- Eastern Pacific – Tropical cyclone activity is not expected during the next 48 hours
- Central Pacific – No tropical cyclones expected through Wednesday night

Significant Weather:

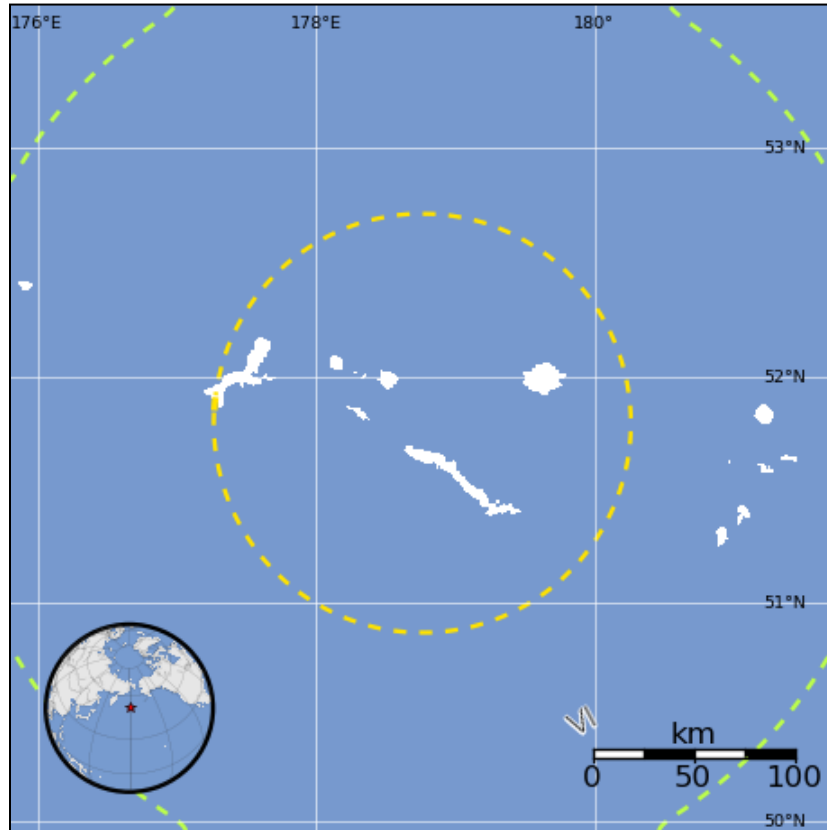
- Severe thunderstorms – Central High Plains

- Red Flag Warnings: None

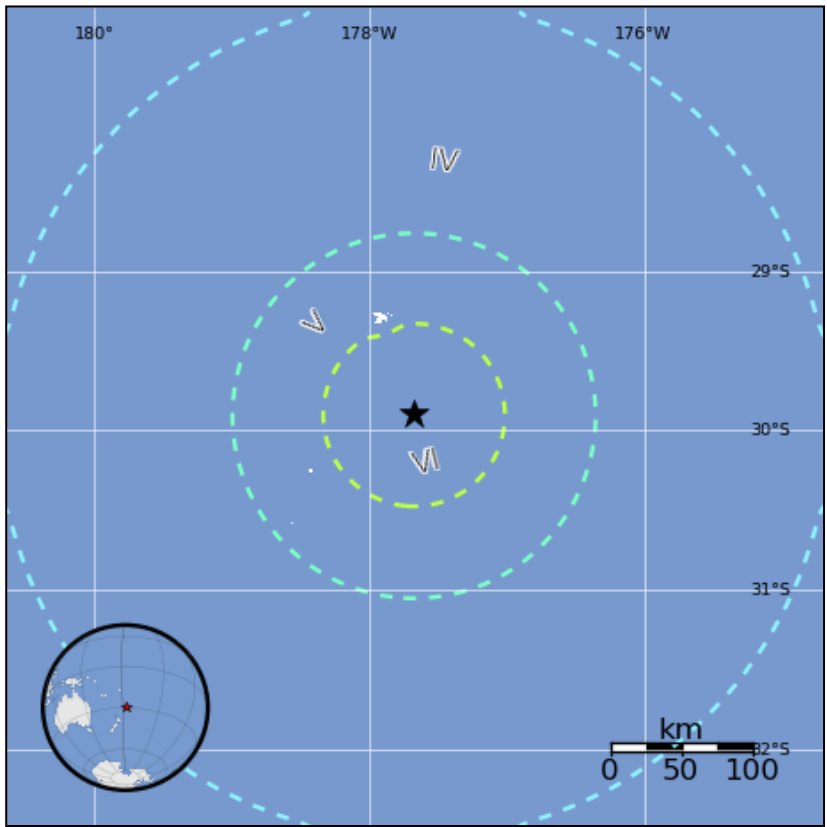
M 7.9 – Rat Islands, Aleutian Islands, AK

