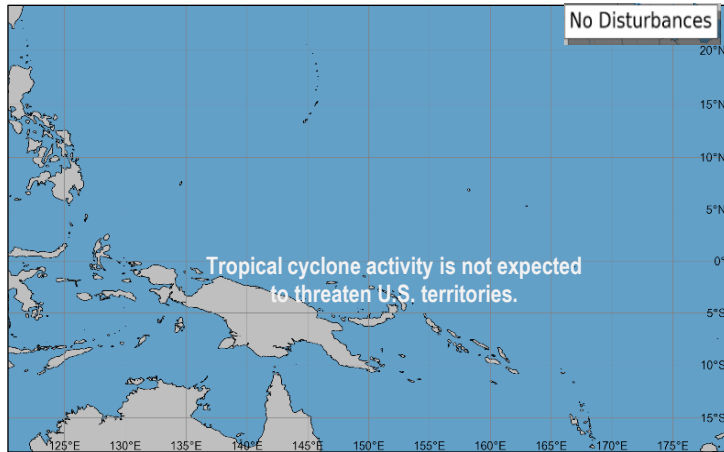

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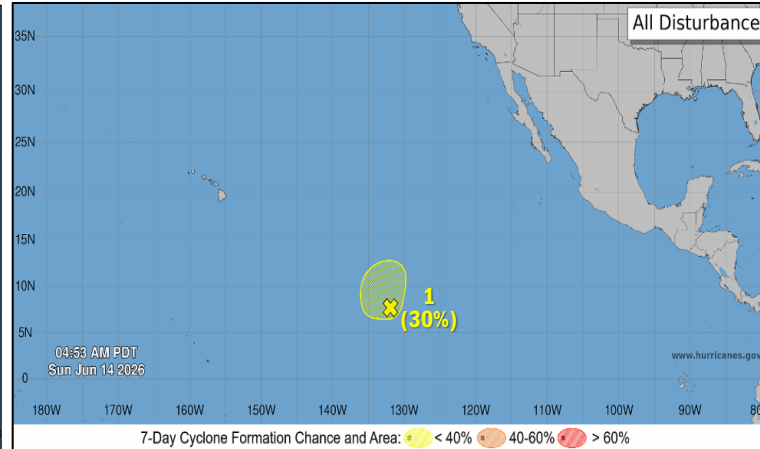

- No tropical cyclones expected

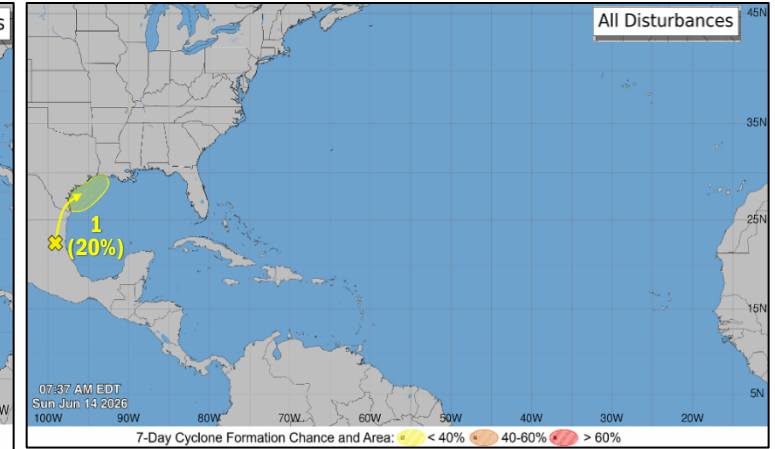
Eastern and Central Pacific

- Located well SW of the Baja California Peninsula
- Moving ENE to NE at 5-10 mph
- Environmental conditions could support some gradual development during the next couple of days
- Formation chance – 48-hour: Low (30%); 7-day: Low (30%)

