
## **Situation:**

- The fire began on June 5, 2021, and is burning on federal land and currently moving to state, and private land around Mammoth Creek Village near the city of Panguitch, Utah (pop 1,785)
- 1,000 acres burned; 0% contained
- Power lines were de-energized and power is out in Bagdad; 911 services were restored following an outage
- Mandatory evacuations in effect for 150 people
- FEMA Region VIII SPOTREP attached

- RVIII RRCC Full Activation (COVID-19)
- FEMA Region VIII RWC/Denver MOC continues to monitor
- FEMA NWC continues to monitor
- FMAG was approved on June 5, 2021









### Disturbance 1 (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)


- Located several hundred miles SSW of Manzanillo, Mexico

- 5-day formation chance: High (90%)


## Disturbance 2 (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)


- A few hundred miles S of the coast of southern Mexico,













# Long Range Outlooks – Jun 11-15




6-10 Day Temperature Probability
