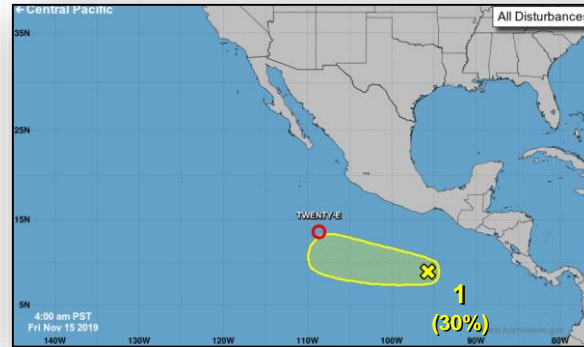
- Atlantic: No new tropical cyclones expected during the next five days

- Expected to become a tropical storm today

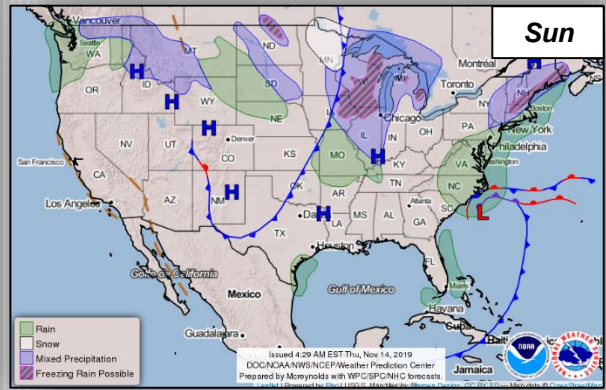
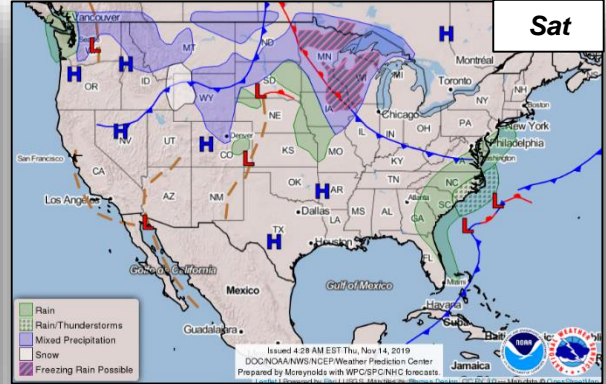
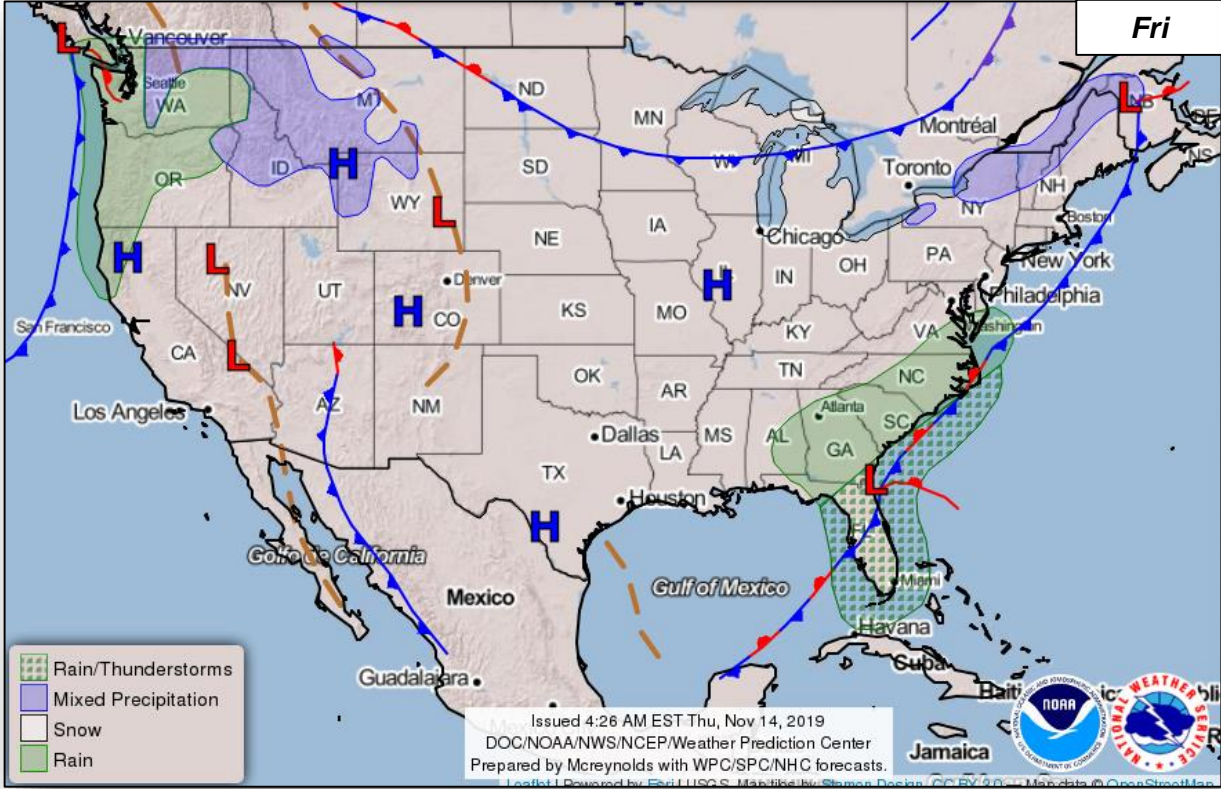

