#### Winter Storm – Midwest to Northeast



#### Situation (January 5 - 7)

- Cold air outbreak impacting much of Central & Eastern U.S.
- Wind chill values of -30 to -60 degrees below zero expected across Upper Midwest
- Additional snowfall (up to 15 inches) expected in portions of the Midwest

#### **Impacts**


- · No major widespread damage reported
- Approximately 121,000 customer outages reported; across FEMA Regions I-V
  - Region V: 67k (39k IN and 19k IL) (DOE EAGLE-I System)
- · 1 unconfirmed fatality reported in Indiana
- Flight, rail, and highway delays and cancelations reported
- · Numerous school districts, state and county government closings and delays reported


#### State Response

- IN,TN & MI SEOCs Partially Activated; all other SEOCs remain at Normal Operations
- ARC Shelters open/ occupants; IN -13/96; IL -3 /142; OH -1/ unk
- · State and city warming centers are open across numerous states
- · IN Governor deployed 48 National Guard Highway Safety Teams
- · No requests for FEMA assistance

#### FEMA Response

- · All FEMA Regions remain at Watch/Steady State
- NRCC is not activated; the FEMA NWC remains at Watch/Steady State







# Precipitation Forecast – 3 Day






## River Forecast – 7 Day






# Convective Outlooks Days 1 - 3





## Critical Fire Weather Areas Days 1 - 8






