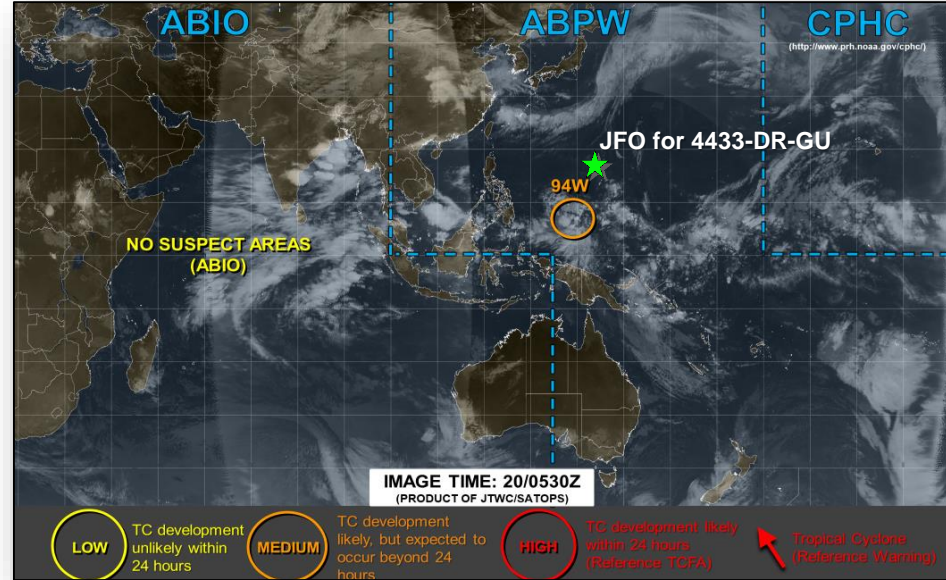

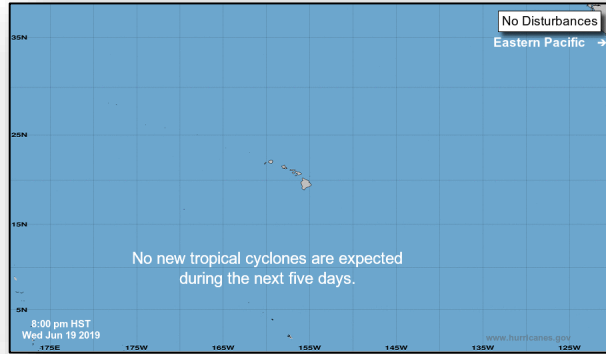

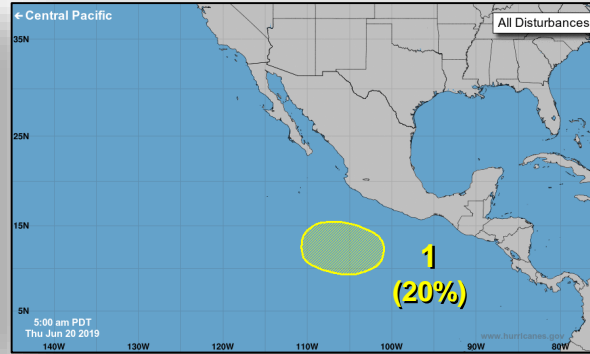
Tropical Outlook – Five Day

