

### **Tropical Storm Felicia – Eastern Pacific**

#### Situation: (Advisory #25 as of 5:00 a.m. ET)

- 1,265 miles E of Hilo, Hawaii
- Moving W at 15 mph
- Maximum sustained winds 45 mph
- Additional weakening expected next couple of days
- Tropical storm force winds extend 45 miles






### **Tropical Depression Guillermo – Eastern Pacific**


#### Situation: (Advisory #12 as of 5:00 a.m. ET)

- Forecast to become a remnant low today and dissipate in a few days






### **National Weather Forecast**







### **Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall**





#### Situation:

The fire began on July 13<sup>th</sup> and currently burning in Plumas County, threatening communities and critical infrastructure. Red Hill Microwave Communication Site, which provides critical service to state agencies is threatened as well as the PG&E 765 Mega Watt Transmission line and PG&E Hydroelectric power facilities. Approximately 8,000 customers are without power. Portions of Hwy 70 are closed, due to landslides caused by fire.

#### Response:

- CA EOC at Full Activation (COVID-19)
- FEMA Region IX RWC is monitoring
- FMAG approved on July 20, 2021




#### NPSC Call Forecasting and Actual Calls Over the Past 4 Weeks 06/20/2021 through 07/17/2021
