COVID-19 Update



Situation: FEMA and HHS continue to work requirements supporting state, tribal, and territorial requests.

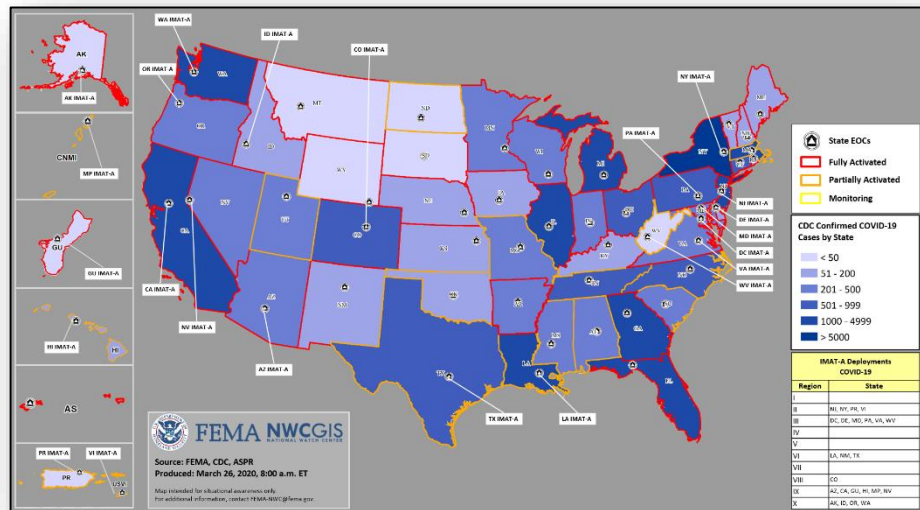
- All 50 states, the District of Columbia, 5 territories, and 5 tribal nations are working directly with FEMA under the nationwide emergency declaration for COVID-19
- Using new acquisitions, the Strategic National Stockpile, and Department of Defense allocations, FEMA is leading the coordinated Federal agency efforts increasing hospital capacity, community-based testing sites (CBTS), and significant deployment of personal protective equipment and medical equipment
- 17 states have issued shelter-in-place orders; 27 community-based testing sites in operation
(HHS/FEMA COVID-19 SLB, as of 12:00 p.m. ET March 25)

State / Local Response:

- All State / Territories activated
- National Guard has been activated in 32 states