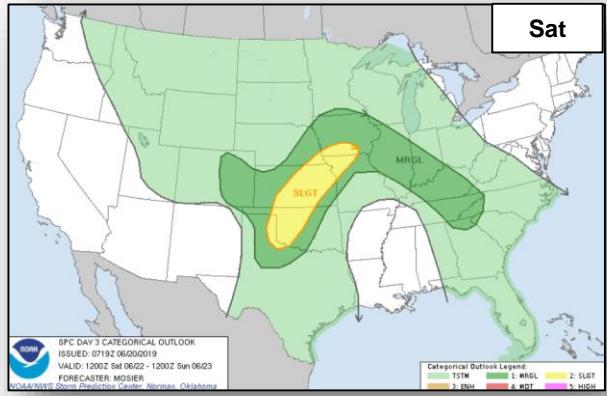
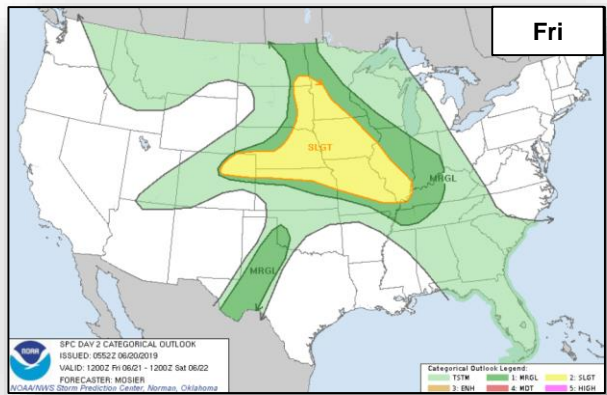
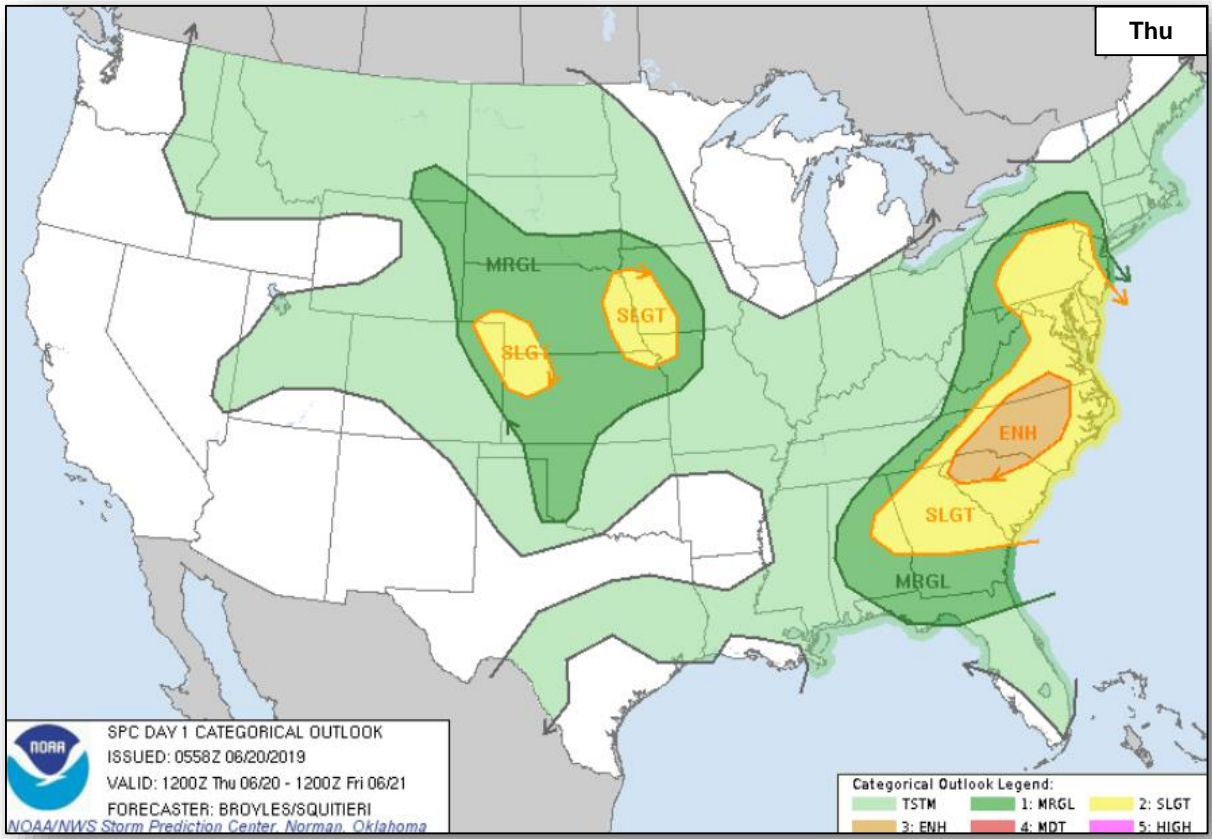
Excessive Rainfall Outlook



