## New Significant Incidents / Ongoing Ops

- Wildfires – Western U.S. and Hawaii

## Hazard Monitoring

- Heavy Rain and flash flooding – Central/Southern Rockies, Southeast to the Mid-Atlantic
- Tropical Activity:
  - Atlantic: Disturbance 1: Low (10%)
  - Eastern Pacific:
    - Tropical Storm Hilda
    - Tropical Depression Ignacio
    - Disturbance 1: High (80%)
    - Disturbance 2: Low (30%)

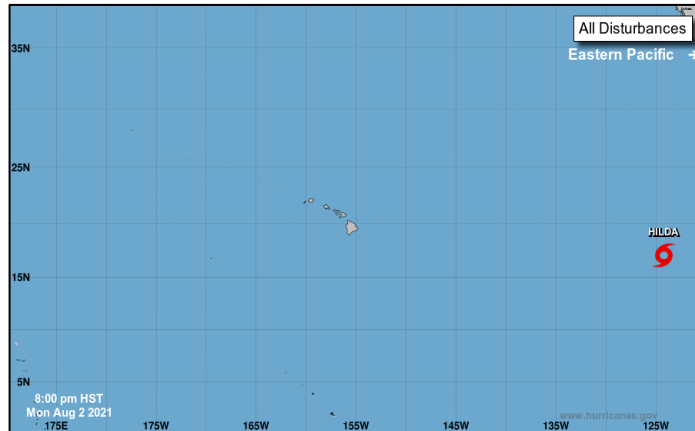

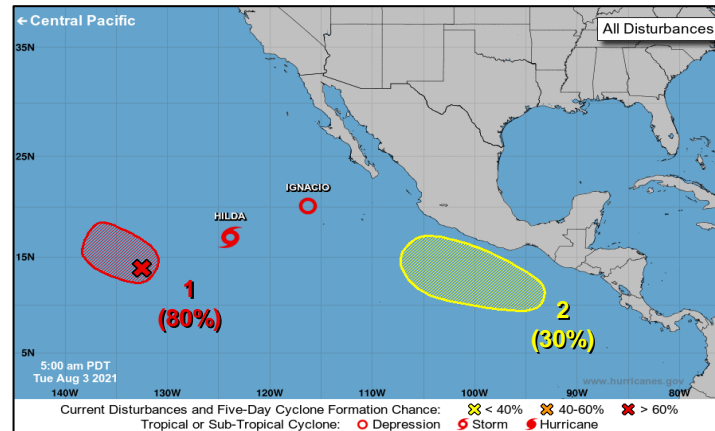
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# Tropical Outlook – Five Day

## Eastern Pacific



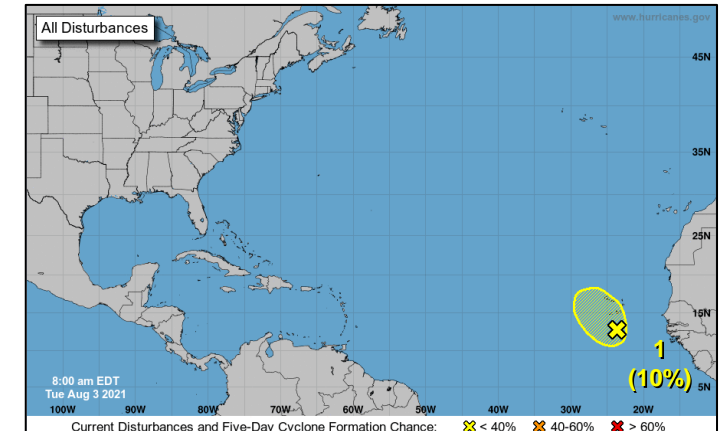
### Disturbance 1 (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- 1,500 miles WSW of the southern tip of Baja California
- A tropical depression likely to form today
- Formation chance – 48-hour: High (80%); 5-day: High (80%)

### Disturbance 2 (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- Expected to develop a few hundred miles S of the southern coast of Mexico late this week
- Formation chance – 48-hour: Low (near 0%); 5-day: Low (30%)

## Atlantic



### Disturbance 1 (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- Few hundred miles S of 120 miles Praia in the Cabo Verde Islands
- Some slow development possible during the next day or two
- Formation chance – 48-hour: Low (10%); 5-day: Low (10%)



