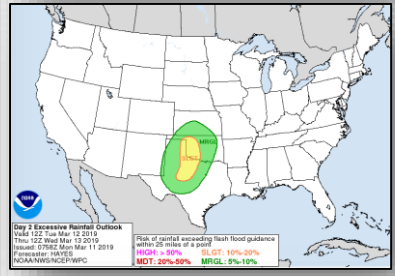

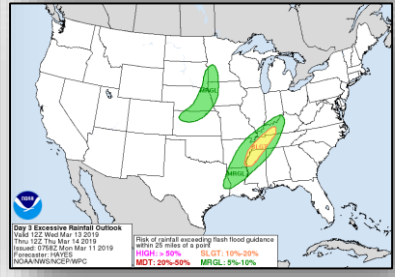

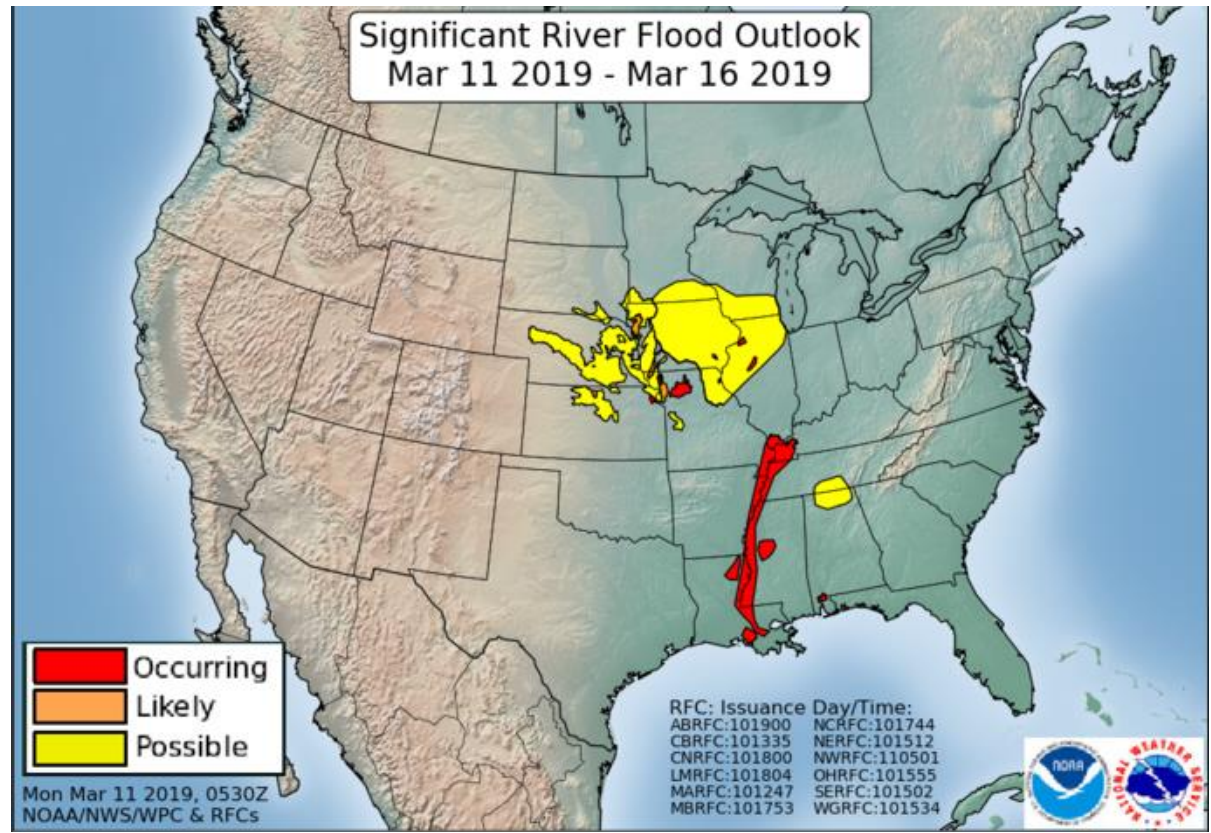

# Significant River Flood Outlook



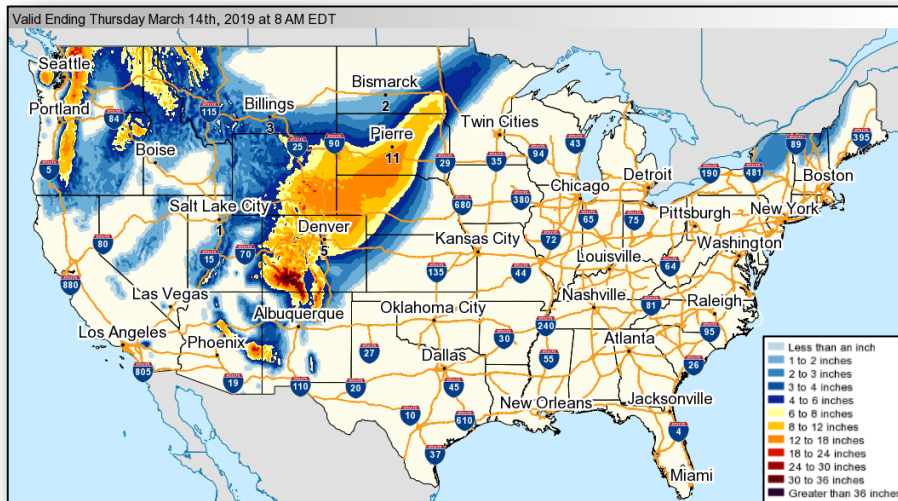

