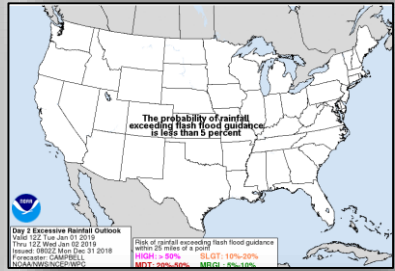
# Precipitation / Excessive Rainfall Forecast



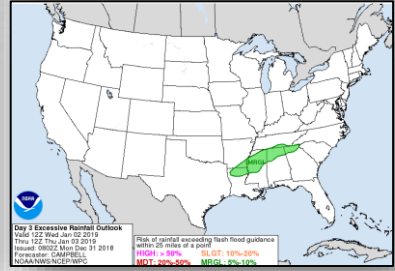

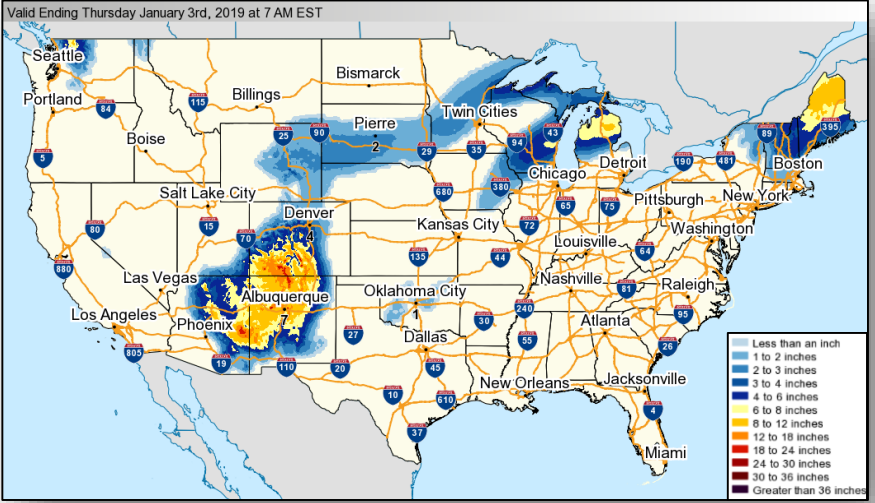

