## **Significant Weather:**

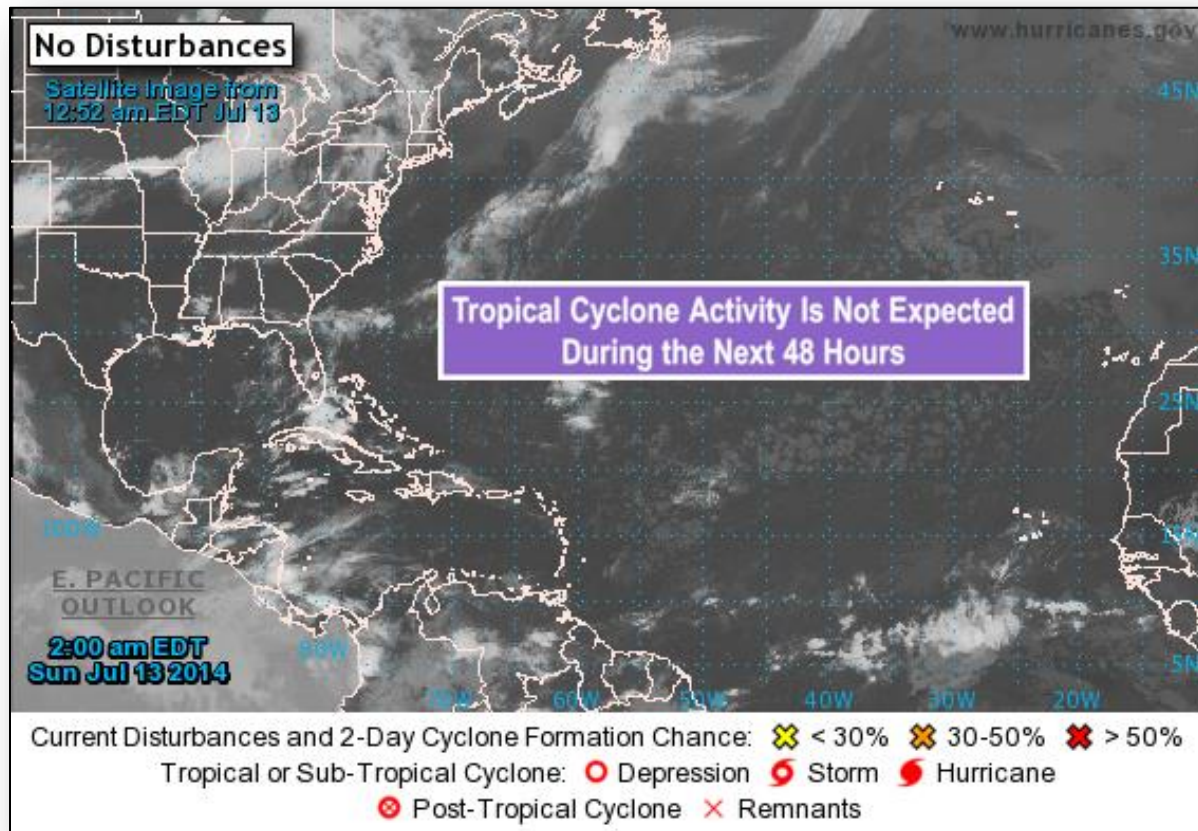
- Slight risk for severe thunderstorms – Middle Mississippi Valley & Lower Ohio Valley into western NY
- Possible flash flooding – Central Rockies; portions of the Midwest, Ohio Valley and northern Mid-Atlantic
- Isolated to scattered dry thunderstorms – Interior Pacific Northwest
- Red Flag Warnings: OR & WA
- Space Weather: No space weather storms occurred past 24 hrs; Minor radio blackouts likely next 24 hrs