- Occurred at 4:53 p.m. EDT on June 23, 2014
 - 25 miles NW of Amchitka, Alaska
 - Depth of 70 miles
- No damage or injuries reported; USGS Green pager alert issued
- All tsunami watches, warnings and advisories have been canceled
 - No Pacific wide Tsunami Warning was issued
 - A coastal Tsunami Warning was issued for several islands, but later cancelled; highest wave observed was 0.7ft in Amchitka, AK
- Aftershocks continue; M6.9 was the highest
- Response:
 - State EOC not activated; no unmet needs
 - FEMA Region X remains at Watch/Steady State
 - No requests for FEMA assistance

Earthquake – Kermadec Island, New Zealand



M 7.2 – Kermadec Islands, New Zealand

- Occurred at 3:19 p.m. EDT on June 23, 2014
 - 45 miles SSE of Raoul Island, New Zealand
 - Depth of 3 miles
- No damage or injuries reported
- USGS issued a GREEN PAGER alert indicating:
 - Not felt; no secondary affects expected
 - 7k residents exposed to weak to light shaking (MMI III-IV)
- No tsunami watches or warnings were issued
- Aftershocks continue in the range of M4.9 to 6.2
- Response:
 - FEMA Region IX remains at Watch/Steady State
 - No requests for FEMA assistance

