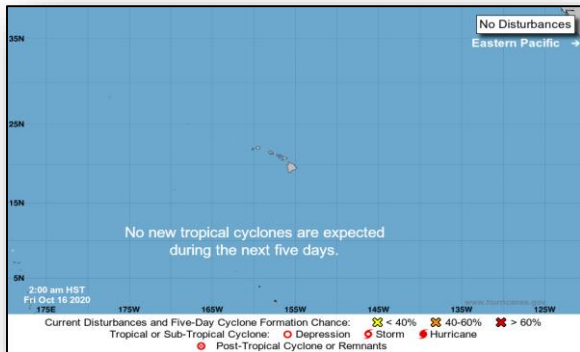
Tropical Activity:

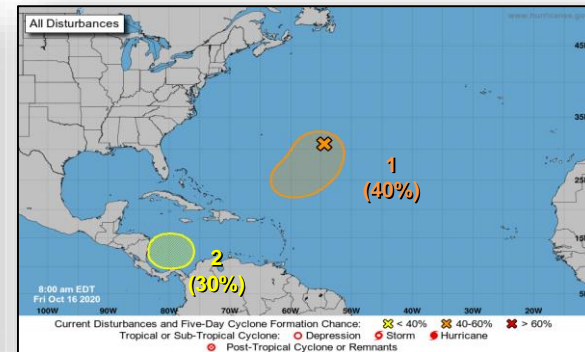

- 600 miles ESE of Bermuda
- Additional gradual development possible
- Formation chance through 48 hours: Low (20%)
- Formation chance through 5 days: Medium (40%)

Disturbance 2 (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- Over the SW Caribbean Sea
- Some gradual development possible
- Formation chance through 48 hours: Low (near 0%)
- Formation chance through 5 days: Low (30%)

Situation: Upward trajectory in COVID-19 case count continues across 38 states/territories, with 8 (+4) jurisdictions in a plateau status, and 10 (-4) jurisdictions on a downward trajectory; 1,248 (-2) FEMA employees deployed. (COVID-19 SLB, as of Oct 15)

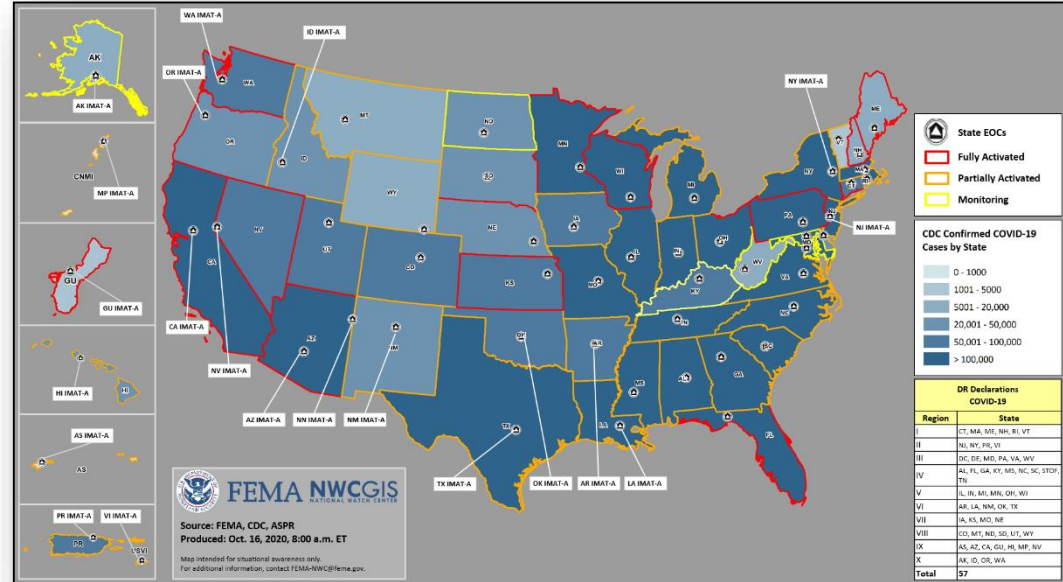
Nationwide Testing: 129,901,989 (+1,038,021) cumulative (COVID-19 SLB, as of Oct 15)

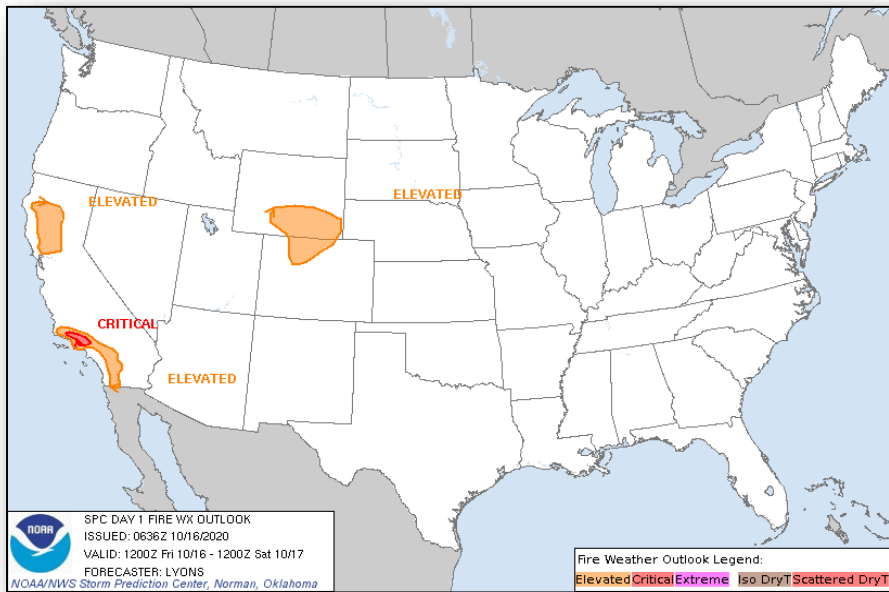
- NRCC conducting COVID response operations

