


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# Tropical Outlook – Five Day

## Central Pacific





### Disturbance 1 (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- 100 miles SSW of Puerto Angel, Mexico
- Conditions not conducive for development
- 48-hour formation chance: Low (10%)
- 5-day formation chance: Low (10%)

## Atlantic



### Disturbance 1 (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- Over the Bay of Campeche
- Slow development possible over the next several days
- Tropical depression could form late in the week
- 48-hour formation chance: Low (10%)
- 5-day formation chance: Medium (50%)




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# Eastern Pacific – Tropical Storm Carlos

## Situation: *(Advisory #3 as of 5:00 a.m. ET)*



- 1,265 miles SW of the southern tip of Baja California
- Moving W at 8 mph
- Maximum sustained winds 45 mph
- Some strengthening forecast during the next 24 to 36 hours
- Tropical-storm-force wind extend out up to 25 miles



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



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
# Severe Weather Outlook



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
# Precipitation Forecast










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# Long Range Outlooks – Jun 18-22


