## Significant Activity: February 8 – 9



### **Significant Events:**

Winter Weather Recovery – Plains to Northeast

#### **Significant Weather:**

- Heavy snow possible Rockies, Great Basin, Great Lakes, and North East
- Snow possible Western US to Mid-Atlantic
- Rain/Snow Pacific Northwest, Southwest, Southeast, Florida, and Mid Atlantic
- Rain CA to Central Great Basin
- Red Flag Warnings/Critical Fire Weather Areas: AK
- Space Weather: Minor /G1 geomagnetic storms over the past 24 hours; Minor /R1 radio blackouts are likely over the next 24 hours

**FEMA Readiness:** Nothing significant to report

## Winter Storm – Plains to Northeast



#### **Current Situation**

- Power restoration is ongoing; outages continue to decrease
- ▲ As of 8:00 a.m. EST, 67k customers remain without power in Region III (peak 907k)
  - o PA: 65k (peak of 723k); MD: under 300 (peak 150k)
- Elsewhere, sporadic outages remain

#### Pennsylvania

- ▲ PA EOC transitioned from Level II (Partial Activation) to Enhanced Monitoring (additional staffing & augmentation of the Depart of Public Welfare and Public Utility Commission)
- 4 long-term care facilities remain on generator power (Region III RWC)
- 3 water treatment/sewage facilities remain offline
- 1 confirmed storm-related fatality (FEMA Region III SITREP #6)
- ▲ 1 shelter open with 70 occupants (ARC midnight shelter count)
- 112 National Guardsmen remain activated

#### **Maryland**

- ▲ MD EOC at Level IV (Normal Operations)
- 4 long-term care facilities remain on generator power (Region III RWC)
- ▲ 1 shelter open with 0 occupants (ARC midnight shelter count)


#### FEMA Response

- NRCC not activated; NWC Watch/Steady State
- Region III RRCC at Watch/Steady State; Region III IMAT is deployed to PA EOC
- All 97 generators delivered to FSA at Horsham Air Guard Station in Horsham, PA; pre-positioning only – no generators have been requested






## National Weather Forecast








## **Total Snow Forecast**


# River Forecast – 7 Day






# Convective Outlooks Days 1 - 3






## Critical Fire Weather Areas Days 1 - 8




