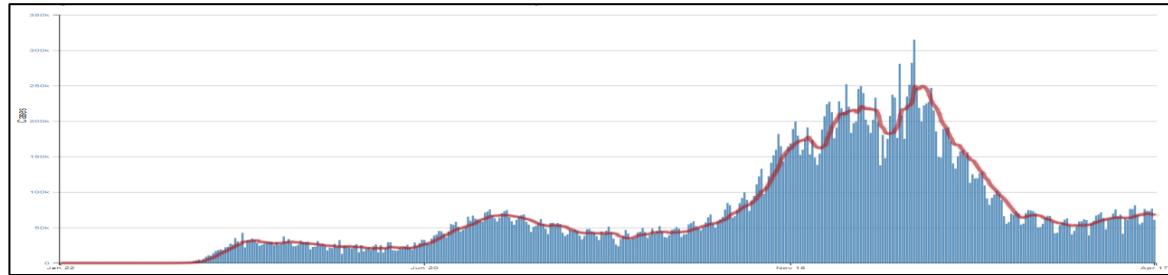

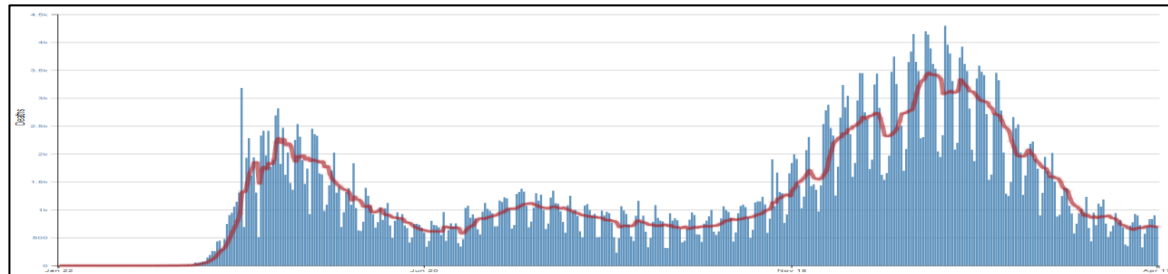

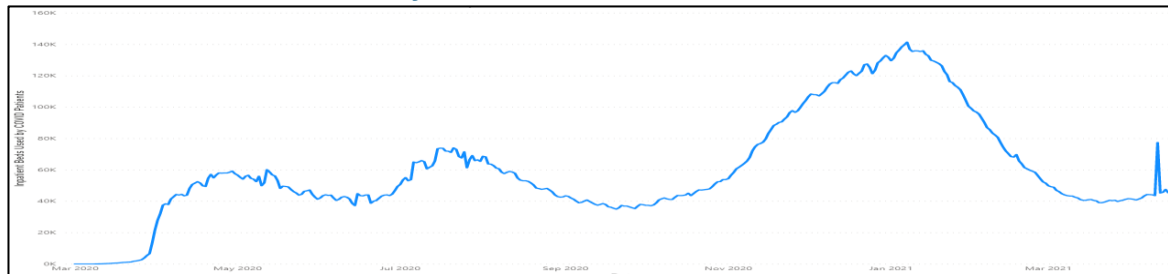
COVID-19 Weekly Update *(CDC data, as of April 18)*



