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## Typhoon Wutip (Advisory #9 as of 4:00 a.m. EST)

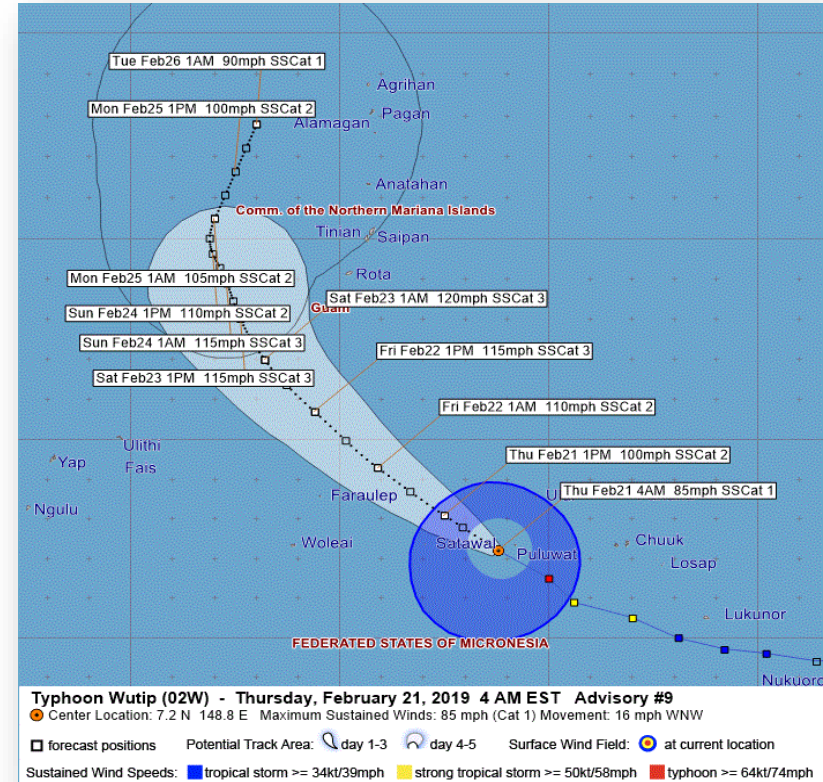
- 510 miles SSE of Guam; moving WNW at 16 mph

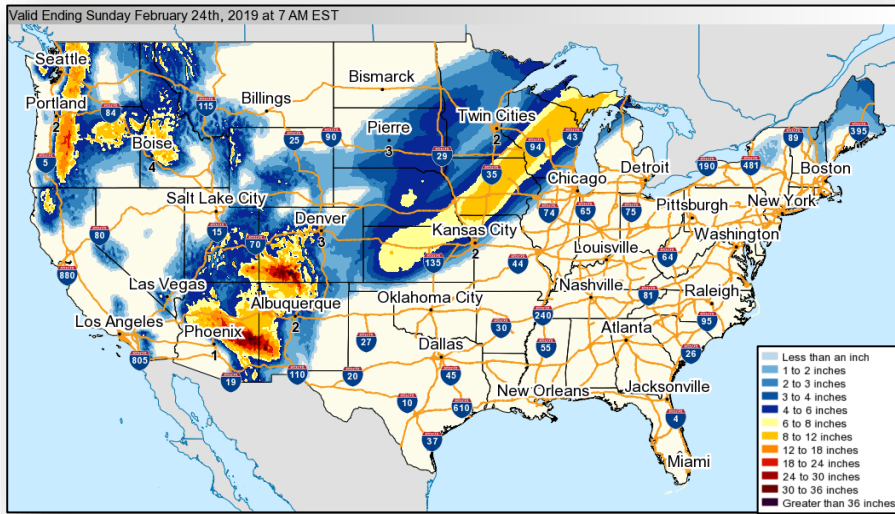


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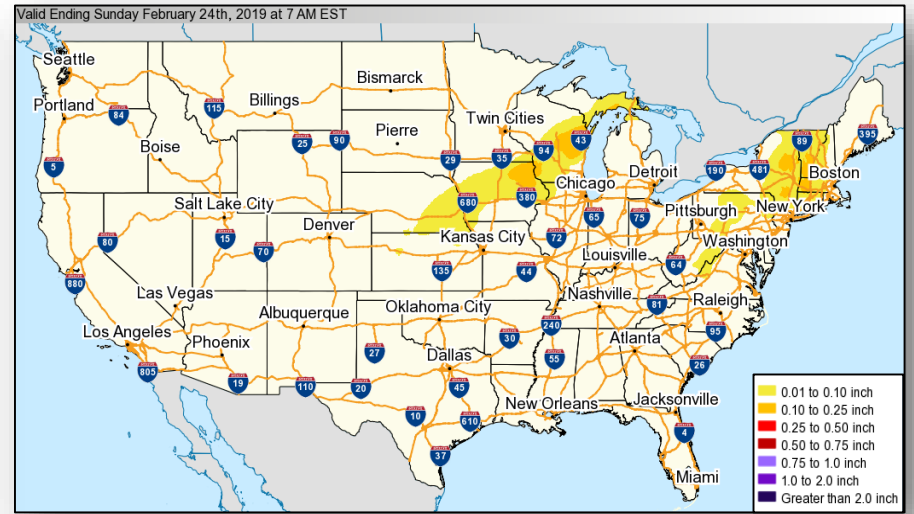