Disturbance 1: (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

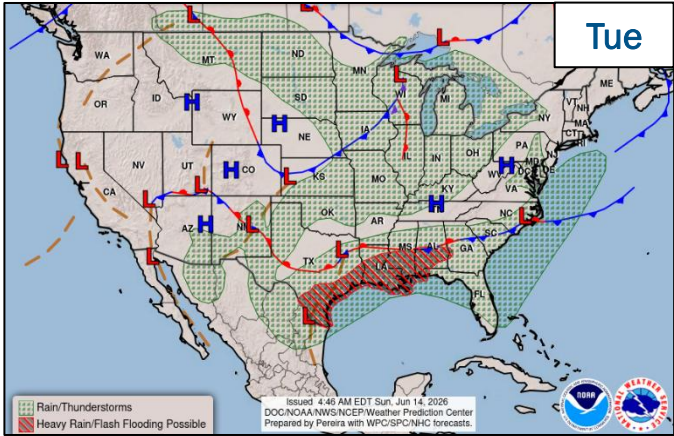
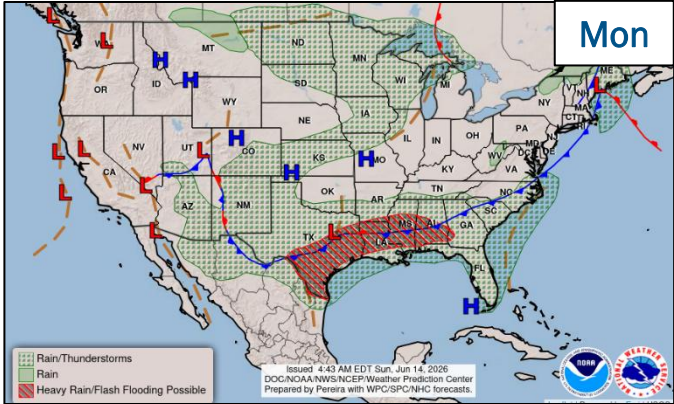
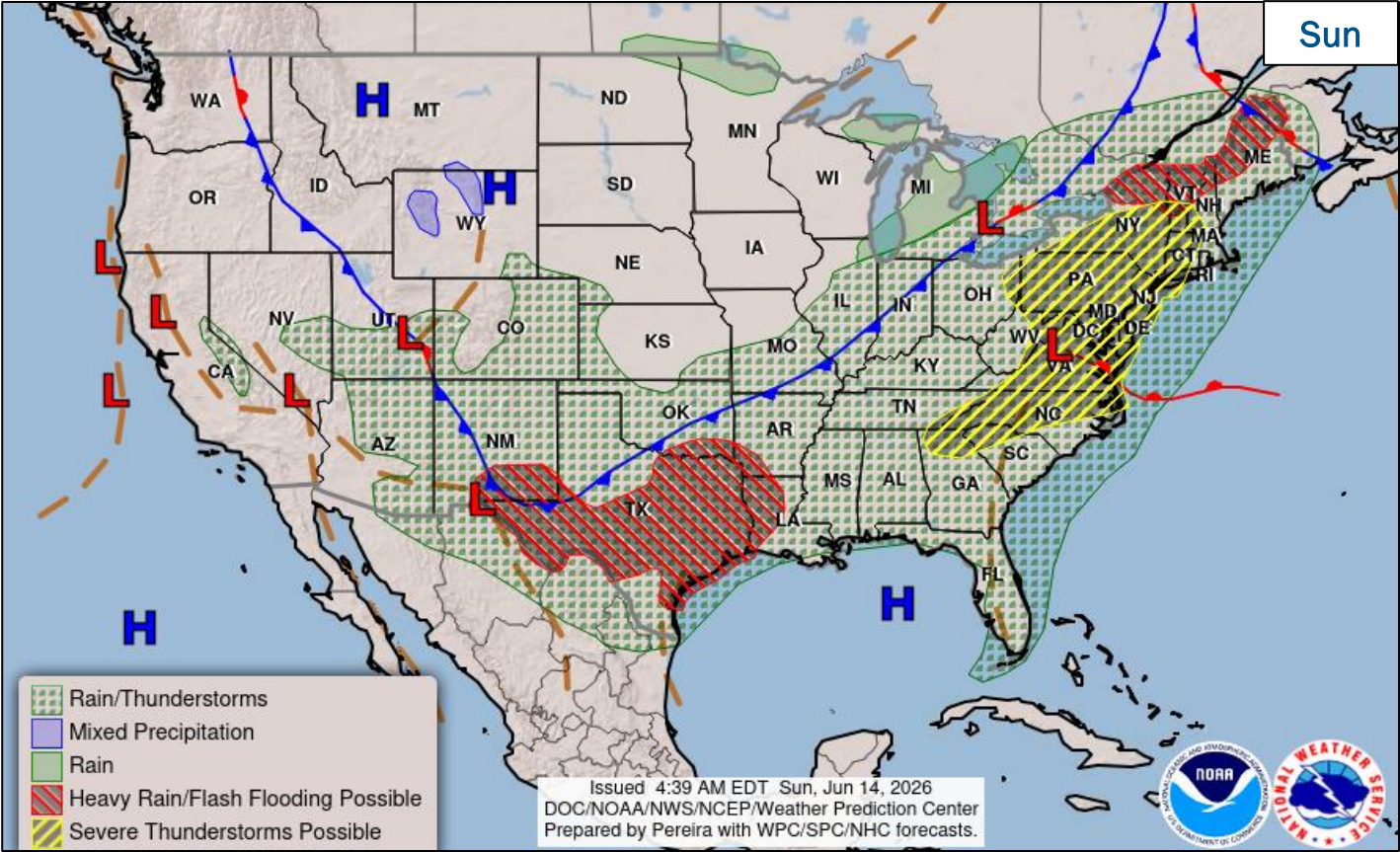
- Located along the coast of eastern Mexico

