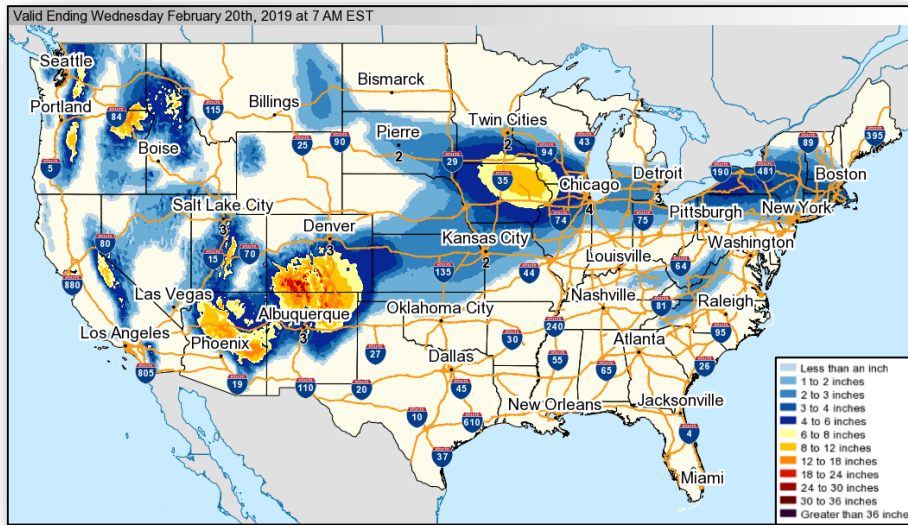

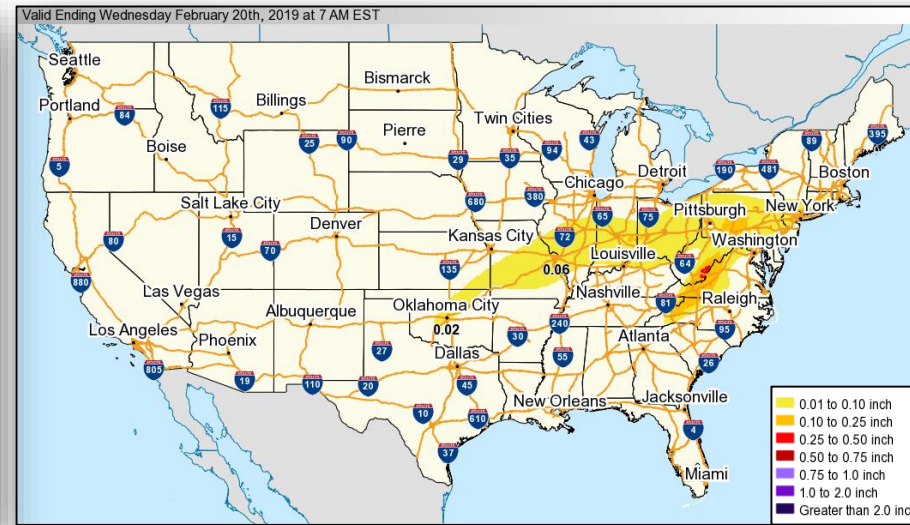
# Winter Precipitation Outlook

**Forecast Snowfall**