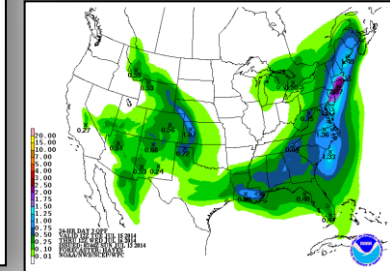
# Precipitation Forecast – 3 Day

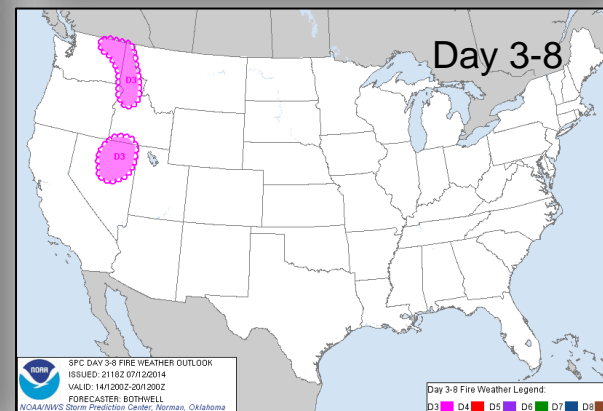
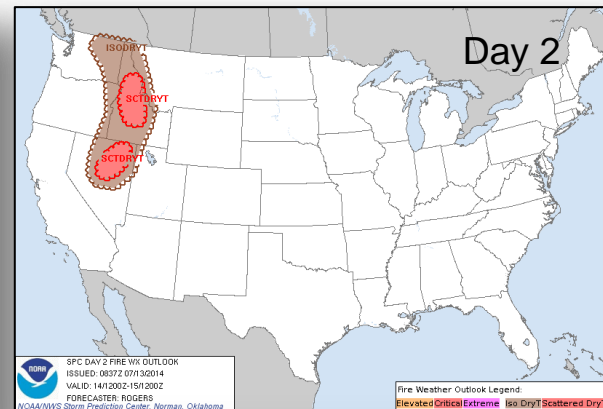
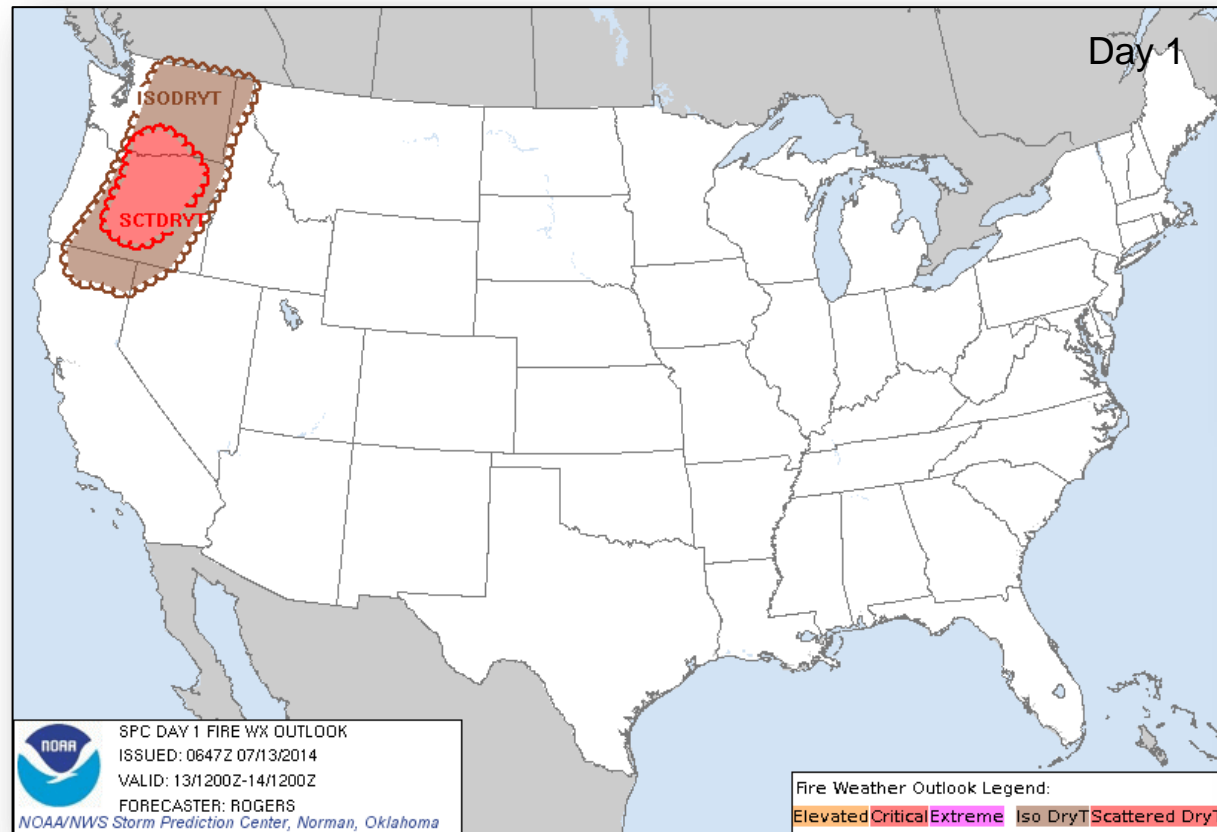