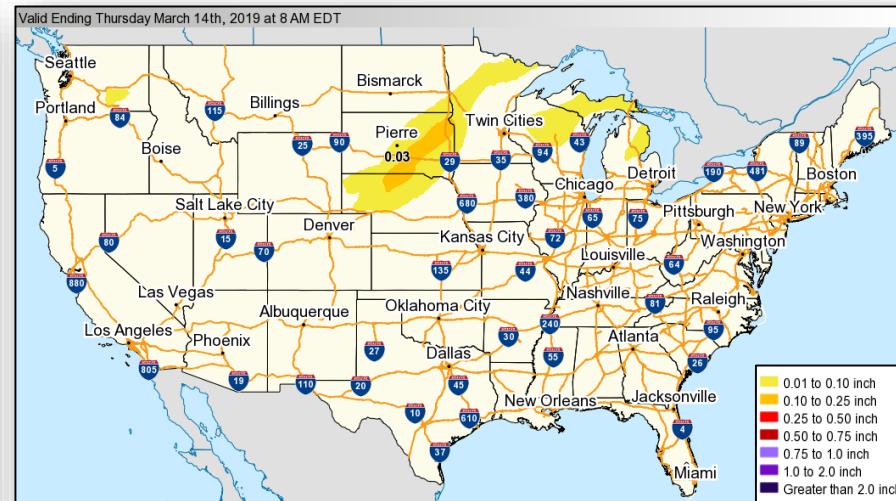
# Winter Precipitation Outlook

**Forecast Snowfall**



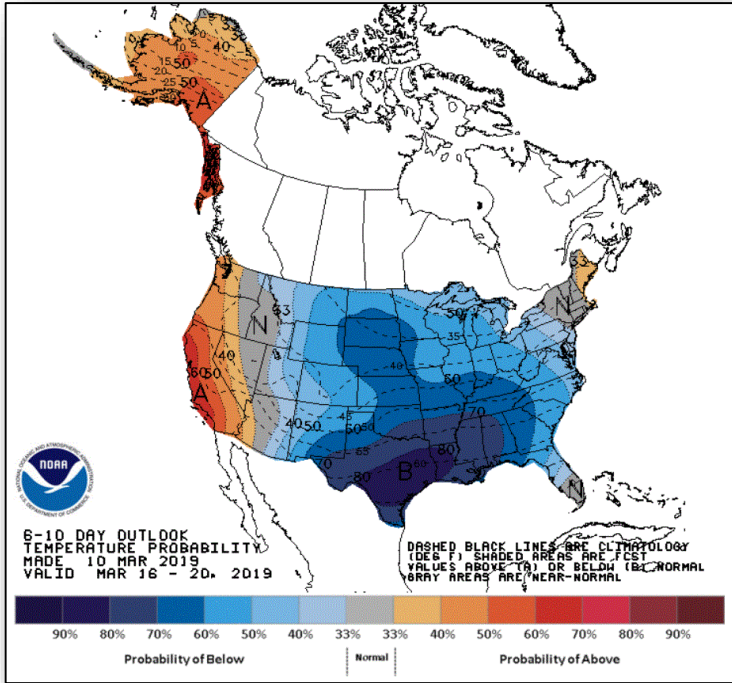
**Forecast Ice Accumulation**



