Colonial Pipeline Cyber-Attack

Current Situation: Colonial Pipeline has announced that product delivery has resumed to 80% of Colonial Pipeline; Colonial Pipeline expects delivery will resume to 100% of markets serviced this afternoon. Currently there are no requests for FEMA assistance.

Impacts:

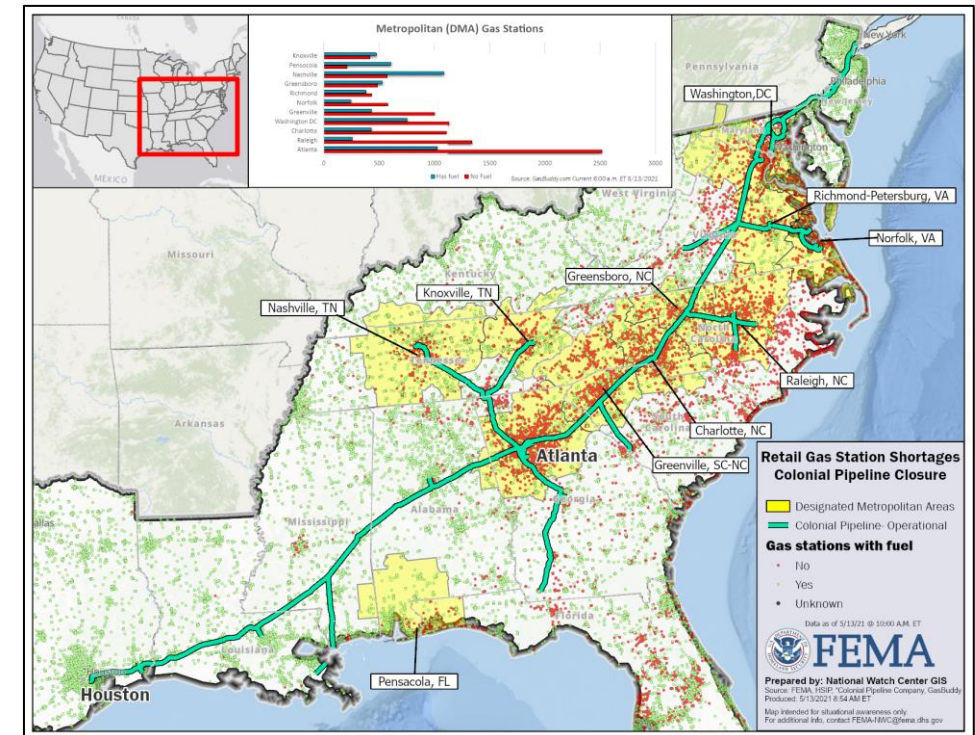
- Approximately 1,800 gas-stations are out of fuel in AL, GA, FL, SC, NC, MD, and VA.
 - Nearly 52% of Virginia's fuel stations are out of gas. Areas on the pipeline within Virginia do not yet have the output to supply the region (*CISA as of 4:50 a.m. ET; May 13, 2021*)
 - Nearly 68% of North Carolina's fuel stations report they are out of fuel (*gasbuddy.com*)
- Airlines are making fuel stopovers to reach destinations, and have cancelled flights

State / Local Response:

- FL and PA at Full Activation (COVID-19)
- AL, AR, DC, GA, MS, NC, NJ, NY, SC, TN, TX, and VA EOCs at Partial Activation (COVID-19)
- DE, KY, LA, MD EOC are Monitoring (COVID-19)
- The Governors of FL, GA, VA, & NC have declared States of Emergency

FEMA / Federal Response Actions and Waivers:

