Colonial Pipeline Cyber-Attack

<u>Current Situation</u>: Colonial Pipeline, which supplies fuel to the east coast, proactively took certain systems offline to contain a threat from a cybersecurity incident. The Colonial Pipeline Operations Team is developing a system restart plan with a goal of substantially restoring operational service by the end of the week. Currently there are no requests for FEMA assistance.


- Colonial Pipeline runs from Houston, TX to Linden, NJ; Transports 2.5 million barrels of gasoline, diesel, jet fuel, and other refined products per day through 5,500 miles of pipeline
- The operations team is developing a system restart plan; they have partnered with the FBI, DHS, and contracted a private Cyber-security provider to address cyber-attack
- Main lines continue to be offline; some smaller lateral lines between terminals and delivery points are now operational

State / Local Response:

- FL and PA at Full Activation (COVID-19)
- AL, AR, DC, GA, MS, NC, NJ, NY, SC, TN, TX, and VA EOCs at Partial Activation (COVID-19)
- DE, KY, LA, MD EOC are Monitoring (COVID-19)
- The Governor of NC declared a State of Emergency; suspending motor vehicle fuel regulations to ensure adequate fuel supplies throughout the state

FEMA / Federal Response:

- Region III RRCC is at Level I (COVID-19); RWC is monitoring
- Region II, IV & Region VI RRCCs are at Level III (COVID-19); RWCs are monitoring
- NRCC is at Level I (COVID-19); NWC is monitoring
- Department of Transportation Actions
 - Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration issued a Regional Emergency Declaration for AL,
 AR, DC, DE, FL, GA, KY, LA, MD, MS, NJ, NY, NC, PA, SC, TN, TX, and VA
 - Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration issued Stay of Enforcement notice through 23 May







Tropical Outlook – Eastern Pacific

Tropical Depression Andres (Advisory 9 as of 5:00 a.m. ET)

- 490 miles S of the Southern tip of Baja California, Mexico
- Moving W at 7 mph
- Maximum sustained wind 30 mph
- Forecast to become a remnant low later this morning and dissipate late Wednesday
- There are no coastal watches and warnings in effect




National Weather Forecast






Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall




FEMA Common Operating Picture