- Formation chance – 48-hour: Low (near 0%); 7-day: Low (20%)



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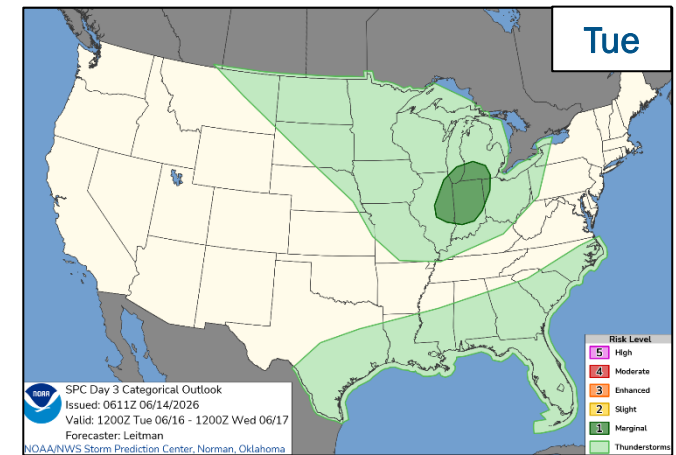
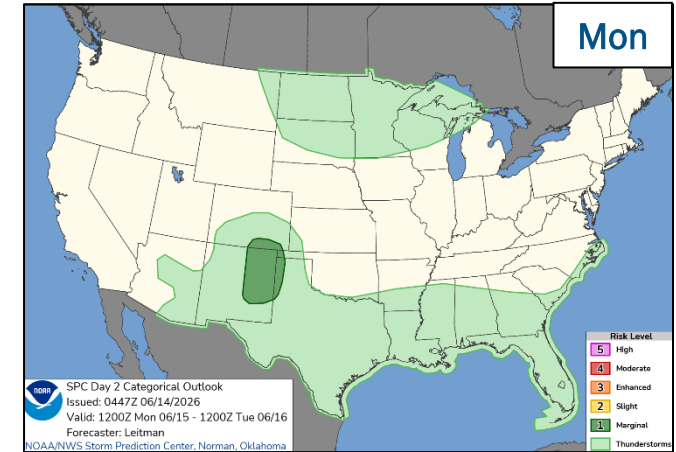
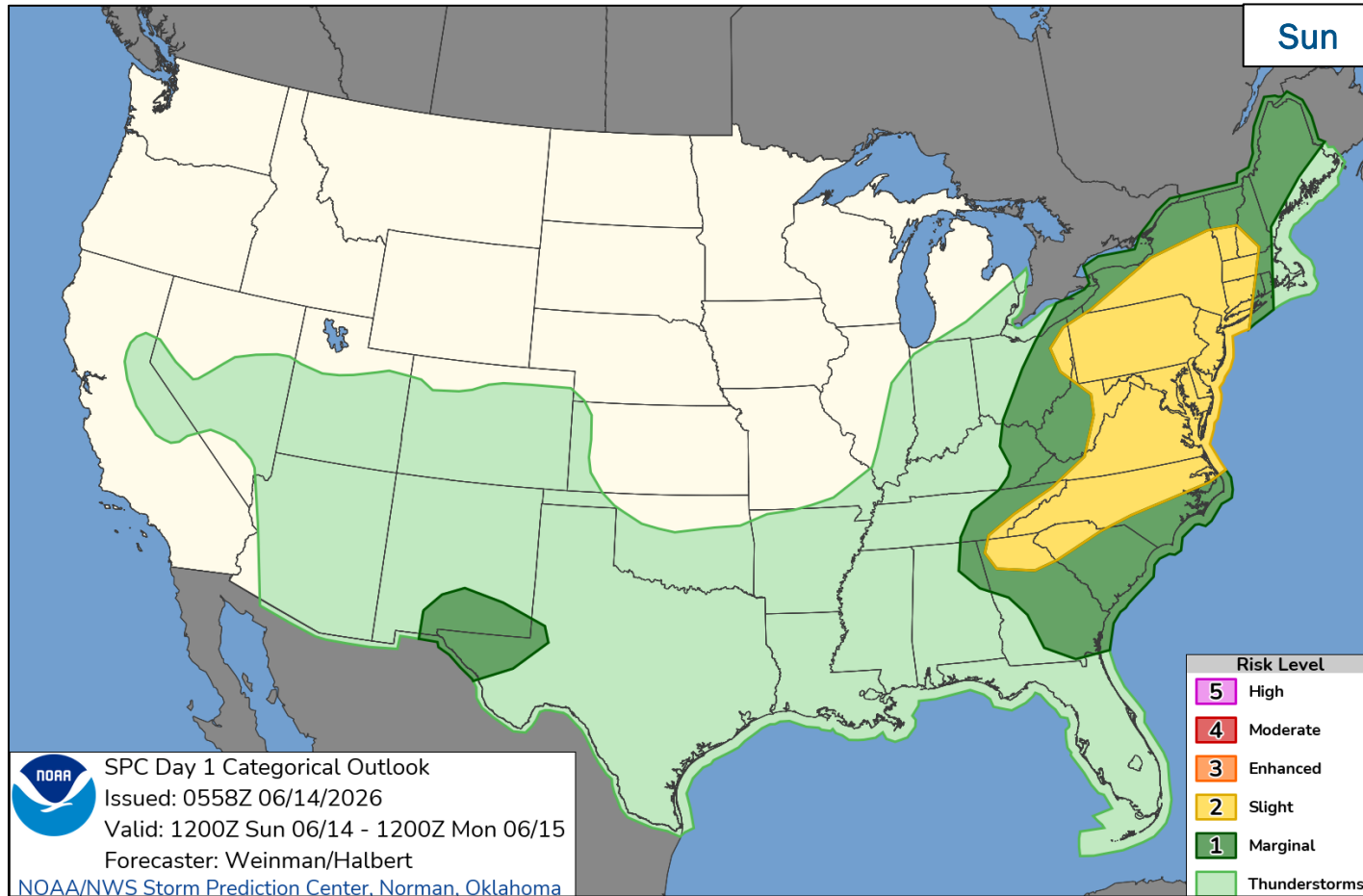

