## MOST LIKELY ARRIVAL OF TS WINDS



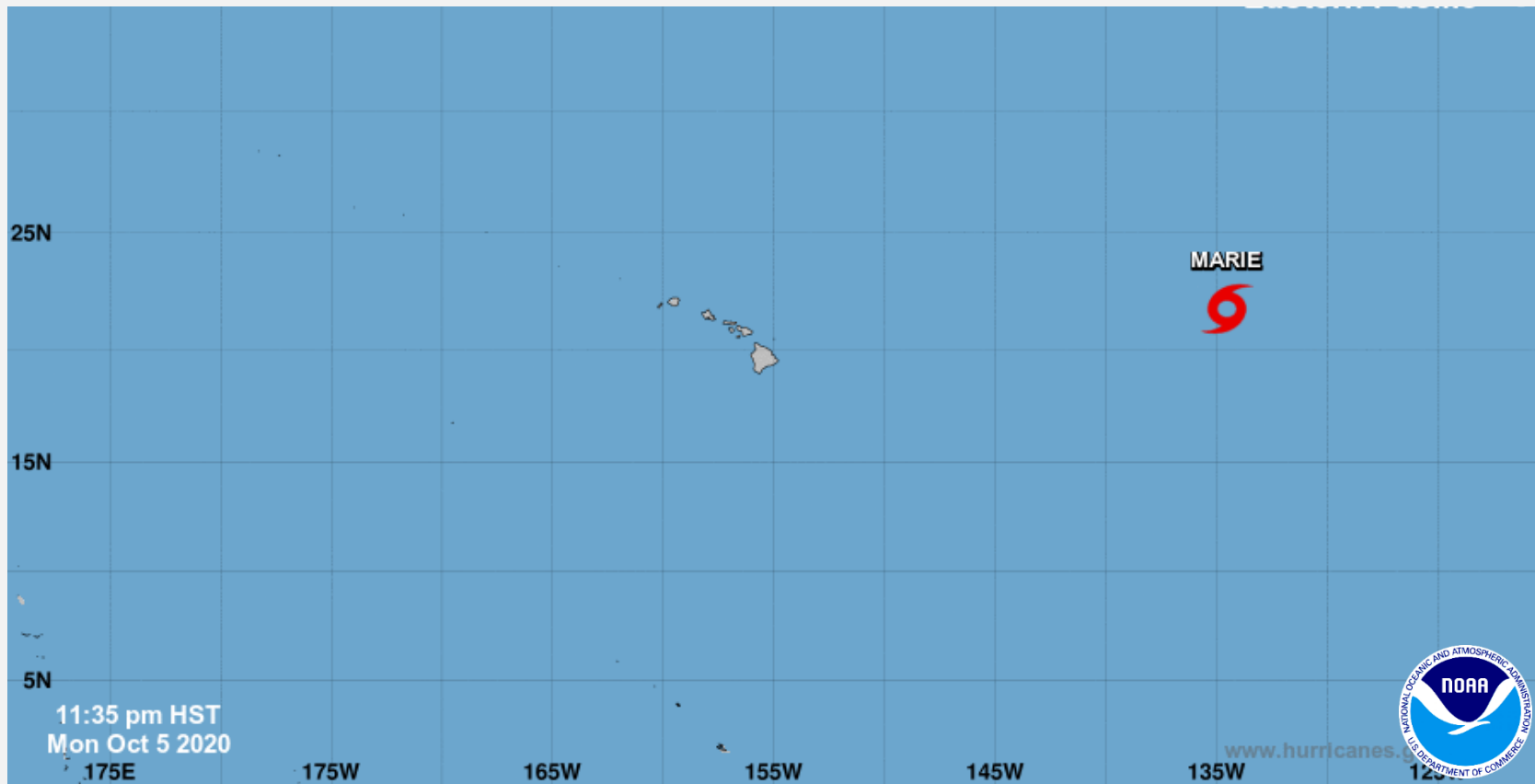

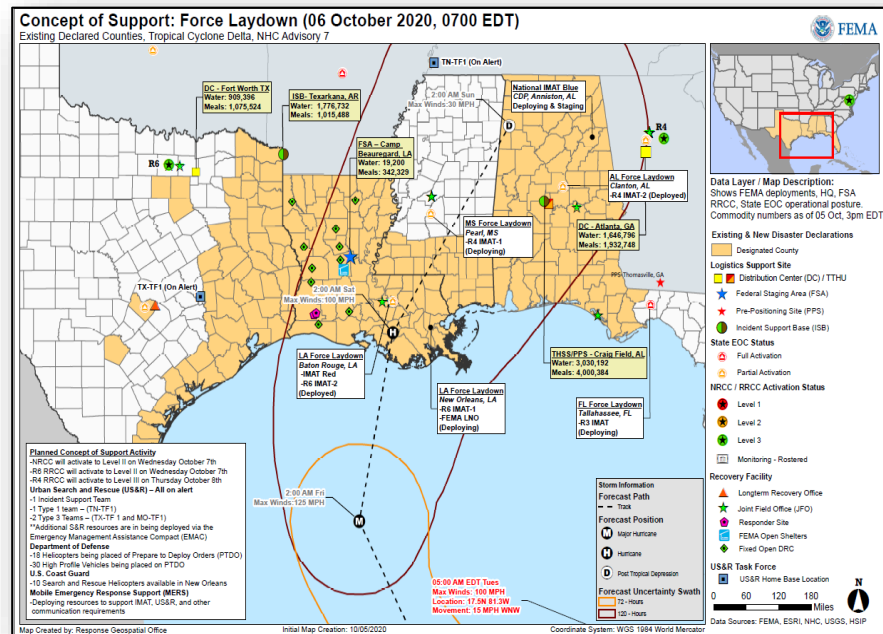
**Situation:** Hurricane Delta threatens portions of the Gulf Coast. In anticipation national and regional assets are deploying.

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## 5-day Rainfall Today through Saturday

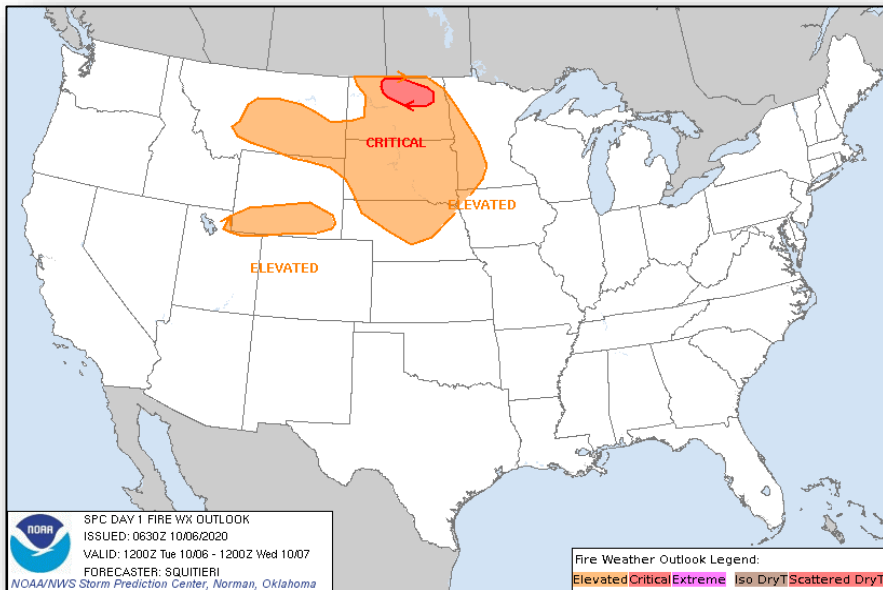