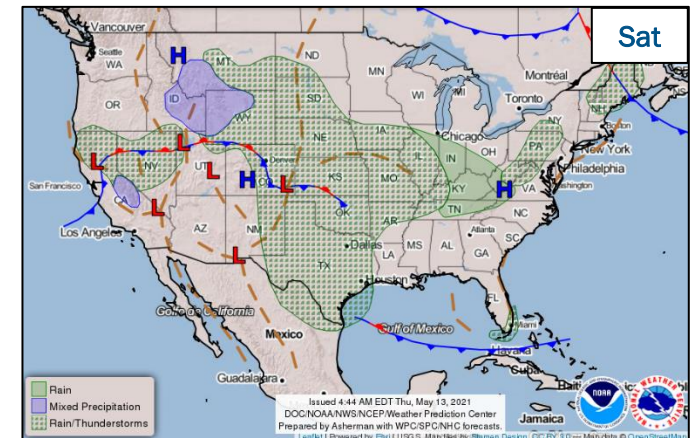
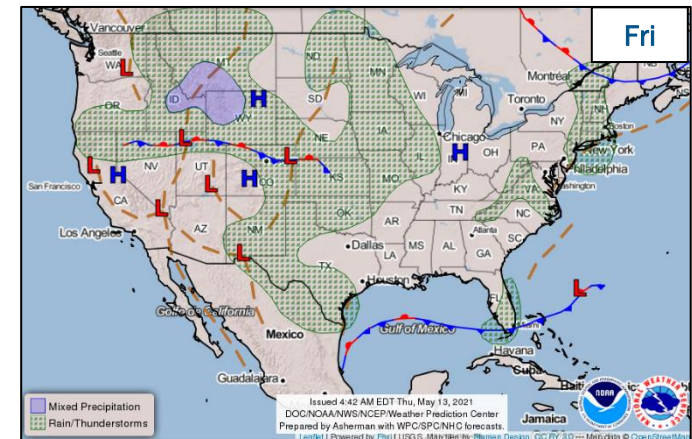
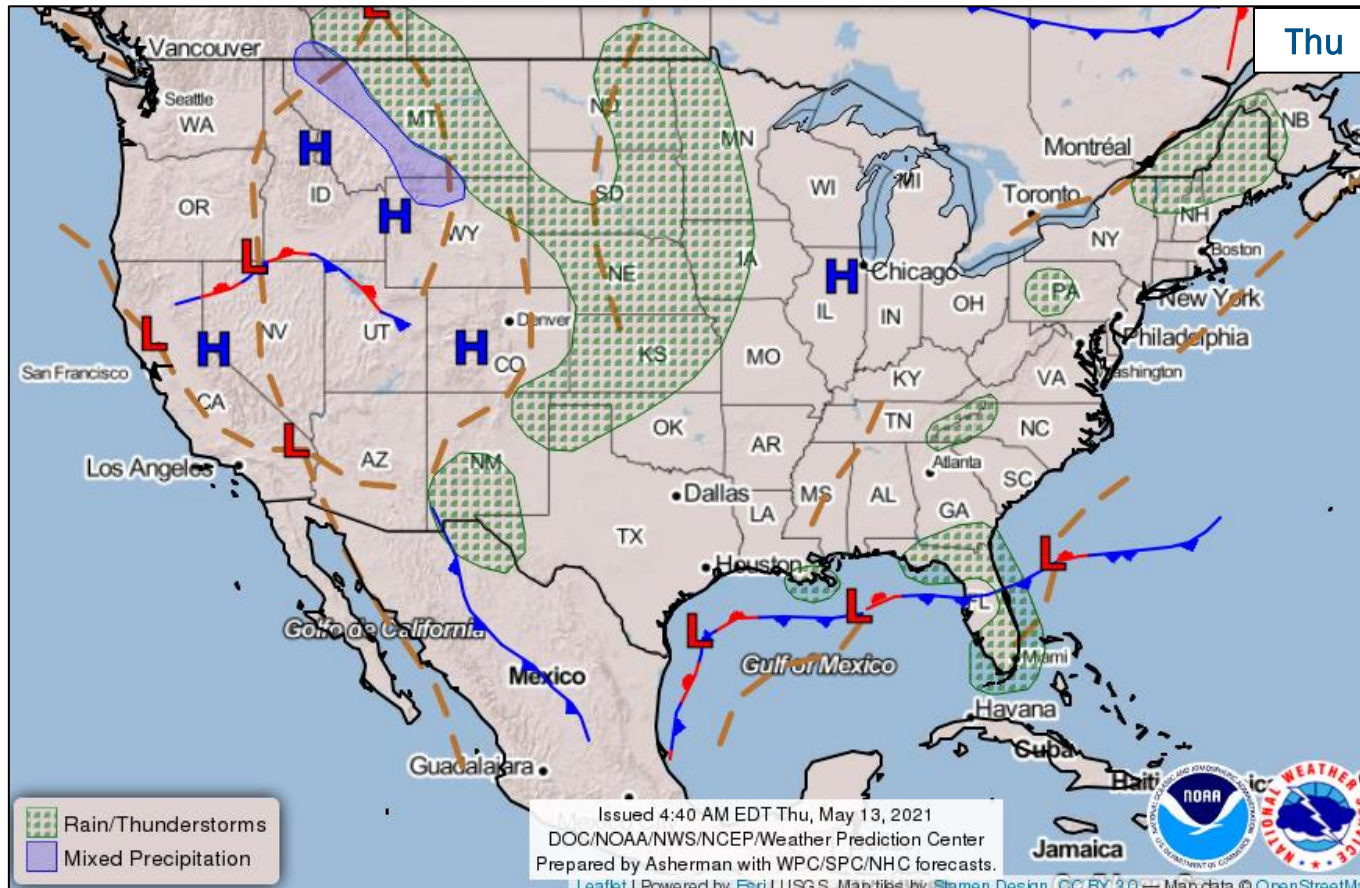
- The FEMA NRCC and Regions II, III, IV, and VI RRCCs are activated for COVID-19
- USACE has opened the Cheatham lock in TN to fuel barge traffic
- Department of Transportation Actions:
 - Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration issued a Regional Emergency Declaration for AL, AR, DC, DE, FL, GA, KY, LA, MD, MS, NJ, NY, NC, PA, SC, TN, TX, WV, and VA
 - AL, GA, KY, LA, MD, MS, NJ, NC, TN, and VA may issue special permits to vehicles delivering relief supplies including petroleum products
- EPA waiver issued alleviating Reformulated and conventional gasoline volatility for DC, MD, PA, AL, DE, GA, FL, LA, MS, NC, SC, and TN

