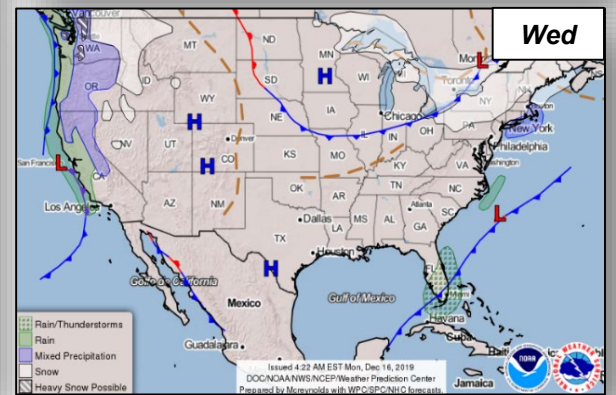

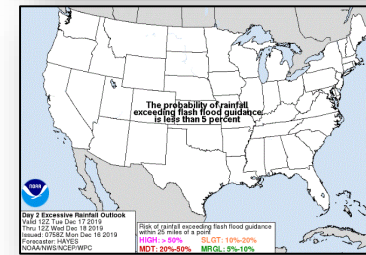
Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall



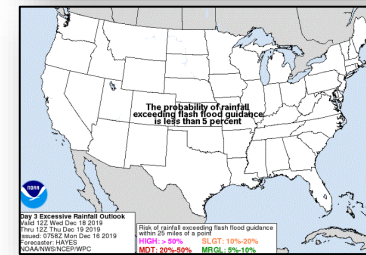

Severe Weather Outlook



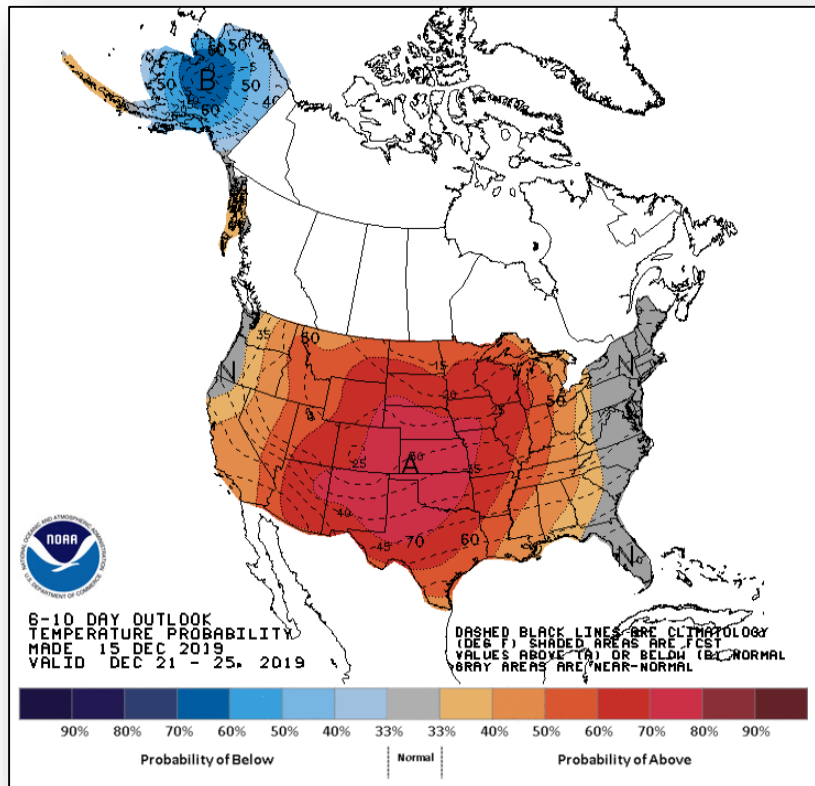