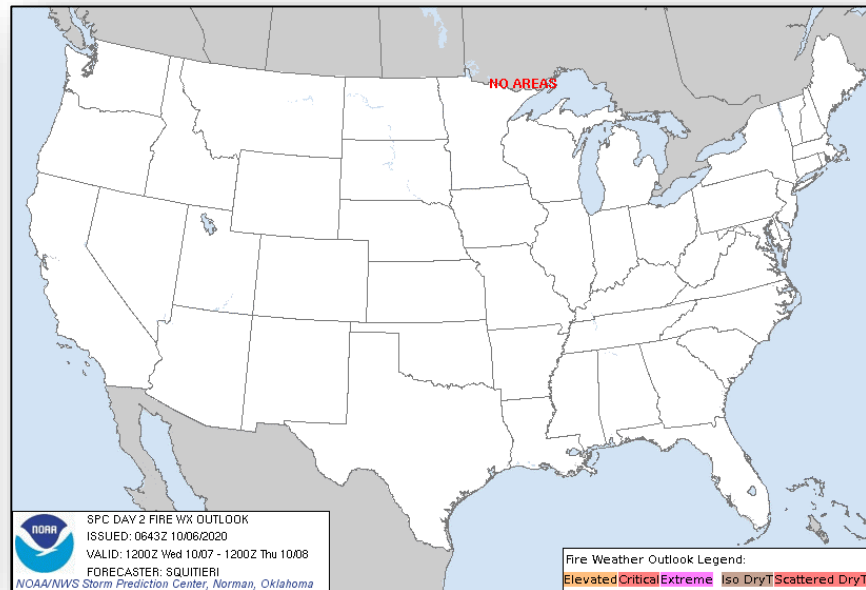

# Wildfires – Western US - FINAL



**Situation:** Of the over 7 million acres burned, the National Watch Center continues to track 11 active fires that have burned nearly 2 million acres from the West Coast to the Rocky Mountains. Mandatory evacuations continue throughout the impacted regions. No reported unmet needs.