National Weather Forecast



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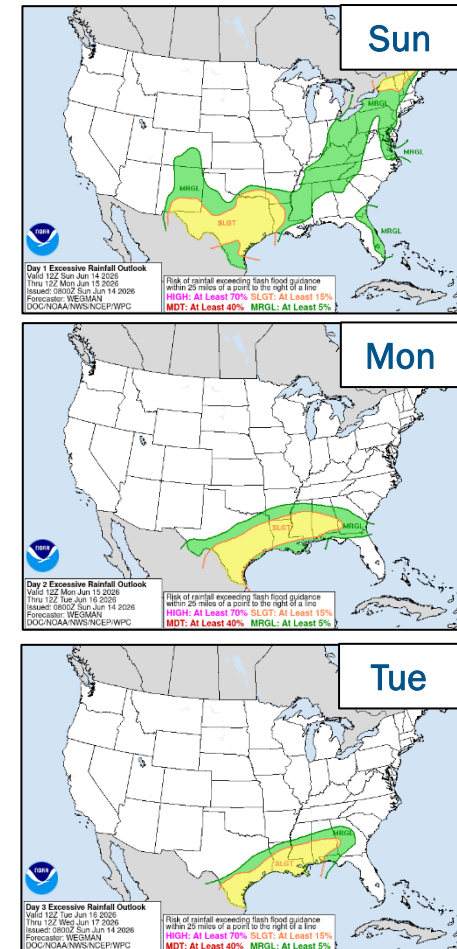
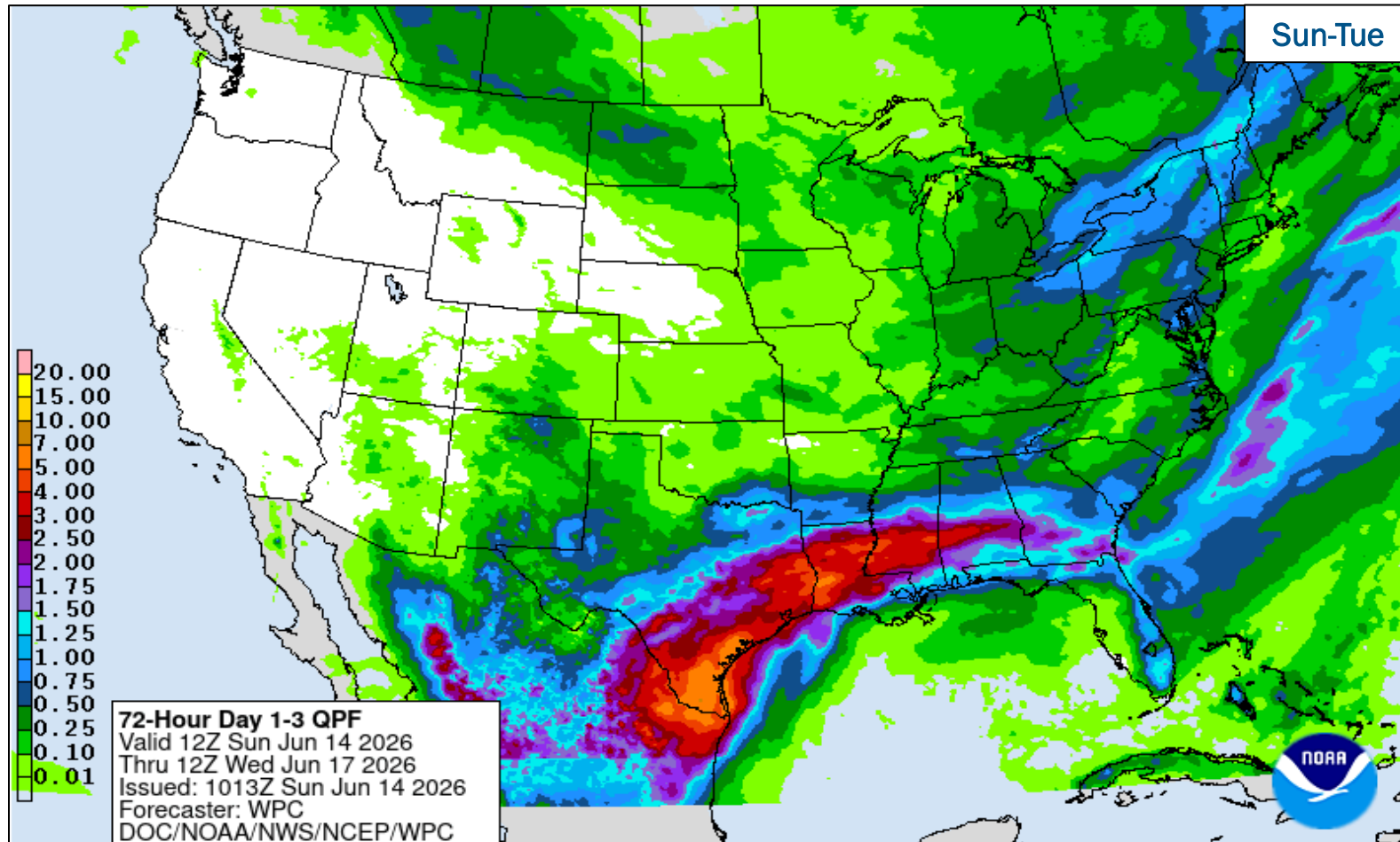
Severe Weather Outlook



