

- Hurricane-force winds extend 10 miles; tropical-stormforce winds extend 45 miles







- Tropical-storm-force winds extend outward 115 miles














Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall








6-10 Day Temperature Probability




6-10 Day Precipitation Probability