Daily Trends of COVID-19 Cases



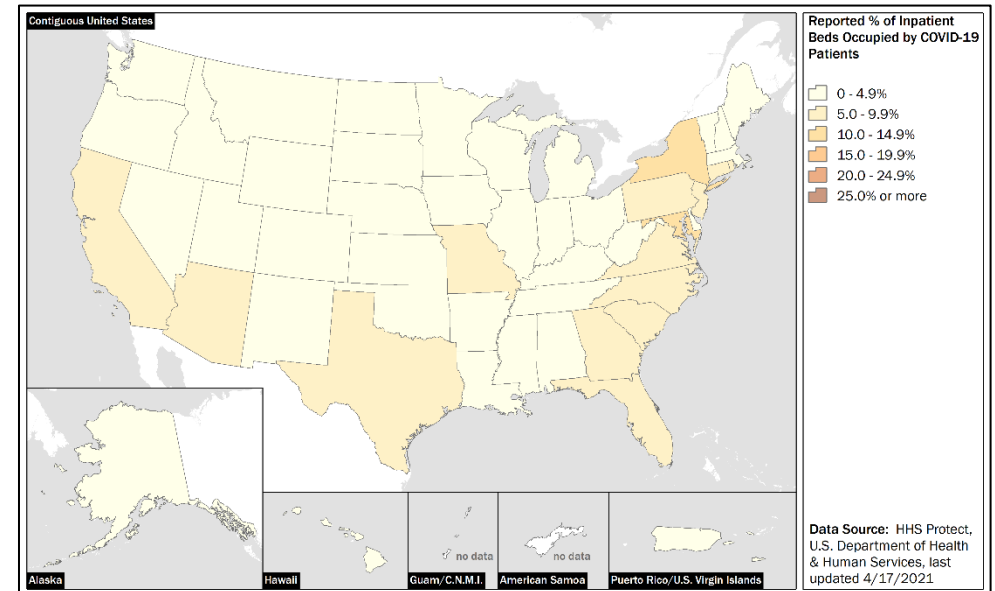
Daily Trends of COVID-19 Deaths



National Inpatient Beds Used – COVID-19 Patients

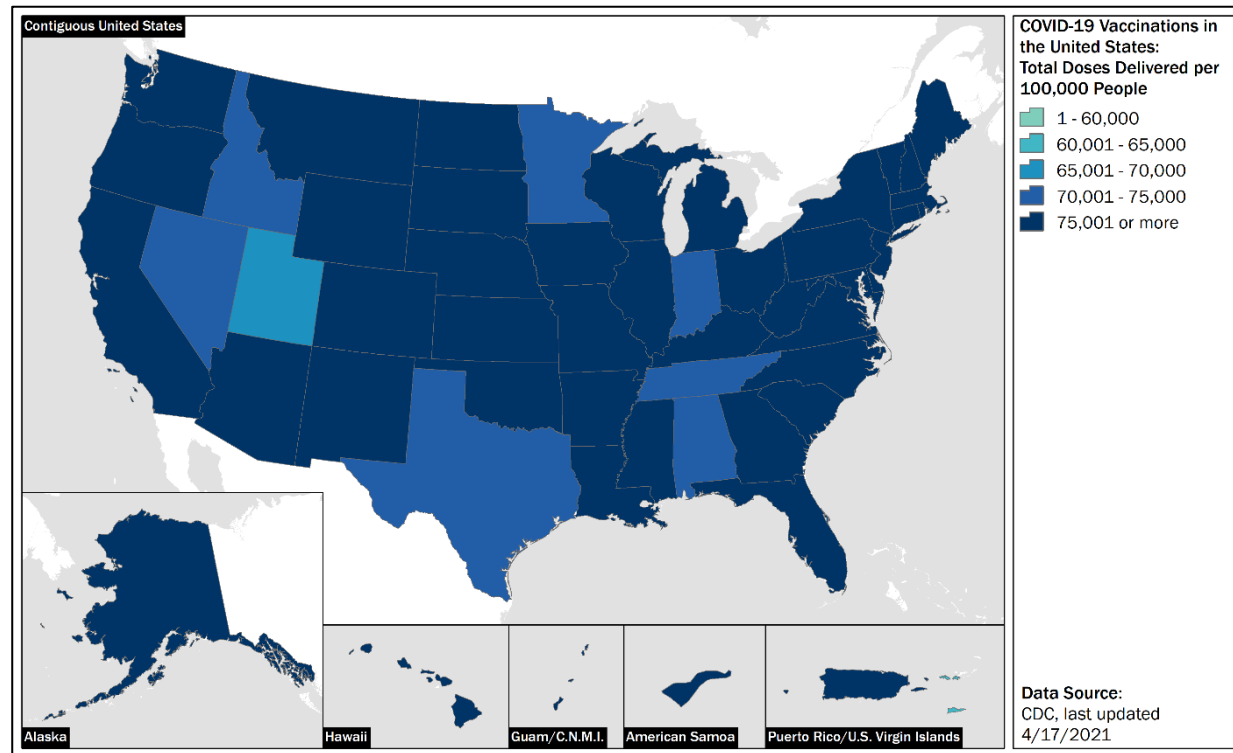
Key Updates:

- U.S. COVID-19 totals:
 - Confirmed Cases: **31,444,706 (+479,129)**
 - Confirmed Deaths: **563,980 (+5,137)**
- Major Disaster Declarations: 59 Emergency Declarations: 43
- Public Assistance obligated for COVID-19 Response: **\$21.5 billion (+\$500 million)**
- FEMA NRCC activated to Level I in support of COVID-19 operations