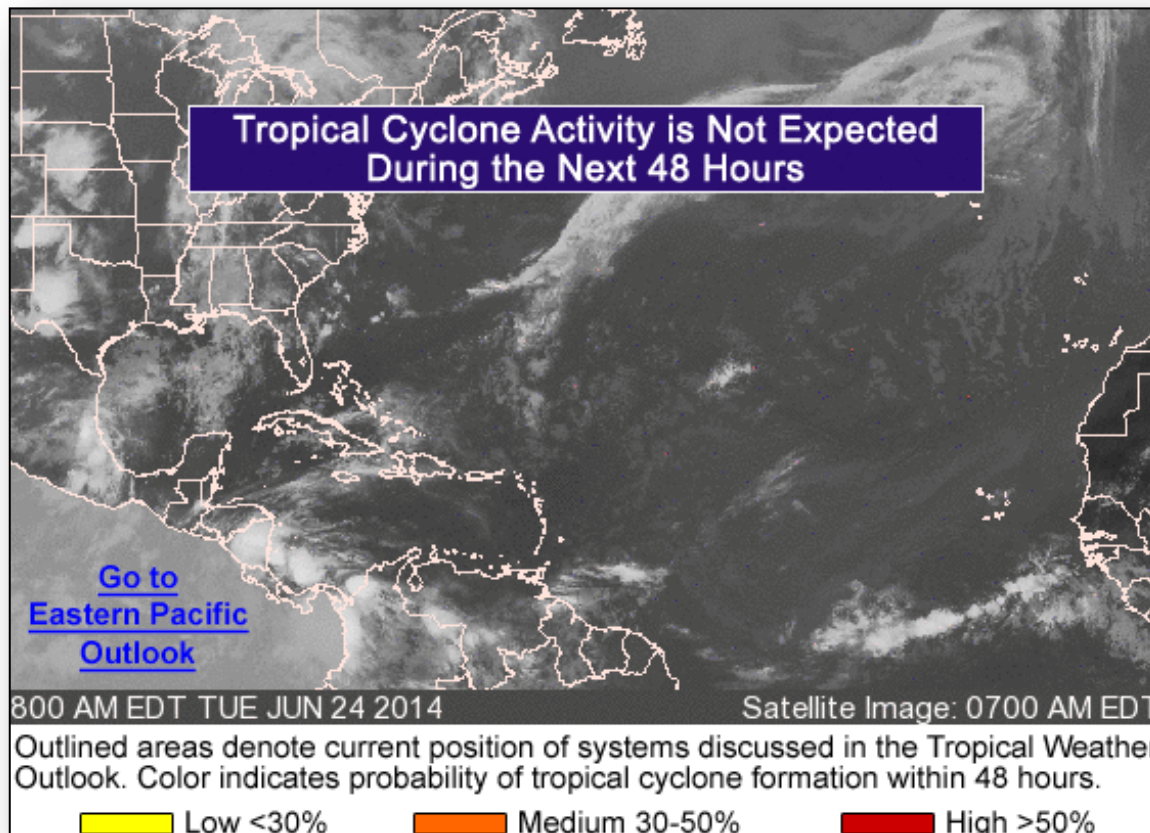

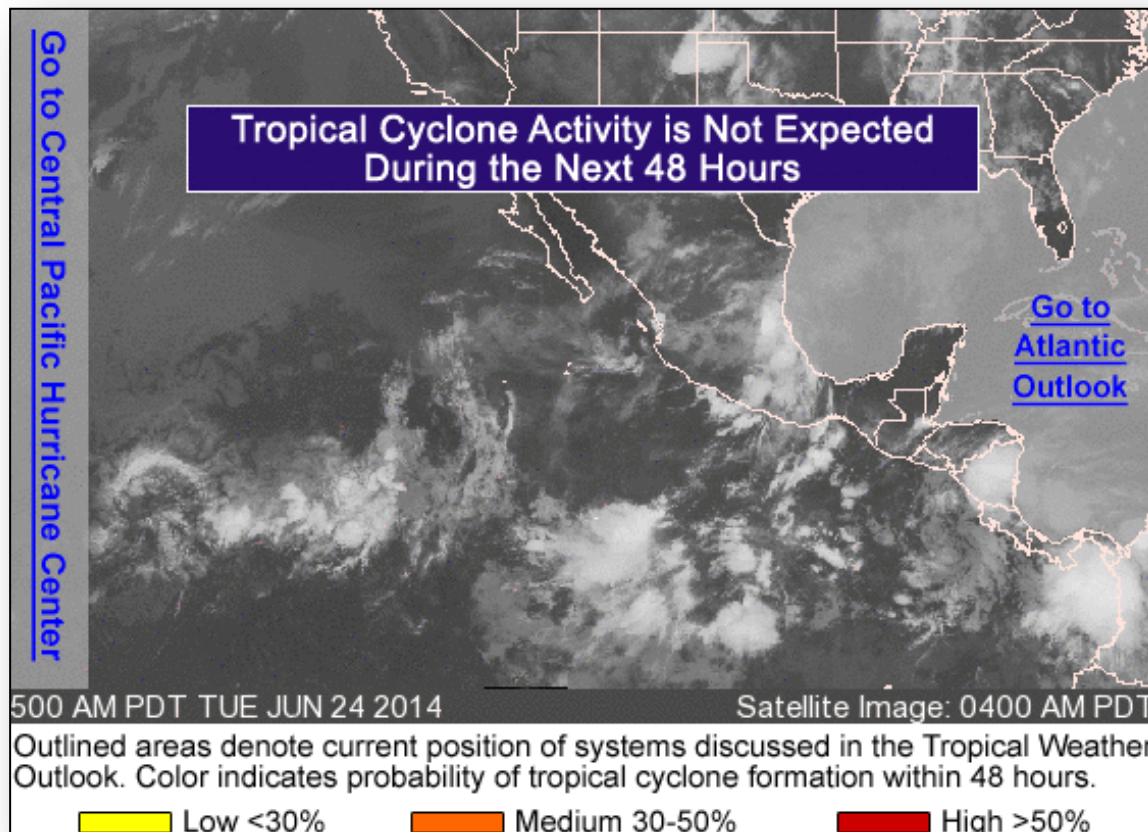