# Winter Precipitation Outlook



**Forecast Snowfall**

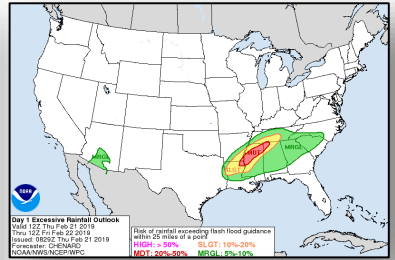
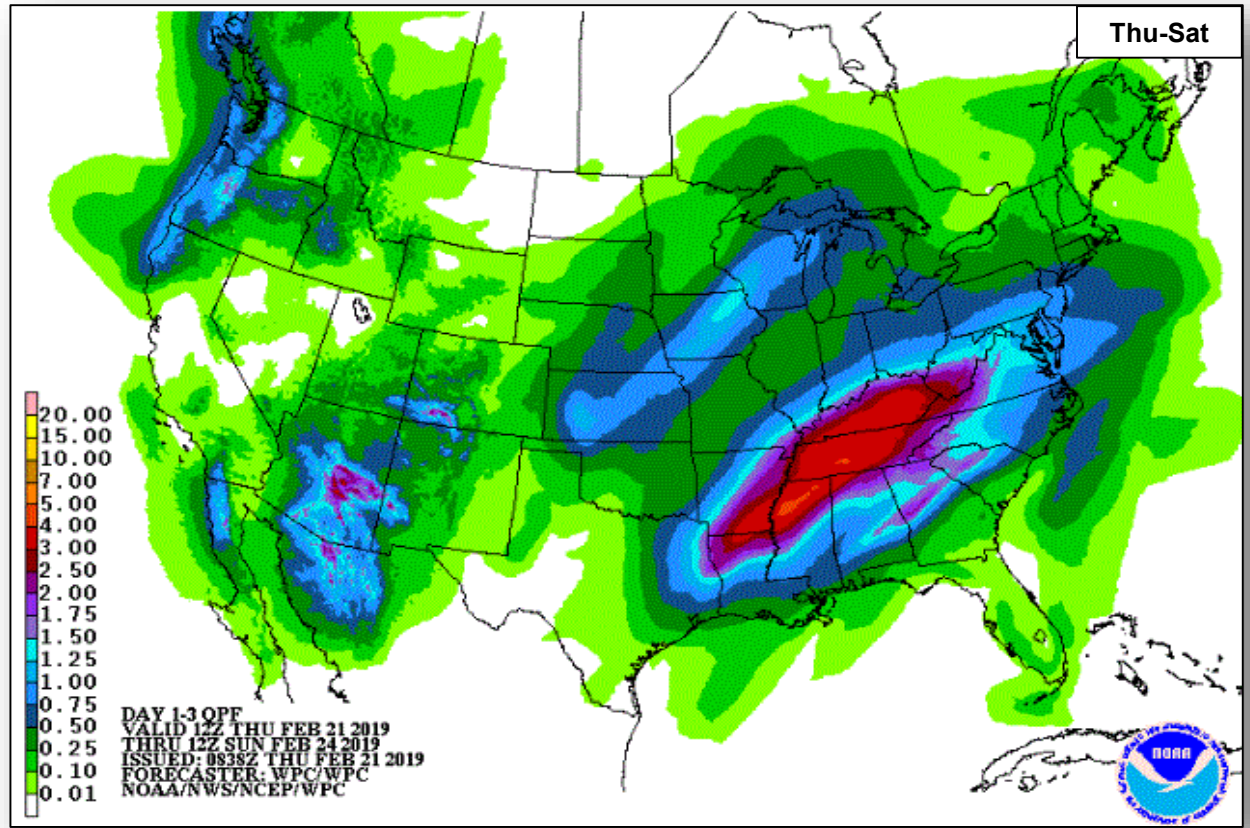


**Forecast Ice Accumulation**

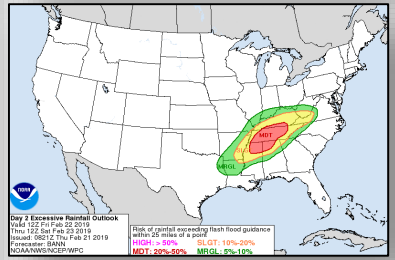
