





**Daily Trends of COVID-19 Deaths** 




National Inpatient Beds Used - COVID-19 Patients



- FEMA NRCC activated to Level I in support of COVID-19 operations




### COVID-19 Vaccine Weekly Update (CDC data, as of April 11)