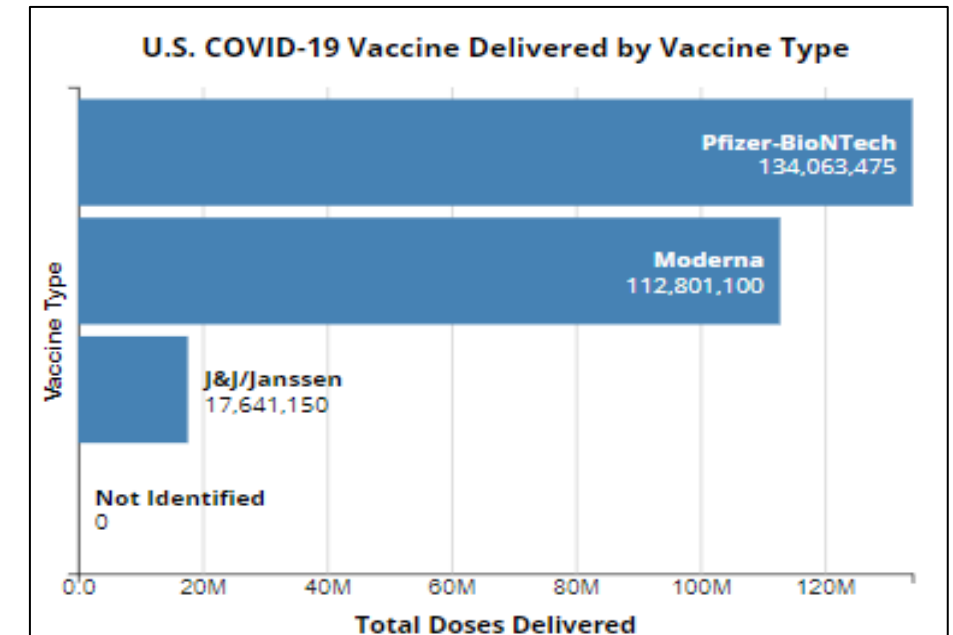

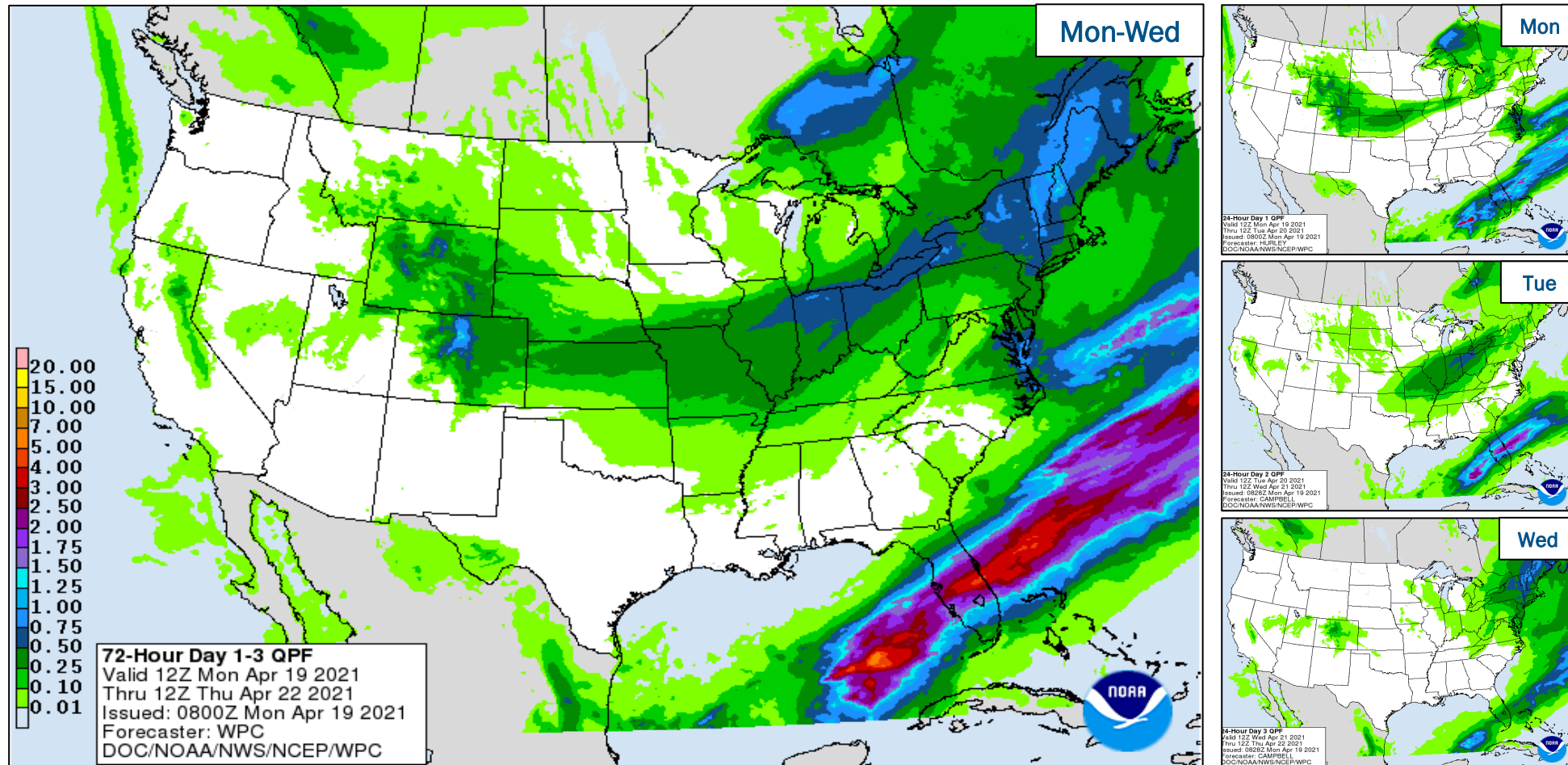
