Colonial Pipeline Cyber-Attack

Current Situation: Colonial Pipeline, which supplies fuel to the east coast, proactively took certain systems offline to contain a threat from a cybersecurity incident. Currently there are no requests for FEMA assistance.


- Colonial Pipeline runs from Houston, TX to Linden, NJ
- Transports 2.5 million barrels of gasoline, diesel, jet fuel, and other refined products per day through 5,500 miles of pipeline
- The operations team is developing a system restart plan; they have partnered with the FBI, DHS, and contracted a private Cyber-security provider to address cyber-attack

State / Local Response:

- FL and PA at Full Activation (COVID-19)
- AL, AR, DC, GA, MS, NC, NJ, NY, SC, TN, TX, and VA EOCs at Partial Activation (COVID-19)
- DE, KY, LA, MD EOC are Monitoring (COVID-19)

FEMA / Federal Response:


- Region II RRCC is at Level III (COVID-19); RWC is monitoring
- Region III RRCC is at Level I (COVID-19); RWC is monitoring
- Region IV & Region VI RRCC is at Level III (COVID-19); RWC is monitoring
- NRCC is at Level I (COVID-19); NWC is monitoring
- DOT Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration issued a Regional Emergency Declaration for AL, AR, DC, DE, FL, GA, KY, LA, MD, MS, NJ, NY, NC, PA, SC, TN, TX, and VA





COVID-19 Weekly Update *(CDC data, as of May 9)*




Daily Trends of COVID-19 Cases

Key Updates:


- U.S. COVID-19 totals:
 - Confirmed Cases: 32,481,455 (+290,113)
 - Confirmed Deaths: 578,520 (+4,740)
- Major Disaster Declarations: 59; Emergency Declarations: 44
- Public Assistance obligated for COVID-19 Response: \$23.5 billion
- FEMA NRCC activated to Level I in support of COVID-19 operations






Tropical Outlook – Eastern Pacific

Tropical Storm Andres (Advisory 5 as of 5:00 a.m. ET)

- 570 miles S of the Southern tip of Baja California, Mexico
- Moving NW at 5 mph
- Maximum sustained wind 40 mph
- Tropical-storm-force winds extend out up to 80 miles
- Gradual weakening expected to begin today and become a remnant low tomorrow
- There are no coastal watches and warnings in effect






National Weather Forecast



Severe Weather Outlook


Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall




