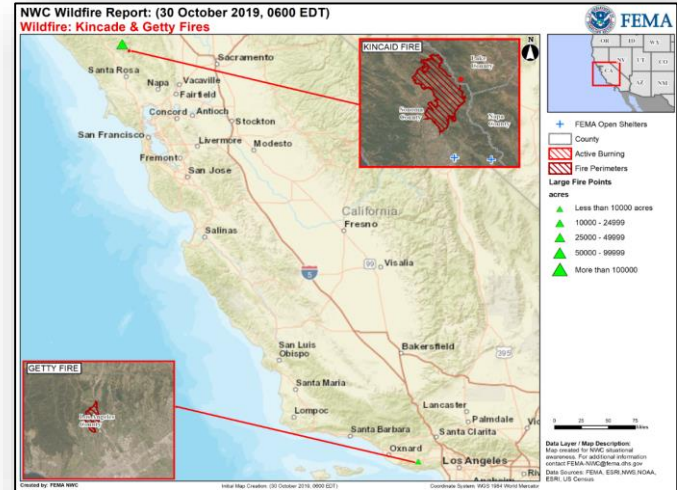
- Statewide: Approx. 404k customers (2.8%) without power due to fires and power shutoff; numbers are trending downward
- PG&E may enact public safety shutoff up to 1 million between now and Friday evening; *(Region IX SPOTREP as of 2:00 p.m. EDT Oct 29)*
- Edison power in southern CA up to 800k during same time frame *(CALOES as of 2:00 p.m. EDT Oct 29)*

### Communication: *(Region IX SLB as of 10:00 p.m. EDT Oct 29)*

- Cell towers: 402 (-61) sites offline and 669 (-16) sites on generators

### Transportation: *(Region IX SLB as of 10:00 p.m. EDT Oct 29)*

- Road closures, multiple public transportation detours, delays and service cancelations



## State/Local Response

- CA EOC at Full Activation
- Governor declared a statewide emergency; National Guard activated

## FEMA/Federal Response:

- FMAG FEMA-5295-FM-CA approved for Kincade (10/24)
- FMAG FEMA-5297-FM-CA approved for Getty (10/28)
- Region IX RWC at Steady State, continues to monitor
  - IMAT-1, [select ESFs](#), and 2 LNOs deployed to CA EOC
- ISB/SMT and MERS deployed to CA
- NWC at Steady State, continues to monitor