National Weather Forecast

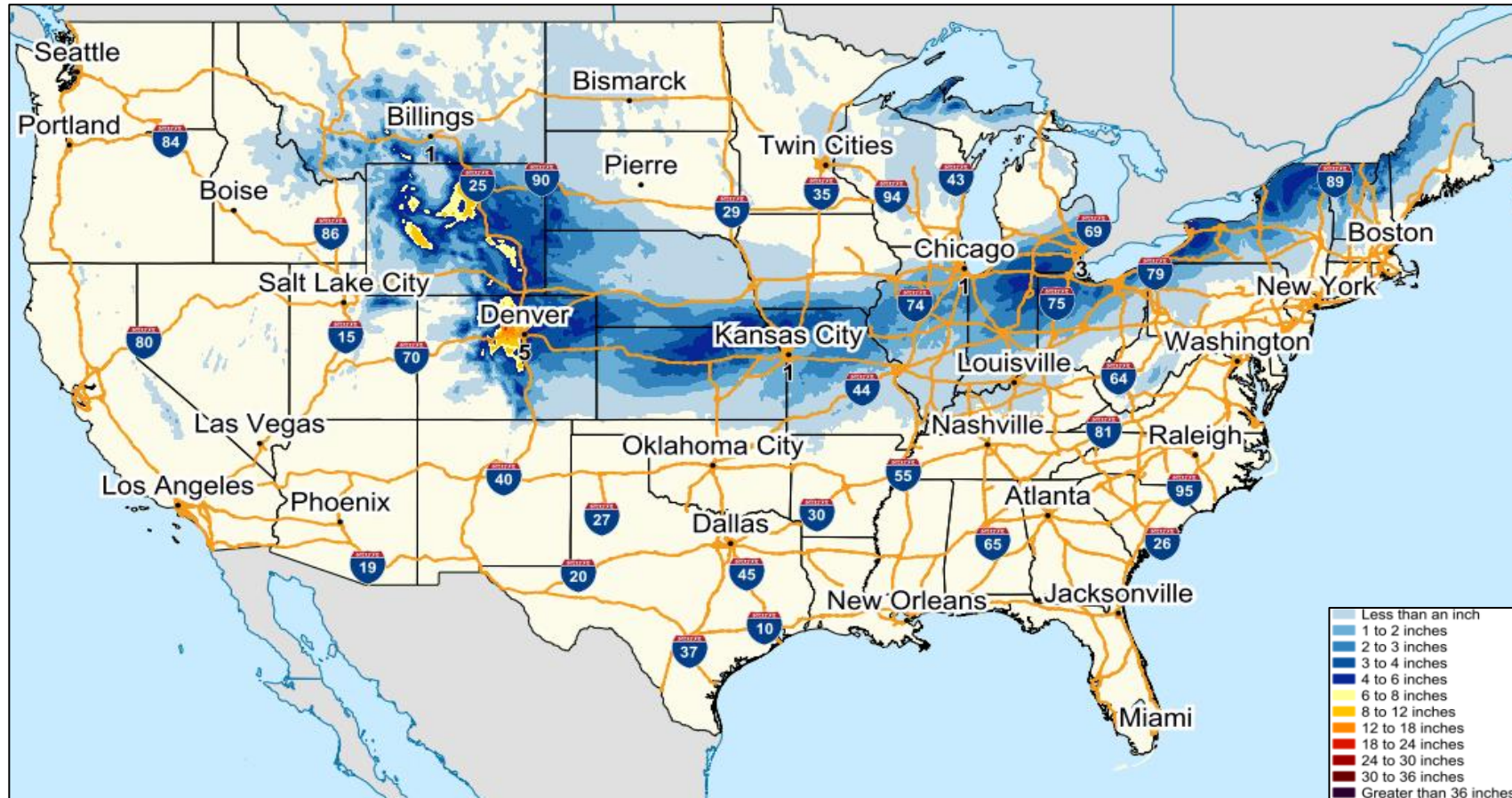