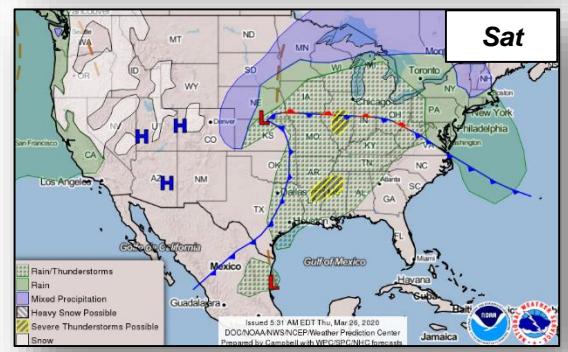
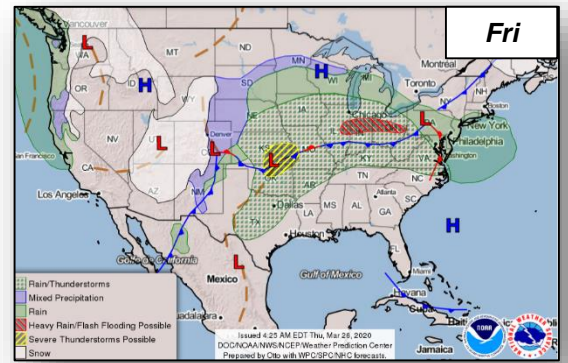
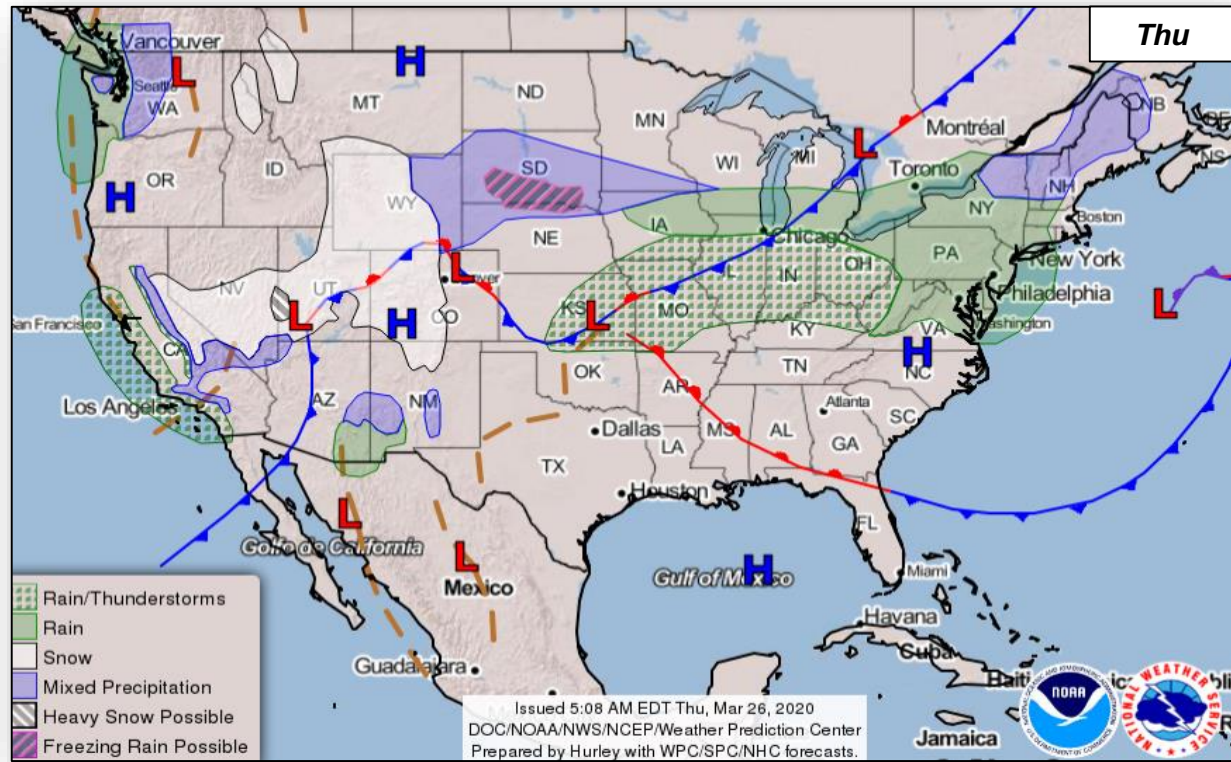
- NRCC: Level I in unified effort with HHS SOC; All RRCCs activated

- Dept. State posted Global Level 4 Health Advisory: Do Not Travel
- Approved COVID-19 Major Disaster Declarations: 8 states/territories
- COVID-19 Major Disaster Declarations requested by: 8 states/territories