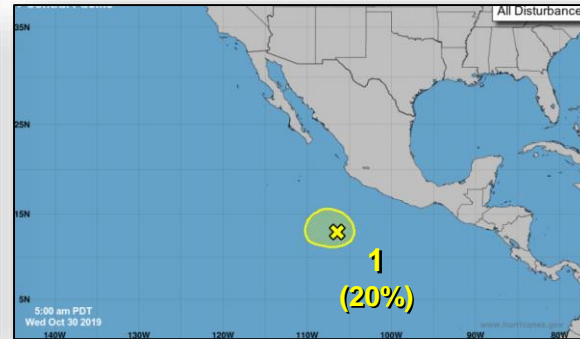

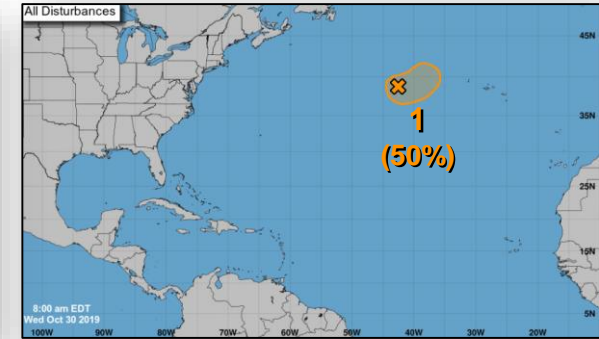

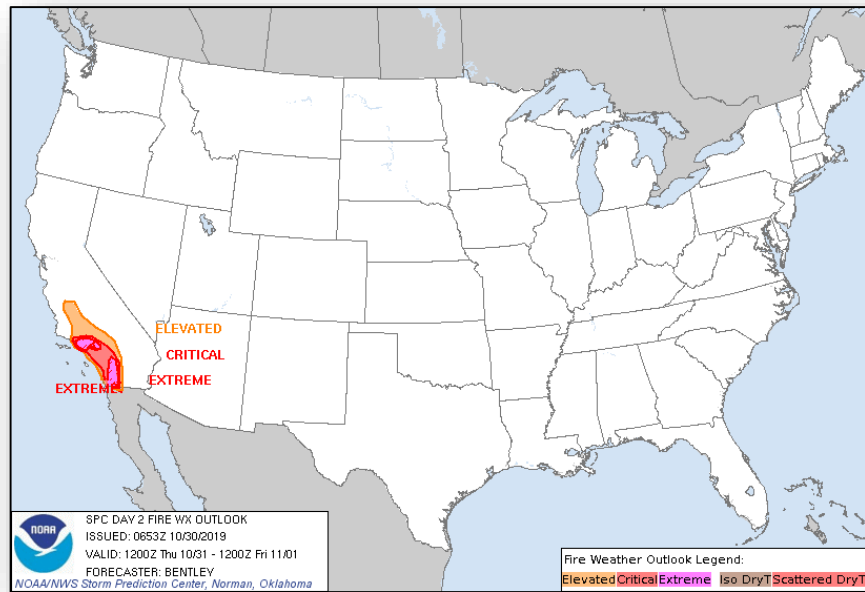

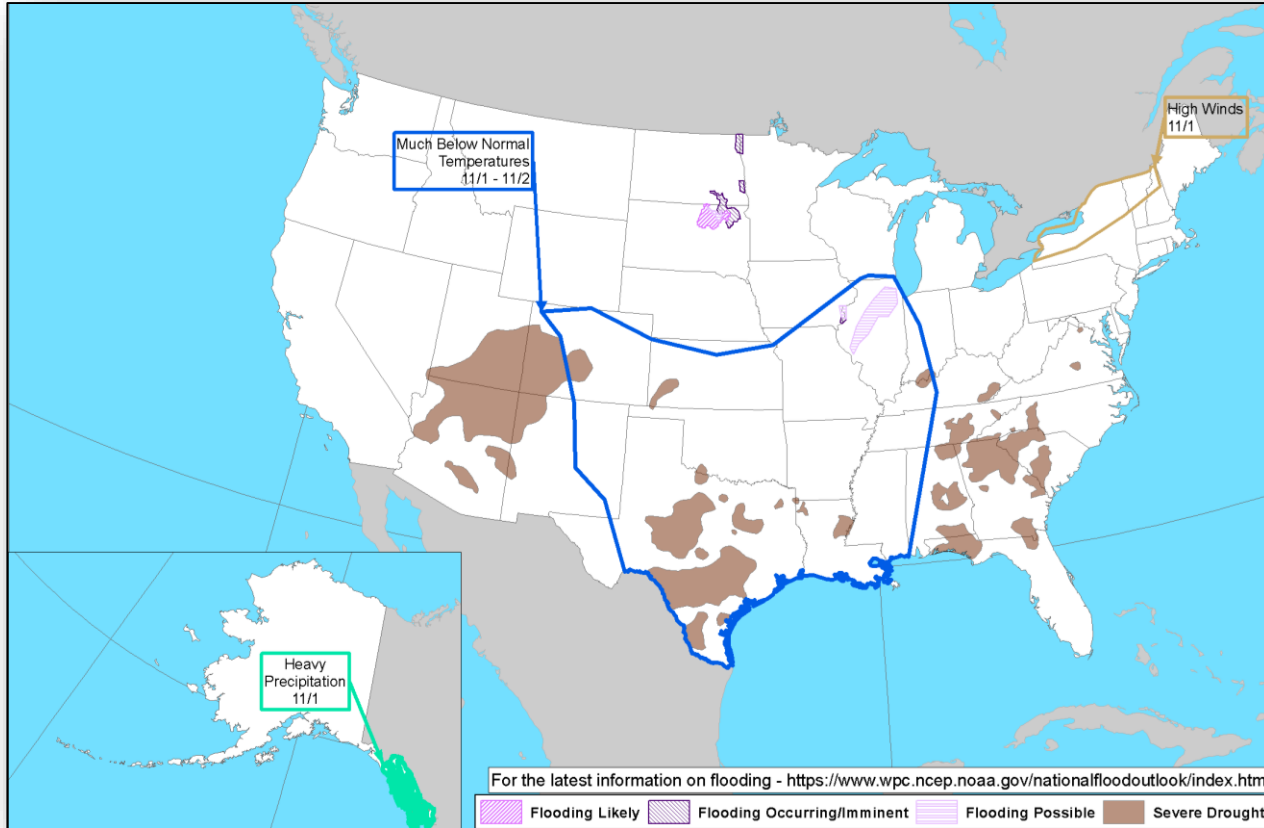