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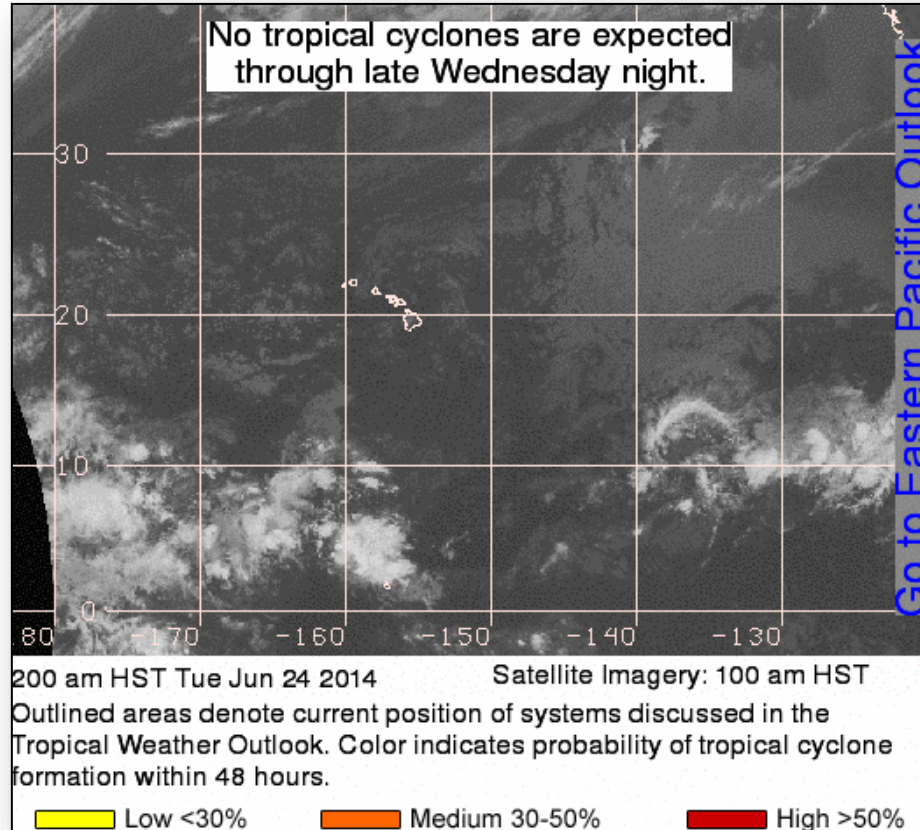
Tropical Outlook – Eastern Pacific