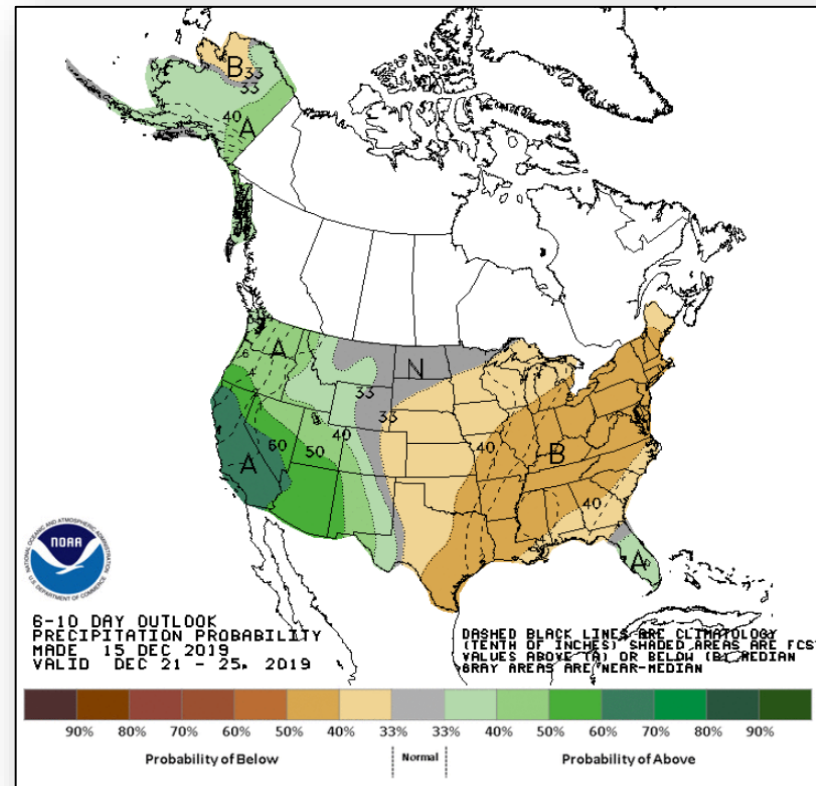
Long Range Outlooks – Dec 21-25

6-10 Day Precipitation Probability

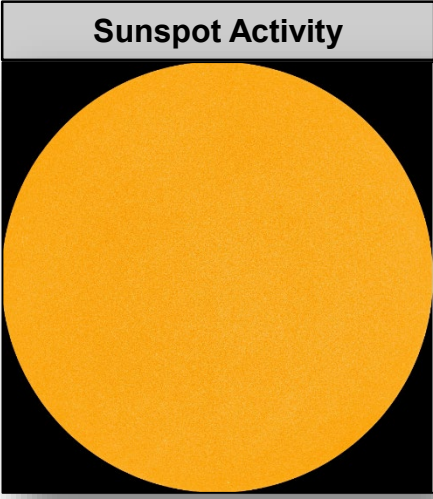
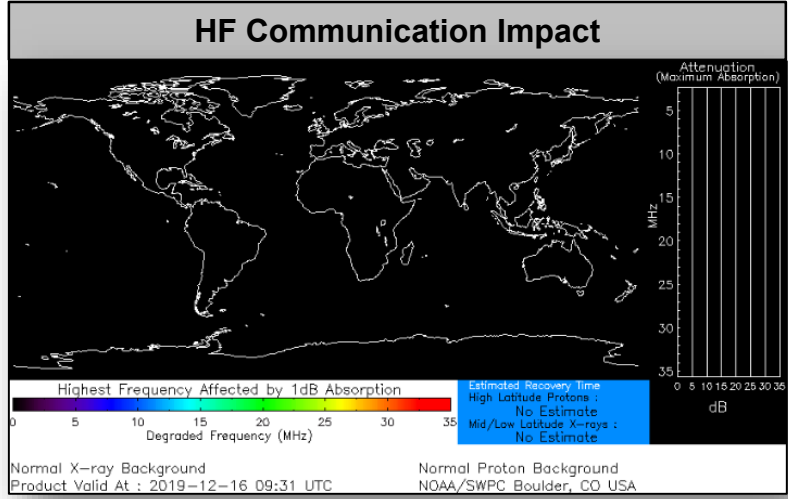

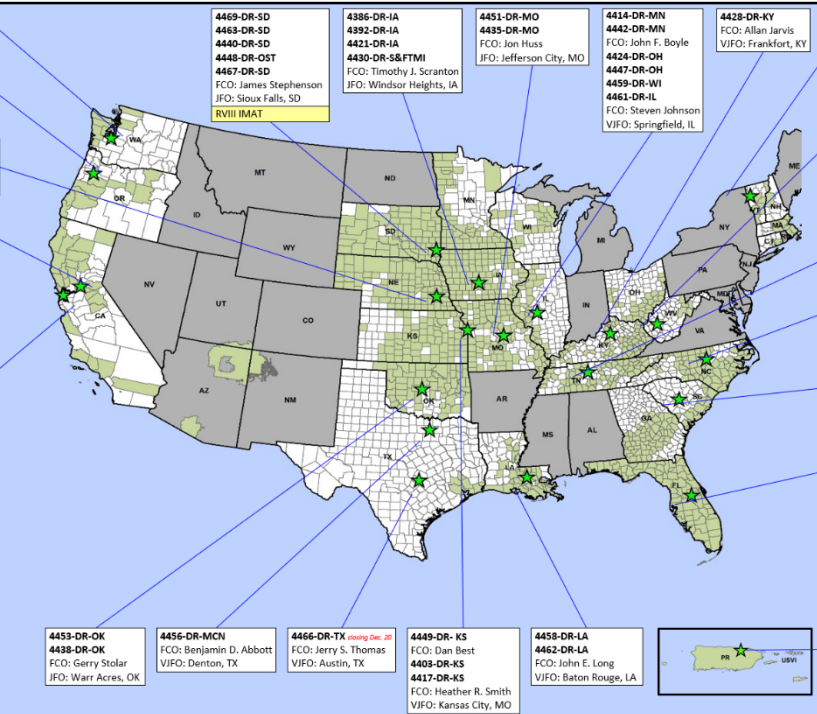