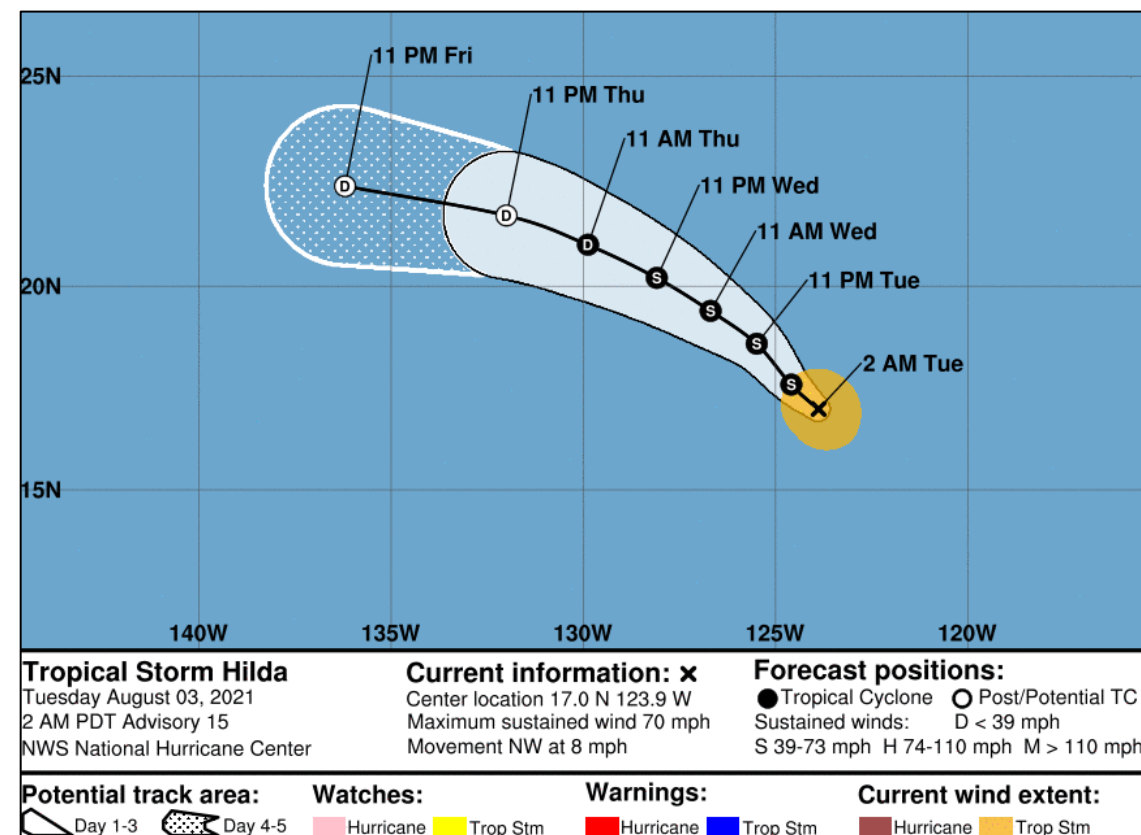
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# Tropical Storm Hilda – Eastern Pacific

**Situation:** (Advisory #15 as of 5:00 a.m. ET)

- 995 miles WSW of the southern tip of Baja California
- Moving NW at 8 mph
- Maximum sustained winds 70 mph
- Forecast to weaken into a tropical depression by Thursday
- Tropical-storm-force winds extend 80 miles



