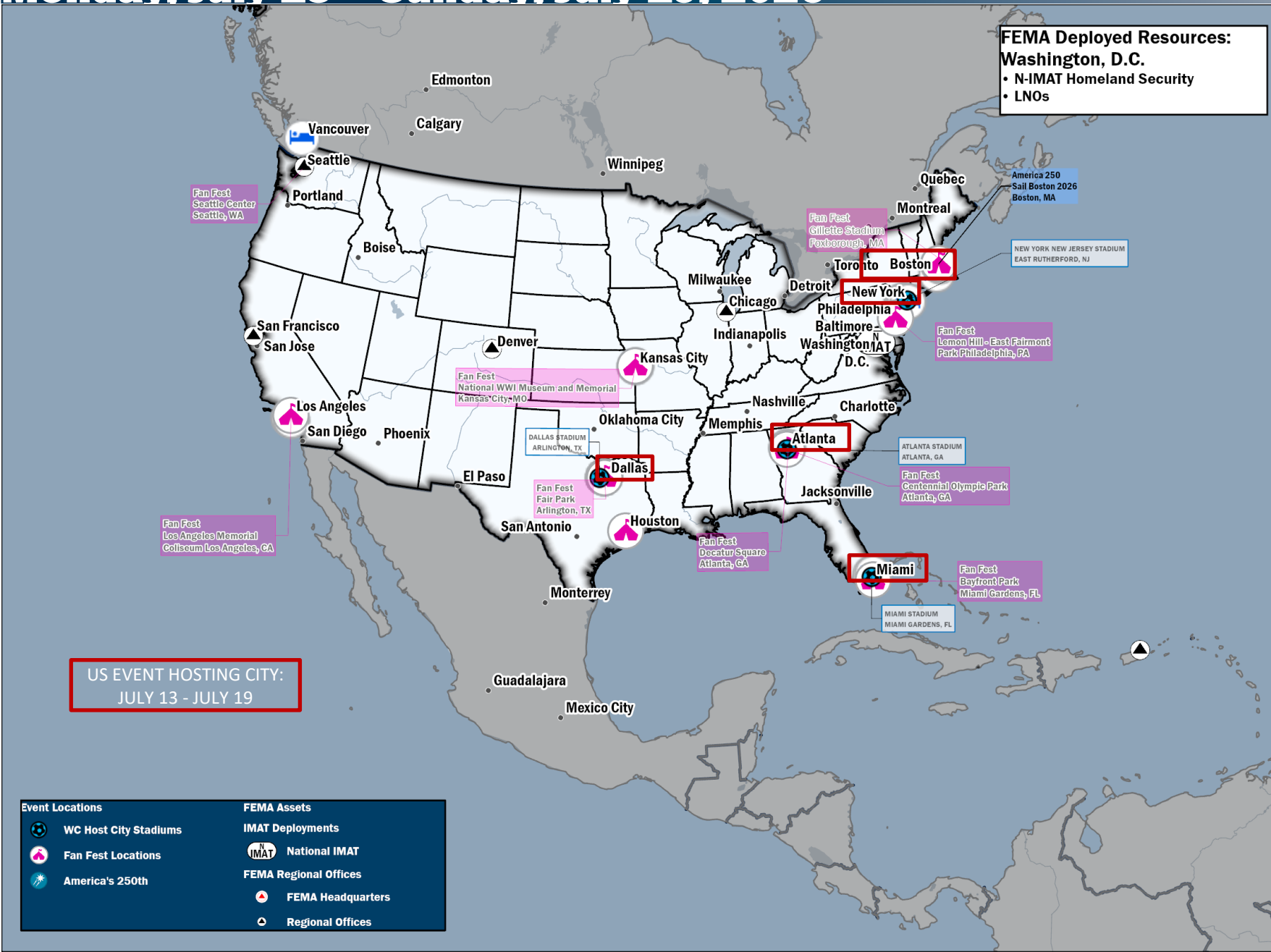

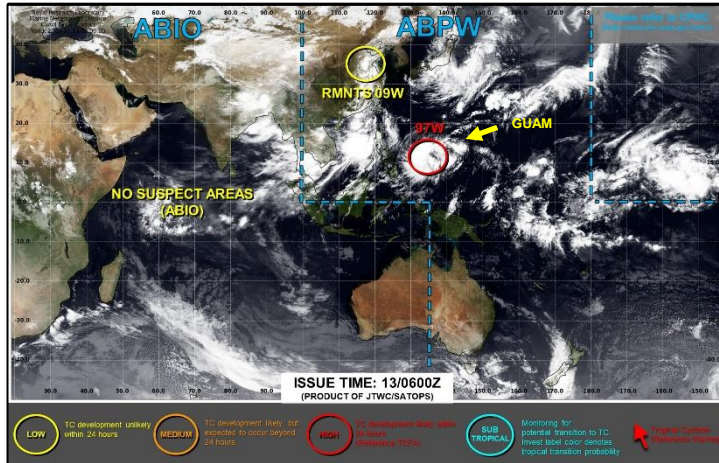

Tropical Outlook

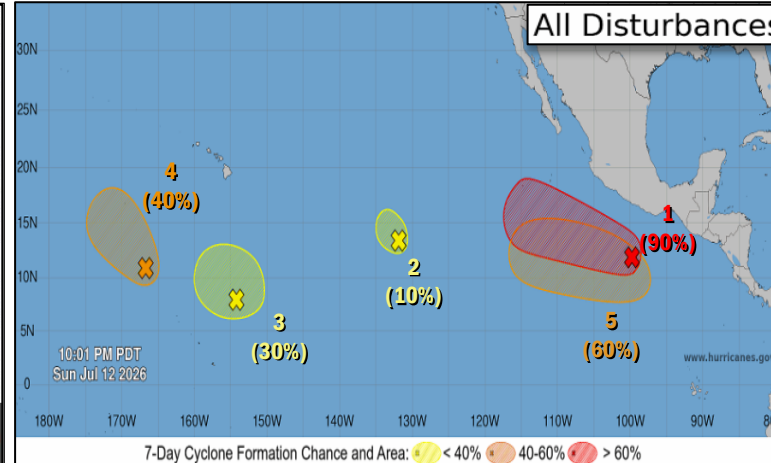
Western Pacific



Invest 97W: (as of 2:00 a.m. ET)

- 594 miles SW of Guam
- Moving NW
- Maximum surface winds 21-26 mph
- Environmental conditions are favorable for development
- Formation chance – 24-hour: High

Eastern and Central Pacific



Disturbance 1: (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- Located several hundred miles S of the coast of southwestern Mexico
- Moving WNW; Conditions favorable for gradual development; tropical depression likely to form during the early to middle part of this week
- Formation chance – 48-hour: Med (50%); 7-day: High (90%)

Disturbance 2: (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- Located WSW of the Baja California peninsula
- Moving WNW into less favorable conditions, with development chances decreasing
- Formation chance – 48-hour: Low (10%); 7-day: Low (10%)

Disturbance 3: (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- Located several hundred miles S of the Hawaiian Islands
- Minimal movement; gradual development of this system is possible during the next several days
- Formation chance – 48-hour: Low (10%); 7-day: Low (30%)

