Significant Weather:


- Slight risk of severe thunderstorms Northern Plains

Disturbance 1 (as of 8:00 a.m. EDT)


- Located over western Caribbean Sea

Next 5 days: Medium (40%)


2-Day Tropical Outlook – Eastern Pacific






National Weather Forecast






Active Watches/Warnings





Precipitation Forecast – 3 Day






River Forecast






Convective Outlook, Days 1-3






Fire Weather Outlook, Days 1 - 8





