- Western Pacific: No activity affecting U.S. interests

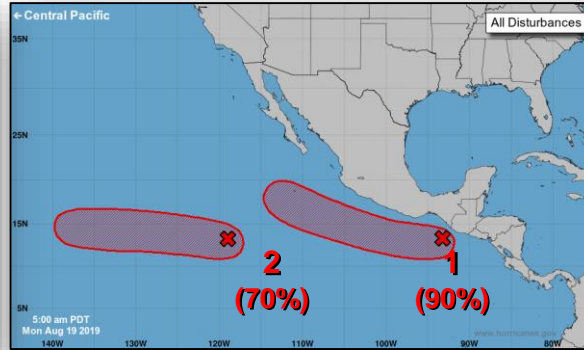

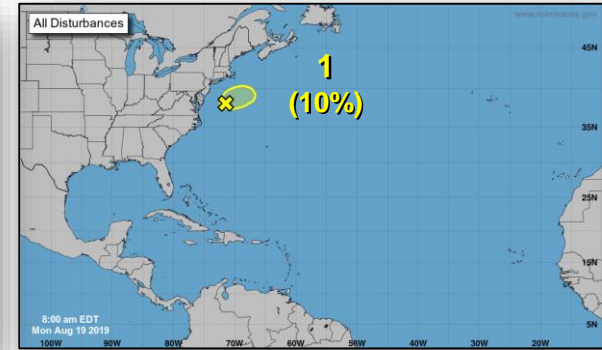

- High chance of formation (70%)