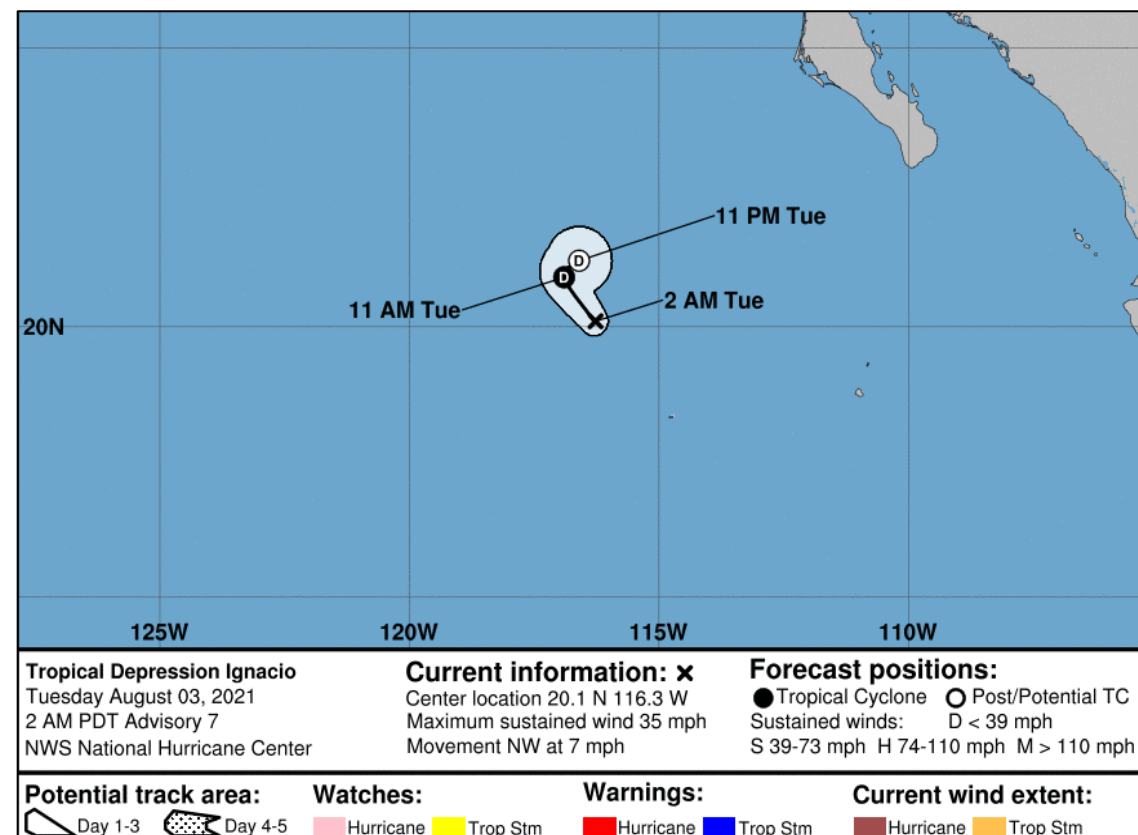
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# Tropical Depression Ignacio – Eastern Pacific

**Situation:** (Advisory #7 as of 5:00 a.m. ET)

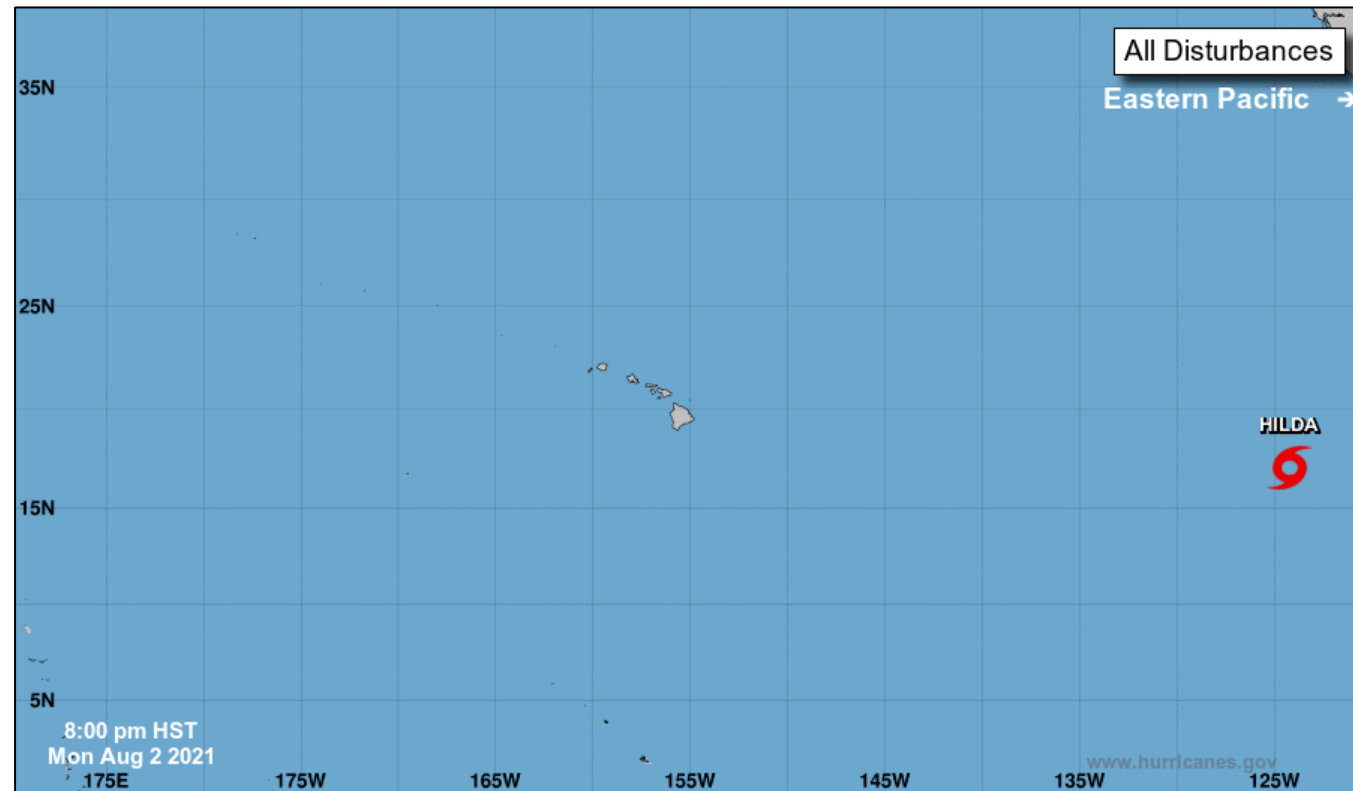
- 455 miles WSW of the southern tip of Baja California
- Moving NW at 7 mph
- Maximum sustained winds 35 mph
- Expected to degenerate into a remnant low by tonight