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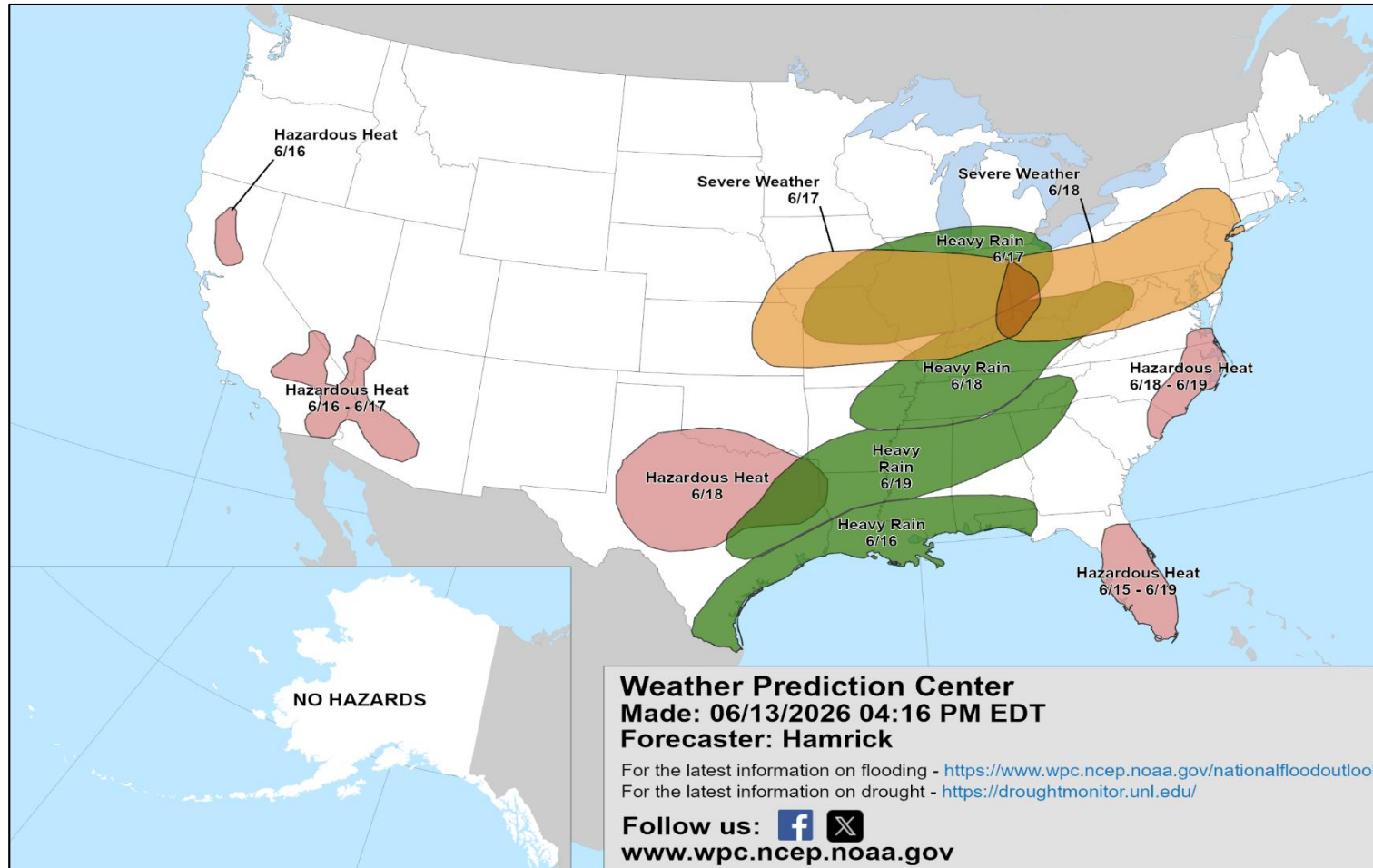
Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall