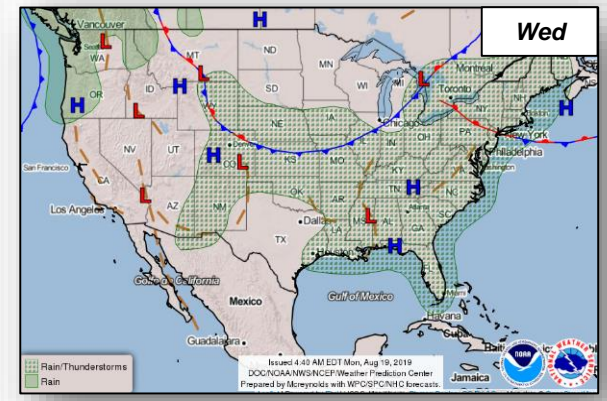
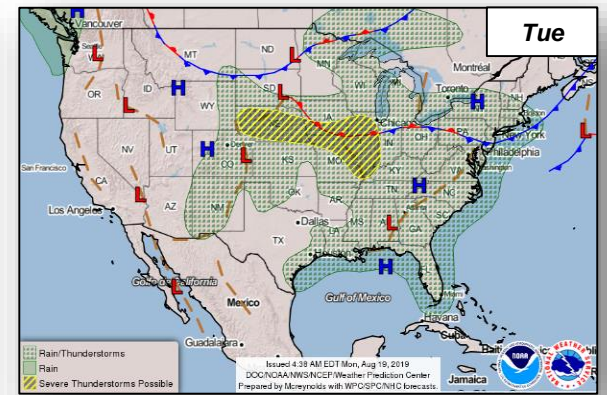
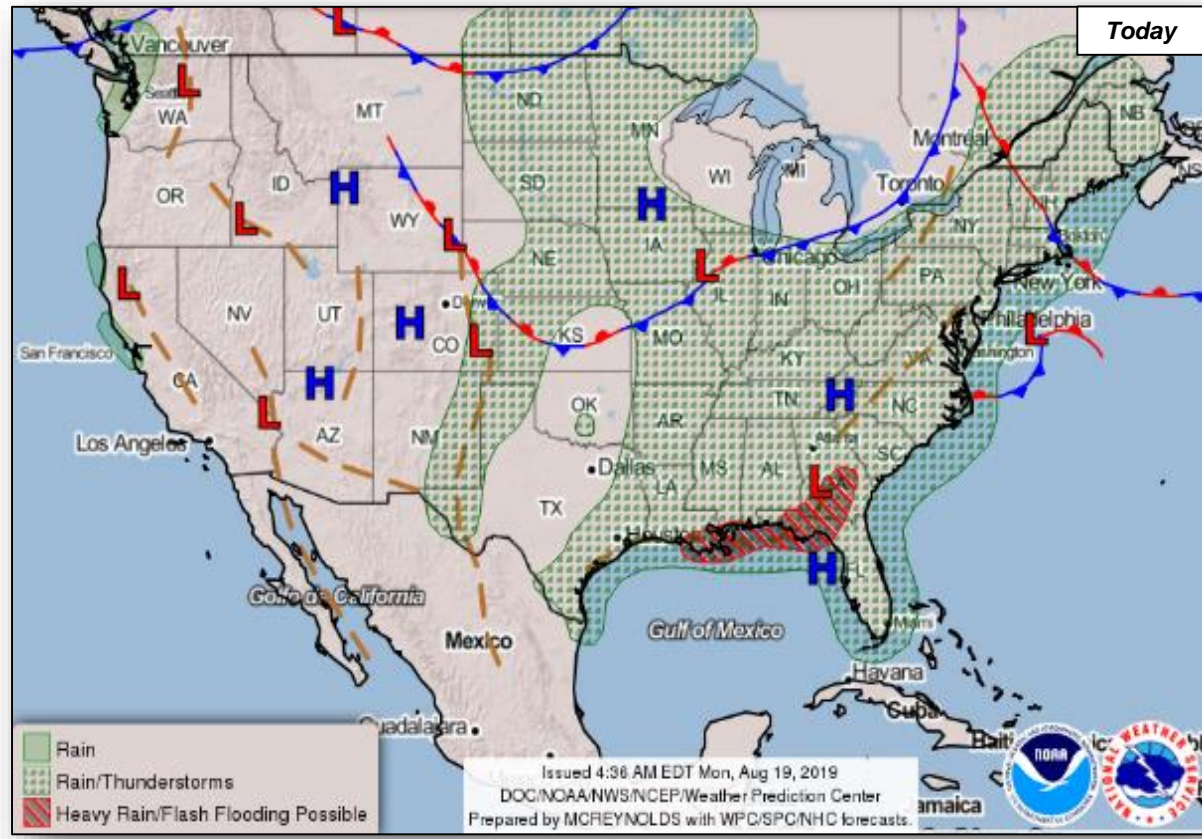