# Critical Fire Weather Areas – Days 1-8



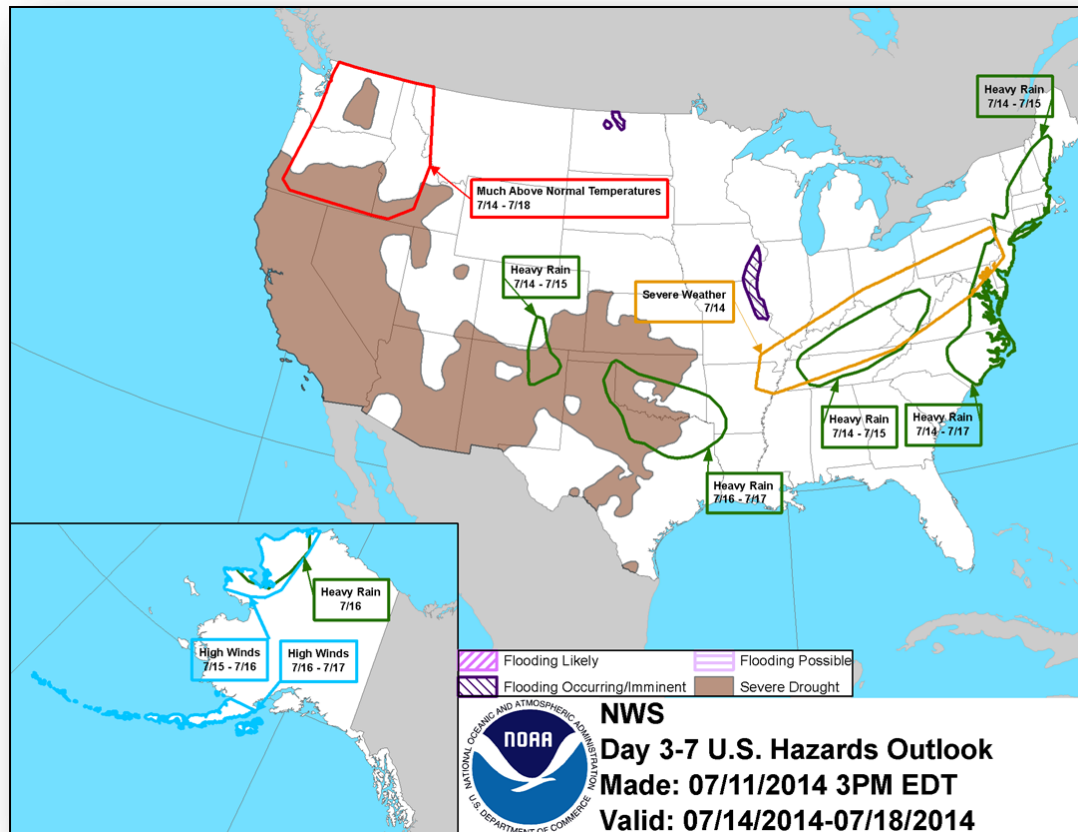

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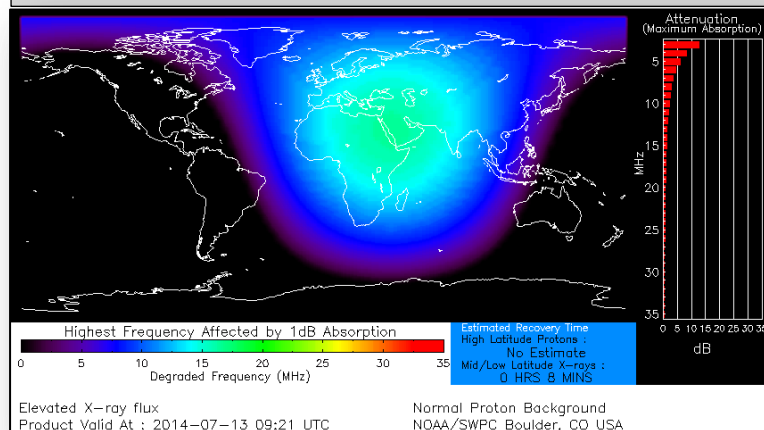

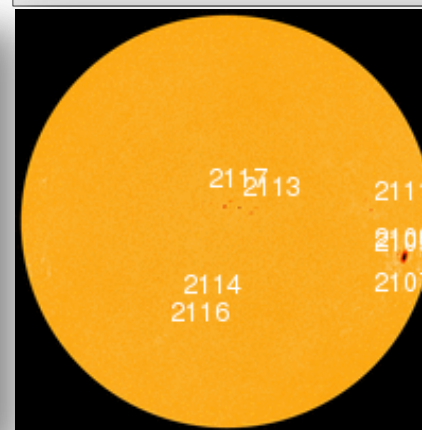