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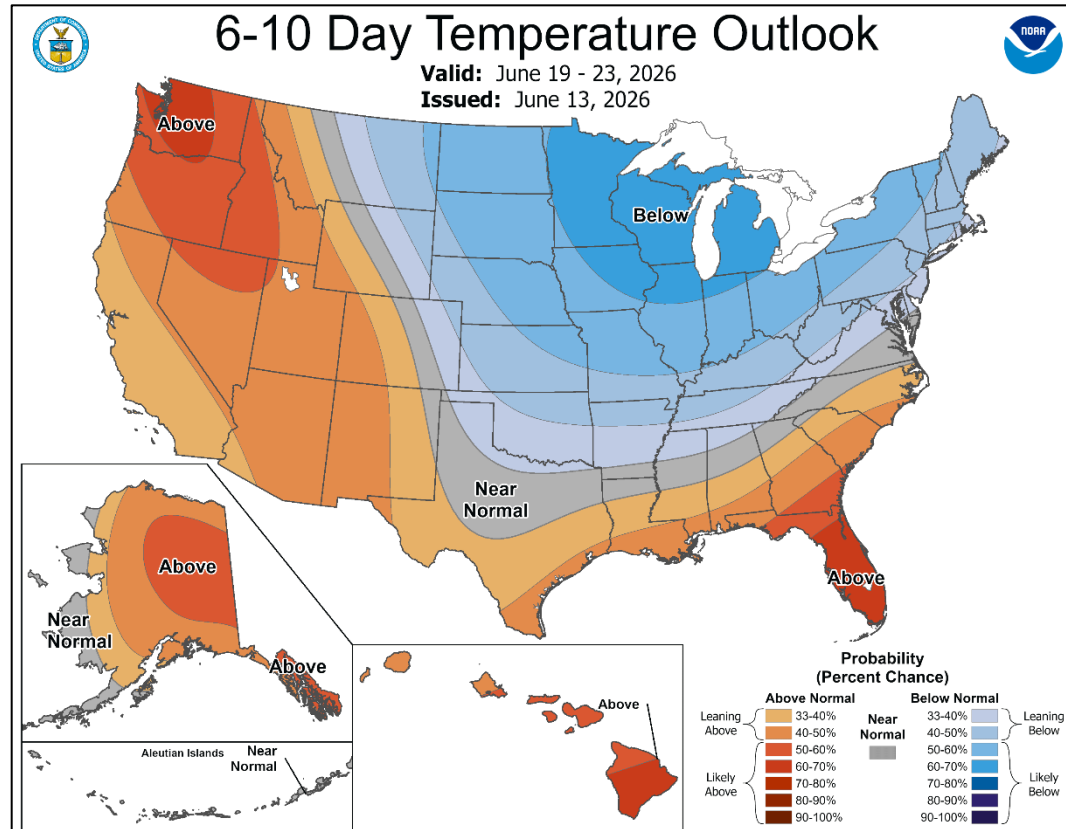
Hazards Outlook – Jun 16-20



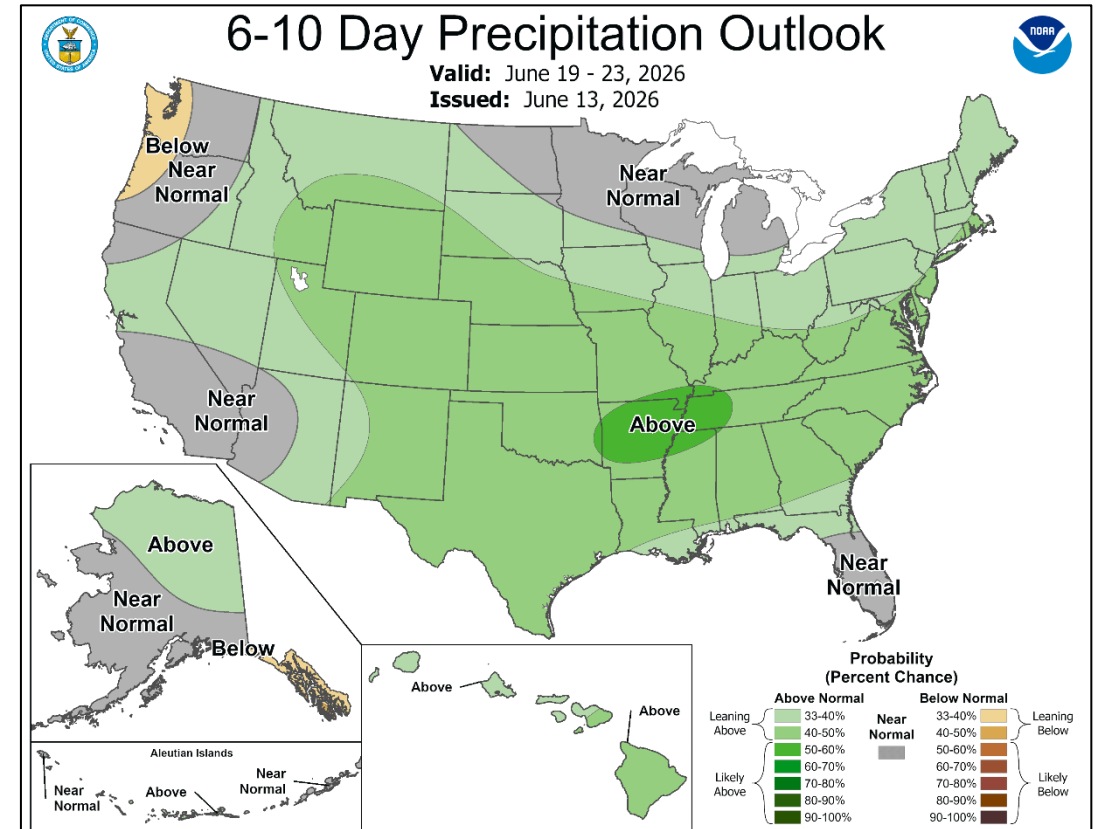
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Long Range Outlooks – Jun 19-23