Precipitation Forecast

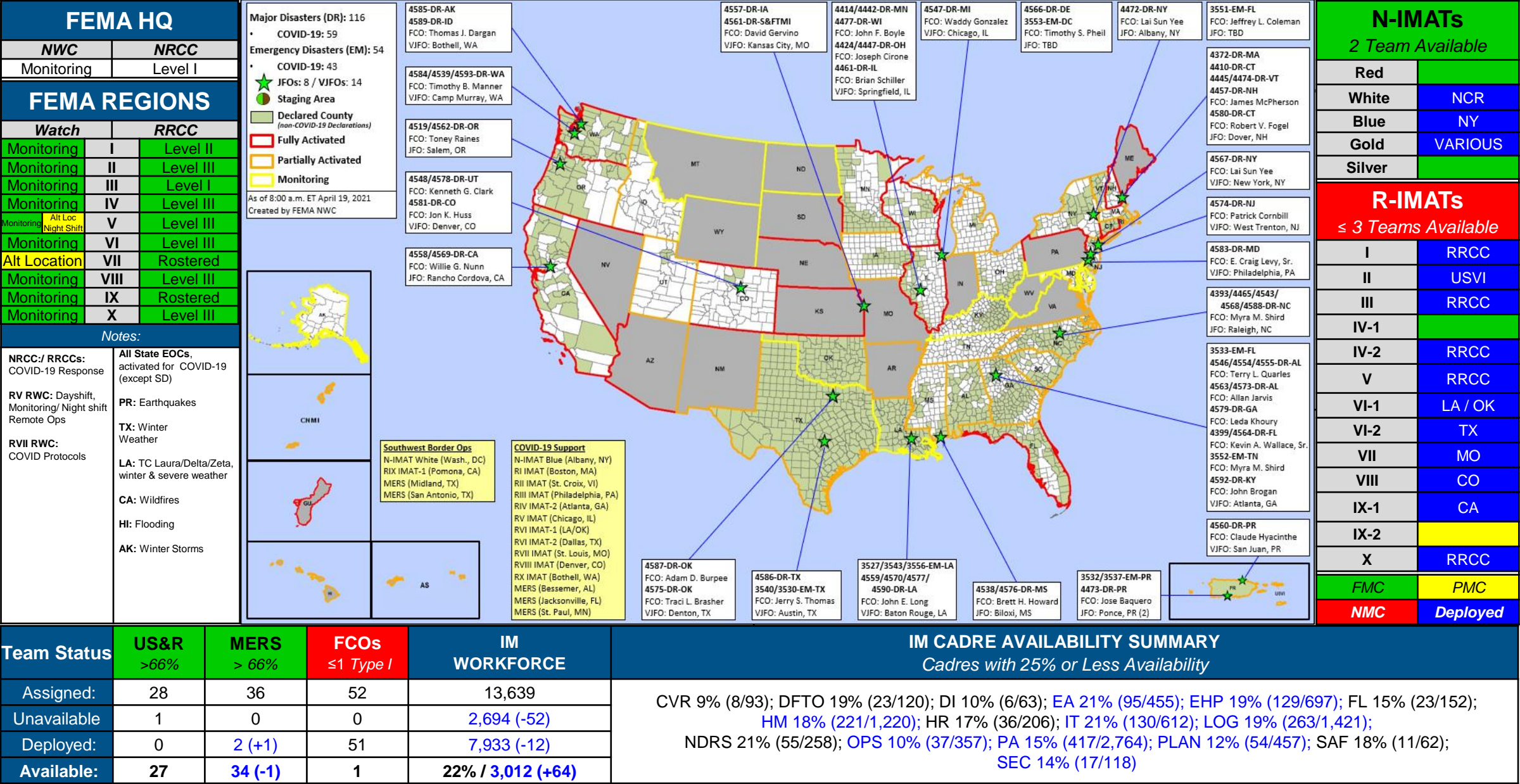
