




Tropical Outlook – Five Day





- 1,265 miles E of Hilo, Hawaii
- Moving W at 15 mph
- Maximum sustained winds 45 mph
- Additional weakening expected next couple of days
- Tropical storm force winds extend 45 miles






Tropical Depression Guillermo – Eastern Pacific


Situation: (Advisory #12 as of 5:00 a.m. ET)

- Forecast to become a remnant low today and dissipate in a few days






National Weather Forecast







Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall





Fire Weather Outlook







Situation:

The fire began on July 13th and currently burning in Plumas County, threatening communities and critical infrastructure. Red Hill Microwave Communication Site, which provides critical service to state agencies is threatened as well as the PG&E 765 Mega Watt Transmission line and PG&E Hydroelectric power facilities. Approximately 8,000 customers are without power. Portions of Hwy 70 are closed, due to landslides caused by fire.

Response:

- CA EOC at Full Activation (COVID-19)
- FEMA Region IX RWC is monitoring
- FMAG approved on July 20, 2021




NPSC Call Forecasting and Actual Calls Over the Past 4 Weeks 06/20/2021 through 07/17/2021
