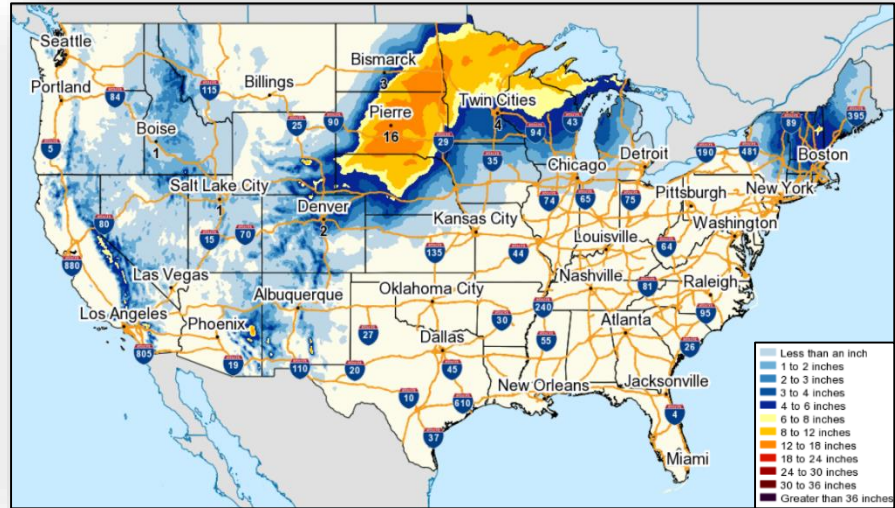
# Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall