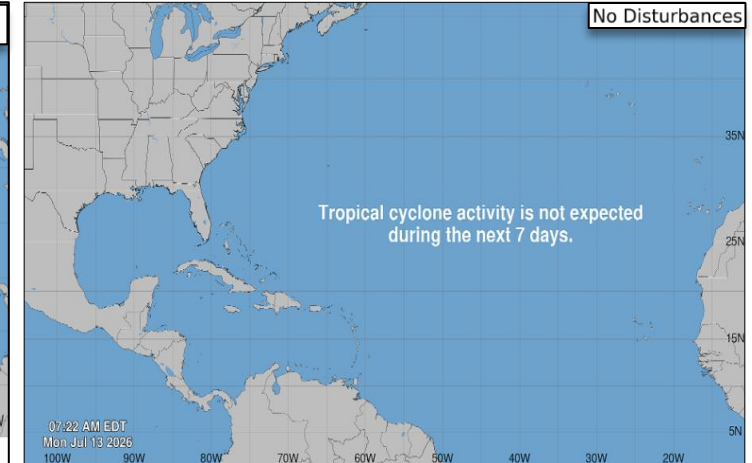
Disturbance 4 (CP90): (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- Located several hundred miles SW of the Hawaiian Islands
- Moving WNW; conditions appear favorable for gradual development during the next several days
- Formation chance – 48-hour: Low (20%); 7-day: Med (40%)

Disturbance 5: (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- Located offshore of Southern and Southwestern Mexico
- Moving WNW; conditions appear conducive for gradual development of this system and a tropical depression could form by the end of the week or weekend
- Formation chance – 48-hour: Low (near 0%); 7-day: Med (60%)