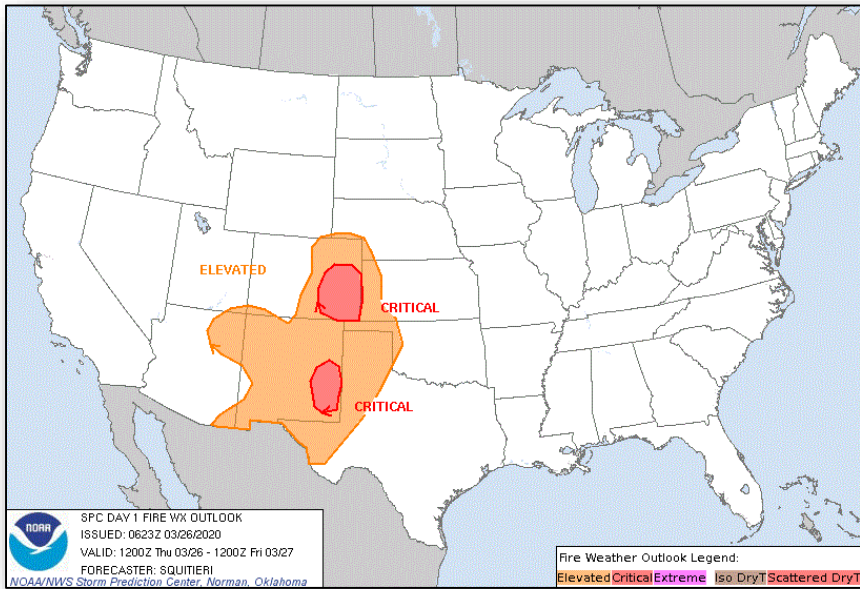

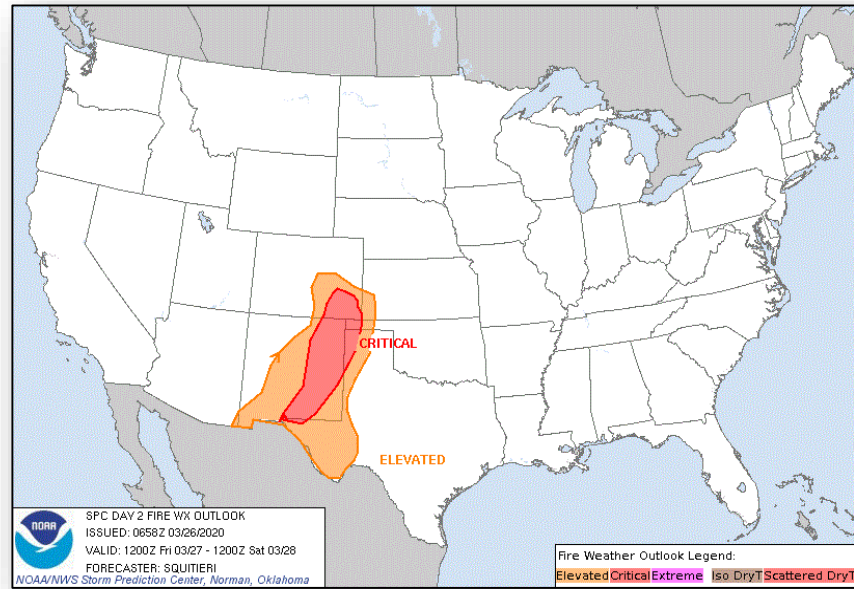
National Weather Forecast

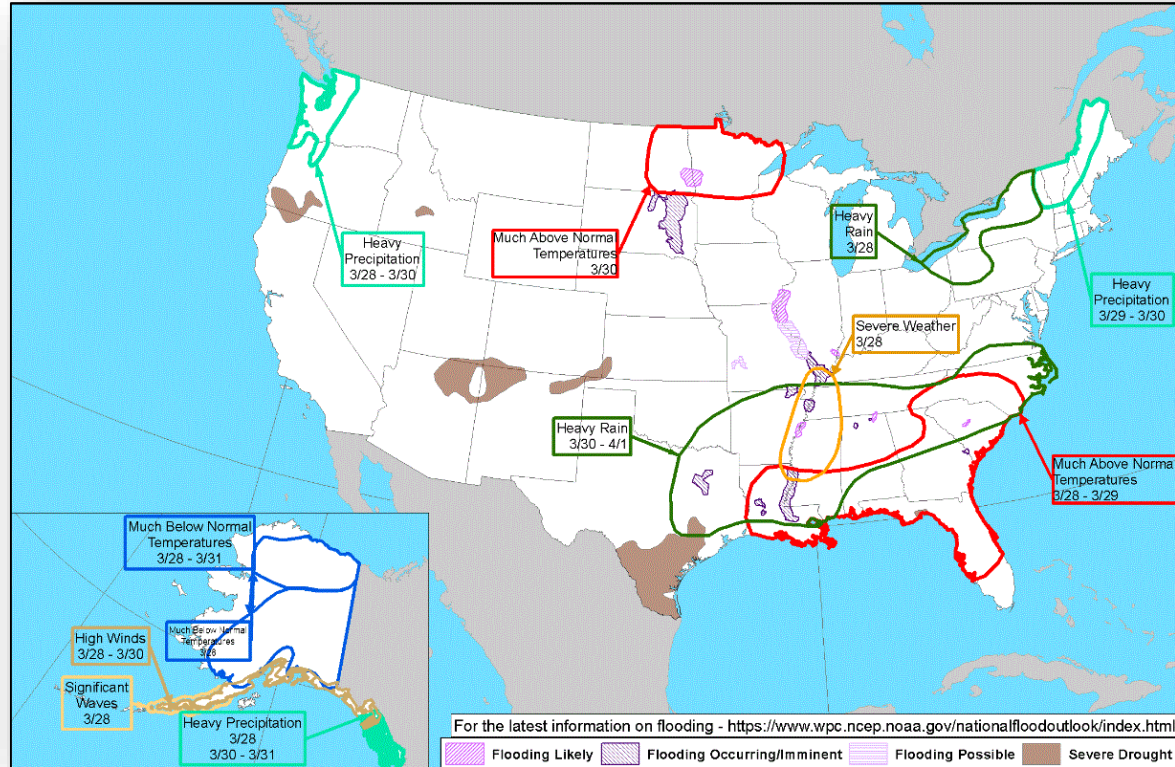