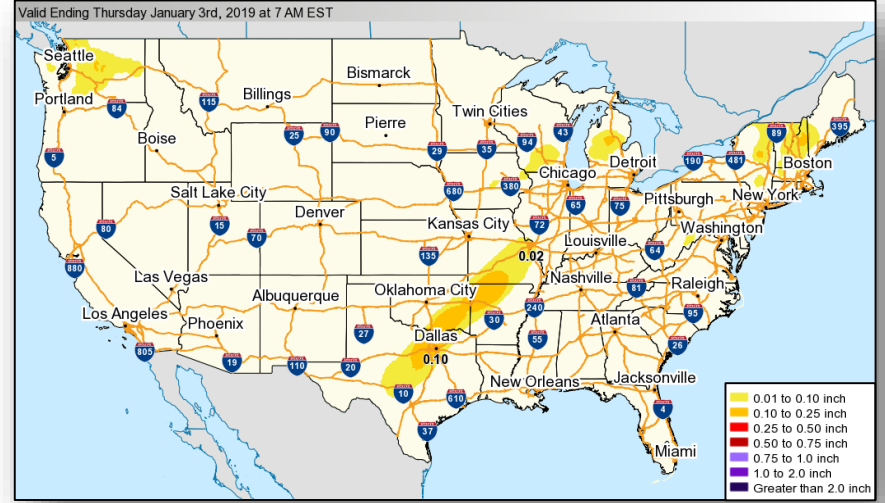

**Forecast Snowfall**

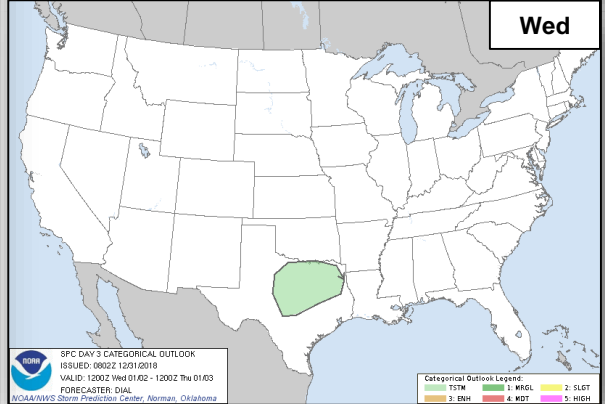
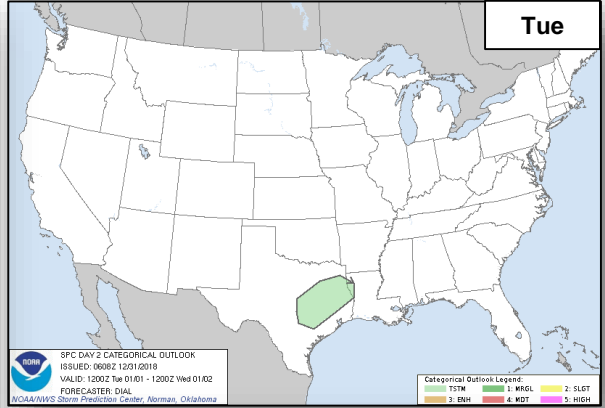
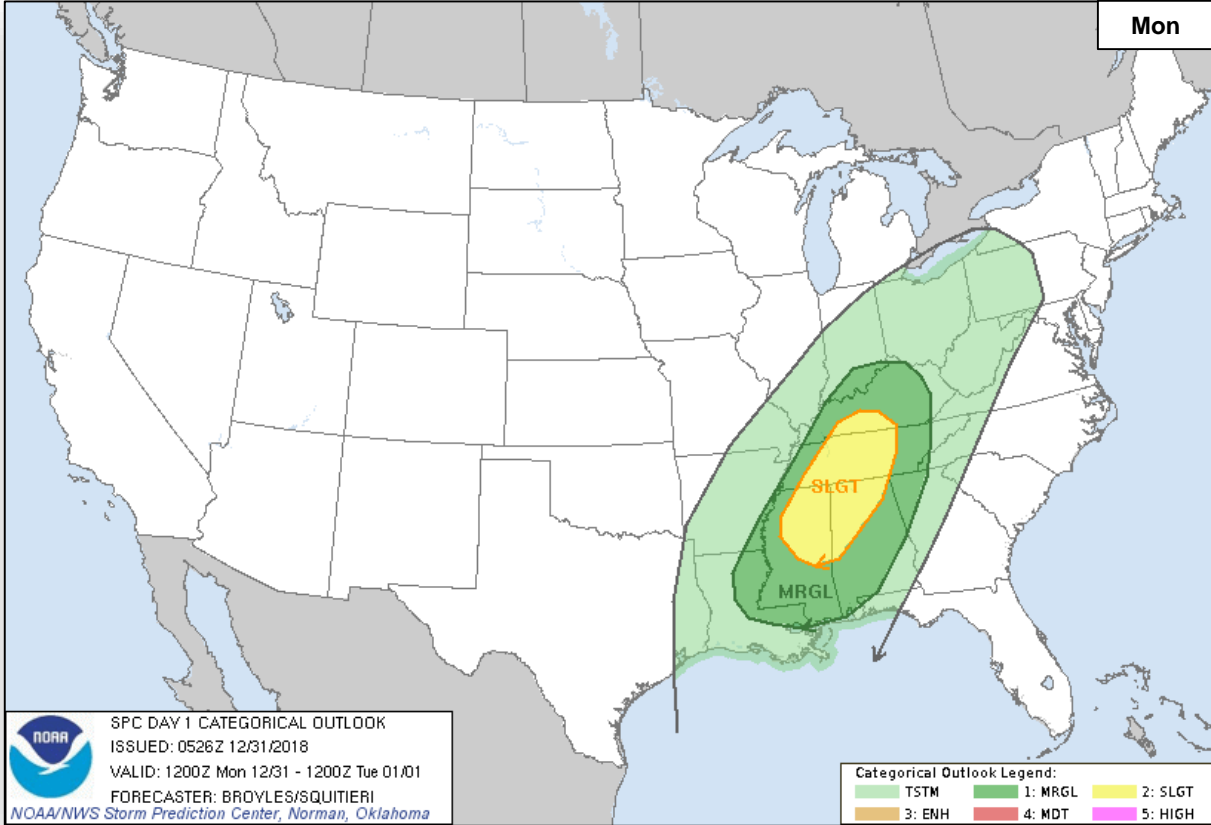