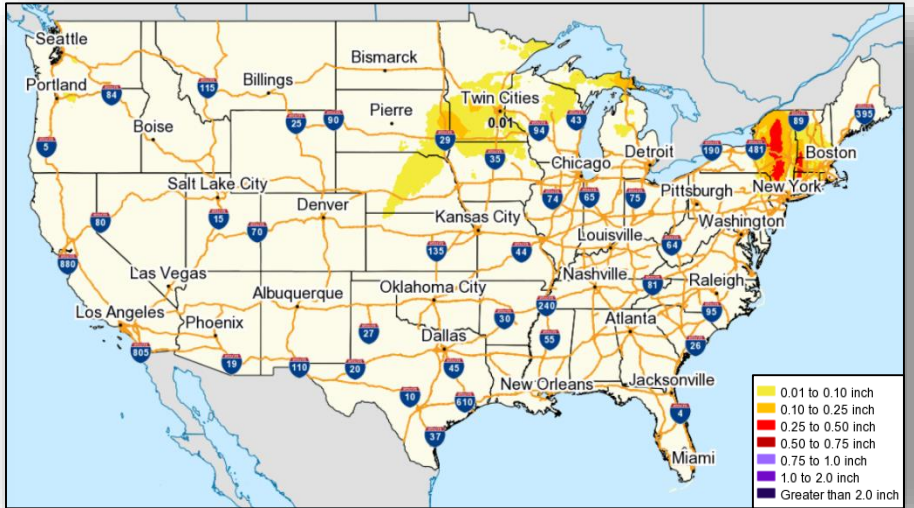

# Winter Precipitation Outlook

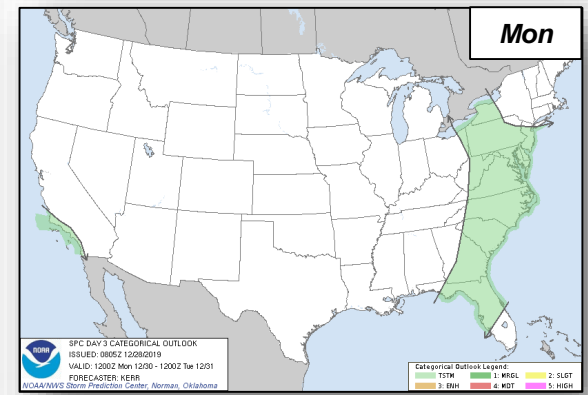
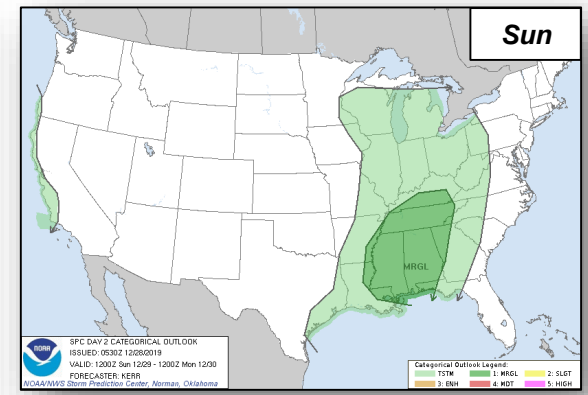
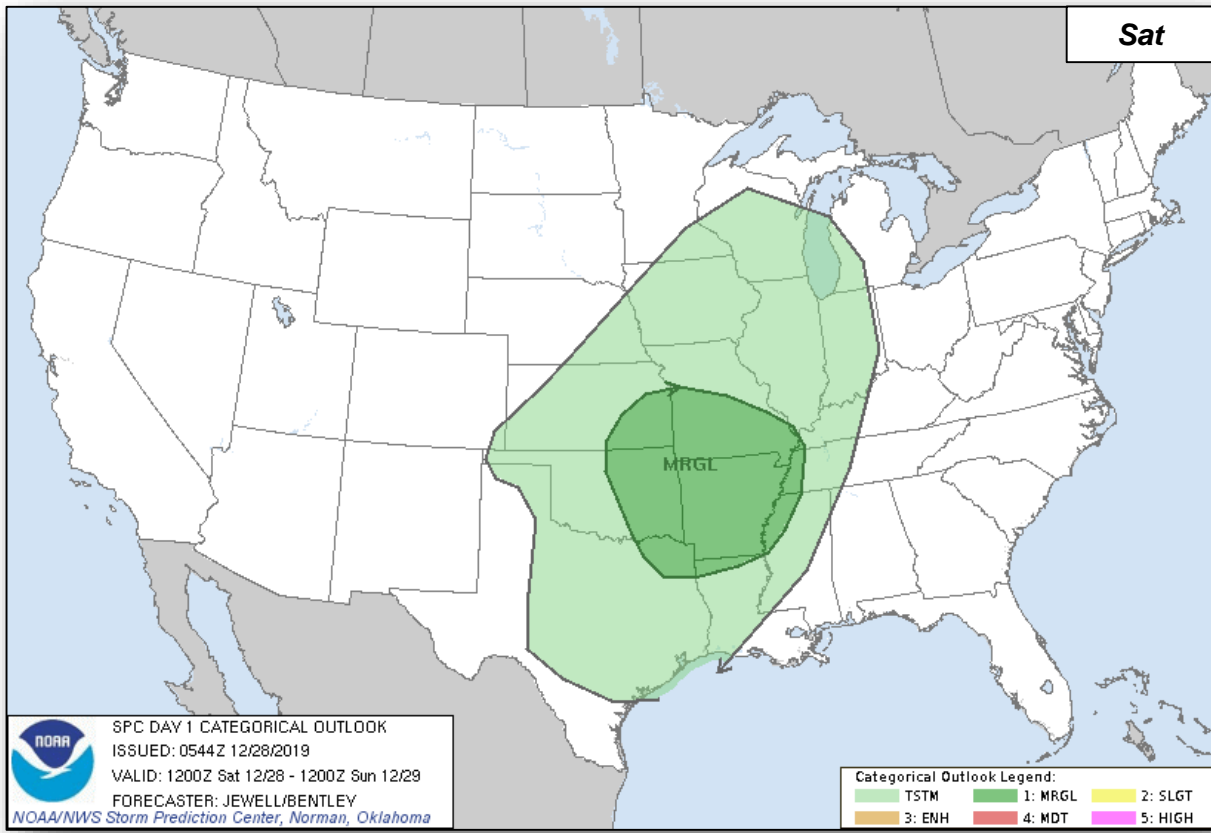


