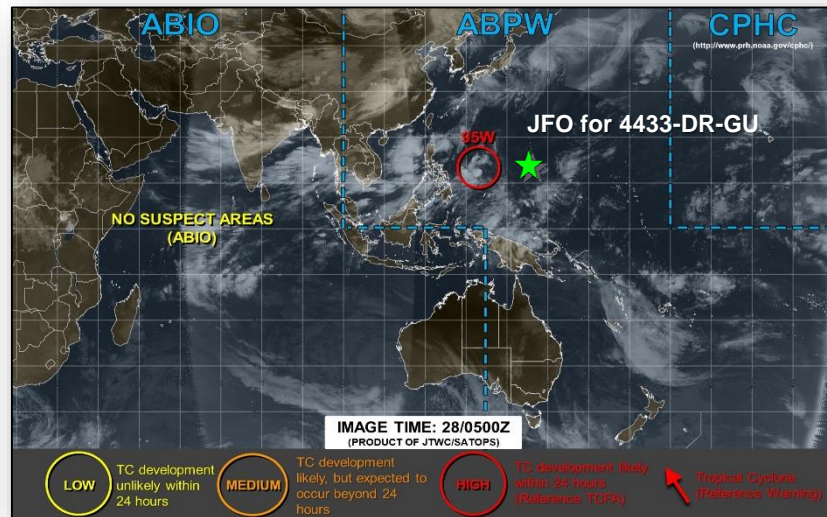

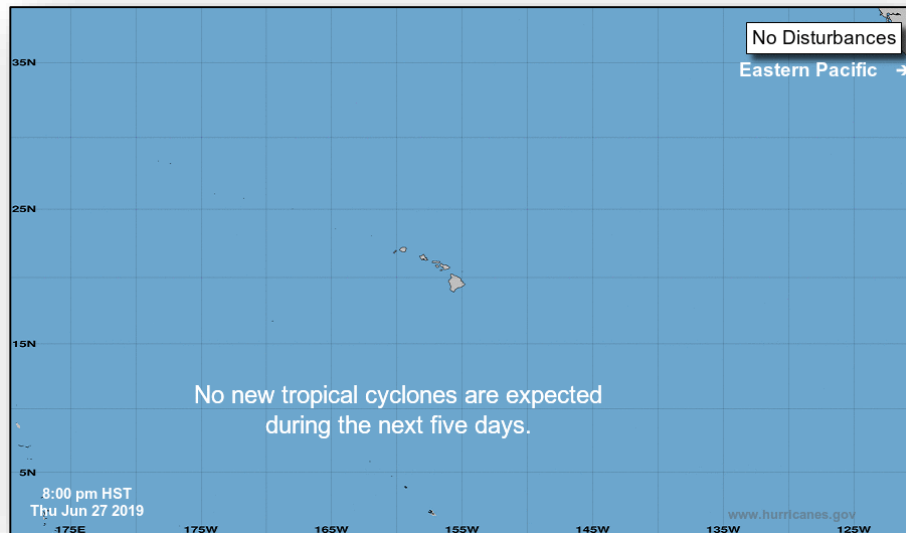
- 720 miles W of Guam; moving away from the island

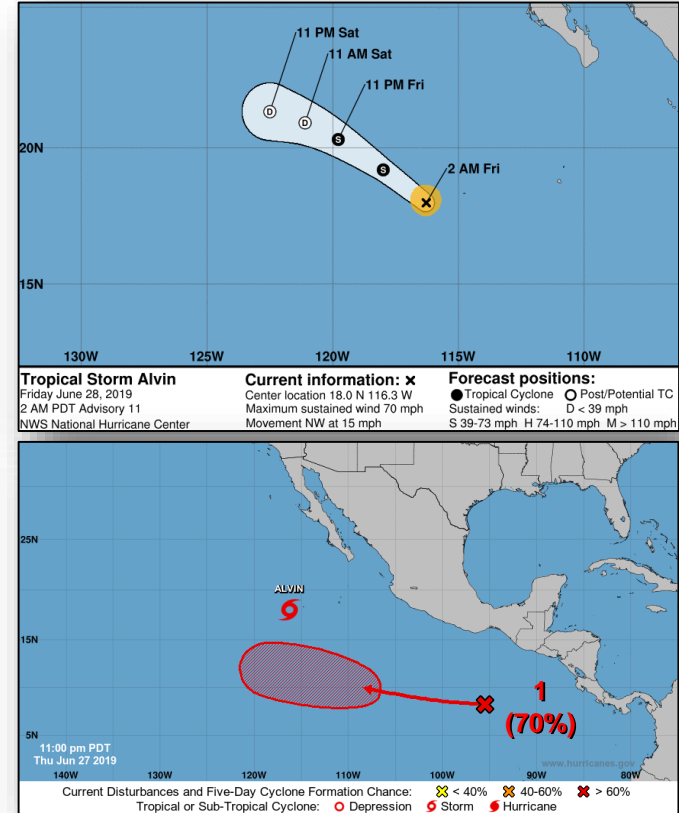
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## Tropical Storm Alvin (Advisory #11 as of 5:00 a.m. EDT)

