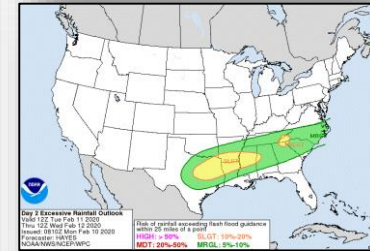
National Weather Forecast