**Forecast Snowfall**



**Forecast Ice Accumulation**

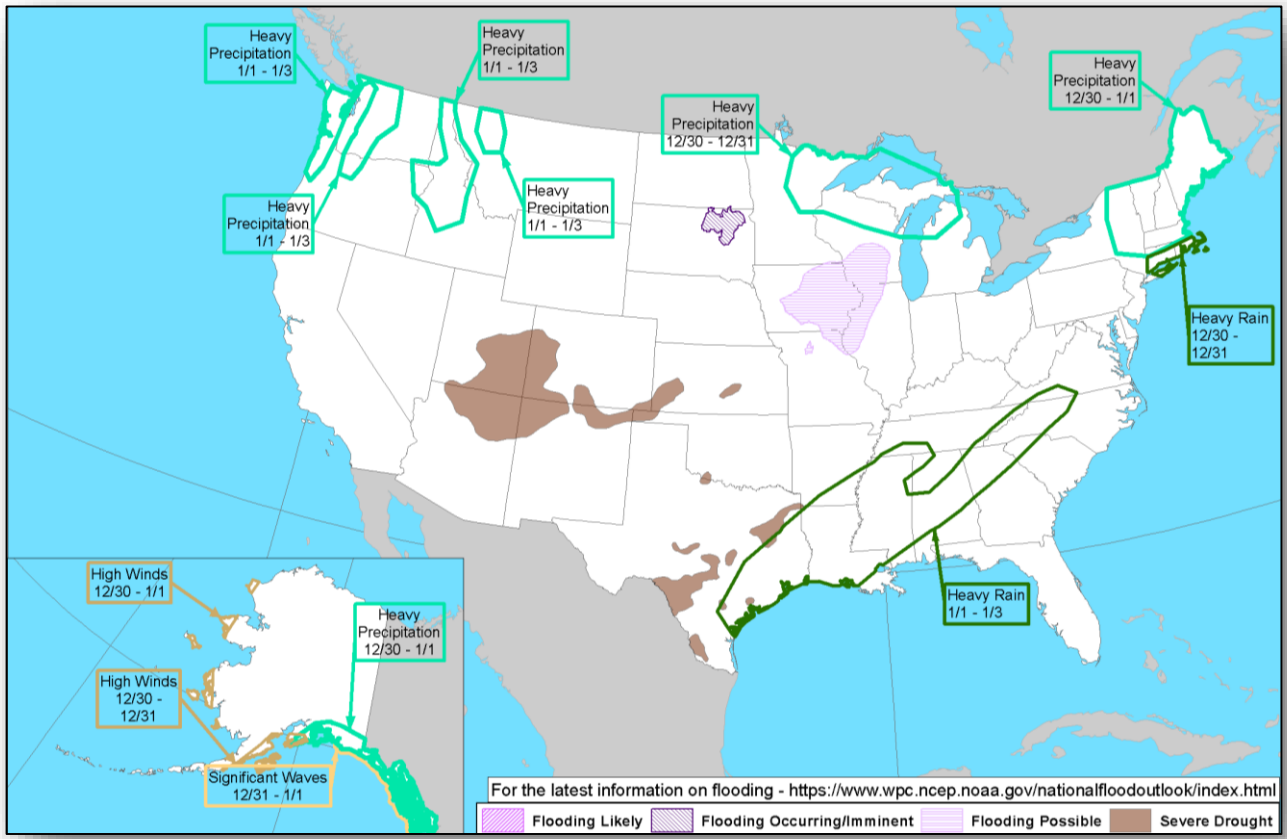