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# Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall

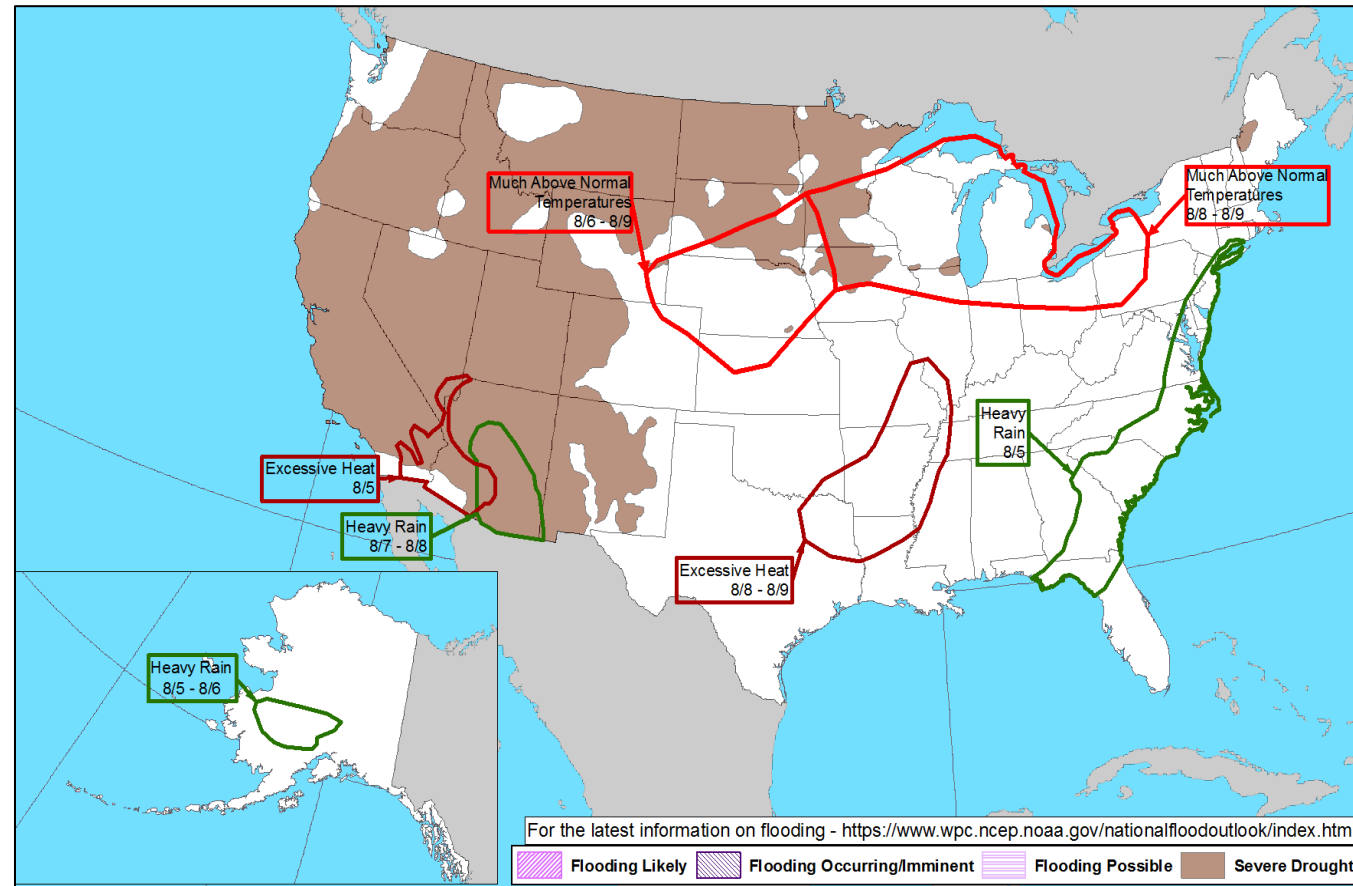

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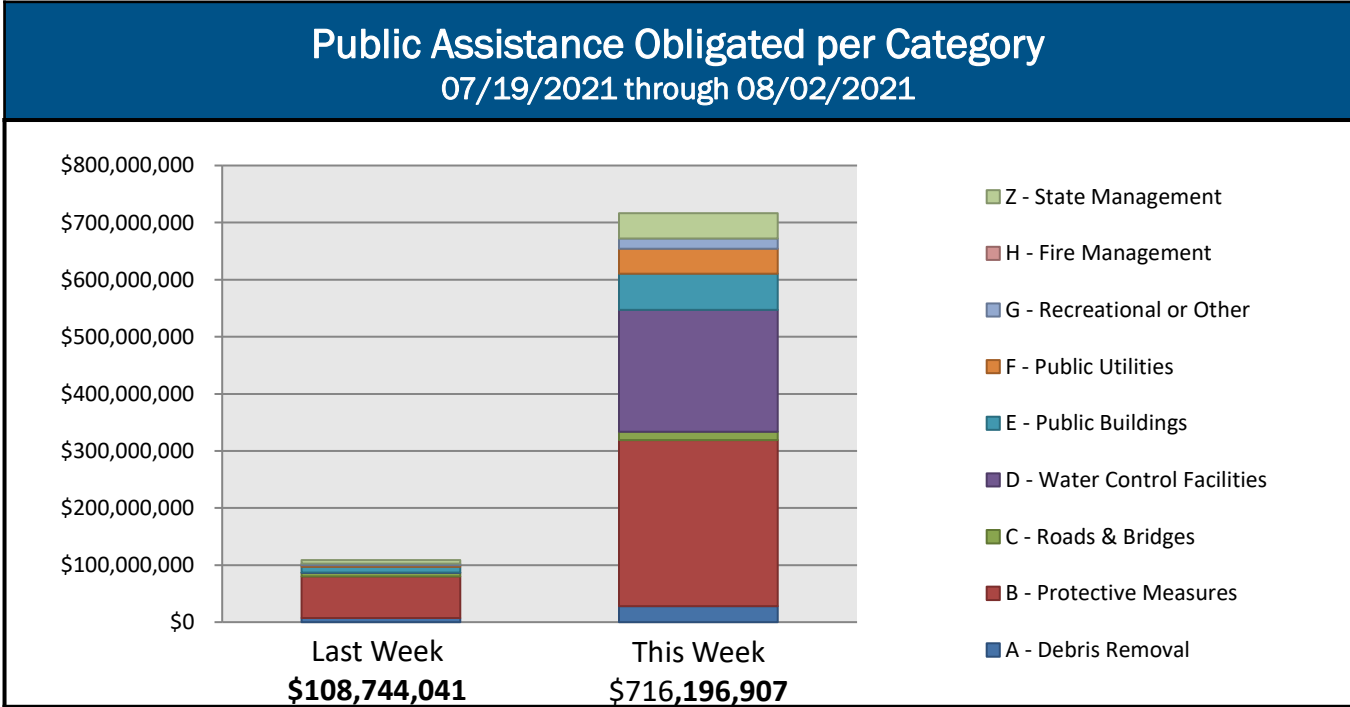

