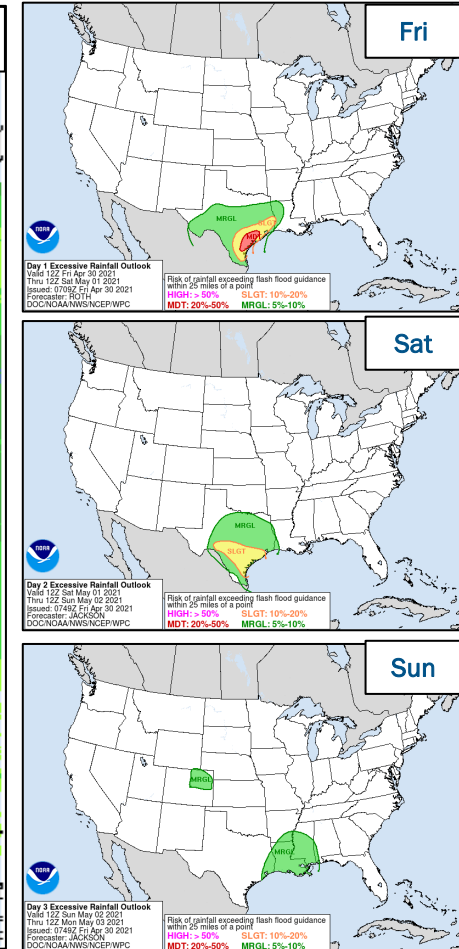

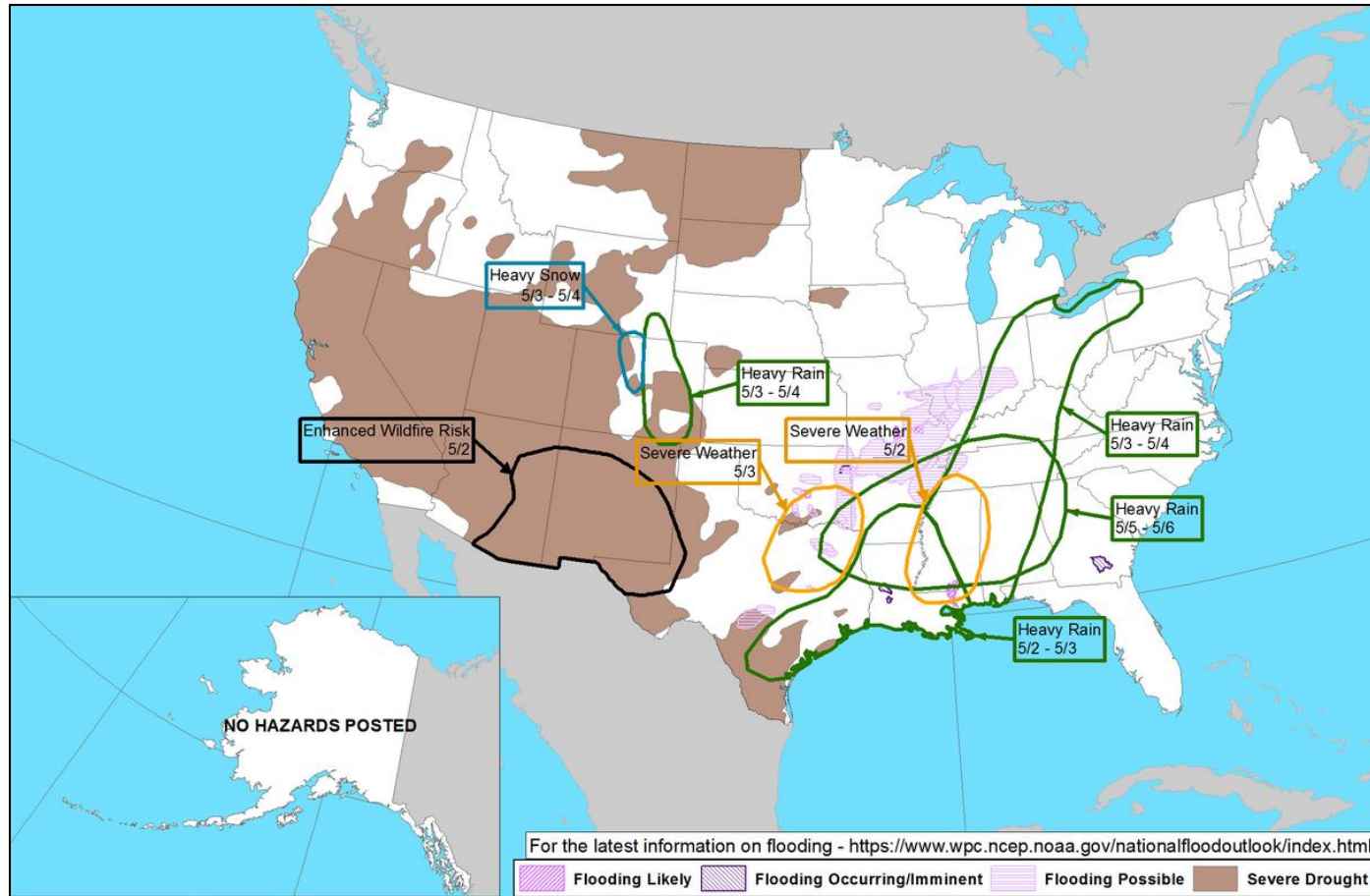
Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall

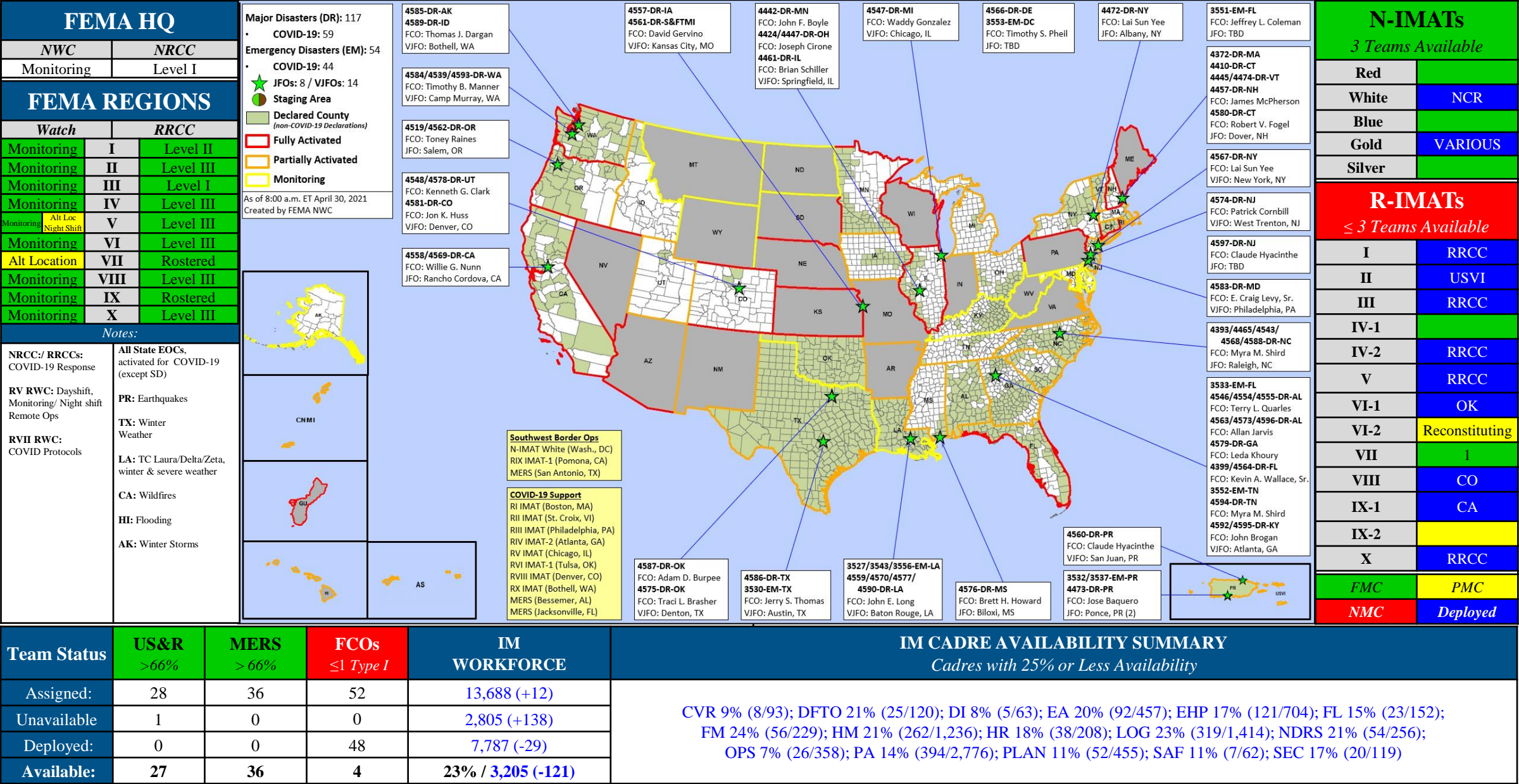
