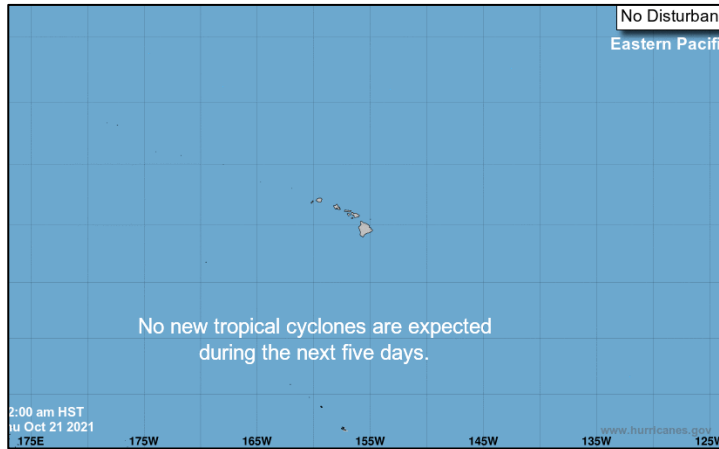

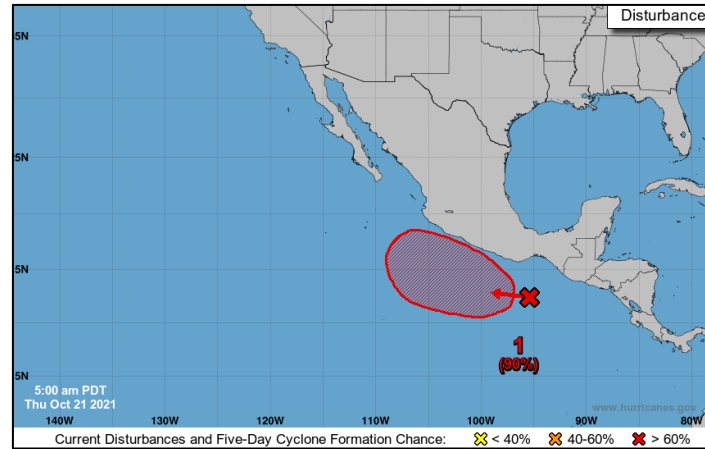
Tropical Outlook – Five Day

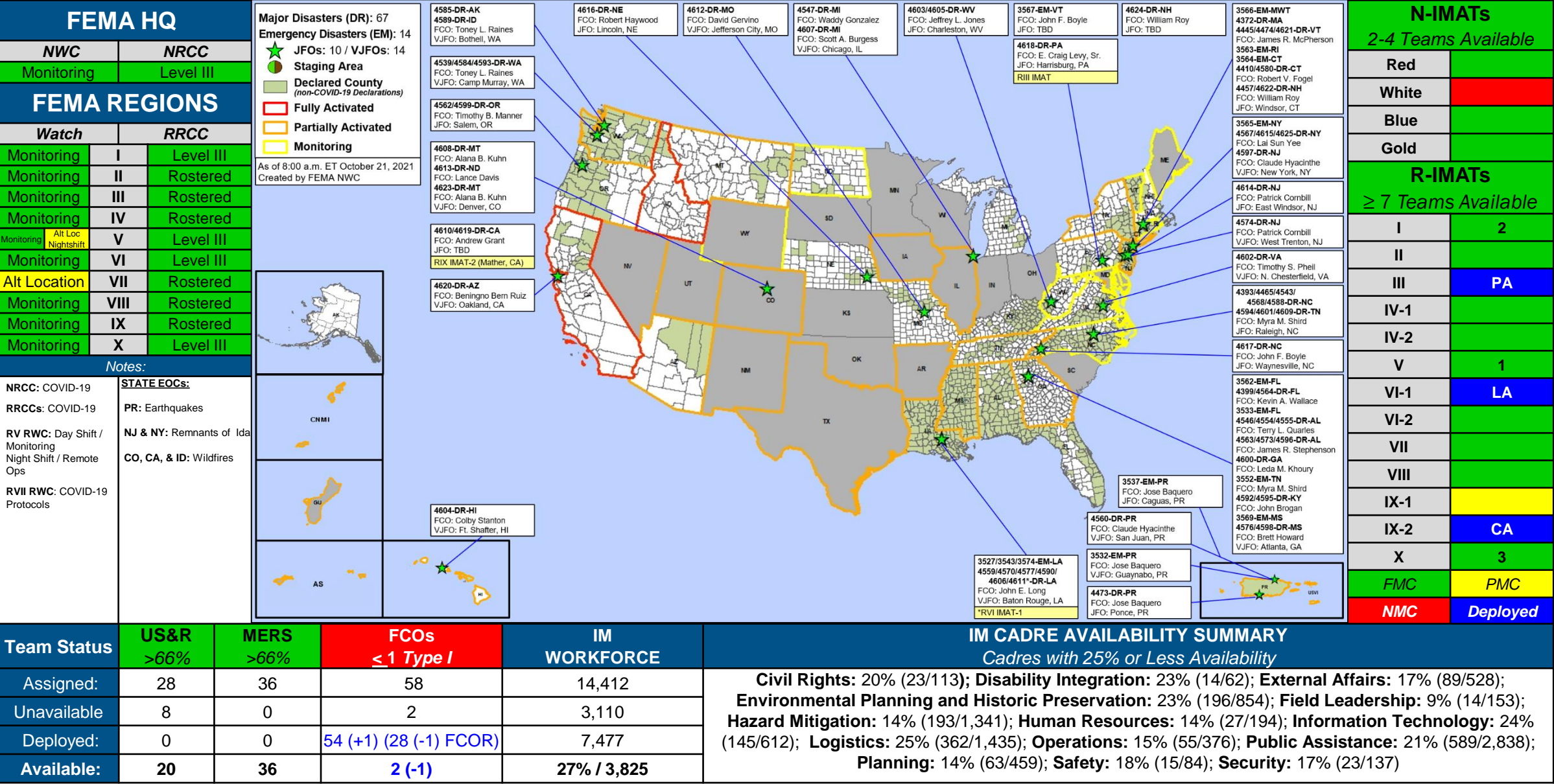