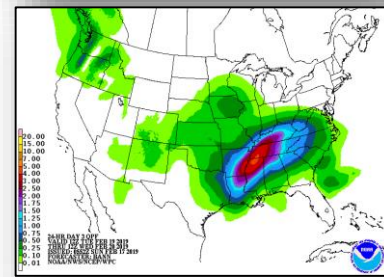
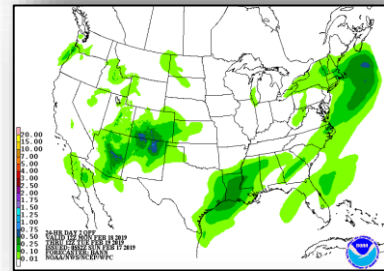
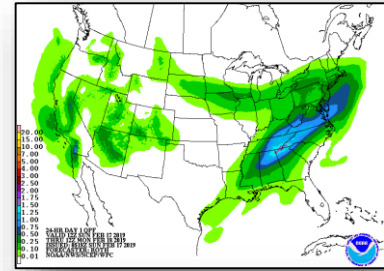
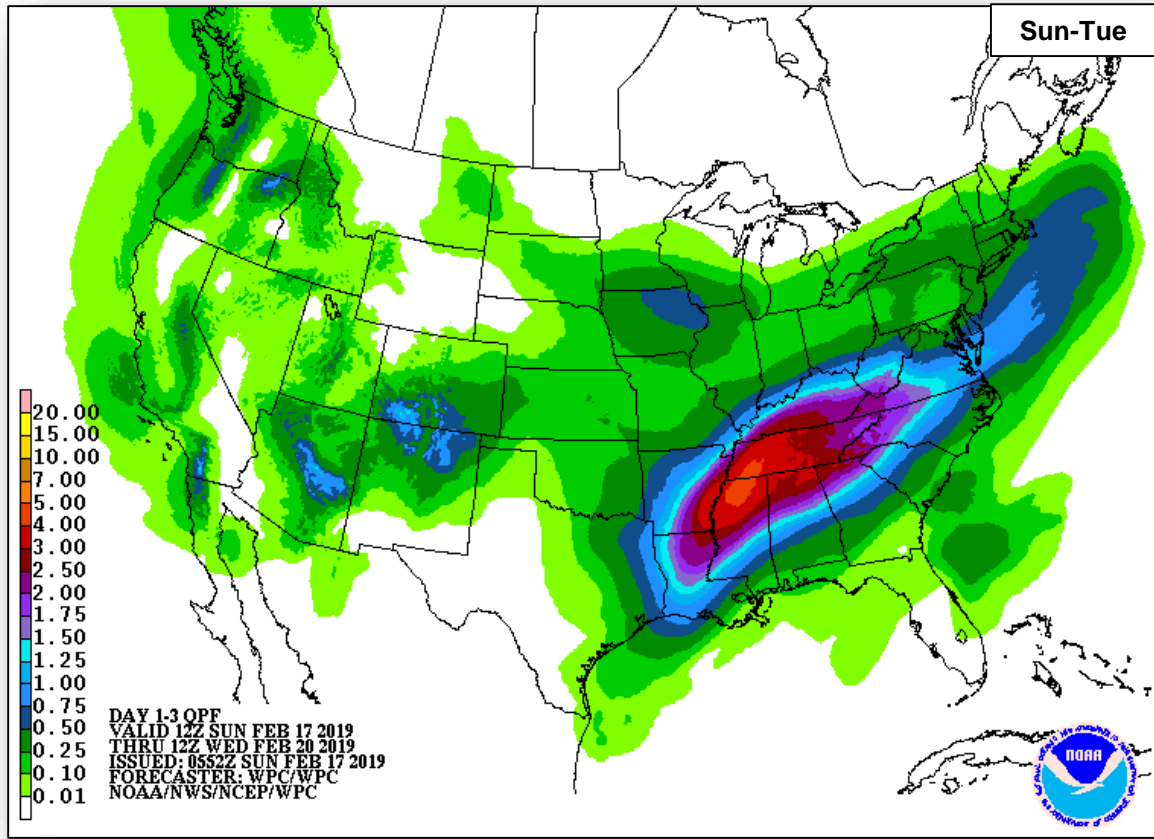