National Weather Forecast



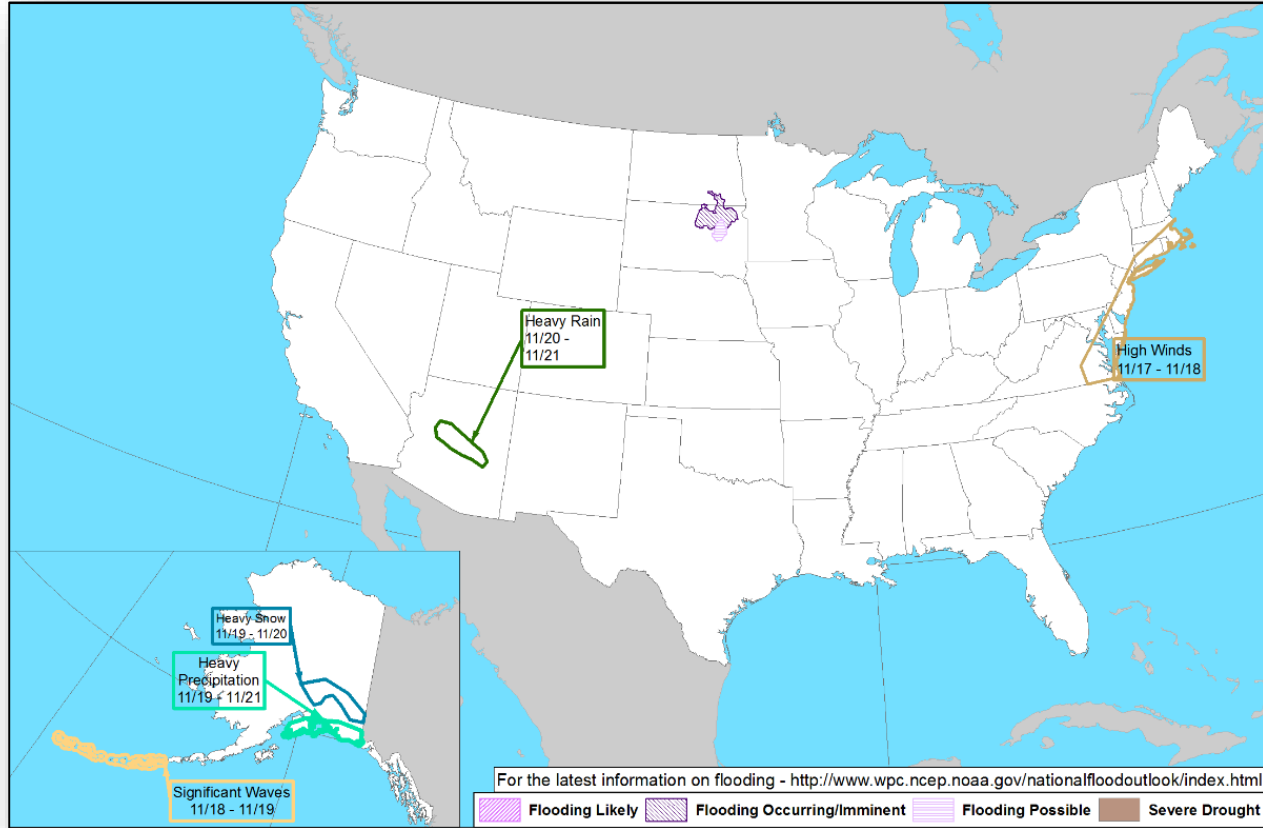
Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall