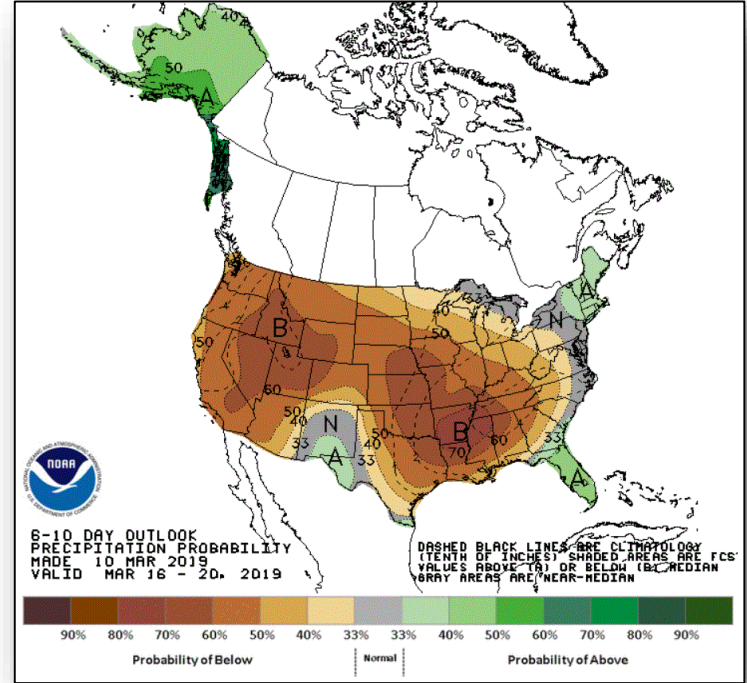

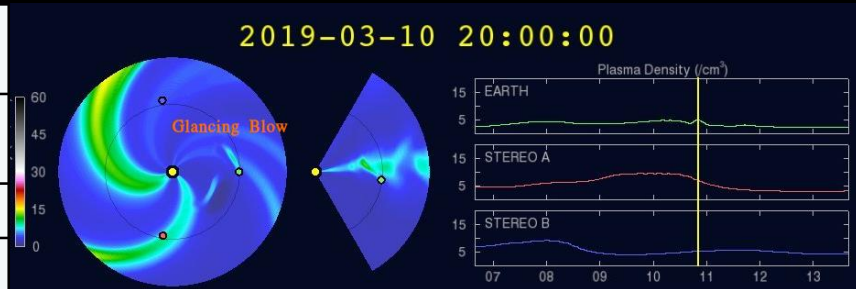
**6 - 10 Day Temperature Probability**

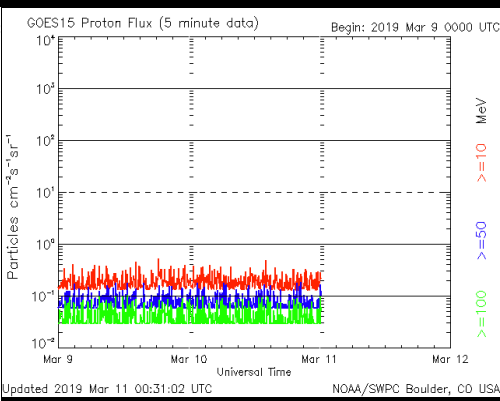
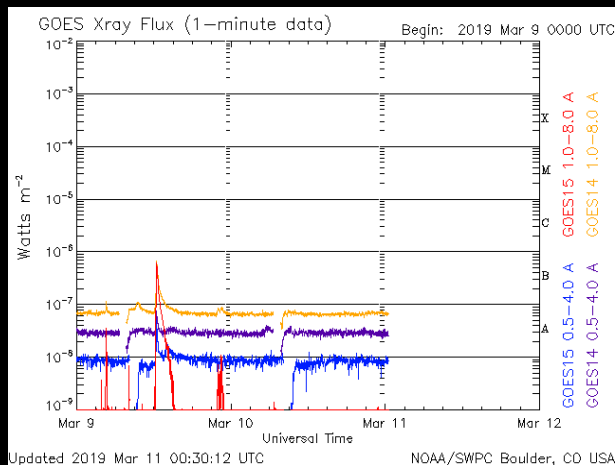