6-10 Day Precipitation Probability

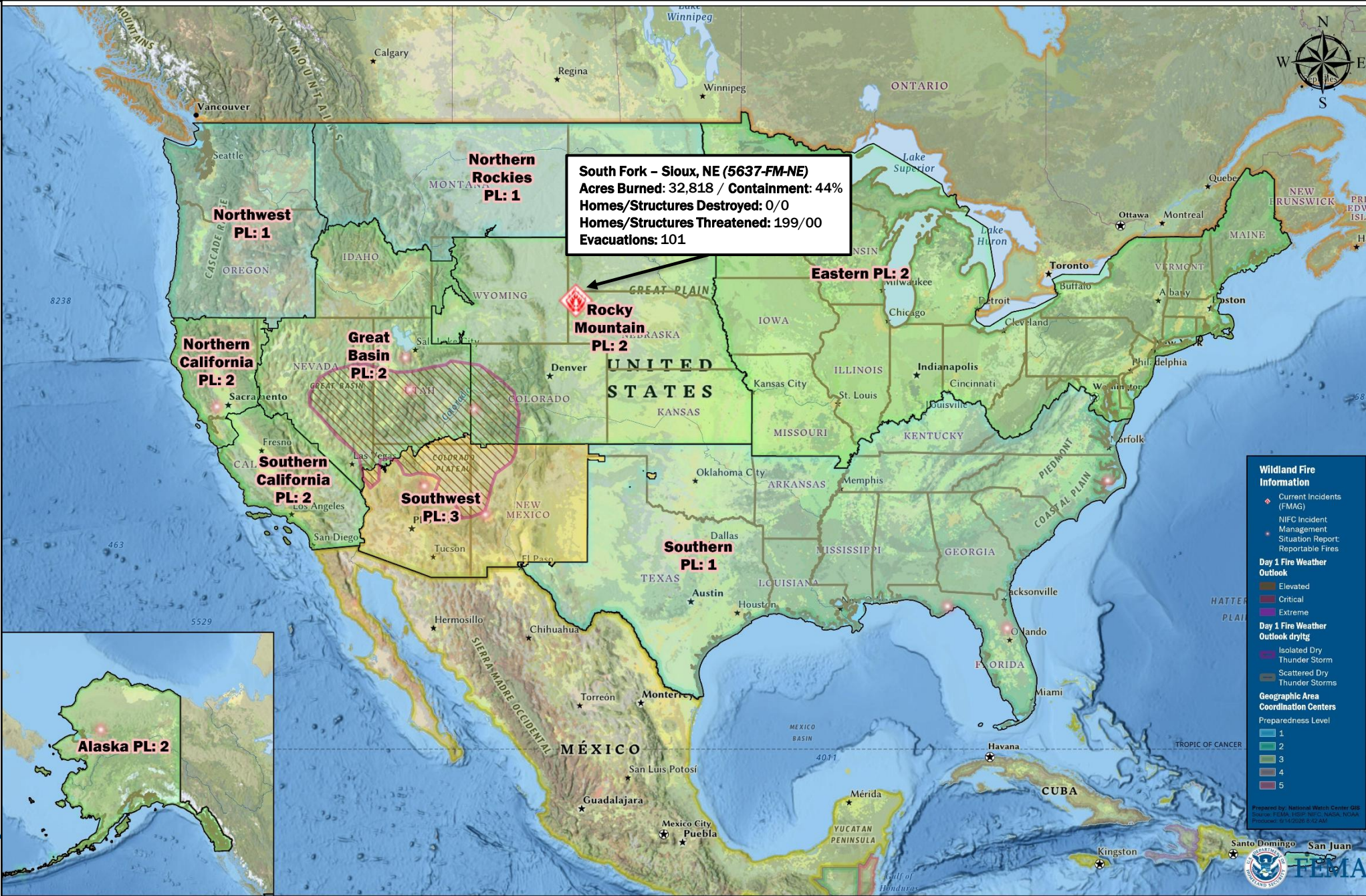
