Tropical Cyclone 18P (Wasi) *(Advisory 9 as of 10:00 a.m. ET, Feb 23)*

- 150 miles NNW of Niue; moving SSE at 7 mph
- Maximum sustained winds 29 mph
- This is the final update on this system from the Joint Typhoon Warning center

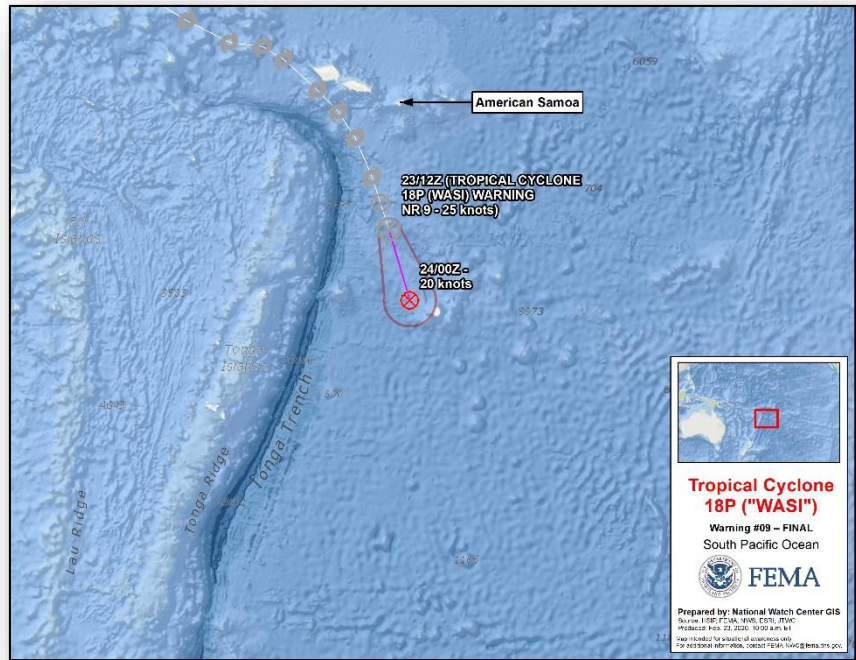

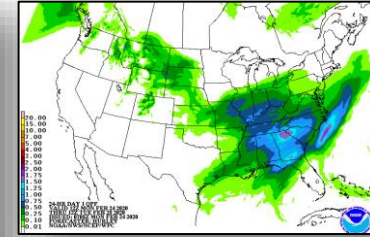

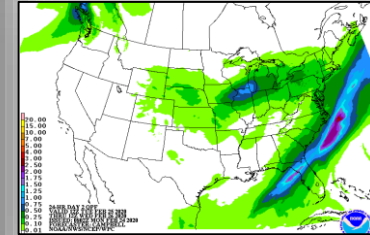

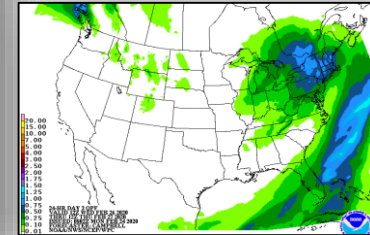

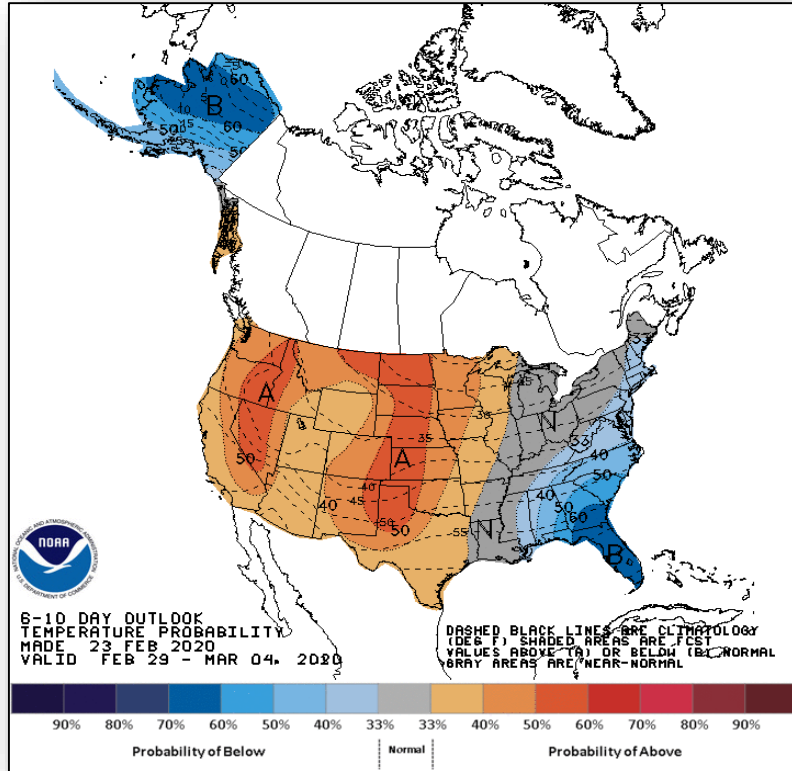

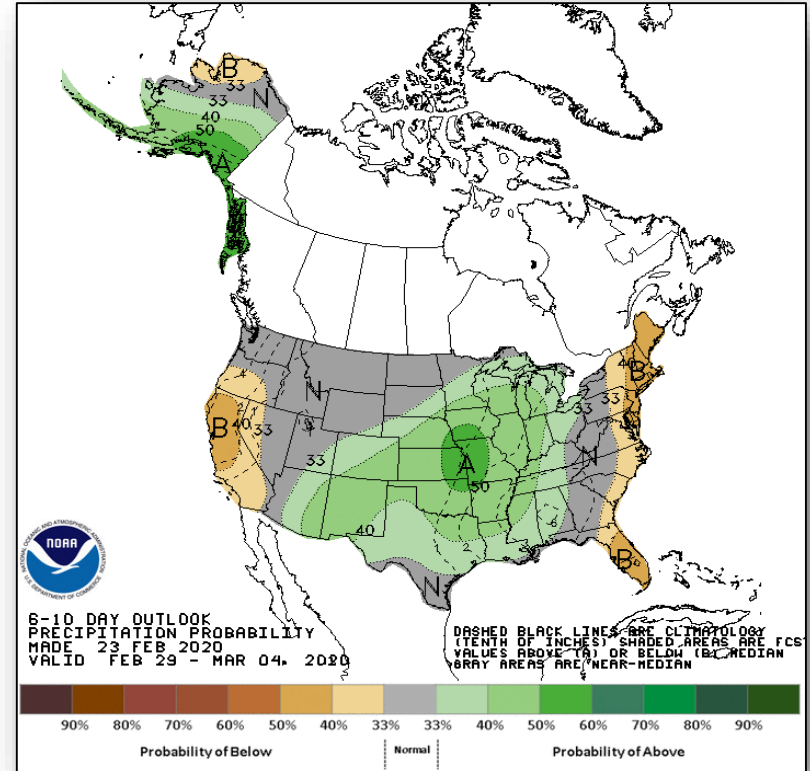
Long Range Outlooks – Feb 29-Mar 4
