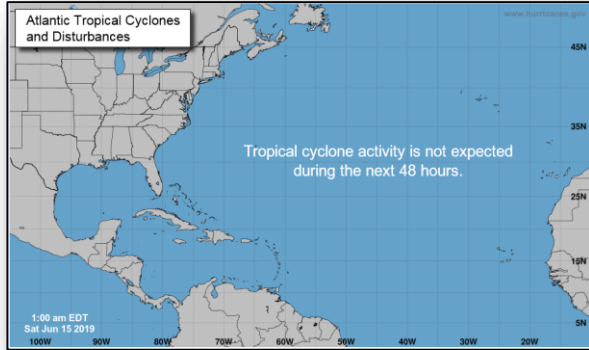

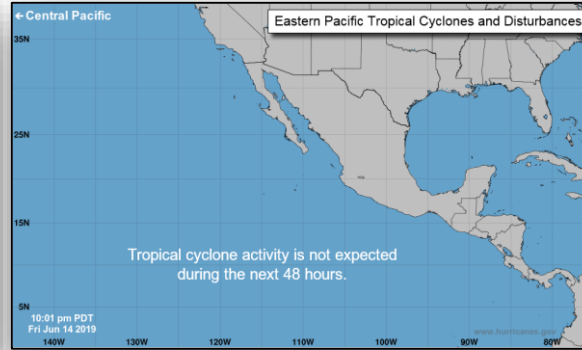

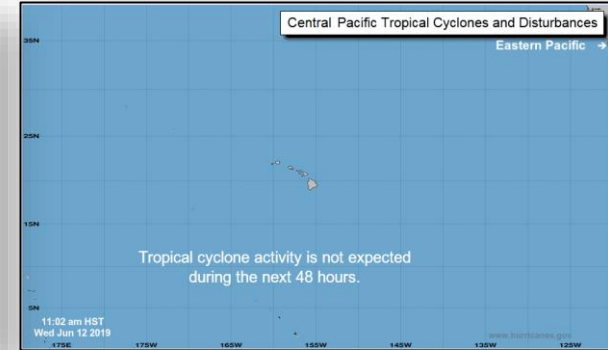
# Tropical Outlook – Five Day

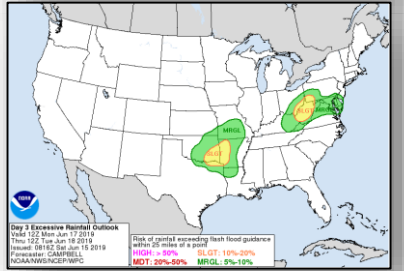