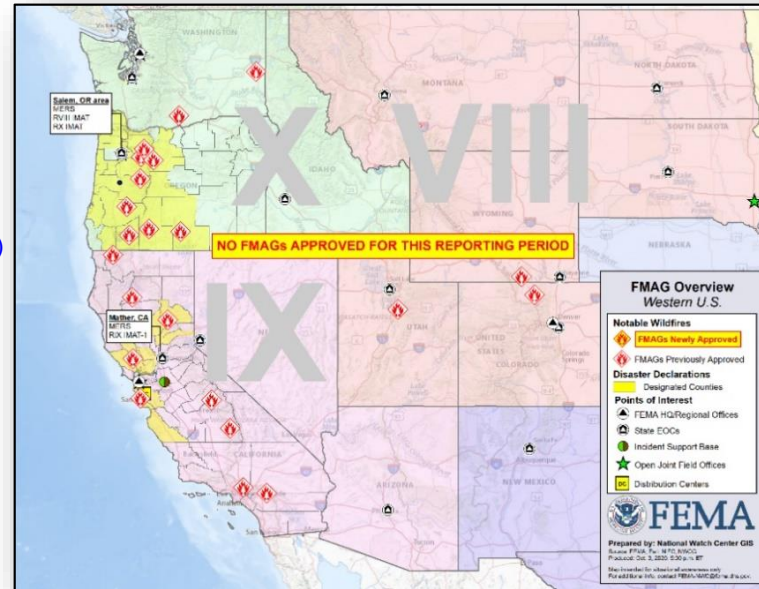

**Situation:** Upward trajectory in COVID-19 case count continues across **33 (+4)** states/territories, with **4 (-4)** states/territories in a plateau status, and 19 states/territories on a downward trajectory. 16,763 National Guard deployed / activated; **1,279 (-14)** FEMA employees deployed. (COVID-19 SLB, as of Oct 5)

