- Elevated & Critical Fire Weather – NV, UT, and AZ
 - Red Flag Warnings – Great Basin, Southwest, & Northern Plains
- Tropical Activity:
 - Eastern Pacific: Disturbance 1: High 90%; Disturbance 2: Low 30%



Situation:

- The fire began on June 5, 2021, and is burning on federal land and currently moving to state, and private land around Mammoth Creek Village near the city of Panguitch, Utah (pop 1,785)
- 1,000 acres burned; 0% contained
- Power lines were de-energized and power is out in Bagdad; 911 services were restored following an outage
- Mandatory evacuations in effect for 150 people
- FEMA Region VIII SPOTREP attached



- FMAG was approved on June 5, 2021




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Tropical Outlook – Five Day

Disturbance 1 (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- Located several hundred miles SSW of Manzanillo, Mexico
- Moving westward
- A tropical depression is likely to form today
- 48-hour formation chance: High (90%)
- 5-day formation chance: High (90%)




Disturbance 2 (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- A few hundred miles S of the coast of southern Mexico, El Salvador and Guatemala in a few days
- Gradual development is possible
- 48-hour formation chance: Low (near 0%)
- 5-day formation chance: Low (30%)






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National Weather Forecast



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

Severe Weather Outlook



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
Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall




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Fire Weather Outlook




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Long Range Outlooks – Jun 11-15



6-10 Day Temperature Probability




6-10 Day Precipitation Probability
