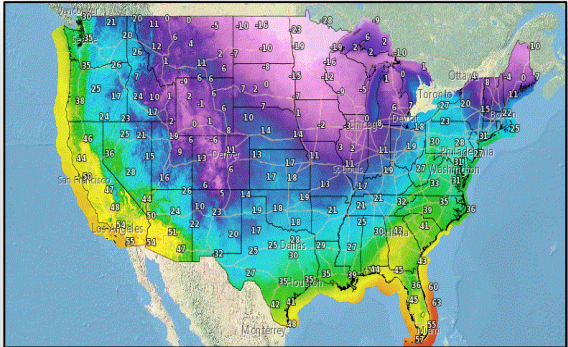

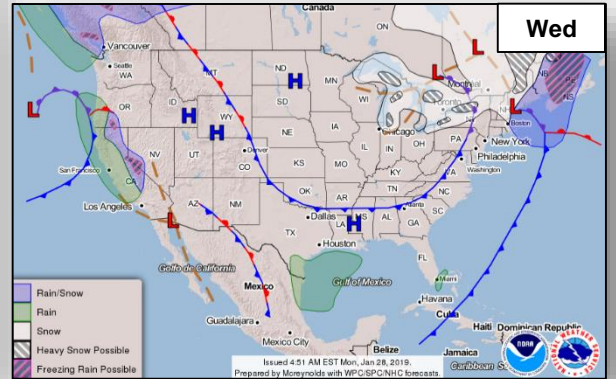
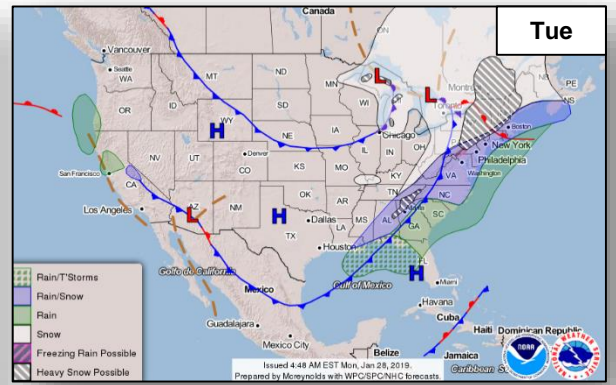
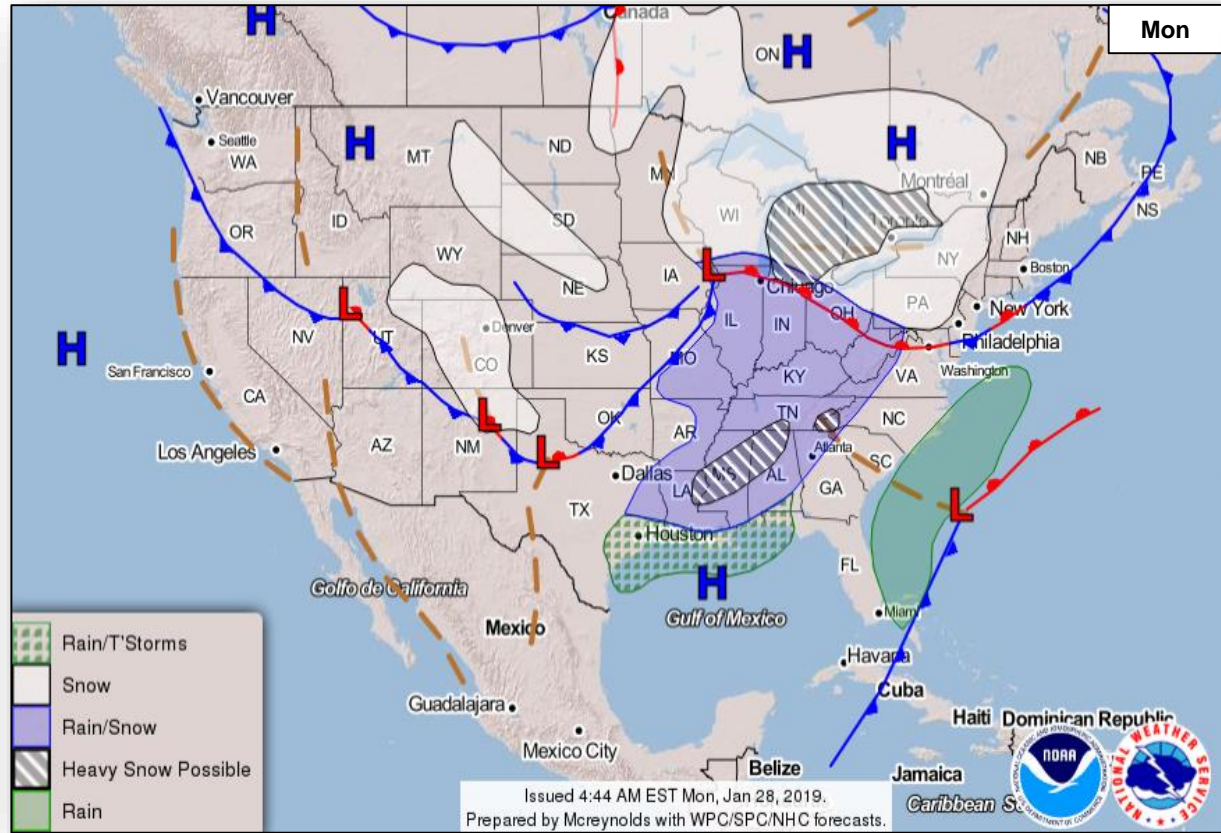