Severe Weather Outlook



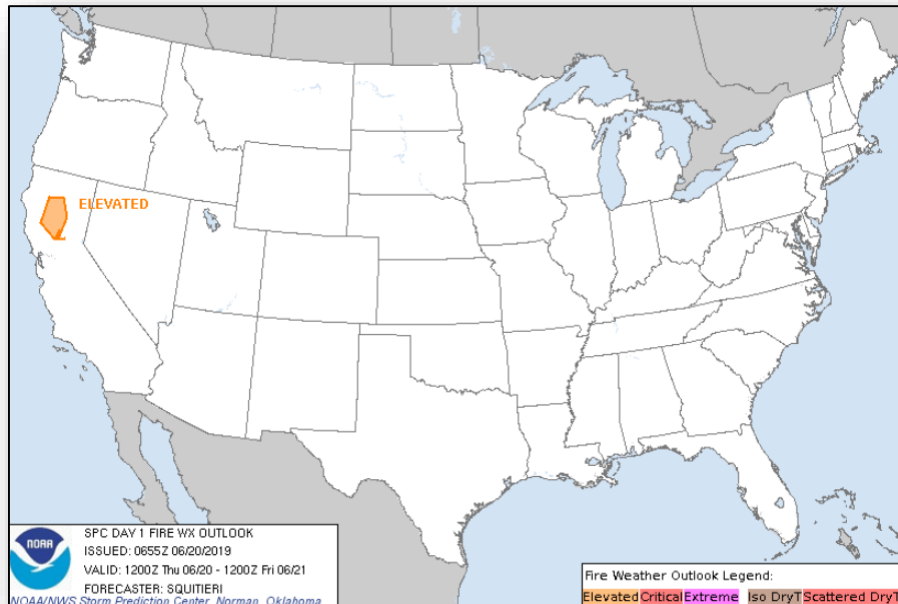

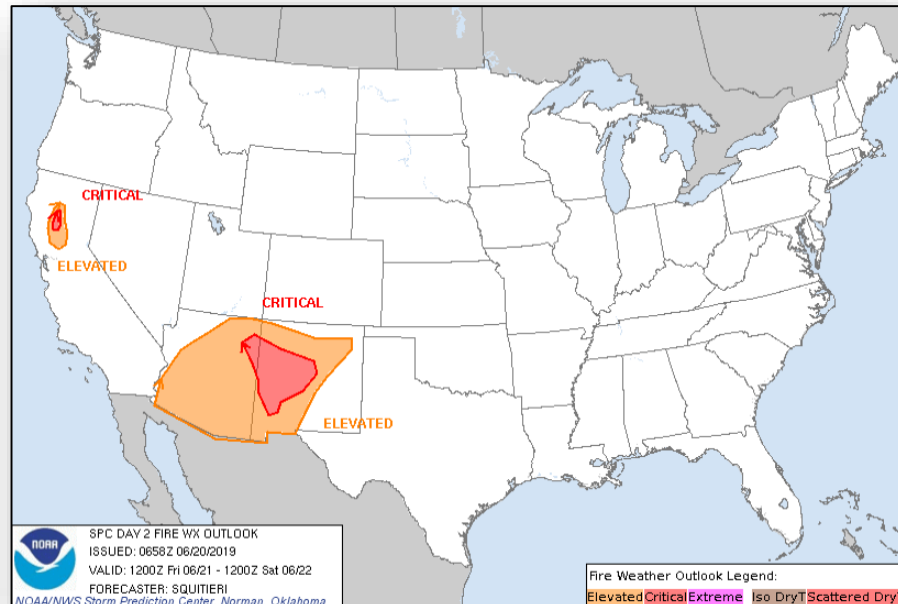
Fire Weather Outlook