**Forecast Ice Accumulation**

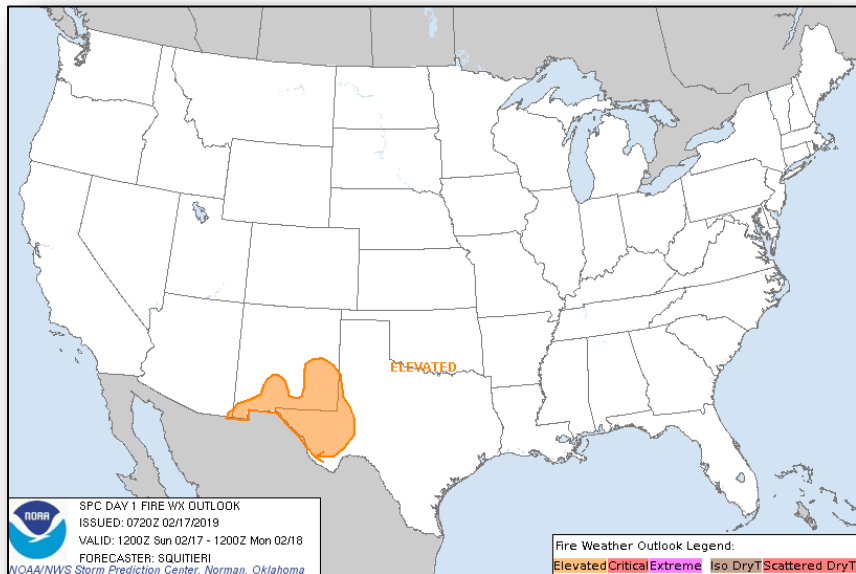
# Severe Weather Outlook



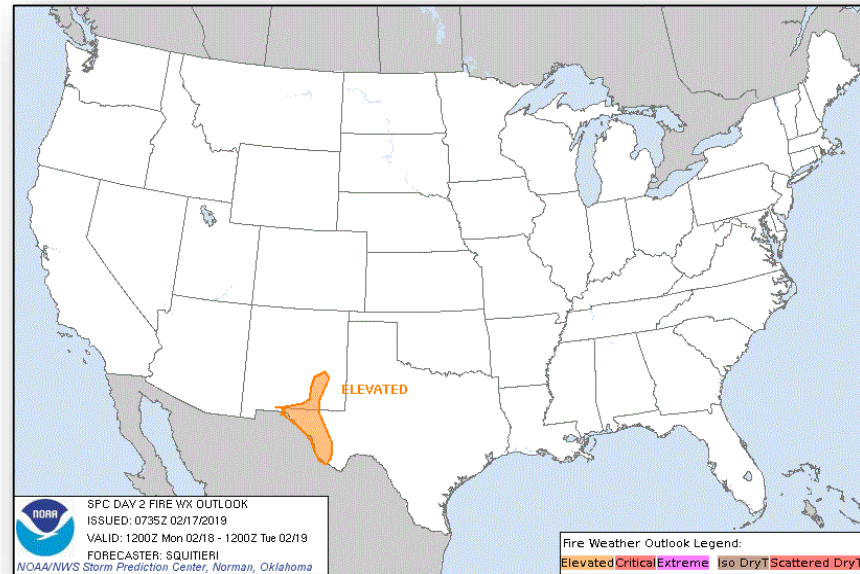

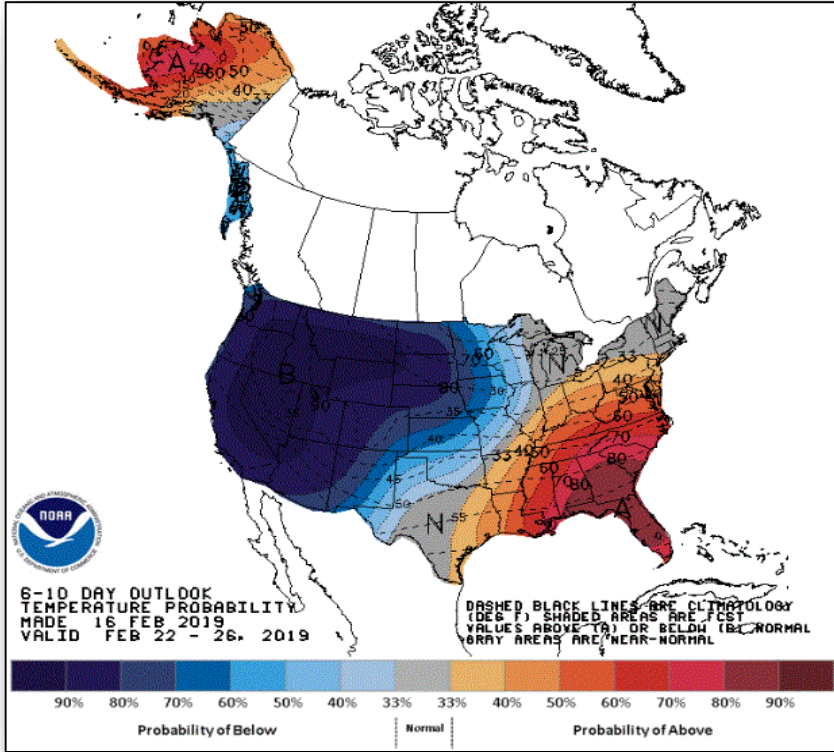