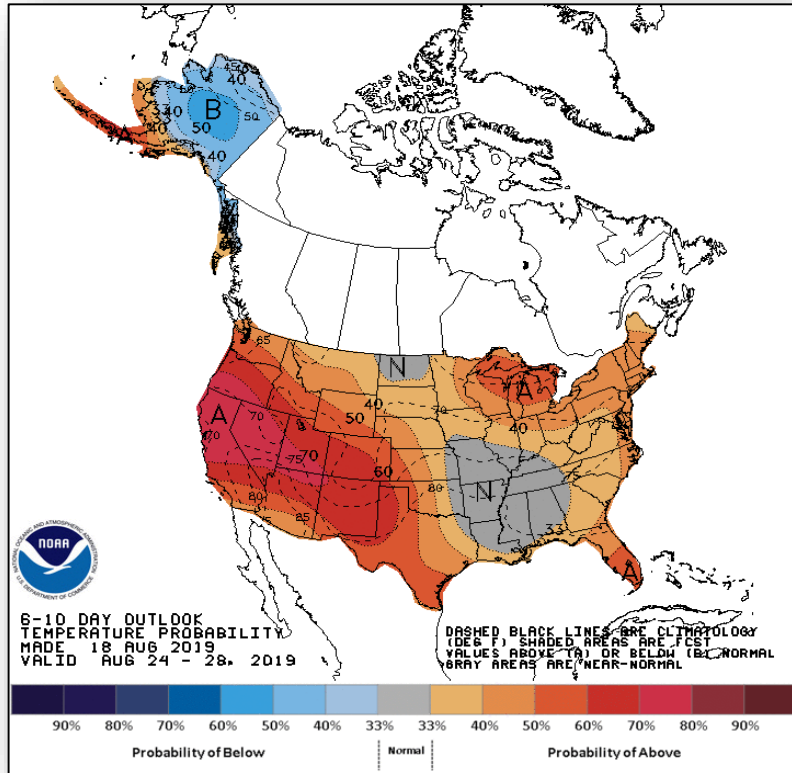
National Weather Forecast



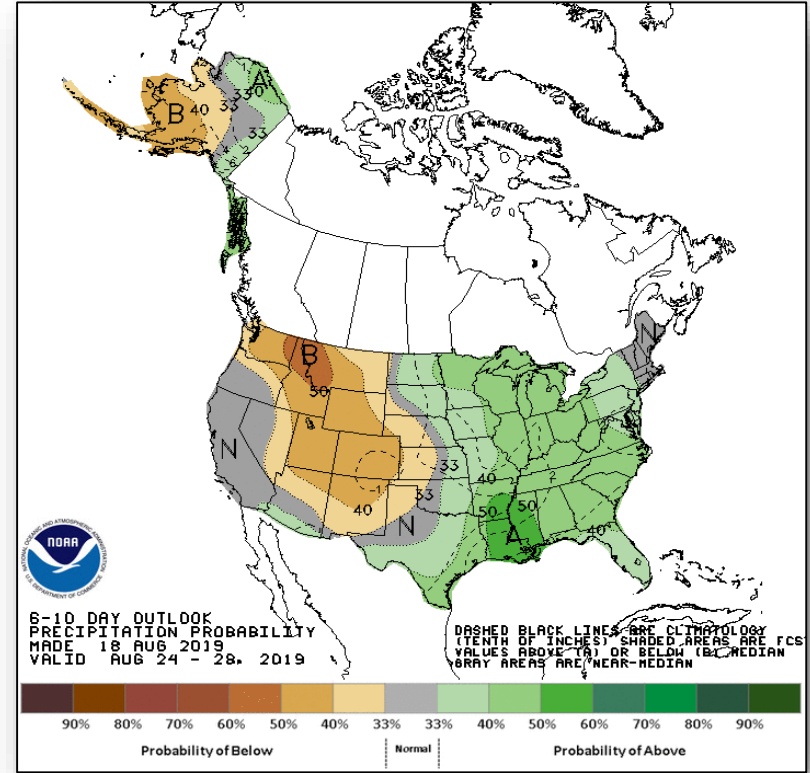
Long Range Outlooks – Aug 24-28

6-10 Day Precipitation Probability

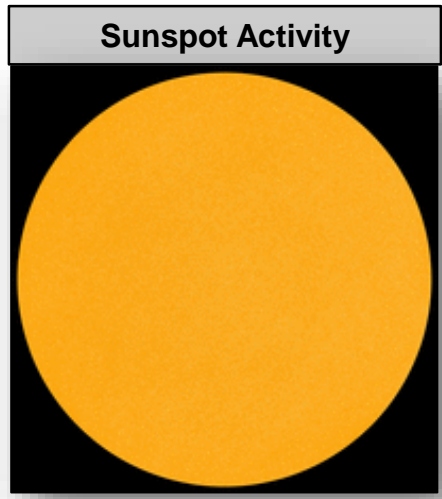
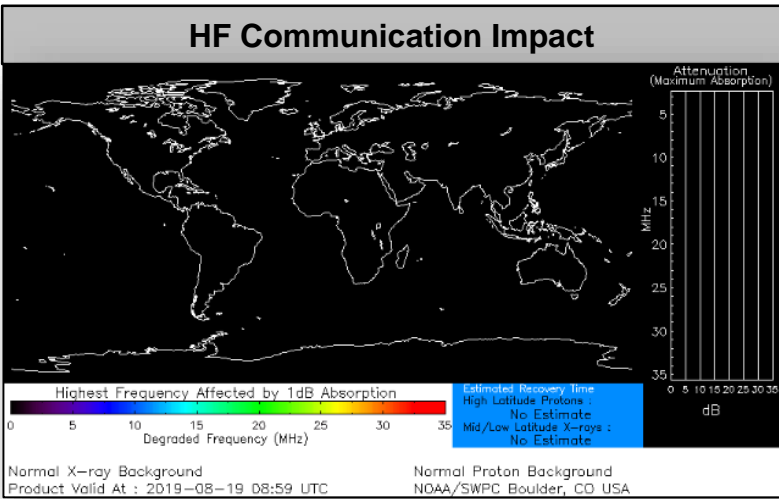