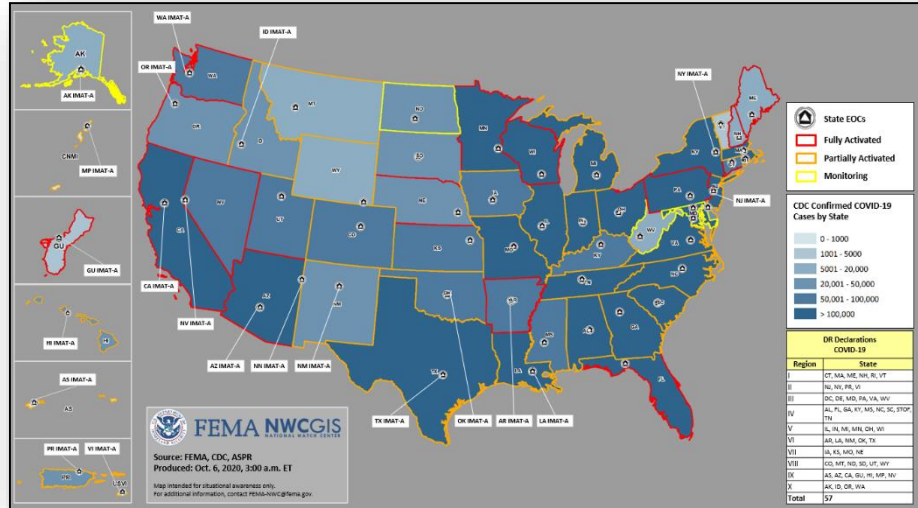

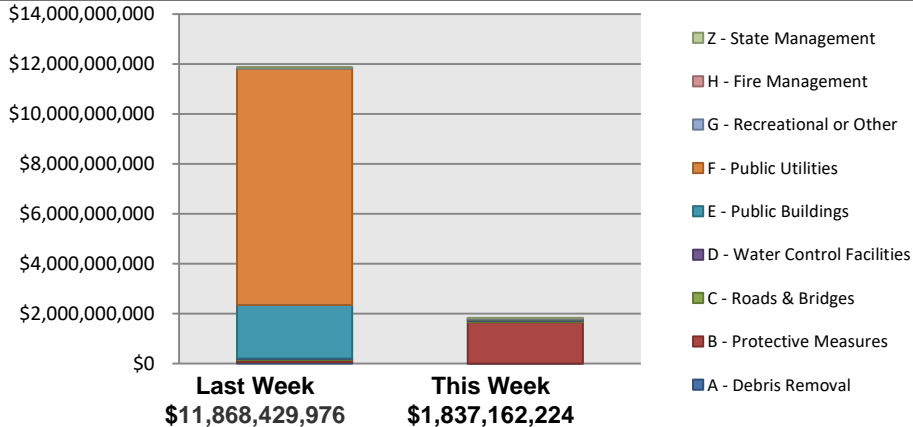

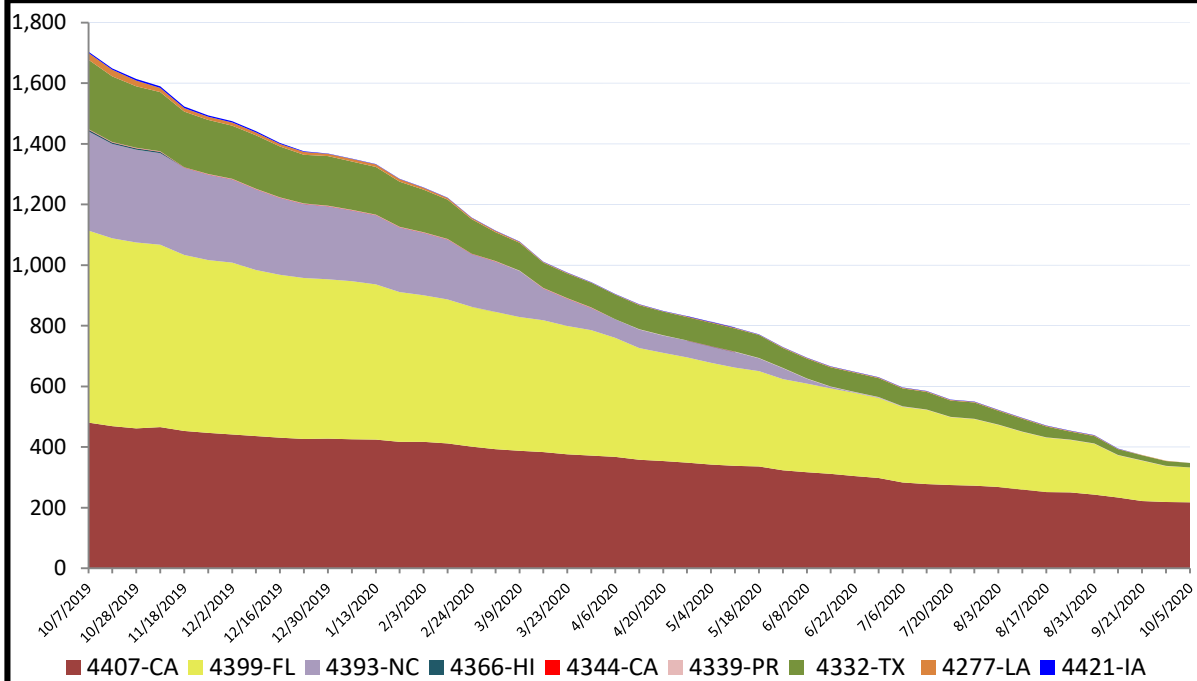

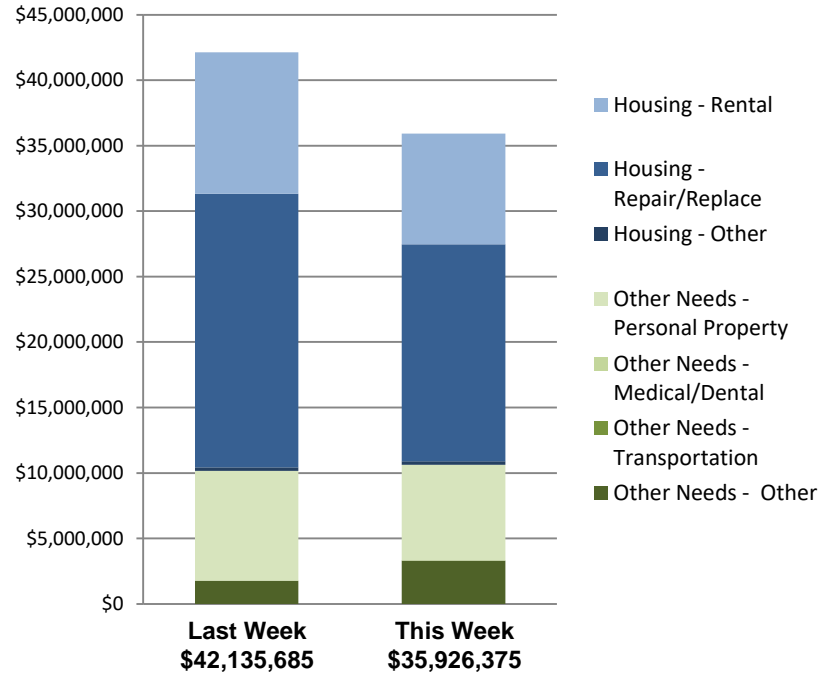
States with Currently Occupied Units
