### Significant Activity: February 7 – 8



#### **Significant Events:**

Winter Weather Recovery – Plains to Northeast

#### **Significant Weather:**

- Freezing rain Pacific Northwest; Central Great Basin
- Heavy snow possible Rockies, Great Basin, Great Lakes
- Snow possible Western US to Mid-Atlantic
- Rain CA to Central Great Basin
- Flash flooding CA
- Red Flag Warnings/Critical Fire Weather Areas: None
- Space Weather: No space weather storms observed past 24; Minor predicted/G1 geomagnetic storms and R1 radio blackouts likely next 24 hours
- Earthquakes: No significant activity

FEMA Readiness: None

### Winter Storm – Plains to Northeast

#### **Current Situation**

- · Power restoration ongoing; outages continue to decrease
- ▲ As of 8:30 a.m. EST, 177k customers remain without power in Region III (peak 907k)
  - PA: 170k (peak of 723k); MD: 6k (peak 150k) (Department of Energy's EAGLE-I system. Note: Comprehensive National coverage of all electric service providers is not available.)
- · Elsewhere, only sporadic outages remain

#### **Pennsylvania**

- PA EOC at Level II (Partial Activation)
- ▲ 4 (-4) long-term care facilities remain on generator power (Region III RWC)
- ▲ 3 water treatment/sewage facilities remain offline
- ▲ 1 confirmed storm-related fatality (FEMA Region III SITREP #6)
- ▲ 2 (-6) shelters open with 37 (-110) occupants (ARC midnight shelter count)
- ▲ 112 (-137) National Guardsmen remain activated

#### <u>Maryland</u>

- MD EOC at Level III (Additional Staffing)
- ▲ 4 long-term care facilities remain on generator power (Region III RWC)
- ▲ 1 (-1) shelter open with no occupants (ARC midnight shelter count)

#### FEMA Response

- NRCC not activated
- ▲ NWC returned to Watch/Steady State
- Region III RRCC at Watch/Steady State
- Region III IMAT deployed to PA EOC
- 97 generators delivered to FSA at Horsham Air Guard Station in Horsham, PA; pre-positioning only no generators requested






### National Weather Forecast







# **Precipitation Forecast**







### **Total Snow Forecast**






# River Forecast – 7 Day






# Convective Outlooks Days 1 - 3






### Critical Fire Weather Areas Days 1 - 8