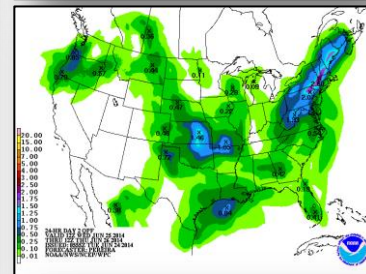




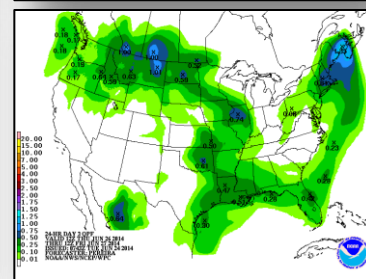
Precipitation Forecast – 3 Day

River Forecast



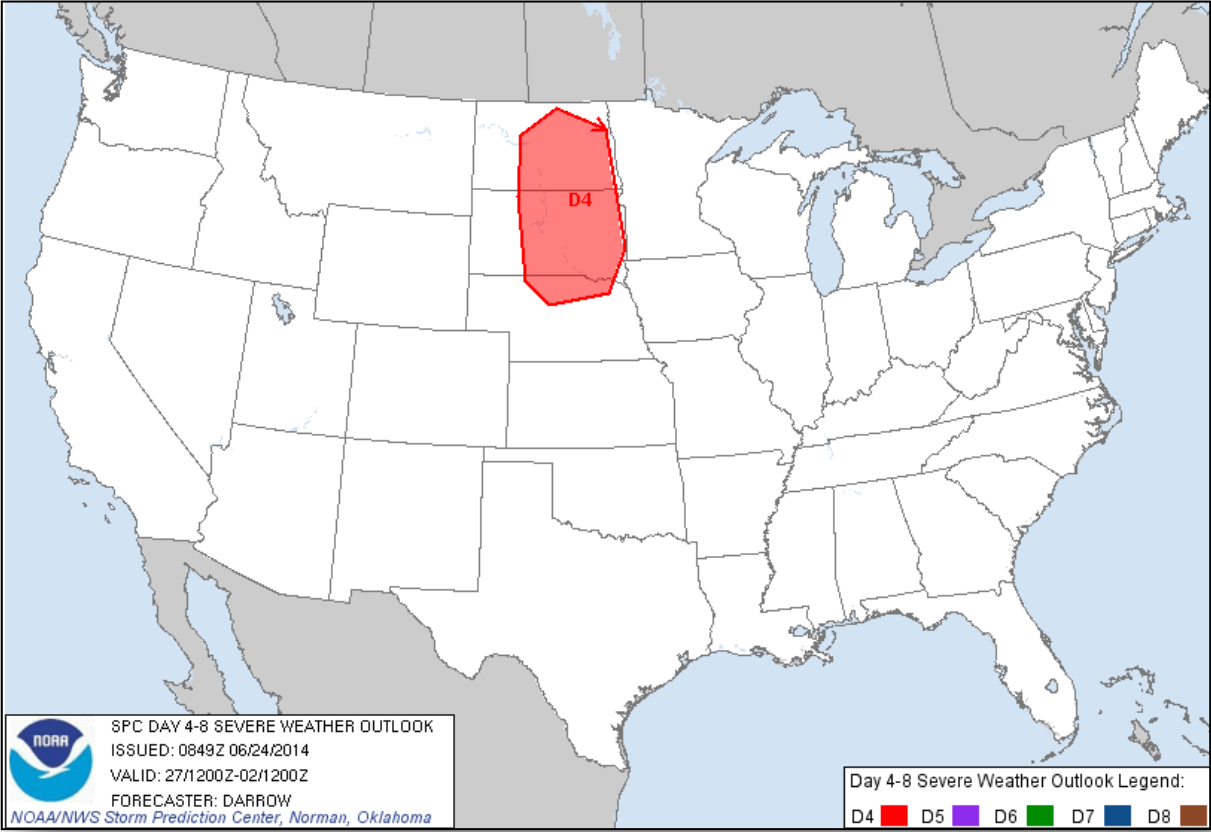