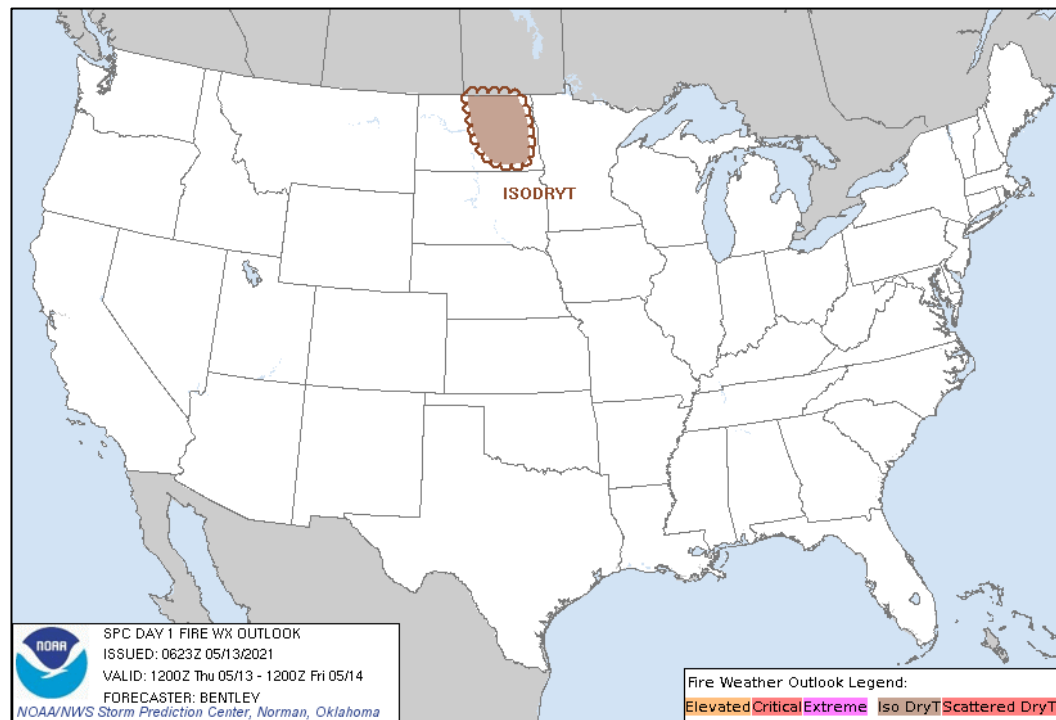

National Weather Forecast

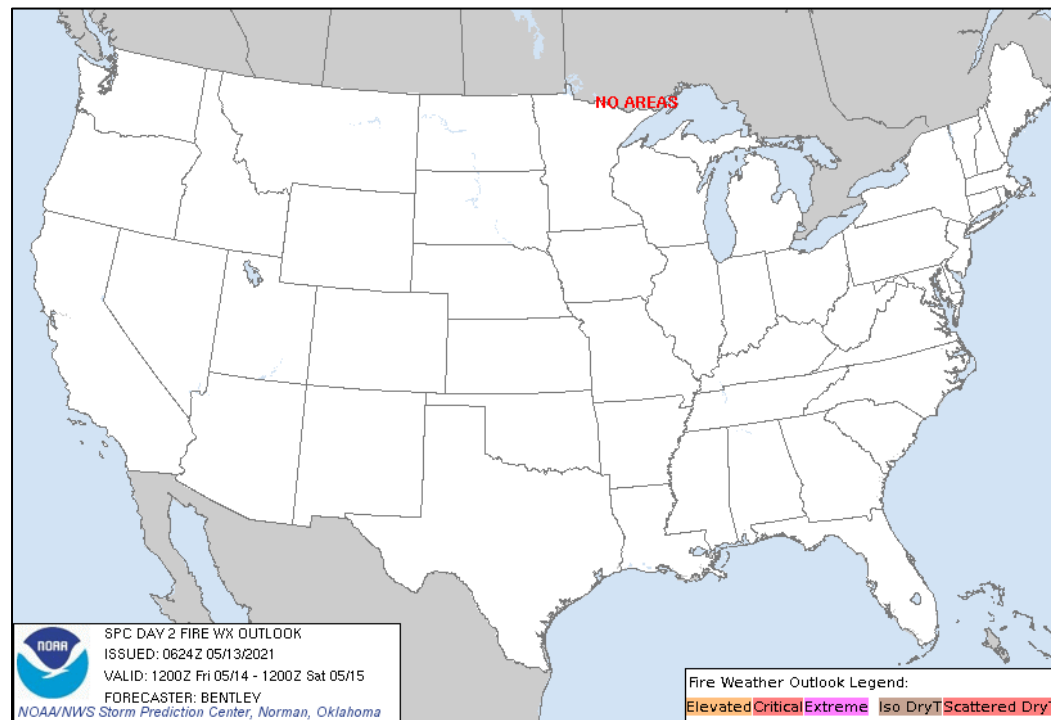