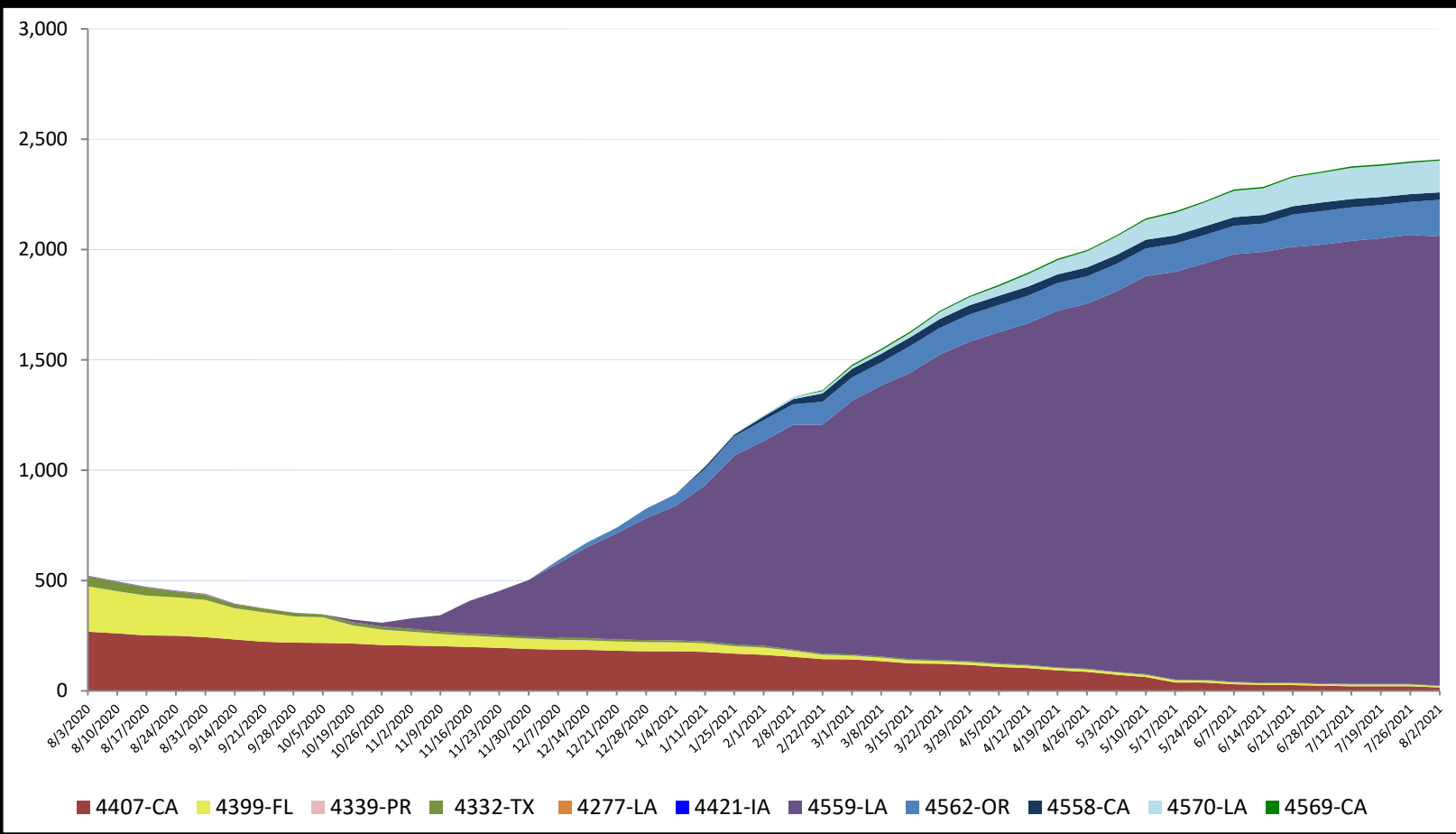

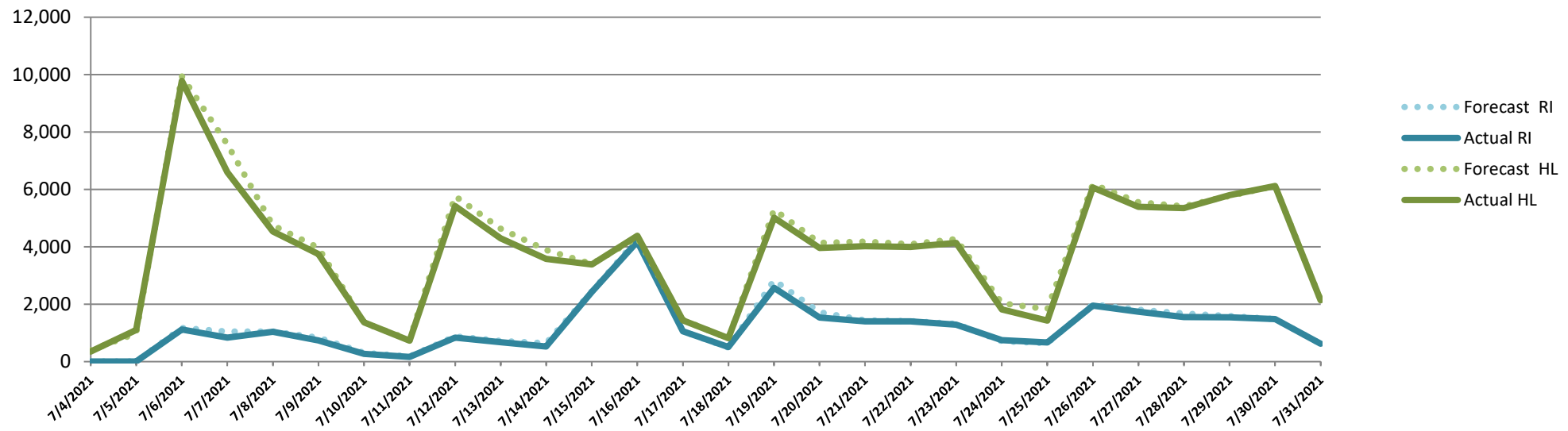