Convective Outlook, Day 1 – 3



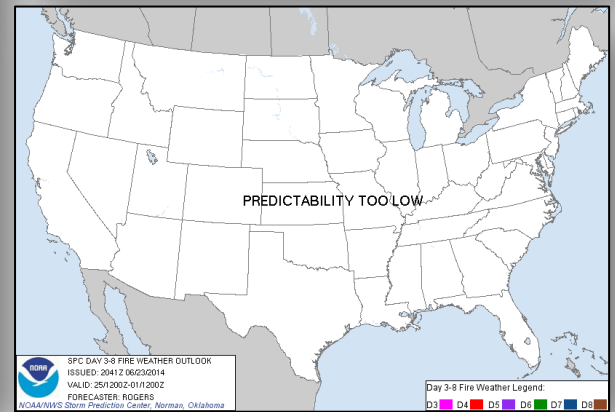
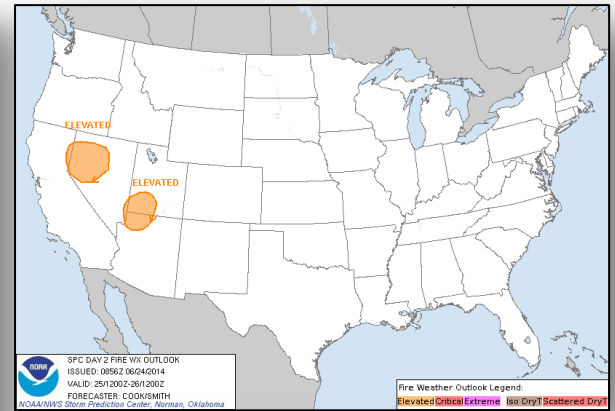
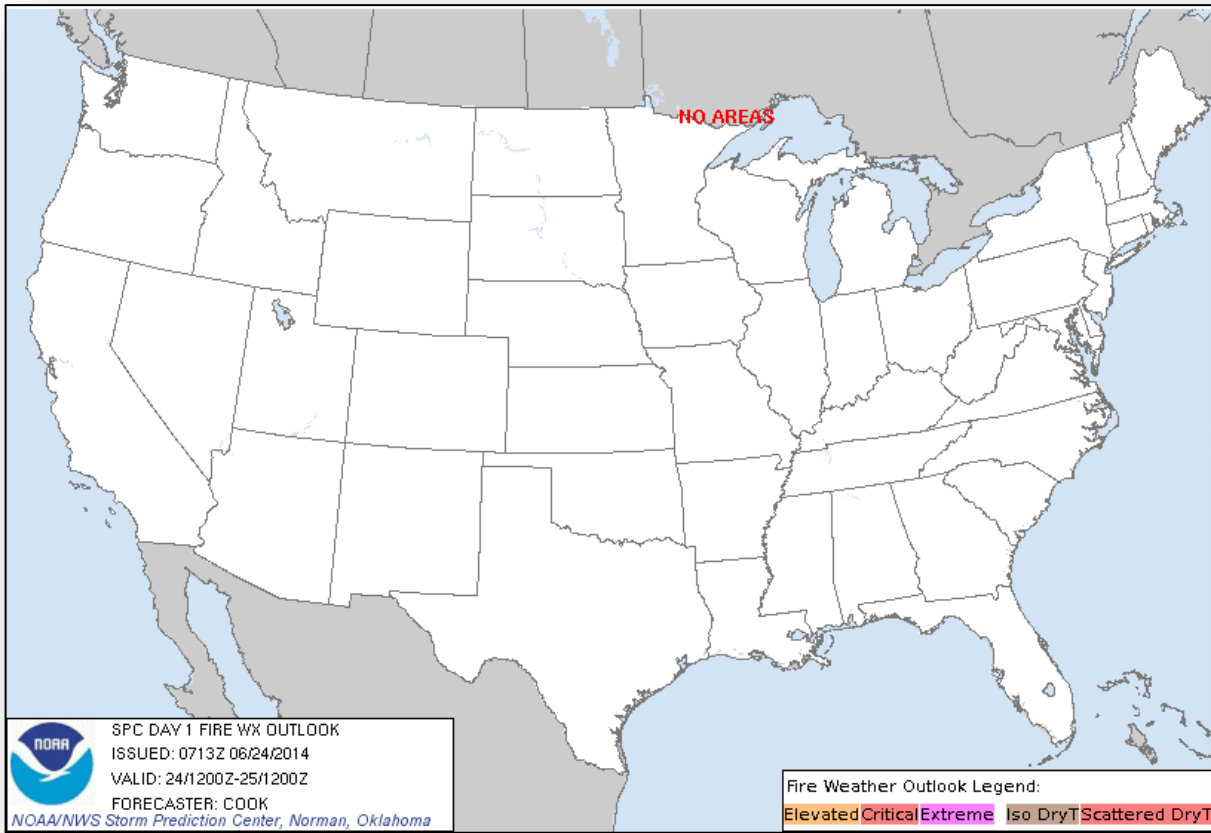
Convective Outlook, Day 4 – 8



