- Elevated fire weather – Southern TX

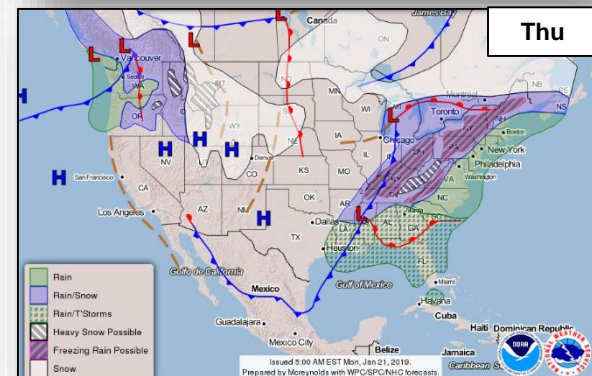
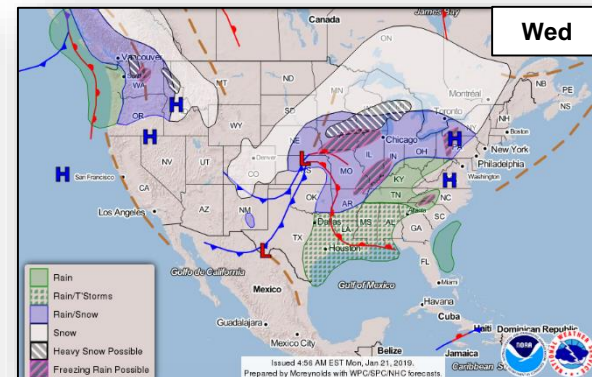
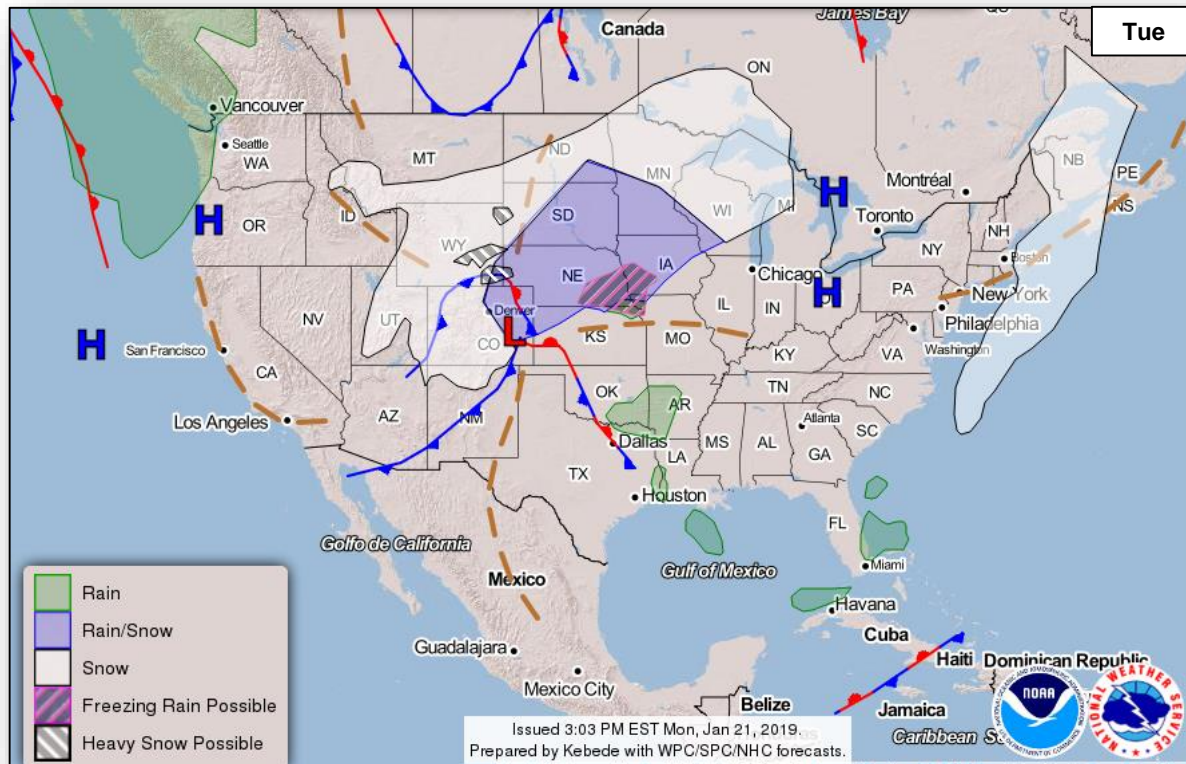