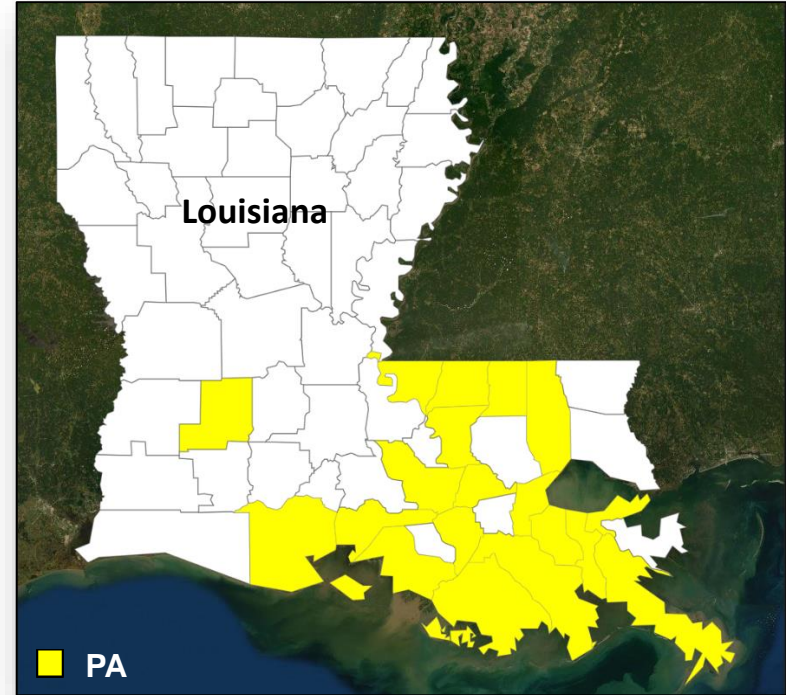