National Weather Forecast



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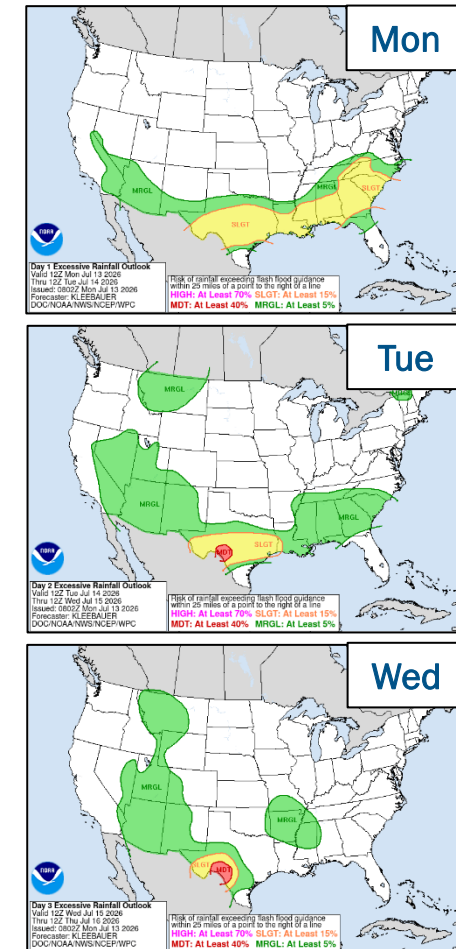
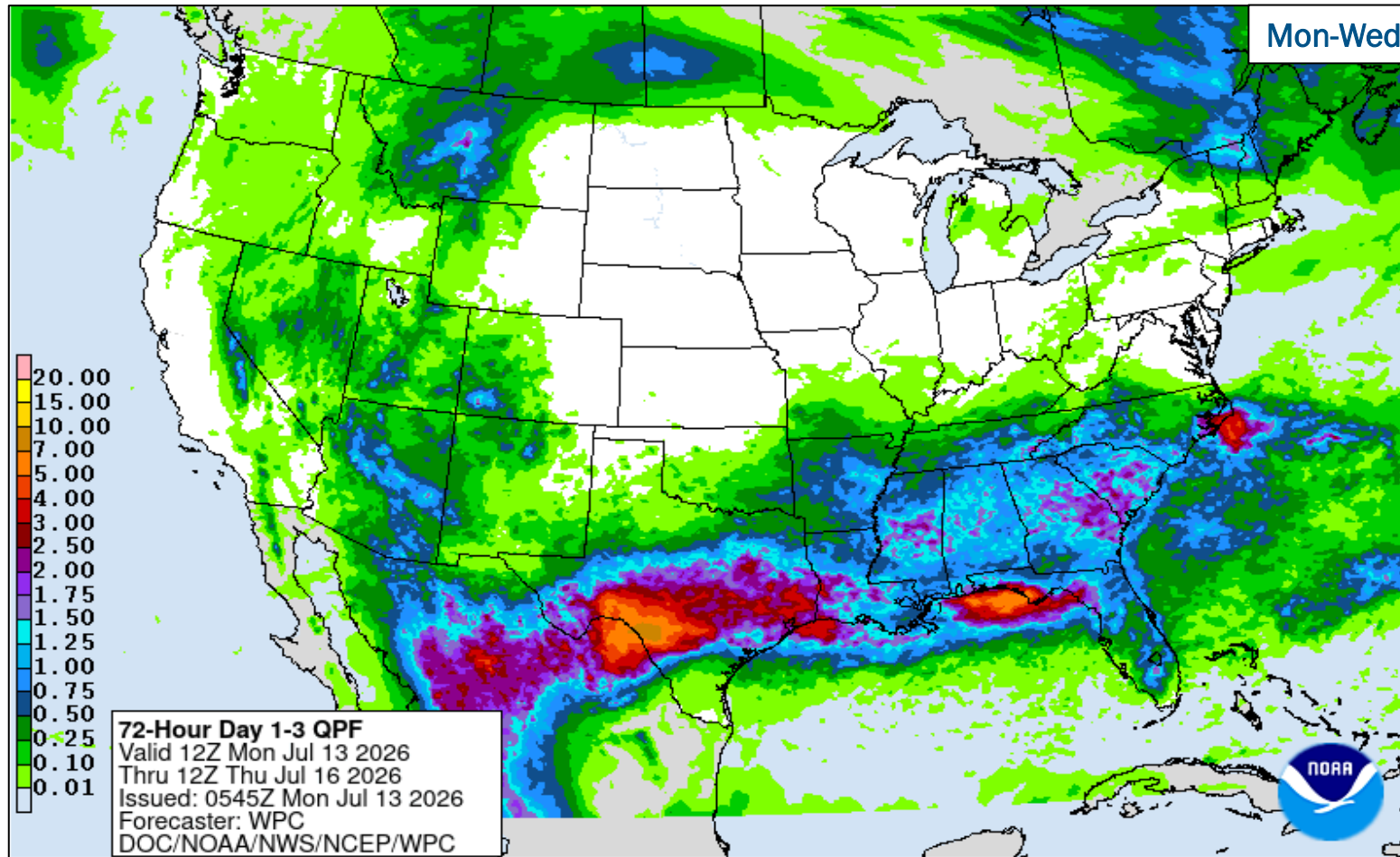
Severe Weather Outlook