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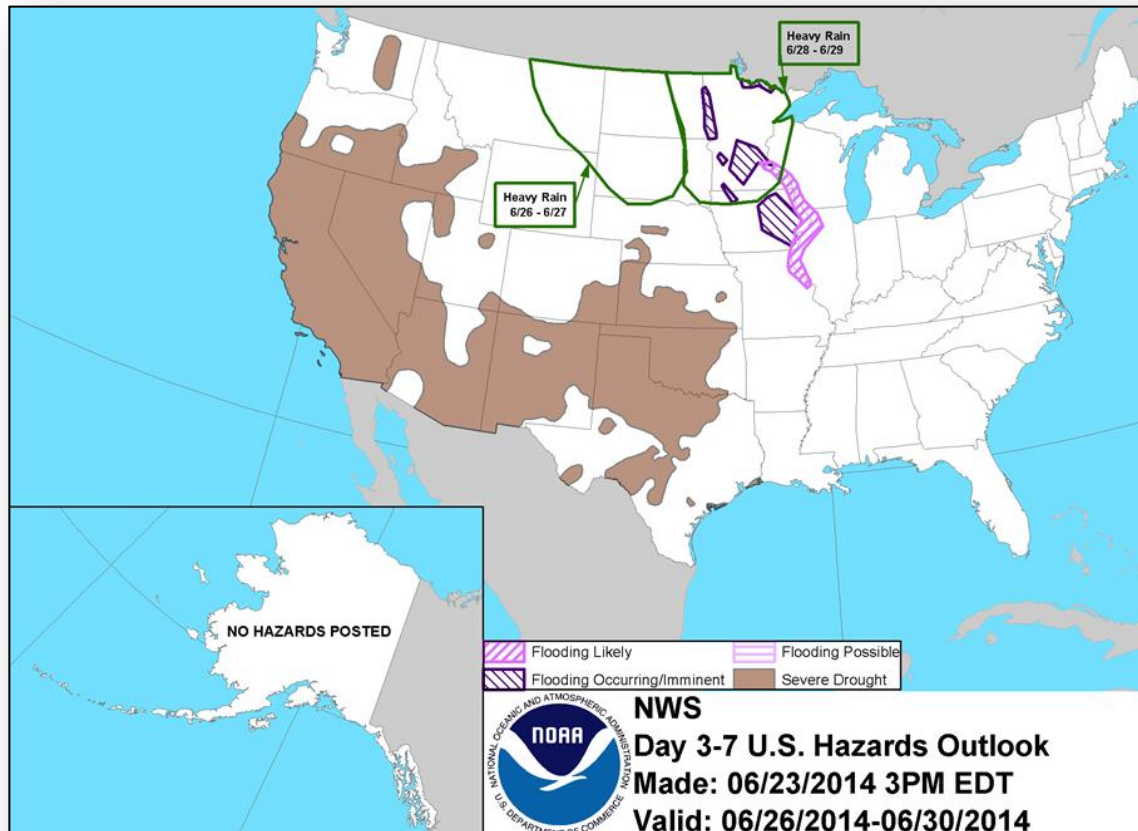
Critical Fire Weather Areas – Days 1-8

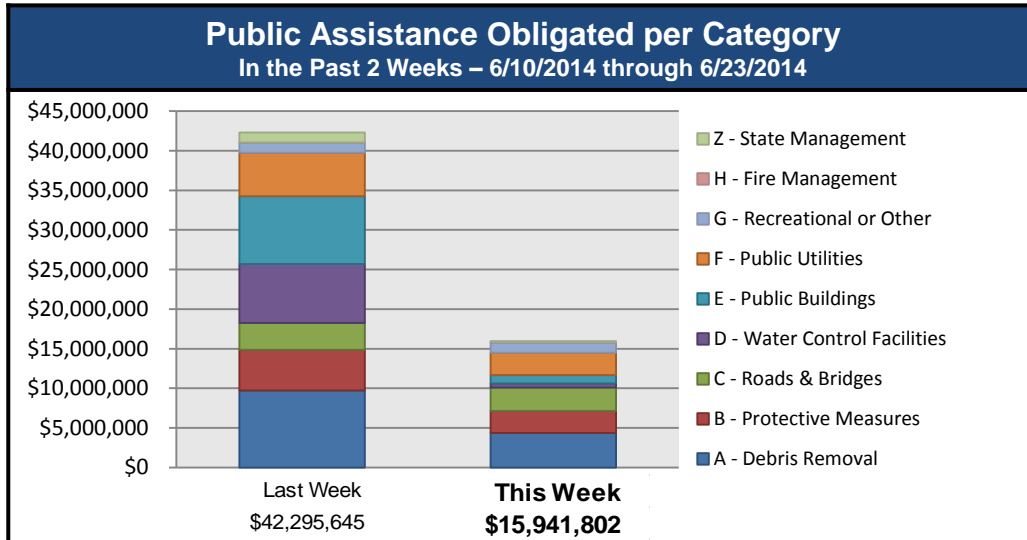