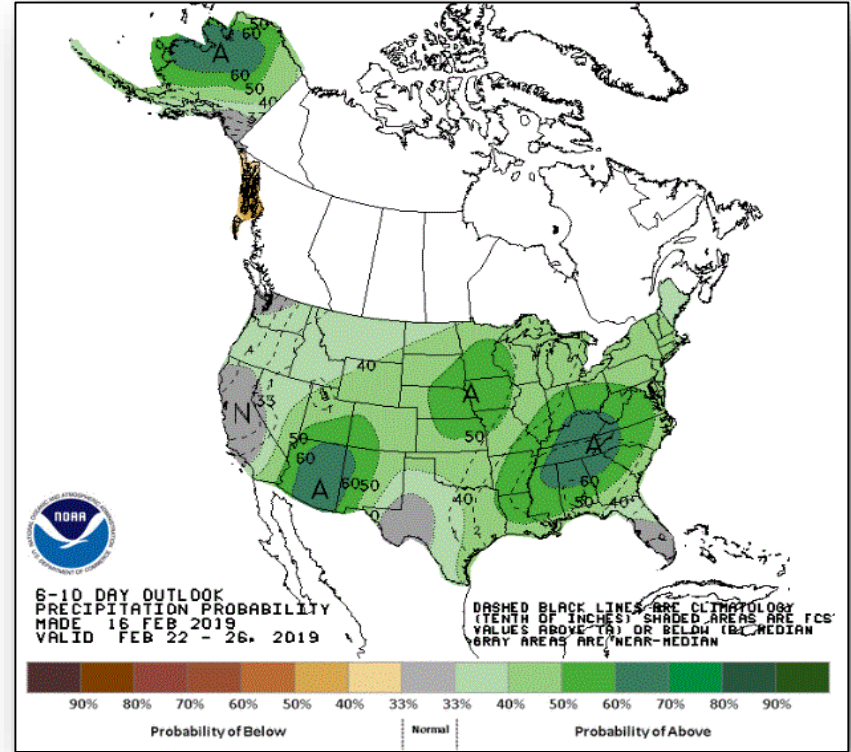

**6 - 10 Day Precipitation Probability**

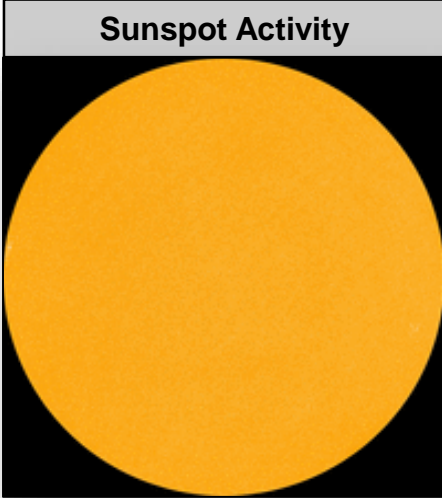
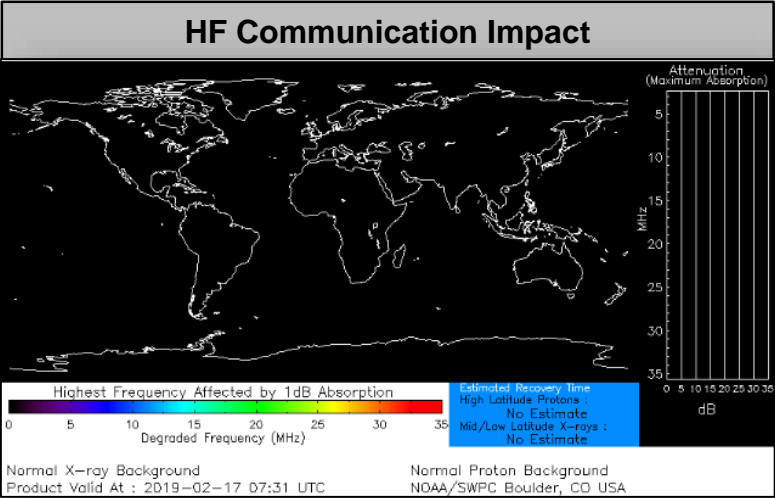
