


# **Tropical Outlook - Five Day**

 No new tropical cyclones are expected during the next five days


#### **Eastern Pacific**



#### Disturbance 1 (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- Located a few hundred miles SSW of Manzanillo, Mexico
- Tropical depression could form by the weekend
- Formation chance through 48 hours: Low (near 0%); 5 days: Med (40%)

#### **Atlantic**



#### Hurricane Sam (CAT 4) (Advisory 23 as of 5:00 a.m. ET)

#### Disturbance 1 (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- Located several hundred miles SW of the Cabo Verde Islands
- Tropical depression likely to form during next couple of days
- Formation chance: 48 hours: High (70%); 5 days: High (80%)

#### **Disturbance 2** (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- Located over far eastern tropical Atlantic
- Tropical depression likely to form in a day or two
- Formation chance: 48 hours: High (80%); 5 days: High (90%)

#### Disturbance 3 (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- Located about 350 miles east-northeast of Bermuda
- Could become a short-lived tropical depression
- Formation chance: 48 hours: Med (50%); 5 days: Med (50%)



### **Hurricane Sam – Atlantic**


#### Situation: (Advisory 23 as of 5:00 a.m. ET)

- 810 miles E of the northern Leeward Islands
- Moving NW at 9 mph
- Maximum sustained winds 130 mph
- Hurricane-force winds extend outward 40 miles.
- Tropical-storm-force winds extend outward up to 125 miles
- Sam is forecast to pass well northeast of the northern Leeward Islands on Wednesday and Thursday