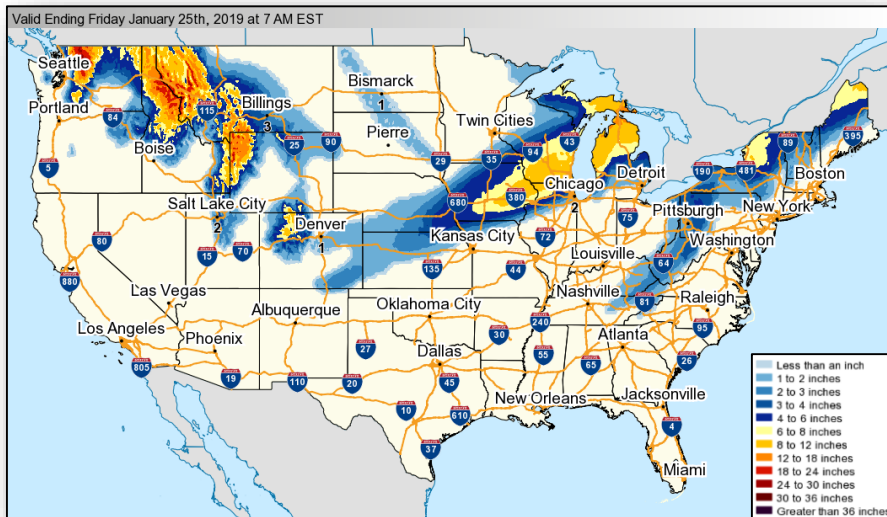

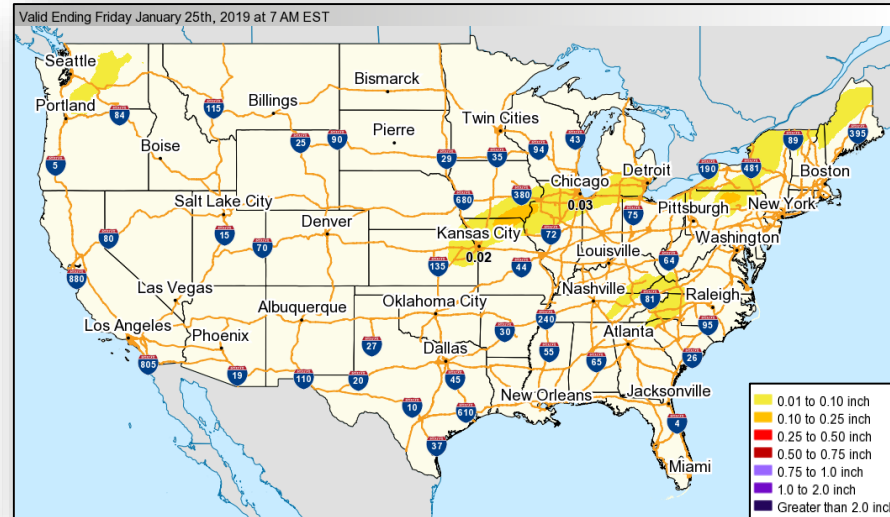
Winter Precipitation Outlook

Forecast Snowfall

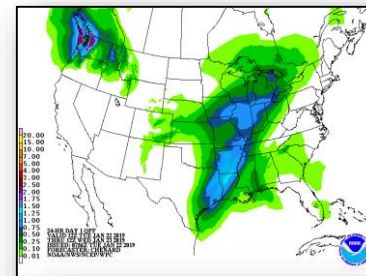