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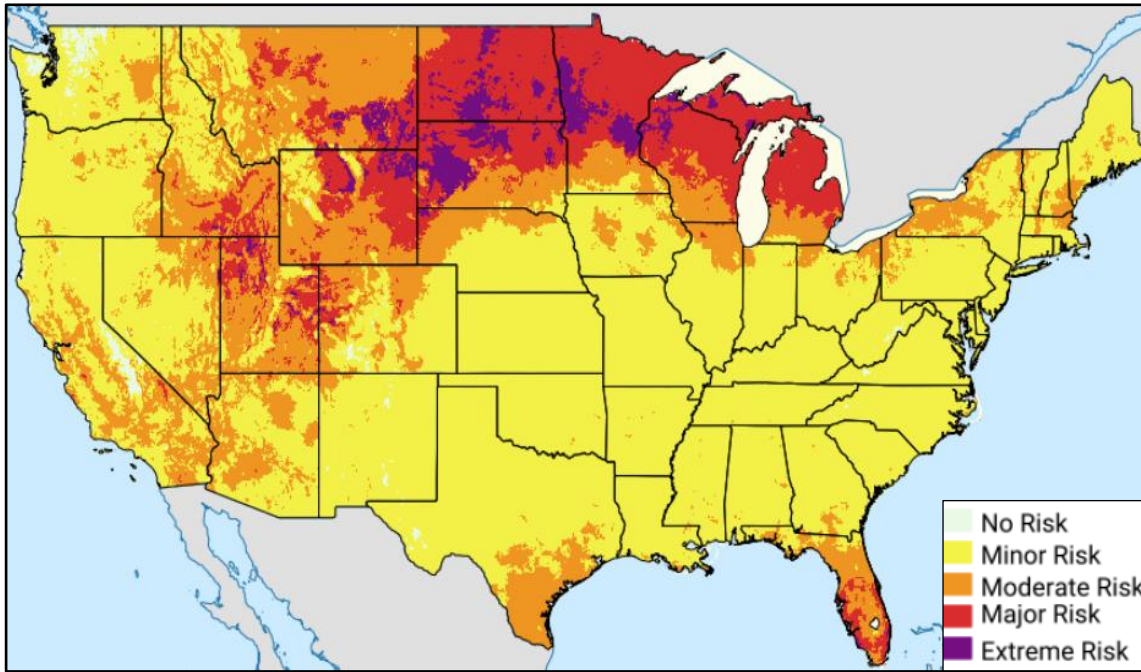
Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall