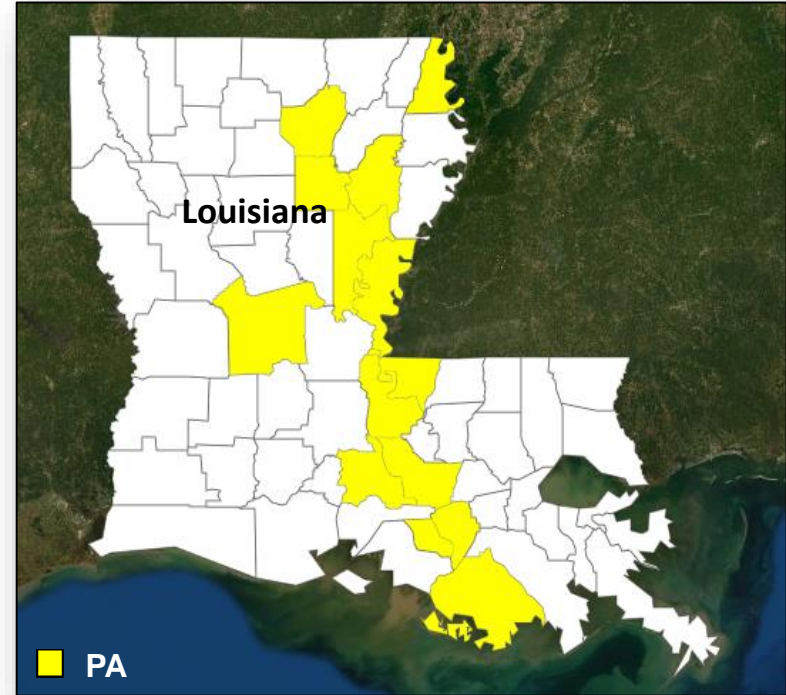

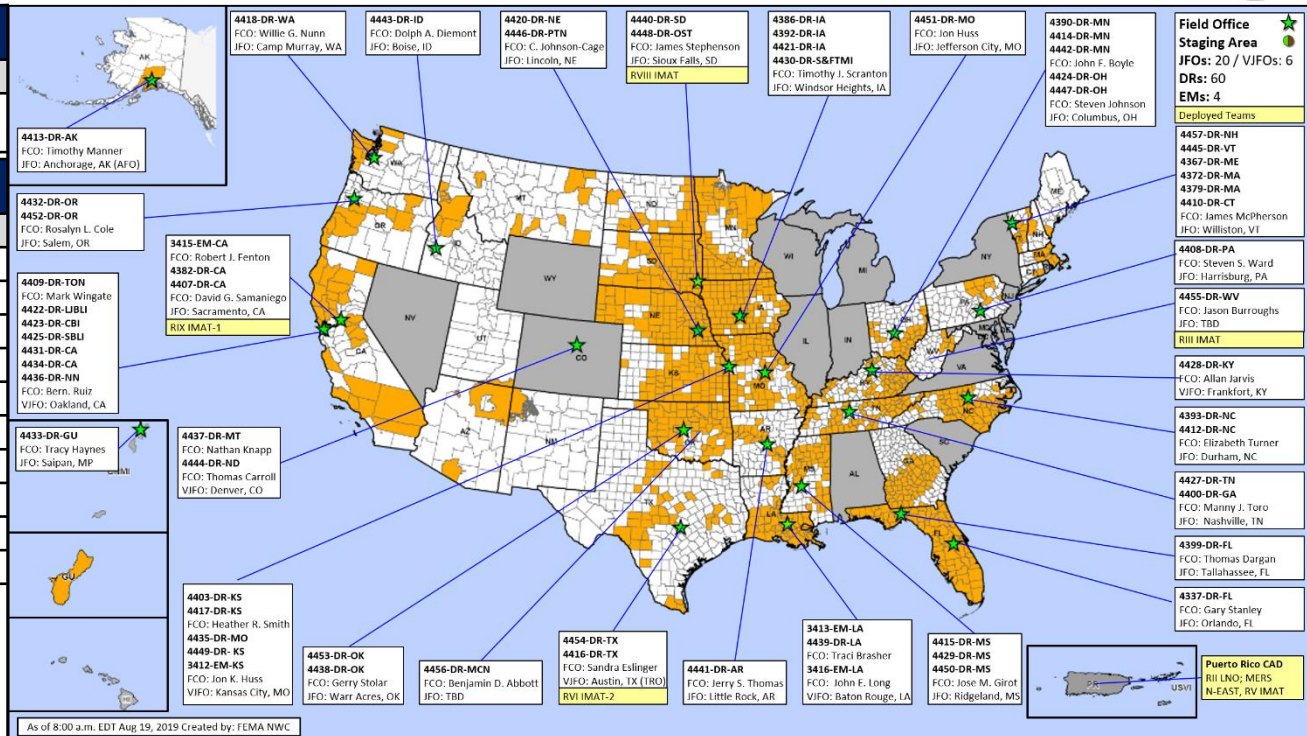