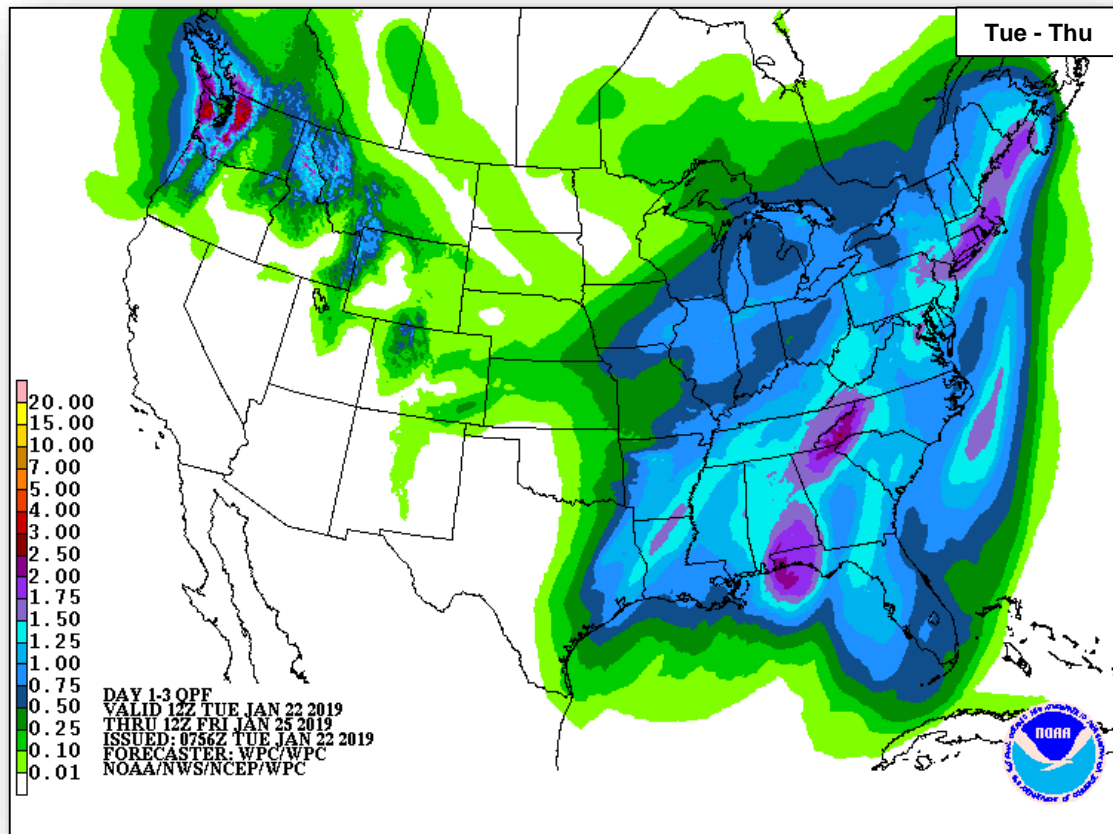


Forecast Ice Accumulation

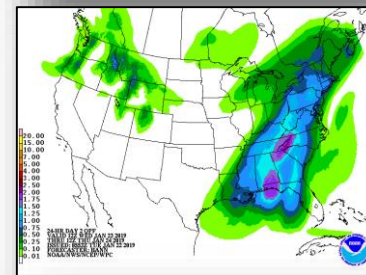
Precipitation Forecast



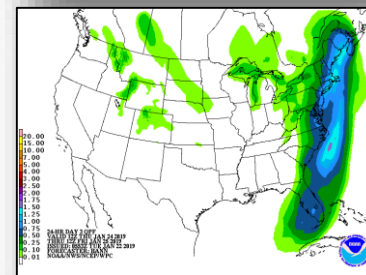
