



 No new tropical cyclones expected during the next five days


Eastern Pacific



Tropical Storm Pamela (Advisory #5 as of 5:00 a.m. ET)

- 490 miles S of Mazatlan, Mexico
- Moving WNW at 12 mph
- Maximum sustained winds 50 mph
- Tropical-storm- force winds extend 70 miles
- Forecast to become a hurricane by tonight and could a major hurricane before it reaches the coast
- On the forecast track , Pamela will pass S of the southern tip of the Baja California peninsula Tue night or early Wed and make landfall on west-central mainland Mexico on Wed

Disturbance 1 (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)


- 350 miles ESE of Windward Islands
- Regardless of development, could produce locally heavy rain and gusty winds across the Virgin Islands on Wednesday
- Formation chance: 48 hours: Low (20%); 5 days: Low (20%)

Disturbance 2 (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- Located over the eastern Caribbean Sea
- Regardless of development, locally heavy rain is possible over portions of Puerto Rico during the next couple of days
- Formation chance: 48 hours: Low (near 0%); 5 days: Low (20%)




National Weather Forecast






Severe Weather Outlook







Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall





Fire Weather Outlook









6-10 Day Temperature Probability





6-10 Day Precipitation Probability