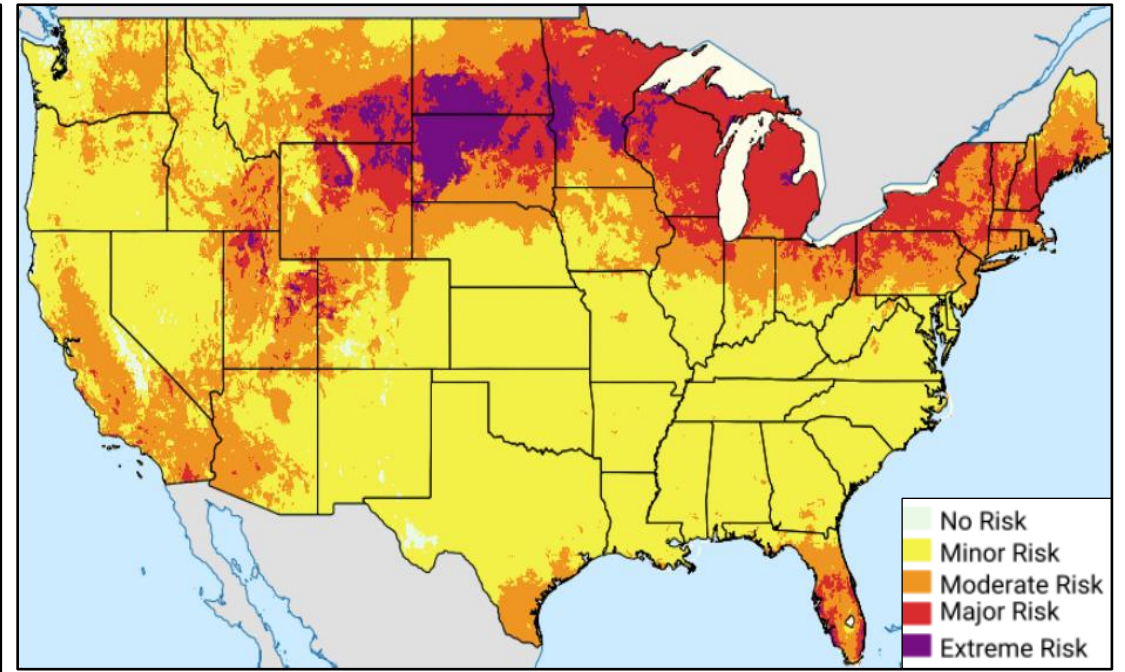

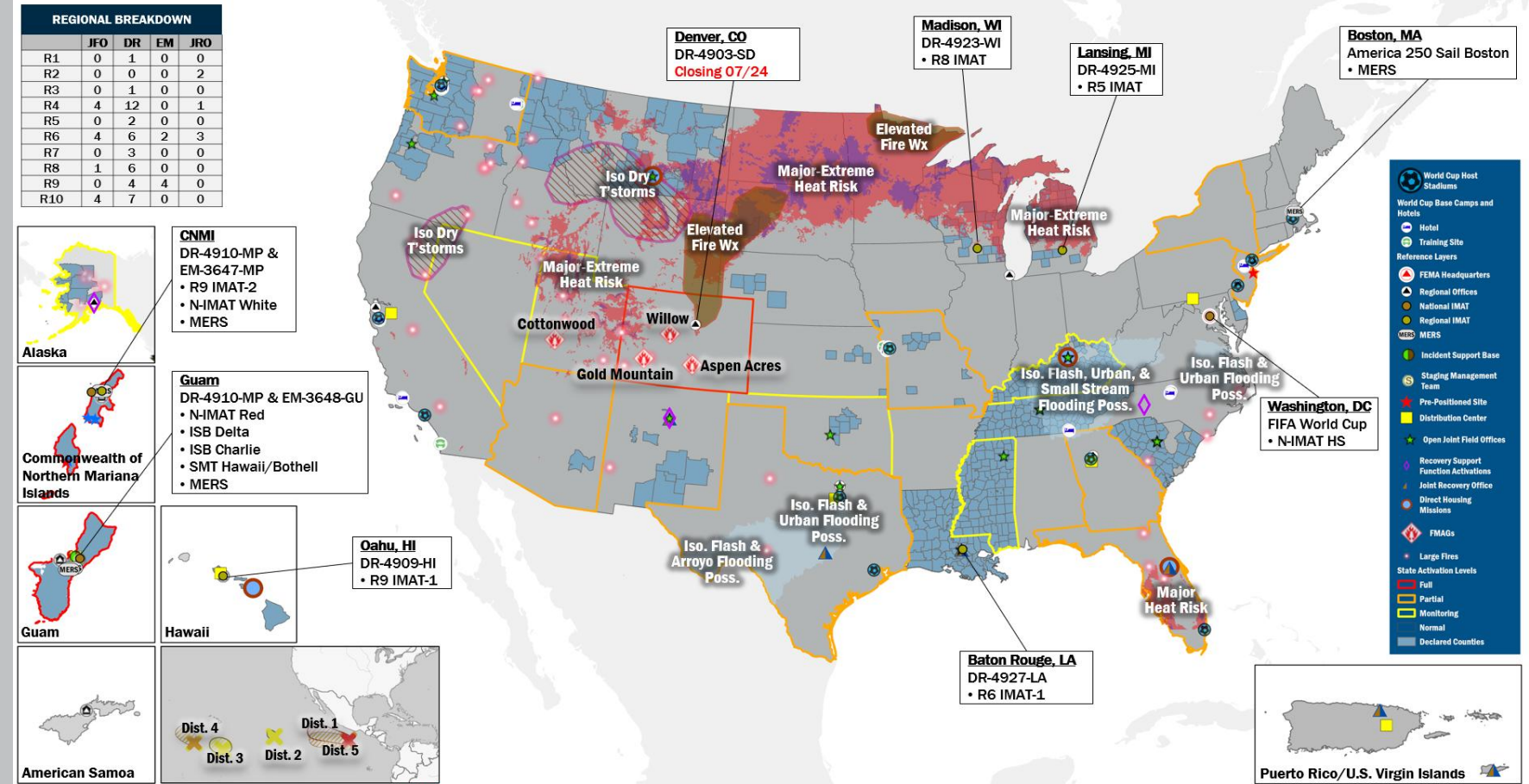