Minimum Temperatures – Tuesday

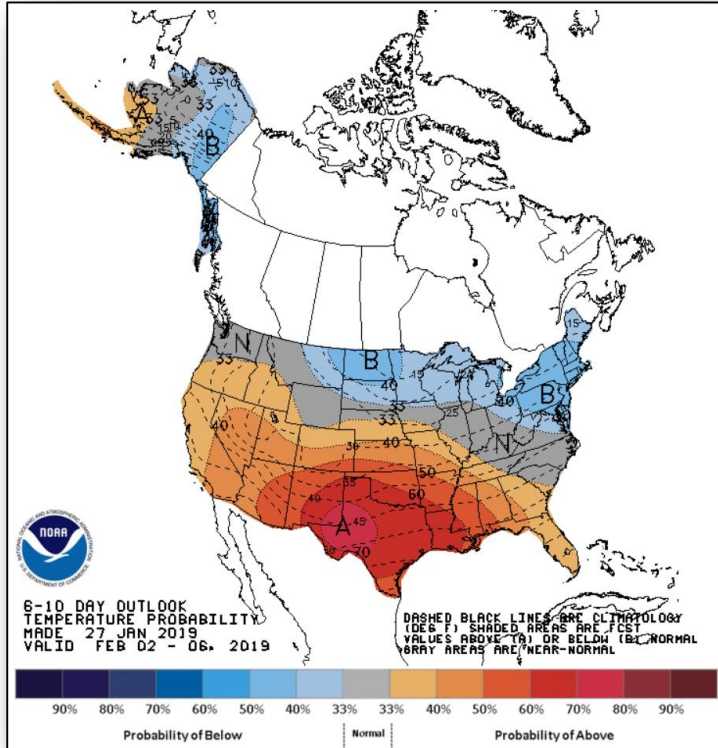


Minimum Temperatures – Wednesday

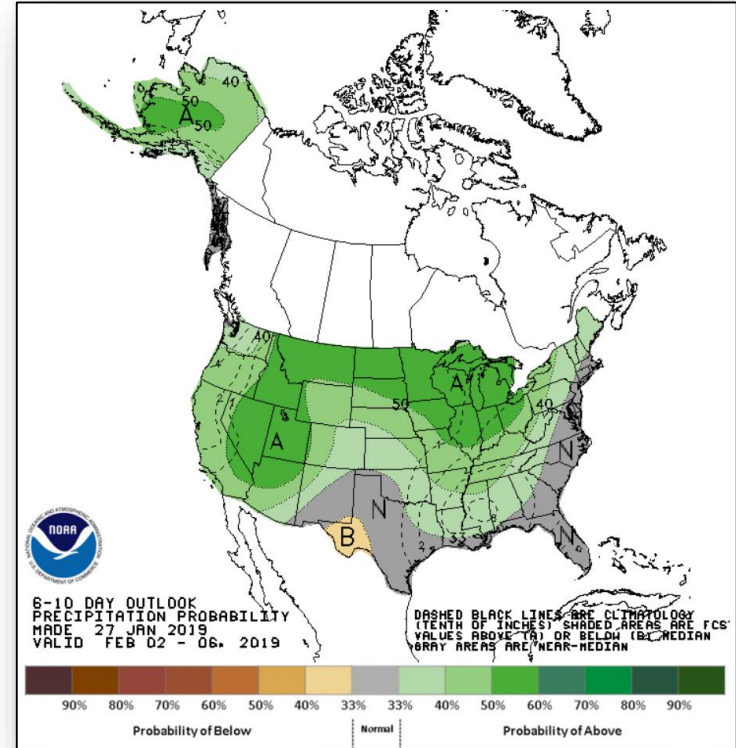
National Weather Forecast

6 - 10 Day Precipitation Probability

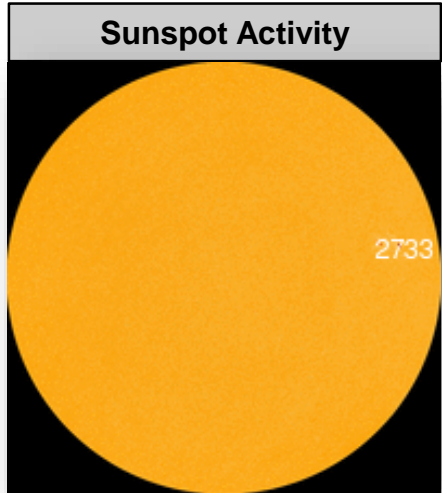
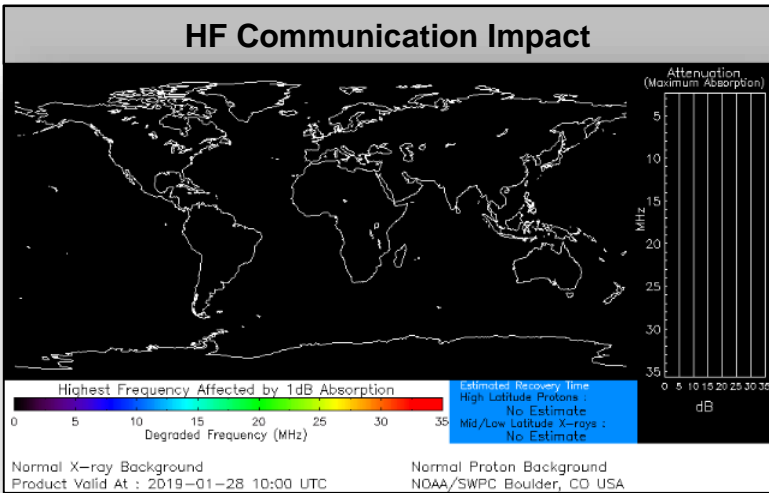
