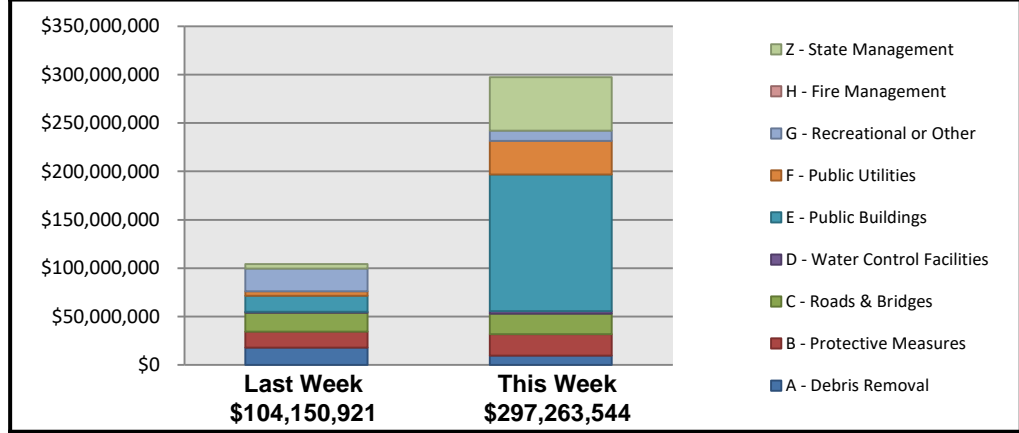

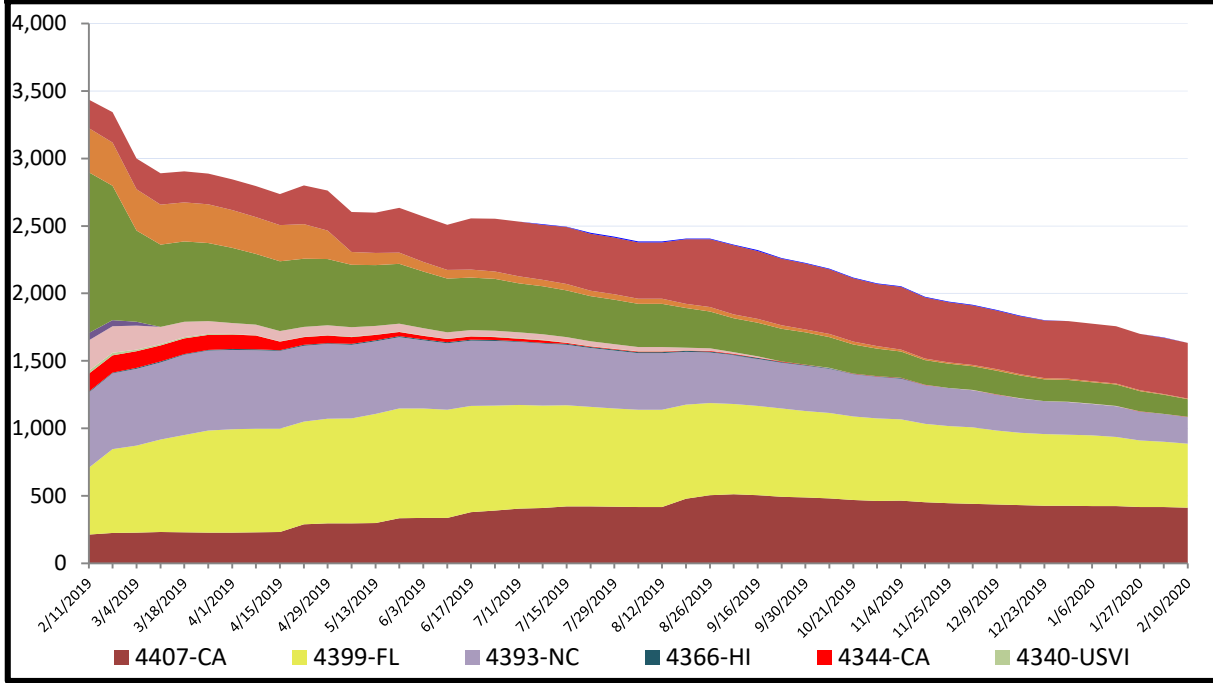

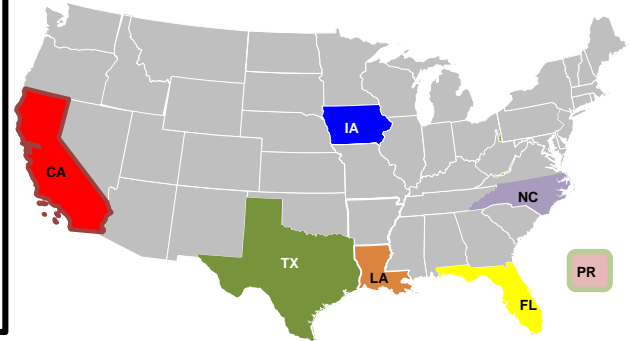

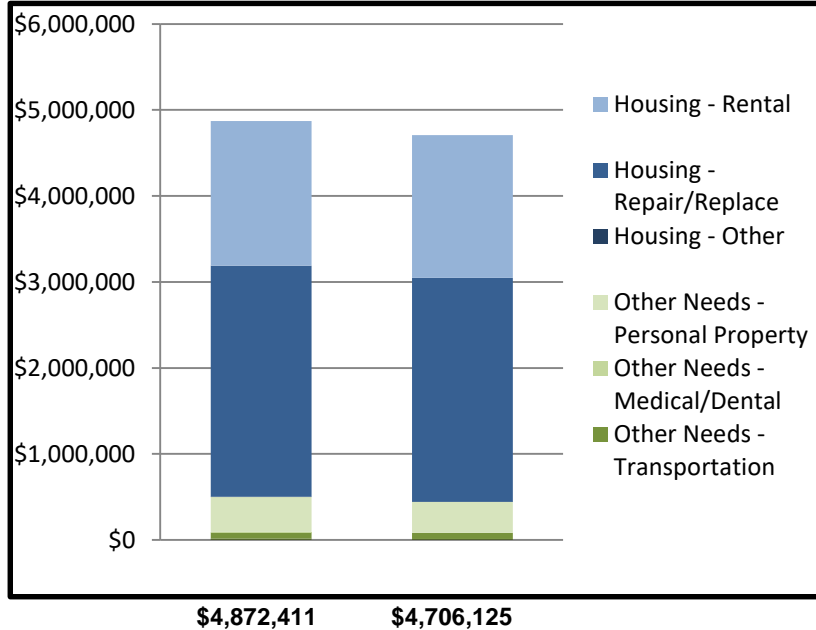


States with Currently Occupied Units