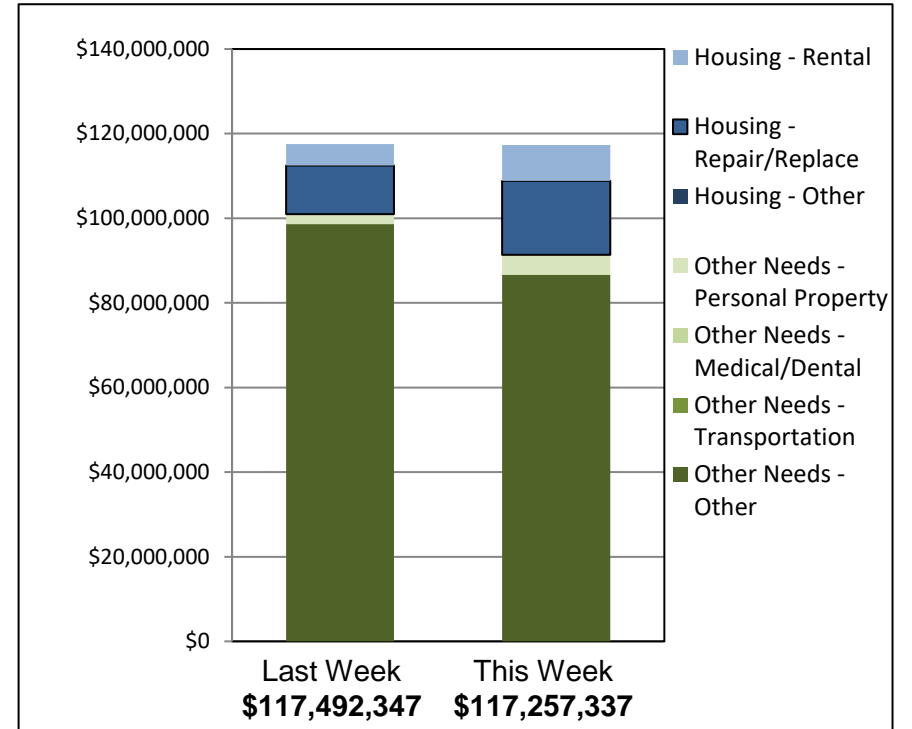
NPSC Call Forecasting and Actual Calls Over the Past 4 Weeks