- NWC, all RWCs, and MOCs are monitoring



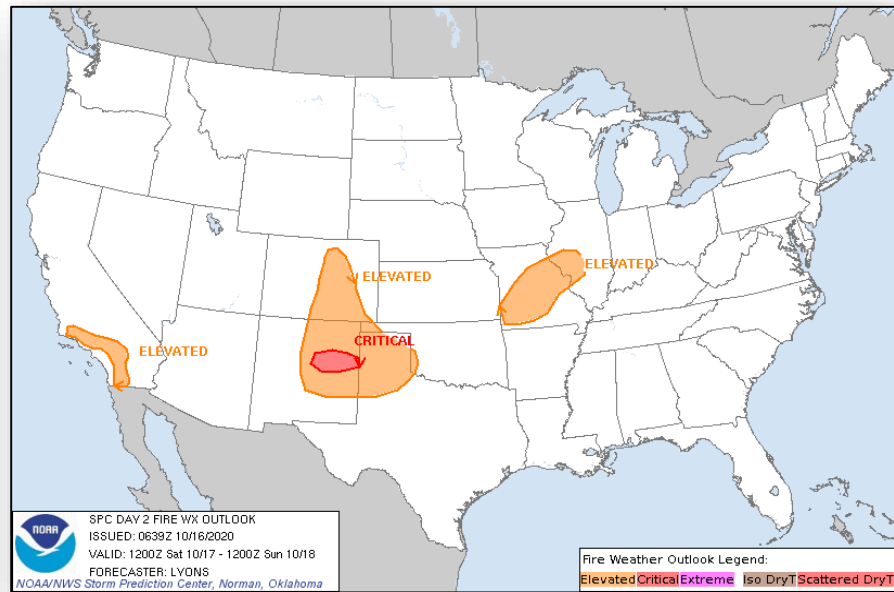
National Weather Forecast

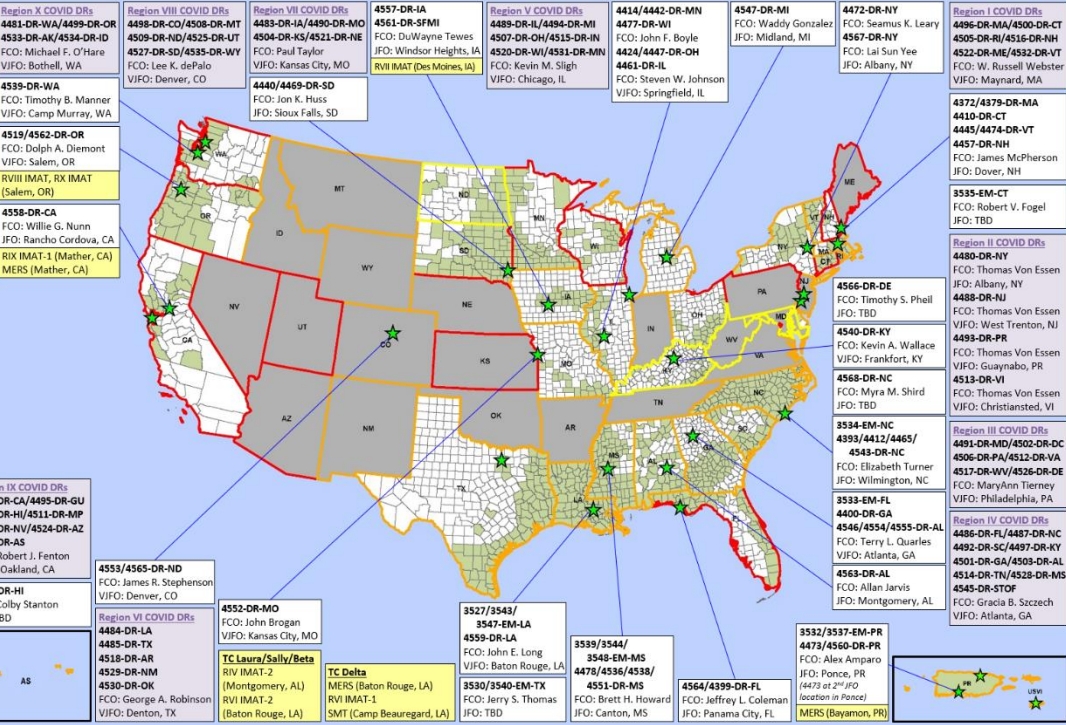