## Disturbance 1 (as of 2:00 a.m. EDT)

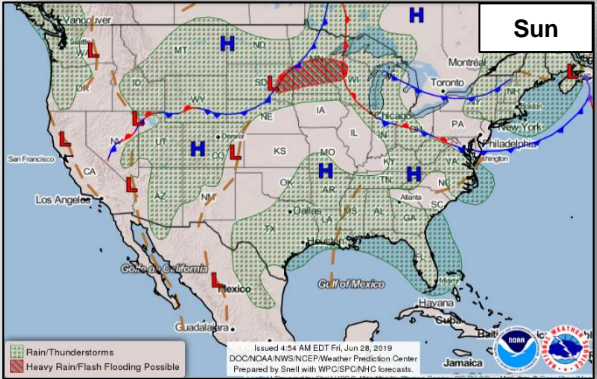
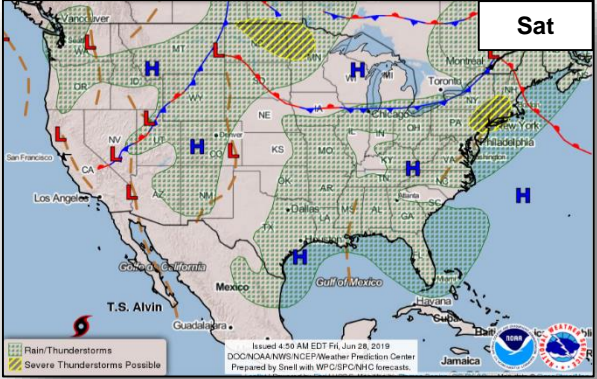
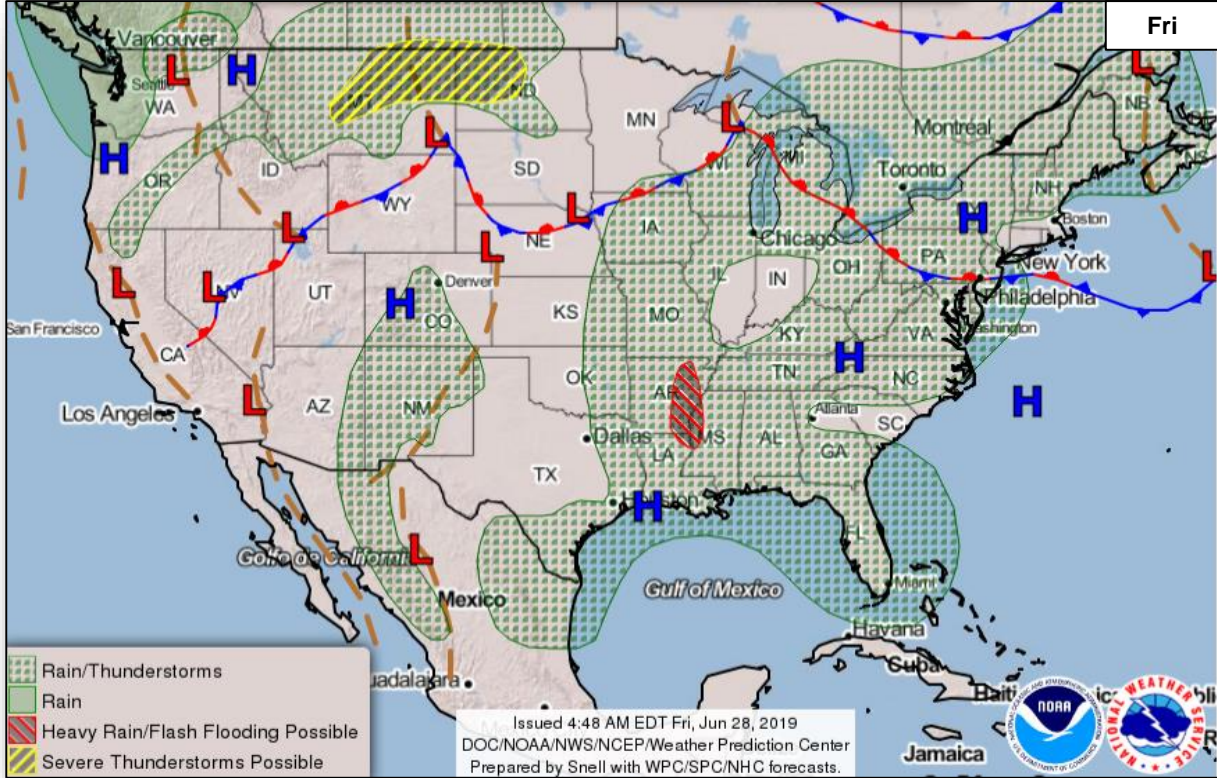
- Several hundred miles south of the Gulf of Tehuantepec