**Forecast Ice Accumulation**

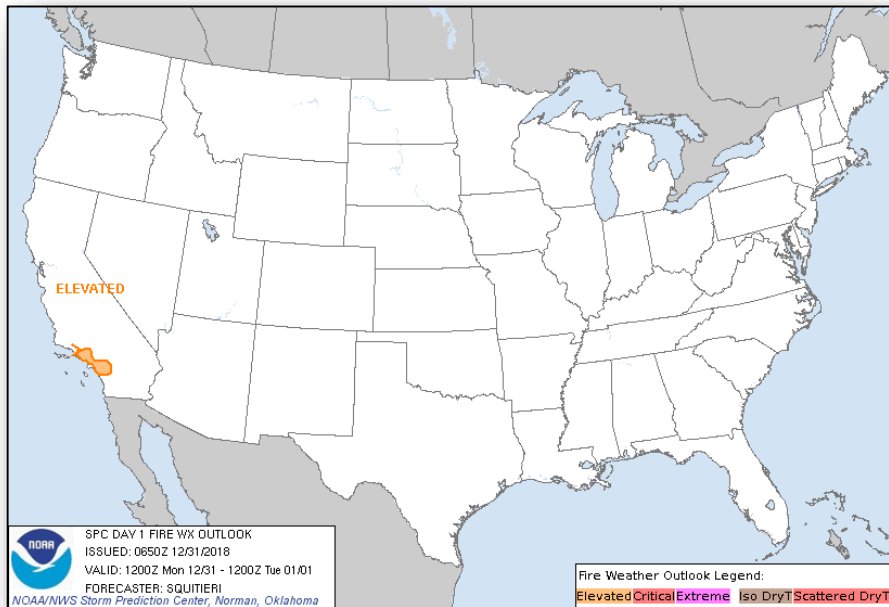

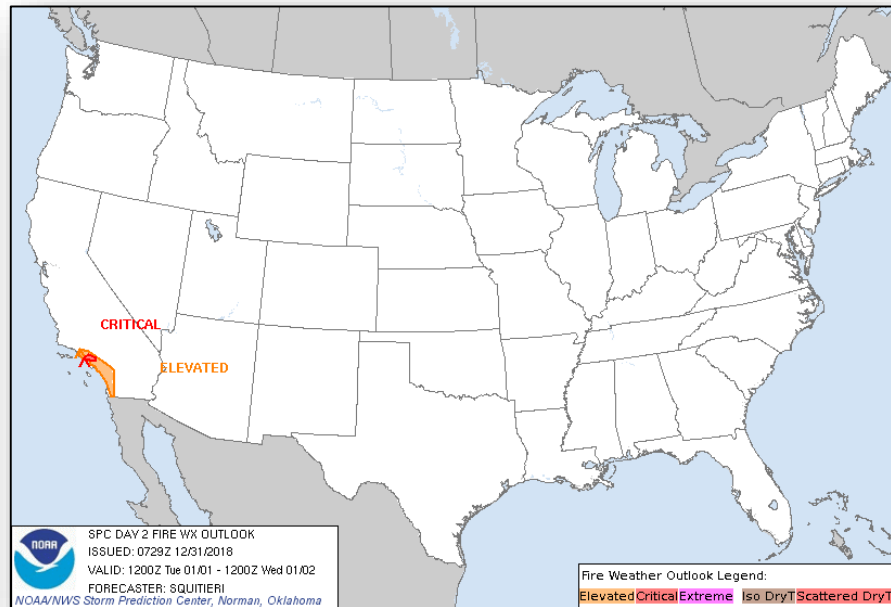

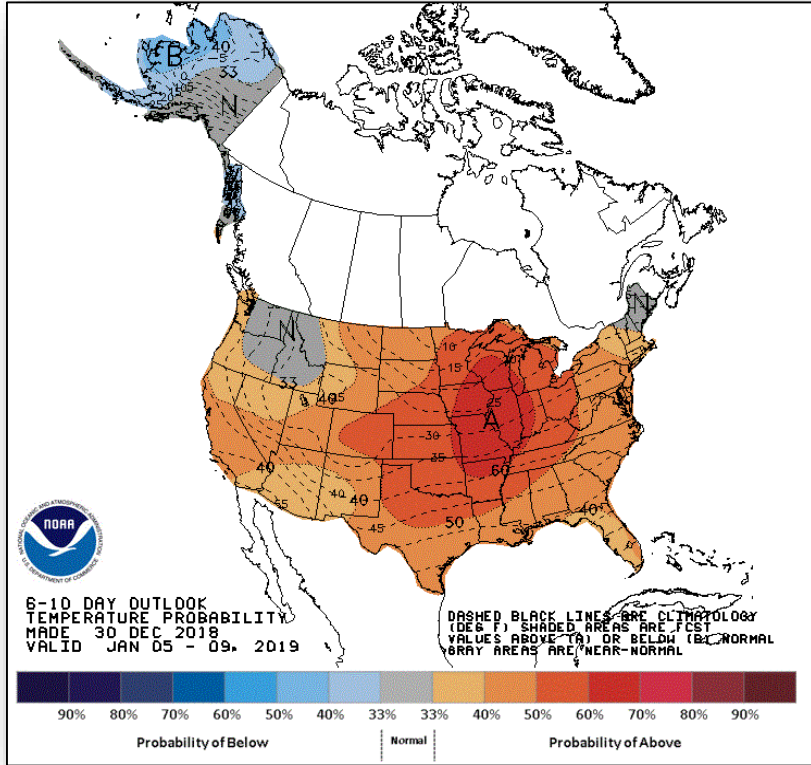