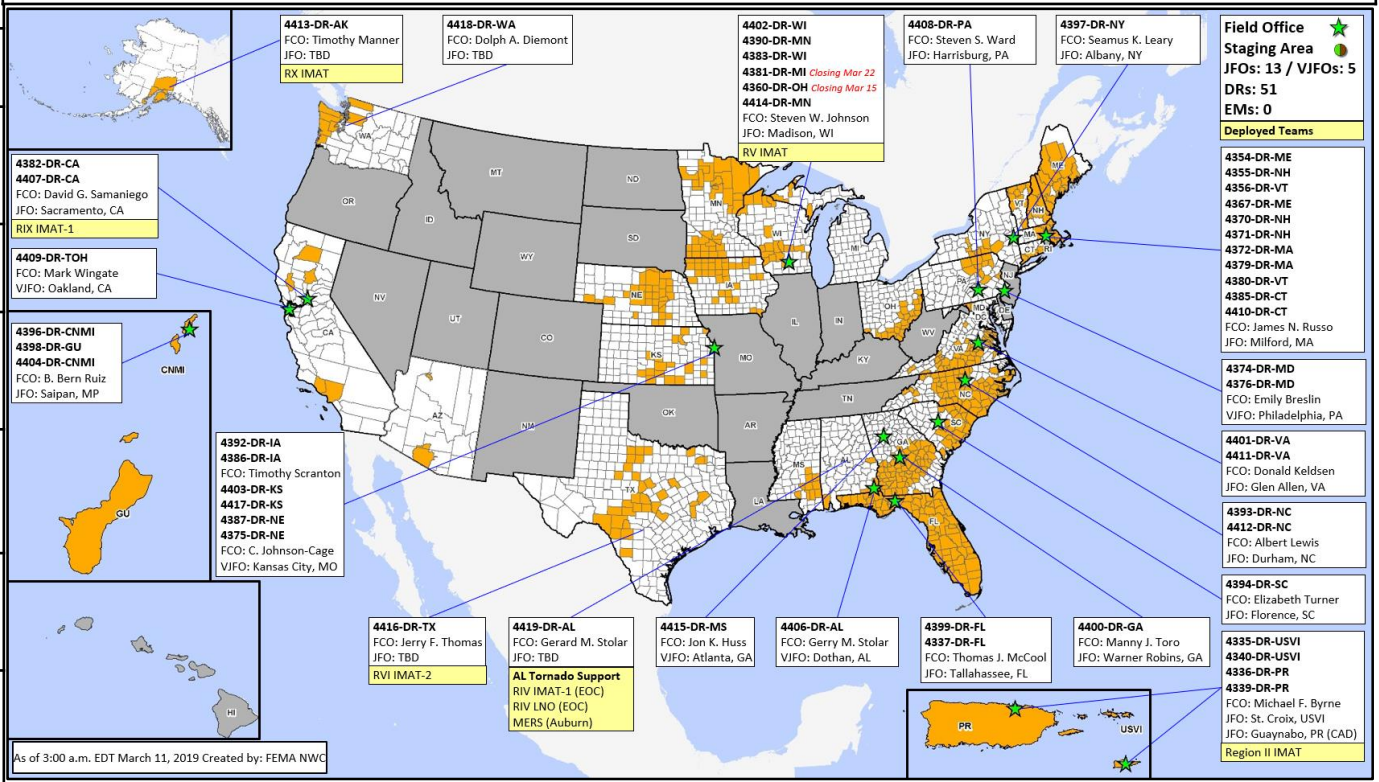
