





#### **Daily Trends of COVID-19 Deaths**




National Inpatient Beds Used - COVID-19 Patients



- FEMA NRCC activated to Level I in support of COVID-19 operations




## COVID-19 Vaccine Weekly Update (CDC data, as of March 21)


















6-10 Day Temperature Probability




6-10 Day Precipitation Probability