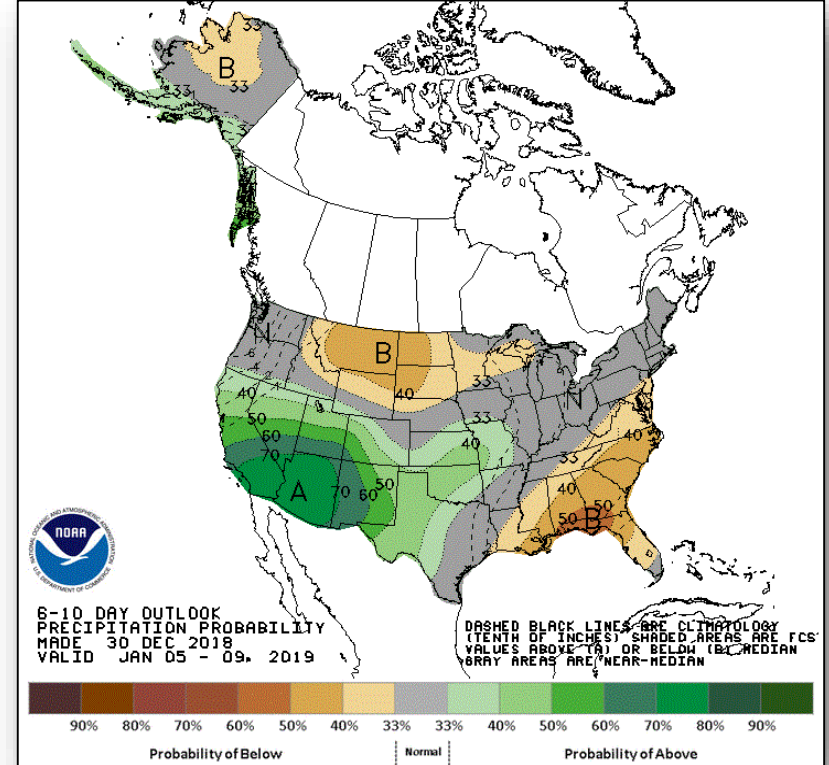
# Long Range Outlooks – Jan 5-9

6 - 10 Day Precipitation Probability

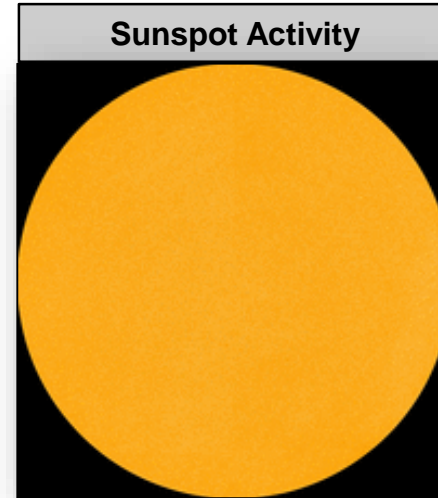
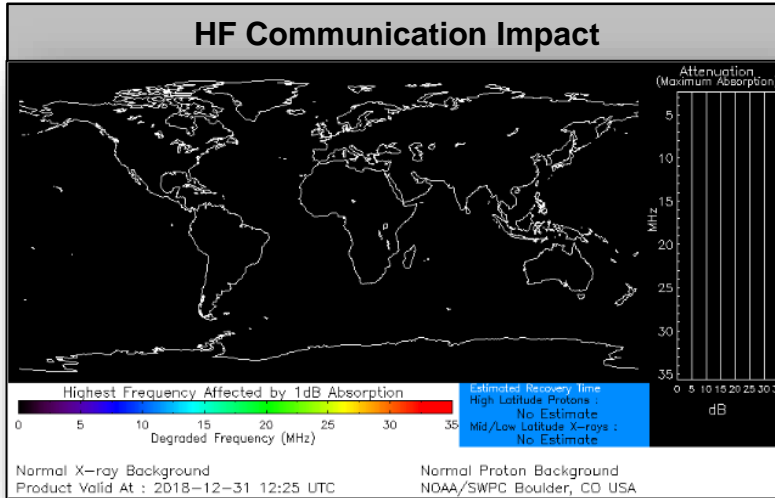