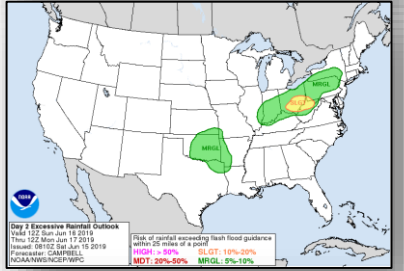
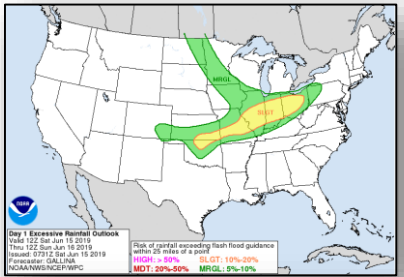
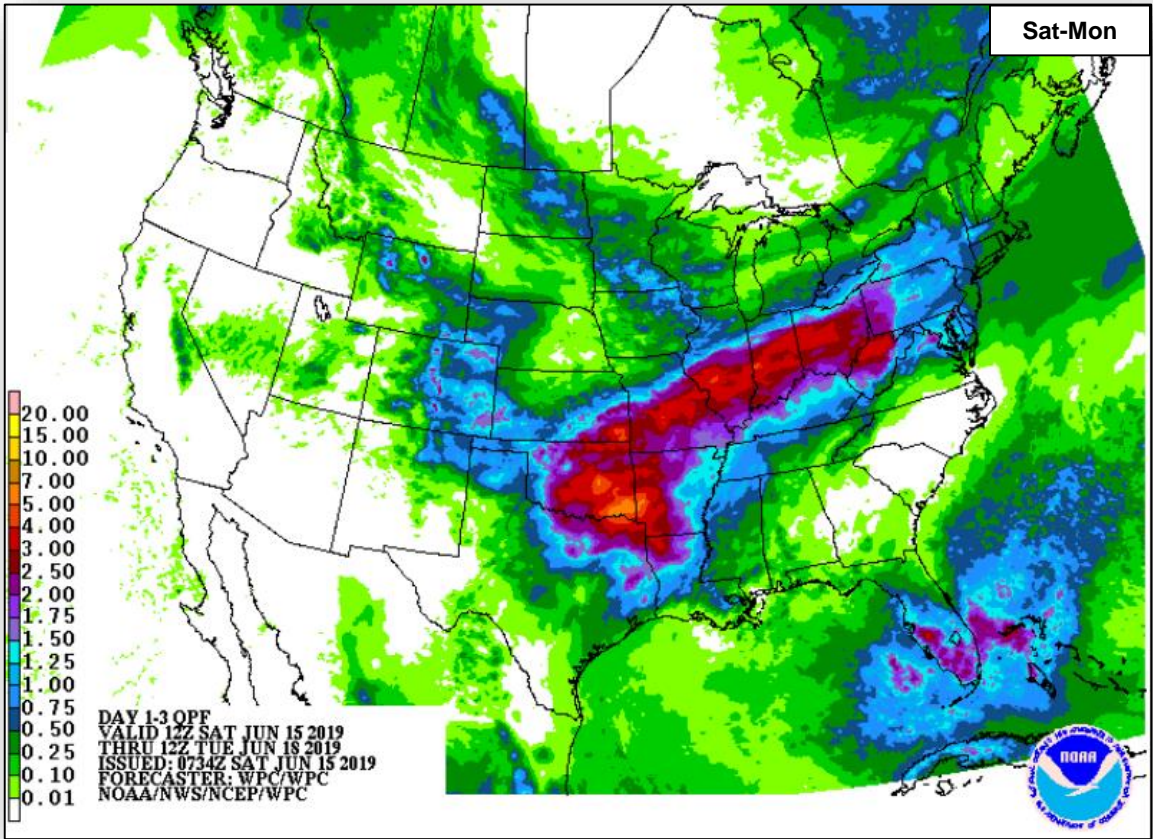




# Precipitation Forecast



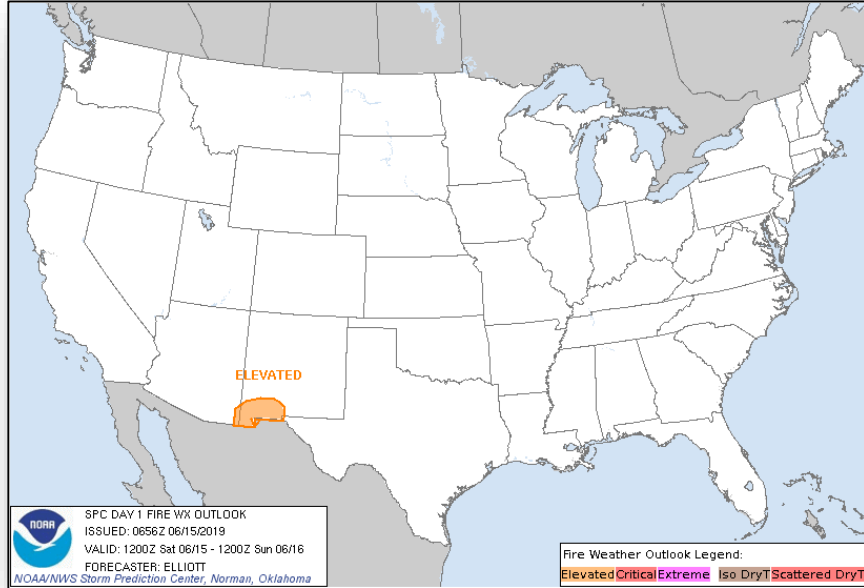
